Then, after Finn's investment of 30 billion Federal coins, the total market value of Activision Blizzard will reach around 47 billion Federal coins.

On calculation using this ratio, the shareholding percentage of Artis Electronics will reduce to 8.6%, and that of Vivandi will shrink to around 3.6%.
