Sect Master 431

Chapter 431: Plan

Back in the day, when Meng Zhang detained Shangguan Wen from the Earthfire Sect, he allowed the Earthfire Sect to attack the Flying Swan Sect. Later, he used Shangguan Wen to convince the remaining disciples of the Earthfire Sect to surrender, eventually taking over the Earthfire Sect's mountain gate. His actions were twofold - to prevent Shangguan Wen from leaking the information and earning the Flying Swan Sect's enmity and to safeguard the lives of the remaining Earthfire Sect disciples from retaliation.

As a Gold Core Daoist Master now, those past events were trivial matters to both the Flying Swan Sect and Meng Zhang. The Flying Swan Sect would not bother confronting Meng Zhang, a Gold Core Daoist Master, over such matters at this point.

The Earthfire Sect now had a place to hold on and preserve their legacy. Meng Zhang fulfilled his promise, and with his current identity and strength, he had no worries about any dissatisfaction or grudges from the remnants of the Earthfire Sect. If those remnants didn't wise up, they might find their sect eradicated sooner or later, without any need for Meng Zhang to order it.

After dealing with this insignificant matter, Meng Zhang had a deep realization. In the Cultivation World, one's cultivation base indeed held great significance. A higher cultivation base and realm would solve many difficult problems effortlessly. While Meng Zhang handled various affairs of Taiyi Sect, Gu Yue Huaidie finally communicated with the Flying Swan Sect.

The Flying Swan Sect agreed to let Gu Yue Huaidie enter the Mirage Secret Realm, but she must not cause extensive damage to the environment inside, affecting the growth of various spiritual herbs. In return, Gu Yue Huaidie would organize Meng Zhang and others to join forces in attacking the Demon Wind Gobi, helping the Flying Swan Sect relieve the pressure from the demon beast army.

Gu Yue Huaidie came to Taiyi Sect and brought this good news to Meng Zhang. She also met with Luo YeDaoist Master. Although Luo YeDaoist Master had some reservations about Gu Yue Huaidie, she remained straightforward and focused on the matter at hand. The Mirage Secret Realm originally opened approximately once every hundred years, but Gu Yue Huaidie had a way to open it ahead of schedule. Of course, opening the Mirage Secret Realm early required favorable timing, location, and personnel.

Although Gu Yue Huaidie's organization meant that Meng Zhang already had plans to attack the Demon Wind Gobi, to resolve Luo YeDaoist Master's issue quickly, it was better to stick to the original plan and hunt down the Golden Tiger outside the Demon Wind Gobi.

Having spent years in the Dark Alliance, the Golden Tiger had disclosed a lot of information about his own background and secrets. After leaving the Dark Alliance, the organization made significant efforts to track him down, uncovering many of his secrets. In the Endless Sea of Sand, Dark

Alliance was reluctant to easily dispatch a Gold Core Daoist Master for fear of misunderstanding from Primordial Spirit True Monarchs. However, they had established and developed black markets in various places in the Cultivation World, gaining tacit approval from many major forces.

Even though the Endless Sea of Sand seemed to be under the Flying Swan Sect's control, the Dark Alliance managed to convince the Flying Swan Sect to establish a black market there.

Investigating Golden Tiger was not a top priority for the Dark Alliance, and they wouldn't invest too much effort in this matter. However, the intelligence capabilities of the black market were quite impressive. With routine investigations, they gained a lot of information related to Golden Tiger.

After deciding to take action against Golden Tiger, Luo YeDaoist Master put considerable effort into gathering all kinds of information related to him. With a Gold Core Daoist Master personally intervening and offering generous rewards, even though the black market in the Endless Sea of Sand was not under Luo YeDaoist Master's control, they still cooperated and diligently investigated the matter.

Combining the years of intelligence collected by the black market with the latest investigation results, Luo YeDaoist Master uncovered a major secret about Golden Tiger. For years, Golden Tiger had been secretly enslaving Human Clan cultivators, even going so far as to turn some of them into Human Pets, using them to carry out covert operations throughout the Endless Sea of Sand.

Although it was unclear what secret activities these cultivators were engaged in, their activities seemed to be somehow connected to the Purple Gold Sect from the past. Given that the Purple Gold Sect was once a major cultivation sect with a Primordial Spirit True Monarch, the measures left behind by the Primordial Spirit True Monarch were not easily discernible even to a group of Gold Core Daoist Masters. At that time, it would be the perfect opportunity for everyone to ambush Golden Tiger.

However, before that, they needed to select a suitable place for the ambush from the activities of Golden Tiger's Human Pets that would effectively deceive Golden Tiger while facilitating their plan.

Chapter 432: Past events

Luo Ye, a Daoist Master, took out a map that showed the area where the Golden Tiger kept its human pets and where they had previously been active. The three Gold Core Daoist Masters needed to search these places separately to find the traces left by the senior members of the Purple Gold Sect, so they could choose a suitable location to set up an ambush.

They would work together to open the small world left by Purple Gold Sect and, after entering that small world, they absolutely could not kill each other. They had to face all kinds of dangers together and present a united front to the outside world.

As for the distribution of treasures, whoever got it first would keep it, and those obtained together would be distributed according to the amount of effort each person put in. Even if someone had a treasure that others needed, they had to negotiate a trade and could not take it by force.

They didn't know what situation they would encounter in advance, so they could only reach a rough agreement first. To reassure each other, the three of them made a heart demon oath to ensure that they would not violate the agreement.

As for Deep Earth Spirit General and Wen Qiansun, Foundation Building cultivators did not yet have the qualifications to join the agreement between Gold Core Daoist Masters. Moreover, they were disciples of Taiyi Sect and were naturally regarded as part of Meng Zhang. With this agreement, the three Gold Core Daoist Masters no longer had any worries and could trust their companions with their backs.

The biggest problem now was how to communicate with the void and enter that small world through this Great Void Restriction. To maintain the operation of the Great Void Restriction, so many hidden arrangements had to be left throughout the entire Endless Sea of Sand. Now that Meng Zhang and the others had discovered these arrangements, they had to use them to figure out the details of the Great Void Restriction. In this regard, Deep Earth Spirit General and Wen Qiansun could provide great assistance.

Of course, they were currently only at the Foundation Building stage of cultivation base. Because the difference in cultivation base was too great, even if their formation skills were high, they would probably encounter many difficulties. Gu Yue Huaidie's formation skills were not weak, but they were far from enough. As for Meng Zhang and Luo Ye, they could only say that they had a basic understanding of the way of formation.

Chapter 435: Spiritual Tool

The small world left behind by the three Gold Core Daoist Masters of the Purple Gold Sect faces a significant challenge: competition from other rivals.

Golden Tiger, a spirit pet of the previous generation of the Purple Gold Sect, undoubtedly knows many secrets of the sect. He dispatched his Human Pet to search for these places, indicating that he likely knows about the Great Void Restriction, but his knowledge is not detailed enough.

If the small world left behind by the Purple Gold Sect is opened, that guy Golden Tiger will definitely come to seize it.

Furthermore, as the new overlord of the Endless Sea of Sand, the Flying Swan Sect has ruled over the area for many years. To say that they are completely unaware of the Purple Gold Sect's arrangements would be underestimating them. As for how much the Flying Swan Sect actually knows, that remains unknown.

As the landlord, even though the current situation is not favorable for the Flying Swan Sect, their threat cannot be ignored. Over the years, the Flying Swan Sect has relentlessly hunted down the remnants of the Purple Gold Sect, almost wiping out the majority of cultivators associated with the Purple Gold Sect. The threat from the descendants of the Purple Gold Sect can be disregarded. If the three Gold Core Daoist Masters want to swallow this piece of fat, they will indeed face numerous difficulties.

After discussing among themselves, the three individuals took separate actions.

Deep Earth Spirit General and Wen Qiansun each utilized their respective expertise to continue researching the Great Void Restriction.

On the other hand, Gu Yue Huaidie planned to use the small world left behind by the Purple Gold Sect as bait to contact some reliable Gold Core Daoist Masters and gain more assistance.

Even in the face of the temptation of the inheritance left behind by the Primordial Spirit major sects, Gu Yue Huaidie remained calm and unwilling to involve the Gu Yue Family in this muddy water. The disputes behind the Endless Sea of Sand are too complex and could bury the Gold Core sects.

Other Gold Core Daoist Masters, especially some loose cultivators without sects or factions, have no attachments or concerns, and most likely cannot resist the temptation of the inheritance from the Primordial Spirit True Monarch.

Although it is true that having one more Gold Core Daoist Master means having one more opponent to share the spoils of war, it is still better to have more assistance before obtaining the treasures. Only then can there be a greater chance of entering that small world.

After all, it is a legacy left behind by the Primordial Spirit True Monarch. Even though that Primordial Spirit True Monarch has fallen for many years, no one dares to be careless.

Meng Zhang, as the core member, has not had enough time to cultivate a Divine Ability.

During the Foundation Building stage, he cultivated a small Divine Ability called Twin Forms Towards Heaven Sword. As long as he spends some time to re-cultivate it, he can elevate this small Divine Ability into a true Divine Ability.

In fact, the fastest way for Meng Zhang to enhance his combat power is to refine one or two suitable Third Rank magic tools.

Third Rank magic tools, also known as spiritual tools, can only fully unleash their power in the hands of a Gold Core Daoist Master.

Even in a bustling trading city like Great Wind City, there are not many spiritual tools available for sale. To buy a suitable spiritual tool, one truly needs some luck.

Even among Gold Core Daoist Masters, not everyone possesses a spiritual tool that meets their preferences.

Every time an excellent spiritual tool appears, it attracts competition among Gold Core Daoist Masters.

Meng Zhang has visited Great Wind City several times, but either he didn't come across any useful spiritual tools or the prices were driven up too high by competitors, making it unaffordable for him.

During an auction in Great Wind City, Meng Zhang encountered two spiritual tools that suited his preferences. Unfortunately, Meng Zhang's competition for the spiritual tool was an old Gold Core from the Jiuqu League, who had far more resources and connections than Meng Zhang. In the end, he returned empty-handed, highlighting the difference in the sect's background.

In the eyes of Taiyi Sect disciples, especially the elders, Taiyi Sect is considered to have risen. However, before Meng Zhang became a core member, Taiyi Sect was only a Foundation Building sect with limited resources.

After Meng Zhang became a core member, Taiyi Sect barely qualified as a Gold Core sect. However, with only Meng Zhang as a Gold Core Daoist Master and his short time as a core member, the sect had not accumulated much.

It is easy to imagine that if that small world were to open, Meng Zhang would undoubtedly encounter many powerful opponents and face significant danger.

If he had one more useful spiritual tool, his combat power would increase significantly, giving Meng Zhang more vitality. Just when Meng Zhang was feeling a bit overwhelmed, Shocking Thunder Spirit General reminded him.

In the spiritual eye of Taiyi Sect's old mountain gate spirit vein, there is a damaged spiritual weapon called the Spiritsnake Spear. The Spiritsnake Spear has self-repairing abilities, but it was too severely damaged, and its spirituality almost dissipated, making it unable to recover on its own.

After being nourished by the spiritual eye for many years, the spirituality of the Spiritsnake Spear has recovered significantly. If several suitable materials can be found for repair, the Spiritsnake Spear can temporarily restore most of its combat power.

Shocking Thunder Spirit General is very familiar with the Spiritsnake Spear spiritual weapon and has a deep understanding of refining techniques. He gave Meng Zhang a list that included several rare spiritual materials.

Meng Zhang or Taiyi Sect could not obtain these spiritual materials alone, so Meng Zhang had to seek help from Luo Ye, a female Daoist Master.

The Shadow Killing Sword did not match well with Meng Zhang's practiced techniques, but he could use the Lifeless Killing Sword technique to control the Shadow Killing Sword, unleashing about eighty percent of its power.

However, just when everyone was thinking hard about what to do, an unexpected help came to them and appeared in front of Meng Zhang.

Meng Zhang, who was practicing Divine Ability in Taiyi Sect, received a letter from Jin Qiao'er. The letter said that her master, Jin LiDaoist Master, wanted to meet with Meng Zhang. Meng Zhang knew that Jin LiDaoist Master was an experienced Gold Core Daoist Master with extensive Divine Ability. In the Cultivation World, age is not judged by appearance. Although this woman looked young, Meng Zhang couldn't even catch up with her in terms of her true age.

Meng Zhang had already learned some information about Jin LiDaoist Master from Jin Qiao'er's mouth. "Junior Meng Zhang, I have met Jin LiDaoist Master," he said respectfully. Jin LiDaoist

Master glanced at Meng Zhang and said, "You are quite bold. A few years ago, you and this girl Qiaoer ran into the Deadly Sea of Sand together." "This girl has always been ignorant of the heights of heaven and earth, and as a Sect Master, you should be more stable." Hearing Jin LiDaoist Master's reprimand, Jin Qiao'er, who was standing behind her, made a sorry expression to Meng Zhang.

After returning to Taiyi Sect, Meng Zhang had met Jin Qiao'er a few times. Jin Qiao'er had told him that because of her sneaking into the Deadly Sea of Sand last time, her master was very angry and punished her severely. "What the senior said is true. I was indeed not thinking clearly at that time," Meng Zhang admitted his mistake honestly following Jin LiDaoist Master's words.

Jin LiDaoist Master was not only an elder but also an important strong Gold Corelate stage cultivator. If in the Refining Qi period or Foundation Building period, some talented cultivators could challenge higher-level cultivators. However, in the Gold Core period, this situation was extremely rare. Even if Meng Zhang had just entered the Gold Core initial stage, he would not be able to resist a cultivator in the mid-stage of Gold Core.

Jin LiDaoist Master, as a strong Gold Corelate stage cultivator, just stood there and slightly revealed her aura, which made Meng Zhang feel shocked and unable to resist. Meng Zhang's attitude was good enough to satisfy Jin LiDaoist Master. Jin LiDaoist Master also stopped making things difficult for him. Seeing that everything was settled, Meng Zhang respectfully invited Jin LiDaoist Master inside. After bringing Jin LiDaoist Master to a quiet room and seating her, she went straight to the point without any nonsense. "Recently, you and that little fox Gu Yue Huaidie, as well as the girl from Dark Alliance, are plotting to enter the small world left by Purple Gold Sect, right?"

After hearing Jin LiDaoist Master's words, Meng Zhang almost exclaimed. They had kept this matter strictly confidential, and there was almost no possibility of leakage. Moreover, they had only decided to cooperate to enter that small world not long ago. How did Jin LiDaoist Master already know everything?

Seeing Meng Zhang's surprised expression, Jin LiDaoist Master proudly said, "There are few things in the Endless Sea of Sand that can be hidden from this Daoist Master."

"Do you think the small world of Purple Gold Sect is a big secret? Except for you, there have been many guys who have been eyeing that place for so many years."

"Why did Yellow Lotus Sect East River Branch and Fire Cloud Sect invade the Endless Sea of Sand back then? In addition to wanting to flatter that old guy, their main purpose was to get the small world left by Purple Gold Sect."

"Yellow Lotus Sect East River Branch learned their lesson after suffering a loss. But the people of Fire Cloud Sect have been entangled and want to compete with Flying Swan Sect."

They discovered the Great Void Restriction and judged the existence of the small world left by Purple Gold Sect. They thought they had discovered a great secret, but unexpectedly, there were many covetous people long ago.

Seeing Meng Zhang's somewhat discouraged look, Jin LiDaoist Master seemed to feel that he had not been hit hard enough and said something earth-shattering.

About eight hundred years ago, a Fifth Rank great power came from outside the sky and landed in the north of Grand Dust World, where the Deadly Sea of Sand is located today.

When this great power descended on Grand Dust World, he was already seriously injured. In order to heal his injuries, he drained the spirit vein around the landing site, directly causing the appearance of the Deadly Sea of Sand.

Not long after, True Monarch Tian Zhu, known as the number one person in the Left Path, appeared nearby and fought with this Fifth Rank great power.

True Monarch Tian Zhu had a Primordial Spirit late-stage Cultivation Base and was considered a strong person in the entire Grand Dust World. Although he was a loose cultivator with no sect or school, he had been roaming the Grand Dust World for hundreds of years, experiencing thousands of battles and establishing his own reputation. Even the major sects would not easily provoke him.

The Fifth Rank great power, who was still injured, fought with True Monarch Tian Zhu, and the two were evenly matched, falling into a prolonged struggle.

It is not known what benefits this Fifth Rank great power had, but in addition to True Monarch Tian Zhu, other Primordial Spirit True Monarchs also coveted it.

First, the Primordial Spirit True Monarch of Purple Gold Sect, with a group of Gold Core Daoist Masters, wanted to intervene in their fight and reap the benefits of the fisherman. Even though the two were fighting, they easily wiped out this group of Purple Gold Sect cultivators with a few small tricks.

The still-angry True Monarch Tian Zhu, in order to ensure that his battle was not disturbed, supported the Flying Swan Sect at that time, allowing them to rise up against Purple Gold Sect and replace them as the dominant power.

Fire Cloud Sect and Yellow Lotus Sect East River Branch, who had always had grievances with Purple Gold Sect, also launched a massive invasion of the Endless Sea of Sand under the instigation of Jiuqu League Primordial Spirit True Monarch True Monarch Profound Wind.

In addition, the Qi Family, a large cultivation clan from Middle-Earth Continent, was exiled to a branch of Jiuqu League. Under the command of their clan elder Qi Mingyun True Monarch, they were also involved in the chaos of the Endless Sea of Sand.

It was not until the major defeat 300-400 years ago that the Fire Cloud Sect's Elder Yun Yan was forced to make a ghost oath, bringing a temporary halt to the sect's activities.

Perhaps Jin Qiao'er had spoken highly of Meng Zhang in front of Jin LiDaoist Master, as the latter revealed many unknown details to Meng Zhang.

In order to completely defeat the Fifth Rank great power and prevent a mutually assured destruction, True Monarch Tian Zhu employed a Dao Technique called "One Disappears Another Grows."

The Fifth Rank great power willingly endured this Dao Technique, hoping to determine the victor through a series of gambling matches rather than a single battle.

A Dao Technique is a special technique that can only be performed by a Primordial Spirit True Monarch or higher, allowing them to harness the power of the Grand Dao.

The constraints, such as the Flying Swan Sect's inability to personally intervene, stemmed from the crucial gambling match that led to the destruction of the Forest Spring Watch orchestrated by the Taiyi Sect and other sects.

When this advantage reached a certain level, True Monarch Tian Zhu would achieve victory without even fighting, securing the final triumph.

However, as True Monarch Tian Zhu gained more and more advantage, he also became increasingly entangled and found it harder to divert his attention from the struggle against the Fifth Rank great power.

True Monarch Profound Wind of the Jiuqu League, also a loose cultivator, became embroiled in this conflict without the support of other Primordial Spirit True Monarchs in the Jiuqu League, rendering him unable to utilize the full power of the league. He doesn't have many pawns at his disposal, and the Fire Cloud Sect is the most important one. Originally, the Yellow Lotus Sect East River Branch sought to curry favor with him and was willing to follow his orders. However, due to some incidents, the Yellow Lotus Sect East River Branch became less obedient. Qi Mingyun True Monarch of the Qi Family had long been involved in the situation.

When dealing with the Fifth Rank great power, the three Primordial Spirit True Monarchs had some unspoken understanding, but they also engaged in countless hidden struggles against each other. With True Monarch Tian Zhu's strength, even if Qi Mingyun True Monarch and True Monarch Profound Wind joined forces, they would never dare to oppose him.

However, True Monarch Tian Zhu was too occupied to spare any attention to deal with Qi Mingyun True Monarch and True Monarch Profound Wind. Of course, Qi Mingyun True Monarch and True Monarch Profound Wind also dared not push True Monarch Tian Zhu too hard. True Monarch Profound Wind, although a Primordial Spirit True Monarch of the Jiuqu League, was a loose cultivator without the support of a powerful sect. He did not have the complete trust of the other Primordial Spirit True Monarchs of the Jiuqu League, and although he held a high position, he had no real power. When he intervened in the conflict between True Monarch Tian Zhu and the Fifth Rank great power, he faced strong opposition from the other Primordial Spirit True Monarchs of the Jiuqu League. Although Jin Li Daoist Master had not been in the Endless Sea of Sand for long, she had a deep understanding of the situation and the conflicts between the various factions. Jin Li Daoist Master also provided them with significant help. The three of them had not found a good method for opening the small world of the Purple Gold Sect. However, Jin Li Daoist Master directly told them a shortcut.

Chapter 439: Cooperation

Gu Yue Huaidie had a feeling of helplessness mixed with laughter. After all the effort, they still needed to enter the Mirage Secret Realm first. Jin Li, the Daoist Master, provided detailed instructions on how to pass through the Mirage Secret Realm and ultimately enter that small world. In comparison, the method Gu Yue Huaidie had prepared to enter the Mirage Secret Realm seemed too crude and rough.

Due to the restrictions set by the Primordial Spirit True Monarch, the Mirage Secret Realm only opens approximately once every hundred years, and only small cultivators with a Refining Qi cultivation base can enter. Cultivators in the Foundation Building stage can enter the Mirage Desert but are absolutely unable to enter the Mirage Secret Realm. If a Gold Core cultivator approaches the Mirage Desert recklessly, they may be attacked by the power of the restrictions.

Originally, Gu Yue Huaidie's plan was to borrow a treasure from a senior member of the Jiuqu League, set up a formation, gather the power of multiple Gold Core Daoist Masters, mobilize the power of heaven and earth, and forcefully open a portal to the Mirage Secret Realm. Borrowing the

senior's treasure would come at a great cost, and gathering enough Gold Core Daoist Masters was not easy. Furthermore, Gu Yue Huaidie couldn't guarantee the success of this method.

On the other hand, the method provided by Jin Li, the Daoist Master, was clearly much more brilliant. First, everyone followed her instructions to activate the various nodes of the Great Void Restriction spread throughout the Endless Sea of Sand. Then, she would lend the Yellow Sand Ten Thousand Li Chart to Gu Yue Huaidie and others to control this treasure. Together, they would activate the power of the treasure and open the Mirage Secret Realm ahead of time.

Once the Mirage Secret Realm opened, a group of elite Refining Qi disciples would be selected to enter. These disciples would carry the talismans provided by Jin Li, the Daoist Master, and activate them at crucial nodes within the Mirage Secret Realm. The activation of the talismans would trigger the power of the restrictions, allowing them to communicate with the small world in that void. At that time, Meng Zhang and the others could seize the opportunity to enter the passage to the small world. This method may sound simple, but many details still need careful handling. Jin Li, the Daoist Master, explicitly stated that this method was not her own idea but a feasible one devised by the Primordial Spirit True Monarch Tian Zhu after careful study of the arrangements left by the Purple Gold Sect's Primordial Spirit True Monarch. Of course, Meng Zhang concealed his disdain in front of the Flying Swan Sect cultivators. They were still allies, and it was necessary to maintain a good relationship for the time being. At least the attitude of the Flying Swan Sect cultivators on the surface was still very positive.

After discussing with Meng Zhang and the others, the Flying Swan Sect began to take action actively. They withdrew a group of elite Refining Qi cultivators from the front line and prepared them to enter the Mirage Secret Realm. Moreover, withdrawing a group of Refining Qi cultivators would not have a significant impact on the front line.

In addition to mobilizing Refining Qi cultivators from Taiyi Sect and its affiliates, Meng Zhang also announced with the Flying Swan Sect to the entire Endless Sea of Sand that the Mirage Secret Realm would open ahead of schedule and invited Refining Qi cultivators from all over to come.

Chapter 440: Skythunder Seed

Within the Mirage Secret Realm, there are various dangers, especially groups of demonic beasts, which are extremely difficult to deal with. Previously, the Flying Swan Sect would mobilize

Refining Qi stage cultivators from the entire Endless Sea of Sand to barely gather enough spiritual herbs.

Even these Refining Qi stage cultivators, who are the elite of the major cultivation forces and have made thorough preparations in advance, suffer heavy casualties every time they enter. According to Jin LiDaoist Master's plan, internal and external coordination is needed to break the restrictions of the Mirage Secret Realm and activate the power of the Great Void Restriction, opening the passage to that small world.

This operation is different from before; it requires these Refining Qi stage cultivators to cooperate with each other to clear the obstacles within the Mirage Secret Realm. They absolutely cannot fight and kill each other like before.

Relying solely on the Refining Qi stage disciples of the Taiyi Sect and the Flying Swan Sect would be insufficient to complete the mission. Although Refining Qi stage disciples may be insignificant in the eyes of Gold Core Daoist Masters, these elite Refining Qi stage disciples are the future pillars of their sects.

Both Meng Zhang and the high-ranking members of the Flying Swan Sect do not want excessive casualties among their Refining Qi stage disciples. Therefore, the Taiyi Sect and the Flying Swan Sect have issued messages recruiting outstanding Refining Qi stage cultivators from the entire Endless Sea of Sand.

These Refining Qi stage disciples need to make a blood oath in advance, promising not to kill each other once they enter the Mirage Secret Realm. They must cooperate with disciples from both sects to eliminate demonic beasts and proceed to several key locations.

To attract powerful Refining Qi stage cultivators, both the Taiyi Sect and the Flying Swan Sect have offered high rewards. There is an abundance of spiritual stones, various types of elixirs, magic tools, talismans, and other precious items.

Those who perform exceptionally well as Refining Qi stage cultivators also have the opportunity to join the Taiyi Sect. If they can make significant contributions and succeed in the mission, they may even be able to exchange for a Lesser Foundation Building Pill from the Taiyi Sect.

Even though the Flying Swan Sect has suffered significant losses in recent years and is financially strained, they have also offered generous rewards to these Refining Qi stage cultivators.

Suddenly, these Refining Qi stage cultivators, who are at the bottom of the Cultivation World, have become highly sought after. Countless Refining Qi stage cultivators have flocked from all directions, not hesitating even though they know the items are not easy to obtain and that they may have to risk their lives.

Seeking wealth and prosperity in the midst of danger, for the impoverished lower-level cultivators, having an opportunity to risk their lives in exchange for a promising future is an extremely rare opportunity.

To ensure reliability, Meng Zhang has spent a considerable amount of time screening these numerous Refining Qi stage cultivators. In fact, the actions of Meng Zhang and others in opening the small world align with the intentions of many Gold Core Daoist Masters. Even the Fire Cloud Sect, which is hostile to the Flying Swan Sect, would not send people to cause trouble at this time.

During Meng Zhang's screening process, no individuals with malicious intent or intentions to sabotage were found. Only those with insufficient strength who wanted to take advantage of the situation and a group of useless individuals who were difficult to manipulate were eliminated. When Meng Zhang was screening these Refining Qi stage cultivators, a group of Foundation Building stage disciples from the Taiyi Sect, led by Gu Yue Huaidie and Luo Ye Daoist Master, began searching for the various nodes of the Great Void Restriction throughout the entire Endless Sea of Sand, following Jin LiDaoist Master's guidance. After finding these nodes, they began activating them one by one using the techniques taught by Jin LiDaoist Master.

This process was lengthy and consumed a considerable amount of time. Fortunately, there was plenty of time in Jin LiDaoist Master's plan, so there was no need to rush. While Meng Zhang was screening these Refining Qi stage cultivators, he did not neglect his own cultivation. After borrowing the mine from the Flying Swan Sect, he went deep underground and began absorbing the dense yin-yang fiend qi within the fiend qi pit, refining it and transforming it into the sword qi of Twin Forms Towards Heaven Sword.

With a foundation in practicing the small Divine Ability, Meng Zhang did not spend too much time and successfully refined this Great Divine Ability. With this Divine Ability, he had the confidence to compete with other Gold Core Daoist Masters.

Since Jin LiDaoist Master had promised to do her best to help, Meng Zhang shamelessly asked her for some treasures that could increase his combat power. Jin LiDaoist Master could not act herself, so she naturally had to place her hopes on Meng Zhang and others.

Jin LiDaoist Master knew that Meng Zhang was still forming his core and that the Taiyi Sect did not have much background, so they could not provide too much assistance to Meng Zhang. Enhancing Meng Zhang's combat power would indeed be beneficial to True Monarch Tian Zhu's gambling.

Of course, the power of these three Thunder Sons was also enormous. Even a Gold Core early stage cultivator who accidentally came into contact with one of them could be in mortal danger. The two Yin Thunder Sons she gave to Jin Qiao'er could threaten Gold Core Daoist Masters and played a crucial role in killing a Third Rank demonic beast.
