Chapter 622: Greatly is form the core

The matter of refining magic tools requires careful consideration. Currently, Shocking ThunderSpirit General's main focus is still on repairing the set of Mother - Child Transmission Disc.

During the process of repairing the Mother - Child Transmission Disc, a great thing happened. Delicate WaterSpirit General, originally a Third Rank Alchemist and Second Rank tool refiner, experienced significant improvement in her art of tool refinement during the process. She advanced to become a Third Rank tool refiner.

Of course, because the water refinement technique is relatively niche, there are not many magic tools that can be refined using it, and most of them are relatively special and niche magic tools. Delicate WaterSpirit General, as a Third Rank tool refiner, certainly cannot compare to Shocking ThunderSpirit General. After all, the fire refinement technique is currently the mainstream in the Cultivation World.

However, no matter what, having an additional Third Rank tool refiner in the sect is a tremendous benefit. Moreover, the water refinement technique is not without its merits; it has advantages in certain aspects that the fire refinement technique lacks.

At present, Taiyi Sect has already excelled in most aspects of the Hundred Arts at the First and Second Rank levels. Alchemists, tool refiners, spiritual farmers, Talisman Masters, beast tamers, and others are flourishing. But at the Third Rank level, there are still significant shortcomings.

Especially in the most crucial aspect of Alchemy, the sect only has Delicate WaterSpirit General as a Third Rank Alchemist. However, she prefers to travel outside rather than stay in the sect to practice alchemy obediently, making it challenging for Sect Master Meng Zhang to force her too much. He can only persuade her carefully to produce more elixirs.

The water refinement technique is a special alchemy technique, and there are not many elixir recipes that use this method. Among the Third Rank elixirs Delicate WaterSpirit General masters, the focus is on elixirs for restoring True Essence and healing injuries, as well as some special and niche elixirs.

The Water Element Elixir, which enhances Cultivation Base, is scarce in materials. Even if Delicate WaterSpirit General wants to refine more, it is impossible to achieve. Third Rank Alchemists across the entire Jiuqu League are limited, and most of the elixirs they refine are consumed within their own forces. The number of Third Rank elixirs that can flow into the market is small, and the quality is not high. However, whenever Third Rank elixirs, especially those directly enhancing Cultivation Base, appear on the market, they will trigger a fierce scramble.

With Taiyi Sect's current channels and financial resources, they cannot obtain enough Third Rank elixirs to supply all Gold Core Daoist Masters in the sect. The Third Rank elixirs Meng Zhang obtained from the treasure vault this time are the most they have acquired in recent years.

Fortunately, Taiyi Sect is in a unique situation, as the four Guardian Spirit Generals do not need elixirs that enhance Cultivation Base much. With only a few other Gold Core Daoist Masters in the sect, Taiyi Sect's overall strength can barely support them.

The Pill Hall Master of Taiyi Sect, Zhang Yingying, is already old and has exhausted her potential. Breaking through to the Gold Core stage in this lifetime is virtually hopeless, let alone becoming a Third Rank Alchemist.

Shi Changqing, the Second Rank Alchemist who was once highly regarded from the Shi Family, died several years ago when his lifespan was depleted during meditation.

Meng Zhang has high expectations for his disciple, An Xiaoran. She cultivates the superior technique "Fusang Sutra," which not only possesses tremendous power but is also very suitable for alchemy. With her aptitude and foundation, achieving the Gold Core stage is something to look forward to.

Once she becomes a Third Rank Alchemist, it will be possible to completely solve the issue of Taiyi Sect's elixir supply.

In the blink of an eye, Meng Zhang has been back at Taiyi Sect for ten years. After so many years of effort, the Mother - Child Transmission Disc set has finally been completely repaired. This Mother - Child Transmission Disc, which cost a great deal of manpower and resources to fix, carries the hopes of many in Taiyi Sect.

During these ten years, the batch of Void Nether Stones that Daoist Master Black Fox promised Meng Zhang had already been delivered to Demon Wind Gobi and reached Taiyi Sect's hands. Even if Jin Li True Monarch doesn't intentionally show favoritism or specially care for Taiyi Sect, various aspects of the Jiuqu League tend to treat Taiyi Sect with more respect and consideration due to Jin Li True Monarch's influence.

When the envoy from Azure Origin Sect appeared at Niu Dawei's core formation celebration, almost all the guests couldn't help but take a closer look at Taiyi Sect. Many forces began contemplating how to further develop relations with Taiyi Sect.

Niu Dawei's core formation celebration was grand and joyful, surpassing any previous celebration in Taiyi Sect's history. The gathering point for the forces of the Hanhai Alliance was not at the Hundred Grass Slope but at a frontier stronghold located about two thousand miles west of it.

Although their cultivators had not completely assembled yet, Niu Dawei was prepared to depart and meet up with them.

At this moment, an unexpected visitor proactively arrived at their doorstep.

"Someone from Beast King Mountain wants to see me?" Niu Dawei was momentarily stunned upon hearing the communication from his disciple.

"Which Beast King Mountain? New Beast King Mountain or Old Beast King Mountain?" As soon as he spoke, Niu Dawei already had a good idea of the answer.

Old Beast King Mountain was far away in the Crossing Severing Mountain Range. Only New Beast King Mountain, a member of the Jiuqu League like Taiyi Sect, would have any dealings with them.

As expected, the one seeking an audience with Niu Dawei was Qiu Mingze, the representative of New Beast King Mountain on this side of Demon Wind Gobi.

Chapter 628: Beast King Mountain

When it comes to Beast King Mountain, there's a distinction between the so-called New Beast King Mountain and Old Beast King Mountain, with a story in between.

Originally, Beast King Mountain was situated on the other side of the Crossing Severing Mountain Range and was the most powerful sect within the Three Sects Alliance. The sect boasted numerous Primordial Spirit True Monarchs, a large number of Gold Core Daoist Masters, and countless Foundation Building cultivators. Its strength was unparalleled in the Crossing Severing Mountain Range, making it a dominant force in the region.

Many years ago, a major internal rift occurred within Beast King Mountain. A group of cultivators broke away from the sect, fled the Crossing Severing Mountain Range, and journeyed northward for thousands of miles until they reached the territory controlled by the Jiuqu League.

To distinguish the two different Beast King Mountains, outsiders referred to the one on the Crossing Severing Mountain Range side as Old Beast King Mountain and the one within the Jiuqu League as New Beast King Mountain.

The New Beast King Mountain within the Jiuqu League has grown and prospered over the years, steadily increasing in strength. Among the remaining forces in the Jiuqu League, besides the Azure Origin Sect, the Yellow Lotus Sect, Four Seas Chamber of Commerce, and Beast King Mountain are the most powerful.

After the internal division, the Old Beast King Mountain of the Three Sects Alliance suffered a significant decline in strength and could no longer maintain its position as the leader of the alliance. They view the New Beast King Mountain as the primary cause of their decline and harbor extreme animosity towards them. If it weren't for the presence of the Jiuqu League, they would have likely engaged in a major conflict long ago.

The relationship between the Three Sects Alliance and the Jiuqu League is complex, involving both competition and cooperation. Besides the Old Beast King Mountain, the other two sects of the Three Sects Alliance maintain a relatively decent relationship with the Jiuqu League.

However, the New Beast King Mountain finds itself in a tricky situation and has always remained low-key within the Jiuqu League. Despite their considerable strength, they have no aspirations for dominance or supremacy.

As a Primordial Spirit sect, apart from the powerful Azure Origin Sect, other forces within the Jiuqu League find it challenging to directly contend with the New Beast King Mountain.

Beast King Mountain's cultivation techniques heavily rely on the taming of demonic beasts. In the Cultivation World, there is even a rumor that over half of the abilities of Beast King Mountain cultivators come from the tamed demonic beasts.

Later, when the demonic beasts from Demon Wind Gobi invaded the Endless Sea of Sand, triggering multiple large-scale battles, the outposts of New Beast King Mountain were unable to stand alone and were eventually abandoned. The stationed cultivators returned to their sect.

When the news of True Monarch Tian Zhu's death spread, and Jin Li True Monarch aligned with the Azure Origin Sect, joining the Jiuqu League, Taiyi Sect occupied a large part of Demon Wind Gobi. With the protection of Jin Li True Monarch, New Beast King Mountain found it challenging to easily intervene in the area.

After Taiyi Sect officially became a member of the Jiuqu League, New Beast King Mountain took the initiative to send envoys and negotiate with Taiyi Sect to obtain access to the demonic beast resources in Demon Wind Gobi. Although Taiyi Sect had the protection of Jin Li True Monarch, they couldn't easily offend a Primordial Spirit sect. Therefore, Meng Zhang gave face to New Beast King Mountain and agreed to their request.

Consequently, New Beast King Mountain reestablished their presence in Demon Wind Gobi and gradually gained access to the demonic beast resources. They did not take excessive advantage of Taiyi Sect and occasionally provided them with benefits.

Chapter 629: ...

Niu Dawei did not outright reject the goodwill of Beast King Mountain. Instead, he expressed concern, fearing that there might be casualties among the cultivators of Beast King Mountain during the upcoming battle.

Qiu Mingze first thanked Niu Dawei for his concern, then casually mentioned that some of Beast King Mountain's Gold Core Daoist Masters were traveling nearby in the Demon Wind Gobi. They had heard about the impending invasion of Demon Wind Gobi's demonic beasts into the Human

Clan's territory and were filled with anger, developing a shared animosity toward the invaders. They were willing to lend a hand and help Taiyi Sect resist the invasion of the demonic beasts.

Qiu Mingze's words made Niu Dawei internally vigilant. It seemed that Beast King Mountain had planned this move in advance. It was too coincidental that their Gold Core Daoist Masters happened to be in the vicinity of Demon Wind Gobi when such a significant event was unfolding.

Although Niu Dawei was unsure of Beast King Mountain's intentions, he believed that they would not side with the demonic beasts or the Sea Clan. As they arrived at Yellow Clay Slope, they found a noisy scene. Cultivator teams from various factions within the Hanhai Alliance were gathering there. Niu Dawei's presence as a Gold Core Daoist Master exerted enough authority to command the crowd.

Taiyi Sect had not engaged in external battles for some years, and some factions within the Hanhai Alliance had become lax, especially the newer ones. Niu Dawei's team was small in number but highly skilled and disciplined.

Using these Foundation Building cultivators as the backbone, Niu Dawei and Wen Qiansun began to integrate and assemble a large and imposing army of cultivators. Meng Zhang attached great importance to the Hanhai Alliance organization, as the cultivators of each member were considered the best cannon fodder. Taiyi Sect periodically dispatched cultivators to the member sects to organize training, including formation arrangements and coordinated combat.

The intelligence level of the Sea Clan was much higher than that of the demonic beasts. While in the sea, their combat talents were even more remarkable.
