Chapter 481: Third-order spirit vein

Although the large group of people from the Flying Swan Sect has withdrawn, the small team left behind still dutifully carries out their assigned tasks. This time, the three forces invaded the Demon Wind Gobi and occupied a vast territory. Particularly, after defeating the Lion Demon General and conquering the Grand Lion Ridge, there are many spoils of war to be distributed. The main responsibility of the small team from the Flying Swan Sect is to handle these spoils.

Even though the Flying Swan Sect has already withdrawn its troops, Meng Zhang is not planning to violate the agreement and monopolize all the spoils. As a Gold Core Daoist Master, he doesn't need to lower his status and bicker with a group of juniors. After the disastrous defeat of the Northern Desert Qi Family this time, with one Gold Core Daoist Master dead and another injured, most of their cultivator army was wiped out, and only a few managed to survive. Forced by the circumstances, the Northern Desert Qi Family withdrew its forces from the Demon Wind Gobi. Naturally, the territory they previously occupied was divided between the Taiyi Sect and the Flying Swan Sect.

As for the corpses of those demonic beasts and the resources looted along the way, they naturally belong to whoever took them, and there was no dispute over this matter.

Apart from occupying a large expanse of land, including the Grand Lion Ridge, Taiyi Sect also managed to expand southward and established a direct passage leading to the Jiuqu League. With this passage, Taiyi Sect's flying ships could now directly travel to Great Wind City without passing through the Flying Swan Sect's territory. This passage was of great strategic significance to Taiyi Sect. After defeating the Lion Demon General, Meng Zhang instructed the elders Yang Xueyi and the Guardian Spirit General Delicate Water to work together to achieve this strategic goal. Chapter 482: The Old Friends Pass Away

With the Rainbow Escape Method, not only will Meng Zhang's survival ability greatly increase, but his tactics will also become more diverse.

After Gu Yue Huaidie's departure, the Dark Crow Demon General, who is difficult to discern for human cultivators, did not easily venture outside.

Most of the time, the Dark Crow Demon General is relatively rational. Without strong provocation, it will carefully consider its actions.

It was the death of the Golden Tiger Demon General last time that angered the Dark Crow Demon General and prompted it to launch an attack.

Under Meng Zhang's orders, Taiyi Sect controls the distribution of Lesser Foundation Building Pills strictly. Those favored by him or the upper echelons of the sect find it difficult to obtain Lesser Foundation Building Pills.

However, a considerable number of Lesser Foundation Building Pills produced by Taiyi Sect have leaked out. The surrounding cultivation forces, vassal families, and even loose cultivators can obtain Lesser Foundation Building Pills as long as they pay a sufficient price.

Over the years, the number of Foundation Building stage cultivators around Taiyi Sect has greatly increased.

Among Taiyi Sect disciples, many outstanding Foundation Building stage cultivators have emerged.

Meng Zhang's second disciple, An Xiaoran, and his third disciple, An Moran, came to Demon Wind Gobi after successfully achieving Foundation Building to help their eldest senior brother, Niu Dawei, develop the area.

Grand Lion Ridge possesses a Third Rank spirit vein, making it even more suitable as Taiyi Sect's main sect location. However, as long as the Dark Crow Demon General is not eliminated, Taiyi Sect cannot completely stabilize its territory in Demon Wind Gobi.

Therefore, despite Meng Zhang often being stationed at Grand Lion Ridge, the main sect of Taiyi Sect has not been moved there.

All the affairs on the Endless Sea of Sand side can only be handled by the elders and Hall Masters of the sect.

Indeed, he was skilled in puppet techniques and had significant accomplishments in formation restrictions.

With little effort, the Clever Machine Sect's Gold Core Daoist Master effortlessly opened the secret boxes that had left Meng Zhang's group at a loss.

These secret boxes were from ordinary disciples of Purple Gold Sect, and originally, Meng Zhang and the others didn't attach much importance to them.

However, after opening them, two treasures inside the secret boxes made the Clever Machine Sect's Gold Core Daoist Master covet them.

Of course, he didn't have the courage to forcefully take Gu Yue Huaidie's belongings. Instead, he politely requested a trade, hoping to exchange for those items.

Considering that Meng Zhang currently needed a Third Rank mountain-guarding great formation, Gu Yue Huaidie proposed using these two treasures to acquire a high-quality Third Rank mountain-guarding great formation.

The Clever Machine Sect was adept at mechanical puppets and had great achievements in formations. After some negotiation, Gu Yue Huaidie finally fulfilled Meng Zhang's request and helped him obtain the Metal Wind Violent Flame Formation.

Chapter 485: Guest Official

Gu Yue Huaidie personally made a trip to Demon Wind Gobi and brought the Mountain Protection Great Formation to Meng Zhang.

Normally, placing such a high-level Mountain Protection Great Formation required a Formation Master familiar with the great formation to be present on-site, surveying the terrain, organizing manpower, and carefully setting it up.

The Formation Master of the Clever Machine Sect was unwilling to come to the Demon Wind Gobi. Besides, Meng Zhang believed that the details of setting up the great formation were Taiyi Sect's secrets and should not be entrusted to others.

Therefore, Taiyi Sect independently deployed this Third Rank Great Formation.

The Third Rank Great Formation had many diagrams and a large pile of array flags and plates, and it took quite some time just to organize these items.

As for the other items in those secret boxes, they were just ordinary spiritual objects, which the three Gold Core Daoist Masters casually divided among themselves.

After giving the items to Meng Zhang, Gu Yue Huaidie hurriedly left.

Deep Earth Spirit General, who had been cultivating the spirit vein, also temporarily stopped his work and carefully studied the great formation with Wen Qiansun.

Wen Qiansun's Cultivation Base had already reached the mid Foundation Building stage, and his formation skills had improved significantly. However, assisting Deep Earth Spirit General in researching this great formation still proved to be quite challenging for him.

After spending more than three years, Meng Zhang and Daoist Master Luo Ye had to make several moves under the command of Deep Earth Spirit General to barely complete the setup of this Mountain Protection Great Formation.

Deep Earth Spirit General explicitly informed Meng Zhang that, due to their and Wen Qiansun's current strength, the deployment of the great formation was not perfect. There were many details that could only be adjusted slowly when he regained his strength or after Wen Qiansun advanced to the Gold Core stage.

Nevertheless, this great formation could still be used, although it couldn't unleash its full power.

Furthermore, the spiritual energy provided by the Third Rank Spirit Vein of the Grand Lion Ridge was limited. Most of the functions of the Mountain Protection Great Formation remained closed during normal days and only activated at full power when facing strong enemy attacks.

Despite its many imperfections, at least Taiyi Sect now had the protection of a Third Rank Mountain Protection Great Formation.

In the worst-case scenario, Taiyi Sect could abandon all its bases on the Demon Wind Gobi and retreat with all members to the Grand Lion Ridge, relying on this Mountain Protection Great Formation to defend themselves.

With Meng Zhang leading many Taiyi Sect disciples to defend with the great formation, not even Dark Crow Demon General could hope to break through and attack the Grand Lion Ridge.

Having Meng Zhang as their reliance boosted their confidence.

A few more years passed, and Luo Ye, a Daoist Master, received a summon from the Dark Alliance and had to leave. She could no longer continue staying there and had to depart.

Luo Ye left quietly, but Meng Zhang still had to show himself outside the Crow's Nest to make it difficult for Dark Crow Demon General to discern the situation.

The intelligence capabilities of the monster beasts were far inferior to human cultivators, especially those like Dark Crow Demon General, who remained entrenched and never ventured out. Until now, they hadn't fully understood the specific situation on the human side.

Of course, the prolonged absence of Gu Yue Huaidie raised some suspicions in Poison Sand Demon General's mind.

Meng Zhang roamed outside the Crow's Nest but felt that this was not a viable long-term strategy. Relying solely on intimidation with insufficient strength wouldn't work.

Meng Zhang separately sent letters to Gu Yue Huaidie and Luo Ye, requesting their help in keeping an eye out for a suitable Gold Core Daoist Master that Taiyi Sect could temporarily hire.

After receiving Meng Zhang's letters, Gu Yue Huaidie and Luo Ye did their best to help him inquire.

Gu Yue Huaidie had a wide network of contacts and quickly contacted several Gold Core Daoist Masters.

A Primordial Spirit True Monarch could exert influence on Gold Core sects in various ways, and given Taiyi Sect's current strength, they couldn't afford to offend such a powerful figure.

Since attacking Northern Desert Qi Family wasn't a feasible option, Taiyi Sect had to hold its ground firmly in Demon Wind Gobi. To some extent, Taiyi Sect had become a barrier, helping Flying Swan Sect fend off threats from Demon Wind Gobi.

Chapter 487: Vast Sea Dao Alliance

After the withdrawal of Flying Swan Sect from Demon Wind Gobi, Taiyi Sect has been closely monitoring Flying Swan Sect's movements. As a rising Gold Core sect in the Endless Sea of Sand, Taiyi Sect has a lot of catching up to do, and intelligence capability is one crucial aspect.

Compared to the well-established Flying Swan Sect, Taiyi Sect is far behind in this regard. However, Flying Swan Sect is not without weaknesses and vulnerabilities.

After the return of Daoist Masters Fei Yu and Fei Jiang with their armies, they began a lengthy period of recuperation. With Lion Demon General, the major threat from Demon Wind Gobi, taken care of, and Taiyi Sect acting as a barrier against threats from Demon Wind Gobi, Fire Cloud Sect remains weak and cannot pose a significant threat to Flying Swan Sect.

Seizing this rare period of calm, Flying Swan Sect swiftly recovers its strength. With considerable hidden reserves despite the heavy consumption in recent years, Flying Swan Sect can still provide substantial resources.

The lost disciples are gradually being replenished, and new Refining Qi and Foundation Building stage disciples are emerging. As long as Flying Swan Sect can enjoy a few hundred years of stable development, they should be able to replenish their ranks with Refining Qi and Foundation Building stage cultivators.

Flying Swan Sect's actions this time were not due to any grudges against Taiyi Sect, but rather a natural caution toward Taiyi Sect as a ruler in the Endless Sea of Sand, prompting them to take instinctive actions.

Meng Zhang, who is constrained in Demon Wind Gobi, knows that he cannot antagonize Flying Swan Sect right now. With his temperament, he won't remain idle either.

After Qin Hongying settled in Grand Lion Ridge two years ago, the situation in Demon Wind Gobi remained relatively stable. Under Meng Zhang's instructions, Taiyi Sect made significant moves.

By publicly bringing Earthfire Sect back, Meng Zhang not only shows contempt towards Flying Swan Sect but also sends a message to other cultivation forces. Even the sect that Flying Swan Sect extremely hated, Earthfire Sect, can be protected and its heritage preserved by Taiyi Sect.

If Earthfire Sect remains loyal to Taiyi Sect and serves the alliance faithfully, it may have a chance to thrive again.

The establishment of the Vast Sea Dao Alliance was not a spontaneous decision by Meng Zhang but a long-standing idea and plan. The goal is to unify all the cultivation forces in the area, consolidate resources, grow the alliance, and compete with other sects, including Flying Swan Sect.

As the only Gold Core sect among these cultivation forces, Taiyi Sect takes the leading position. Meng Zhang, as the Gold Core Daoist Master and the Sect Master, is the most suitable candidate for the alliance's leader.

He named this branch "Secret Hall," a crucial and sensitive branch to be managed by someone he trusts deeply.

An Moran has been under Meng Zhang's tutelage for many years. He has a stable and unusually calm personality, making him a capable young man. Meng Zhang entrusted An Moran with the task of setting up the Secret Hall, providing full support and access to Taiyi Sect's resources.

Upon receiving the message, Jue Ying quickly arrived in Demon Wind Gobi to meet with Meng Zhang. After years apart, Jue Ying's Cultivation Base has reached the late stage of Foundation Building. It probably won't be long before she faces the threshold of advancing to the Gold Core stage.

After catching up, Meng Zhang entrusted her with an important task. He hoped that Jue Ying would help An Moran establish the Secret Hall and provide guidance to him. Jue Ying's background in the Dark Alliance makes her an excellent assassin and spy, perfectly suited for this role.

Chapter 488: Secret Hall

The organization Dark Alliance itself excels in training assassins and spies, and it has its unique cultivation system. Meng Zhang never had direct contact with Dark Alliance, but they had many dealings with the black market under Dark Alliance's control.

The black market's exceptional intelligence capabilities left a deep impression on Meng Zhang. The market's expertise in gathering and analyzing information comes from Dark Alliance.

However, structures like the Secret Hall go through a complex process from establishment to development and effectiveness, requiring significant time and accumulation to become truly proficient.

Though Meng Zhang planned to gradually shift Taiyi Sect's focus to Demon Wind Gobi, especially the Grand Lion Ridge area, Endless Sea of Sand held numerous interests and housed the primary headquarters of the Desert Sea Alliance.
