Sect Master 691

Chapter 691: Past events

After the reconstruction of the Taiyi Sect, the interior of the Void Cauldron has always been considered the most reliable secret treasury, where the most important items of the sect are stored, including inheritance scriptures and the like. Before the sect's mountain gate was breached, they had put all sorts of valuable resources into it, knowing that they wouldn't be able to take them away.

Currently, within the Void Cauldron, everything Meng Zhang needs is stored. However, without the permission of the Void Cauldron's tool spirit, no one can take anything out of it.

The four Guardian Spirit Generals have tried various methods to communicate with the tool spirit of the Void Cauldron, but it remains indifferent, providing no response whatsoever. Faced with no other option, the Extreme Sword Spirit General had Meng Zhang come and try it personally.

As the contemporary Sect Master of Taiyi Sect, Meng Zhang holds a high position in the sect, and even if the elders have a bad temper or a significant presence, they should still give him some face. However, to his embarrassment, the tool spirit of the Void Cauldron completely ignores him, despite his attempts to communicate.

Chapter 692: Sacrificial Offering

After a while, the human-shaped shadow leaped out of the cauldron again and took the initiative to speak to Meng Zhang.

Chapter 695: Absorption

As Void Cauldron couldn't utilize the Mother-Child Transmission Disc for transportation, it had to remain within Maple Leaf Mountain City. Apart from arranging sufficient defensive forces here, Meng Zhang himself also stayed in this place.

With the existence of the Mother-Child Transmission Disc, instant transmission between Maple Leaf Mountain City and Taiyi Sect's Hundred Grass Slope was possible, making things quite convenient.

However, due to the dwindling stock of Void Nether Stone, they needed to control the number of transfers and reduce unnecessary teleportations. Originally, Meng Zhang thought that the number of

Gold Core Daoist Masters from Taiyi Sect would be sufficient, but after obtaining Maple Leaf Mountain City, he realized that their numbers were still insufficient.

Maple Leaf Mountain City was Taiyi Sect's extension into the Grand Crossing Cultivation Circle, representing the first expansion in such a distant location and also serving as Taiyi Sect's retreat route. Given its importance, it required careful management.

According to the original plan of the Jiuqu League's high-level, the best scenario would be for Jiuqu League and Grand Crossing Cultivation Circle to form an alliance to jointly confront the Dali Dynasty. In the worst case, effective communication with the major forces in Grand Crossing Cultivation Circle is necessary to obtain some assistance from them.

Although the intelligence capabilities of Maple Leaf Mountain City are limited and unable to obtain specific details about the Jiuqu League delegation, the rumors circulating on the market seem to indicate that the results of the delegation's mission are not very promising.

It appears that the major forces in Grand Crossing Cultivation Circle are not very welcoming to the arrival of the Jiuqu League delegation. The delegation encountered obstacles everywhere and couldn't meet with the true top-level cultivators of Grand Crossing Cultivation Circle.

He felt a sense of urgency; not only did he need to break through to the Primordial Spirit realm as soon as possible, but Taiyi Sect also needed to enhance its strength to face the upcoming challenges.

During the journey back to Jiuqu League, both Cloud Boats, being Fourth Rank vessels, returned smoothly and without any trouble. On their way to the Grand Crossing Cultivation Circle, they had

encountered a Fourth Rank demonic beast attack. However, on the way back, it seemed the presence of three Primordial Spirit True Monarchs was enough to deter the Fourth Rank demonic beasts in the Black Jade Forest, avoiding unnecessary confrontations.

After being delayed on the journey, when Meng Zhang returned to Jiuqu City, the headquarters of Jiuqu League, he only visited the triumphant Jin Li True Monarch briefly before hurrying back to the sect's gate. Once he arrived at Taiyi Sect's gate, Meng Zhang wholeheartedly immersed himself in his cultivation, ignoring everything else.

During this time, several major events occurred within Taiyi Sect, but they did not interrupt his practice. When Meng Zhang turned 300 years old, the senior disciple Niu Dawei had planned to organize a grand celebration for his 300th birthday. Although they passed this hurdle for the time being, Meng Zhang specifically instructed the high-ranking members of the sect to be extra careful and vigilant against the Yellow Lotus Sect cultivators. They must not give the Yellow Lotus Sect any chance to exploit their weaknesses.

Meanwhile, at the Yuantu Great Prairie, the war led by the Jade Sword Sect intensified, with various factions of the Jiuqu League investing more and more resources. Consequently, Taiyi Sect faced a shortage of manpower in various aspects, particularly in the number of Gold Core Daoist Masters left behind, leading to several problems.

While in seclusion, Meng Zhang also worried about the losses suffered by Taiyi Sect cultivators in the war.

While the frontline cultivators suffered heavy casualties, Taiyi Sect in the rear kept receiving good news. Over the years, Taiyi Sect had four Foundation Building cultivators successfully break through to the Gold Core realm. First, a disciple of Qiaoshou Sect, specially nurtured by Jin Qiao'er, successfully entered the Gold Core realm. Later, a highly talented disciple of Land Walk Sect, who had received great expectations from the entire sect, also became a Gold Core Daoist Master.

Chapter 698: Gold Core Completion

In the past, Taiyi Sect might have suppressed other members of the Hanhai Alliance and secretly sabotaged the formation of Gold Core by others. After all, Taiyi Sect itself is just a newly established Gold Core sect. If new Gold Core sects were to emerge under their control, it would certainly affect their grip on the Hanhai Alliance and even their rule.

Similar to how the Flying Swan Sect ruled over the Endless Sea of Sand in the past, they acted in the same manner. As rulers of the Endless Sea of Sand, they wouldn't tolerate any forces that could challenge their authority. Taiyi Sect should learn from their example.

Jin Qiao'er was accepted by Taiyi Sect not only because of her relationship with her master, Jin Li True Monarch, but also because she never sought power and never interfered with Taiyi Sect's rule.

As Taiyi Sect grew stronger and more powerful, the higher-ups in the sect seemed to become more magnanimous and accommodating, able to accept others. Meng Zhang's cultivation at the Gold Core stage was approaching completion, and it seemed that he was not far from breaking through to

the Primordial Spirit stage. Moreover, Taiyi Sect had more than ten Gold Core Daoist Masters, ensuring their overwhelming advantage over all members of the Hanhai Alliance.

At this point, even if a few more Gold Core Daoist Masters emerged within the Hanhai Alliance, it wouldn't affect Taiyi Sect's rule; instead, it would enhance the overall strength of the alliance. Taiyi Sect showed great tolerance in this matter.

During Meng Zhang's seclusion, he maintained some contact with the outside world. Periodically, someone from the sect would summarize the latest news and inform him through a communication talisman. At such times, Meng Zhang would temporarily interrupt his cultivation to issue some instructions to the sect.

As the saying goes, there should be a balance between work and leisure, both in civil and martial ways.

Upon learning that Qiaoshou Sect had a new Gold Core Daoist Master, Meng Zhang considered the current state of their Dustfall Mound, which had a Third Rank spirit vein of low quality, providing limited spiritual energy. Long ago, Meng Zhang had planned to develop the Grand Lion Ridge into a major trading city in the Demon Wind Gobi.

After many years of development, the Grand Lion Ridge had grown substantially and become the foremost market for hundreds of miles around. However, there was still a long way to go before it could become a grand trading city like Great Wind City. Now, most of Taiyi Sect's Gold Core Daoist Masters were deployed outside, and Jin Qiao'er was also trustworthy.

Meng Zhang decided to appoint Jin Qiao'er as the city lord of Grand Lion Ridge, responsible for overseeing all related matters in that vast market. This decision would be beneficial for his future plans.

Even during his seclusion, Meng Zhang delegated some of his responsibilities to the sect's cultivators, instructing them to handle this matter and sending representatives to convey his appointment.

Jin Qiao'er did not refuse Meng Zhang's appointment and quickly took up her post in Grand Lion Ridge.

There were many things inside and outside Taiyi Sect that occupied Meng Zhang's mind, but most of them were handled well by the disciples. This allowed him to focus more of his time and energy on his cultivation.

His cultivation at the Gold Core late stage was progressing quite smoothly, especially with the help of two bottles of Nine Heavens Refined Essence provided by Xu Mengying, which greatly saved him time.

However, Meng Zhang's consumption of the Nine Heavens Refined Essence far exceeded his expectations. Even after thoroughly absorbing and refining the two bottles, he still hadn't completed the Gold Core stage of his cultivation. He had to interrupt his cultivation and venture to the Nine Heavens to personally obtain more Nine Heavens Refined Essence.

Fortunately, he was lucky enough to obtain enough usable Nine Heavens Refined Essence after three trips to the Nine Heavens. With that, he finally completed the remaining part of his cultivation.

The battle between Jiuqu League and extraterritorial Barbarian Clan was still ongoing, but Meng Zhang had hidden himself within the Taiyi Sect mountain gate and finally completed his cultivation at the Gold Core stage, entering the state of Gold Core completion.

At this stage, it seems that breaking through to the Primordial Spirit stage is just a step away, as if it could be achieved at any moment. However, Meng Zhang, who is in this state, knows that there is still a long way to go before he can enter the Primordial Spirit stage.

He has read many useful scriptures and absorbed the experiences of predecessors. However, their experiences can't directly help him enter the Primordial Spirit stage; they only provide a rough direction.

Transitioning from completing the Gold Core stage to breaking through to the Primordial Spirit stage requires more than just closed-door cultivation. There are many tricks and obstacles along the way.

A Primordial Spirit True Monarch can freely manipulate the power of the Grand Dao, which is the fundamental difference between a Primordial Spirit cultivator and other cultivators.

For Meng Zhang to enter the Primordial Spirit stage, besides nurturing the Gold Core and waiting for the critical moment of breaking through to the divine transformation, he also needs to attempt to comprehend the power of the Grand Dao and determine his future path.

Although Meng Zhang has top-grade spiritual roots, their role diminishes during the breakthrough to the Primordial Spirit stage. His spiritual roots possess both Yin and Yang attributes, and he practices the "Sun-Moon Wheel Turning Sutra." While the Sun-Moon attributes can be seen as equivalent to Yin and Yang attributes, they are not entirely the same.

There are differences between the Sun-Moon Avenue and the Yin Yang Grand Dao. The Yin Yang Grand Dao encompasses a broader range and has greater adaptability. In the universe, there are many places without sun or moon, but places without Yin and Yang are rare.

Meng Zhang has many choices in selecting the Grand Dao. His body attributes make him inclined towards the Yin Yang Grand Dao, and the "Sun-Moon Wheel Turning Sutra" primarily expounds on the Sun-Moon Avenue but extends to the Yin Yang Grand Dao.

Among the Primordial Spirit predecessors who practiced the "Sun-Moon Wheel Turning Sutra" in the Taiyi Sect, some managed to master the power of the Yin Yang Grand Dao through it.

Besides the words "Sun" and "Moon," the sutra also contains the words "Wheel" and "Turning." The Sun-Moon Wheel Turning implies spatial changes and the alternation of time.

If he continues to study this technique in depth, he may even come into contact with the Space Grand Dao and the Time Grand Dao.

The criteria for judging the excellence of a technique are diverse, including ease of cultivation, the magnitude of its power, its associated Divine Abilities, and its upper limit.

In the eyes of the top sects in the Cultivation World, the more Grand Dao aspects a technique encompasses and the deeper it goes, the more potential it has.

From this perspective, the "Sun-Moon Wheel Turning Sutra" being Taiyi Sect's core inheritance and highly valued even during its prime is well-deserved.

To comprehend the rules of the Grand Dao from one's main cultivation technique, it's not enough to merely immerse oneself in cultivation. Apart from a few exceptional geniuses, most Gold Core completion cultivators need to study scriptures and comprehend Daoist texts to sense the existence of the Grand Dao.

Meng Zhang already knew this and, since entering the Gold Core stage, he never neglected his contemplation of scriptures and Daoist texts, no matter how busy he was. Especially after discovering that this comprehension significantly enhanced his Heavenly Prediction Arts, he invested even more effort in it.

Chapter 699: Yin Yang Gourd

Although Meng Zhang is extremely eager to break through to the Primordial Spirit stage as soon as possible, he knows that cultivation cannot be rushed; it must proceed step by step. At many times, besides his own efforts, he also needs opportunities.

After a long period of seclusion, Meng Zhang finally left the closed-door secret room and resumed his responsibilities as the Taiyi Sect Master. When he calmed down and began to settle himself, the four Guardian Spirit Generals also brought him a great surprise.

The storeroom in the Void Cauldron's independent space has been almost fully checked. Useful resources have been taken out and transported back to the Taiyi Sect's main gate and stored in the treasury. The inheritance books and the like have been basically copied and sent back to the Hidden Scripture Pavilion of the Taiyi Sect's main gate.

The four Guardian Spirit Generals did not completely empty the space in the Void Cauldron because it is the most reliable secret storage place, capable of storing many important items. Even if the situation in Jiuqu League deteriorates or Taiyi Sect encounters unexpected events, with the treasures in the independent space of the Void Cauldron, Taiyi Sect still has a chance to rise again.

Besides, Maple Leaf Mountain City was originally prepared by Meng Zhang as a retreat for the Taiyi Sect. When Jiuqu League called for Taiyi Sect cultivators to participate in the war at Yuantu Great Prairie, the four Guardian Spirit Generals, being the most powerful force in the sect, naturally had to go.

Many treasures in the storeroom were not marked with their origins, and unless a cultivator had keen eyesight, they wouldn't be able to recognize their true value. It was only when the four Guardian Spirit Generals took turns to return to the main gate for rest that they could be transported to Maple Leaf Mountain City and slowly sort out the items.

In this way, it took several times longer than the originally planned time to finish counting these items. Not to mention the most precious inheritance books, just the various resources inside surpassed the accumulations of many long-established Gold Core sects over the years.

With this harvest, the entire Taiyi Sect was overjoyed. The risks that Meng Zhang took before were completely worth it. All the efforts were not in vain.

Among these items, Meng Zhang also found a treasure that is crucially important to him. It is a gourd exuding abundant spiritual energy, possessing extraordinary divine abilities. In the Cultivation World, there are many kinds of spiritual gourds. However, this particular gourd has exceptional materials and inherently contains the essence of Yin and Yang. In terms of rank, it is a Fourth Rank spiritual item.

It's unknown where Taiyi Sect's predecessors obtained this gourd.

Ordinary cultivators can attempt to refine a natal magic tool after reaching the Foundation Building stage. As the cultivator's cultivation base steadily improves, the natal magic tool can also be upgraded accordingly. However, it is pitiful that Meng Zhang has already cultivated to the Gold Core completion stage, just one step away from achieving the Primordial Spirit stage, but he has not yet refined a natal magic tool.

Although there are many factors contributing to this situation, Meng Zhang's case is far from being treated as a protagonist. Not to mention the natal magic tool, even his magic tools are not that remarkable. His most powerful spiritual weapon, the Spiritsnake Spear, is a damaged item handed down from Taiyi Sect's ancestors. It has experienced many setbacks and was only reluctantly repaired.

As for other magic tools like the Shadow Killing Sword and Fierce Yang Sword, they are not even worth mentioning.

Many cultivators require suitable magic tools to unleash their strongest combat power, and Meng Zhang is no exception. His current magic tools are only slightly better than basic equipment. If he were to be equipped with top-tier gear, his combat prowess could increase significantly. Now that he has obtained this spiritual gourd, it gives him an opportunity to compensate for his equipment shortcomings.

This spiritual gourd possesses qualities in material, attributes, and future development prospects that make it perfect to be refined into Meng Zhang's natal magic tool. After discussing with Shocking Thunder Spirit General, who is a masterful tool refiner, they formulated the final refinement plan. A truly exceptional tool refiner doesn't merely copy the blueprints of predecessors' magic tools but can innovate and create.

For the sake of refining this magic tool, Shocking Thunder Spirit General spent several years researching and gathering numerous materials. When everything was ready, Meng Zhang used his authority as the Sect Master to recall Shocking Thunder Spirit General back to the sect, allowing someone else to take his place in the war.

After much preparation, Shocking Thunder Spirit General and Delicate Water Spirit General joined forces and took turns using water refinement and fire refinement techniques to begin the refinement process. As copious auxiliary materials were poured into it, the spiritual gourd started to undergo various transformations. The Yin and Yang essence within the gourd was awakened, and its original green body turned into a mix of black and white.

Water and fire can also be seen as representations of Yin and Yang, and by employing both water refinement and fire refinement techniques, the gourd's Yin-Yang attributes were fully stimulated. Day and night, Shocking Thunder Spirit General and Delicate Water Spirit General tirelessly refined the gourd, and it took a full nine years to produce a preliminary item.

Next, it was up to Meng Zhang to contribute. He used his True Essence to refine the item and then incorporated it into his dantian for nurturing. In the Cultivation World, most Fourth Rank magic tools evolved from Third Rank magic tools. Although this item was only Third Rank, it had the potential to advance to Fourth Rank.

To nurture and strengthen this item, Meng Zhang spared no effort, even expending blood essence and depleting his Soul. After six more years, the item began to take shape and grew into a complete magic tool. He named this natal magic tool "Yin Yang Gourd," which had a black and white appearance.

The Yin Yang Gourd could release Yin and Yang Qi. The Yin Qi contained boundless deathly intent, capable of depriving others of their vitality. The Yang Qi, on the other hand, could dispel evil and demons while carrying life-giving properties, offering miraculous healing abilities.

Of course, the so-called "miraculous healing" did not mean it could genuinely revive the dead. It was just a powerful healing technique. When Yin and Yang Qi were combined, they could erode all things. Most things in the world were formed by the combination of Yin and Yang Qi, and if the quality of the spiritual gourd was high enough, it could indeed assimilate all things.

The Yin and Yang Qi in the gourd possessed strong sentience and could transform into special Dao soldiers, obedient to Meng Zhang's commands. With the Yin Yang Gourd, he could also enhance all Yin and Yang-based Divine Abilities. For instance, a Divine Ability called Twin Forms Towards Heaven Sword, which he cultivated in his early years, was refined using Yin and Yang Fiend Qi. With the strengthening from the Yin Yang Spirit Gourd, the power of this Divine Ability could be significantly boosted.

Chapter 700: Yin Yang Dao Soldier

With the Yin Yang Gourd as his natal magic tool, Meng Zhang's combat power has increased significantly. Furthermore, when he achieves the Primordial Spirit in the future, there is a chance for this magic tool to be promoted to a Fourth Rank magic tool.

The importance of a natal magic tool to a Cultivator is self-evident, and Meng Zhang has finally made up for this shortcoming before entering the Primordial Spirit realm.

Soon after refining the Yin Yang Gourd, Shocking ThunderSpirit General and Delicate WaterSpirit General had to respond to the call and go to war in the intense battle at the Yuantu Great Prairie.

As Jade Sword Sect is about to launch a major counterattack against the extraterritorial Barbarian Clan, the demand for combat power on the frontlines becomes more urgent. All major forces of the Jiuqu League have been conscripted.

Several Gold Core Daoist Masters from Taiyi Sect, who were originally staying behind, were also called to the frontlines.

Meng Zhang, after spending a long time in the sect, felt a bit restless and decided to go to the Yuantu Great Prairie to participate in the battle against the extraterritorial Barbarian Clan. One reason was to witness the abilities of the Barbarian Clan, and the other was to rotate some of the Gold Core cultivators from his sect.

However, just as he was preparing to go, there was sudden intelligence from Red Rock Valley that there seemed to be unusual activity from the Sea Clan.

At this moment, Taiyi Sect is particularly vulnerable. Apart from a few recently formed Gold Core Daoist Masters, almost all the experienced Gold Core Daoist Masters have gone to the Yuantu Great Prairie.

More than half of the Foundation Building cultivators from the sect are also mobilized. The remaining less than half have to take care of various affairs within and outside Taiyi Sect, looking after the vast territory of the sect, and they are already overwhelmed with work.

The fact that the Sea Clan chose this time to cause trouble really angered Meng Zhang.

Having reached the Gold Core completion realm and possessing a new natal magic tool, Meng Zhang was itching for action.

If the Sea Clan dares to cause trouble at this time, he will not back down.

Meng Zhang teleported from the Hundred Grass Slope of the sect to Red Rock Valley, where the newly formed Gold Core Daoist Master, Luo Sanping, was patrolling outside. He hurriedly came to report when he heard that the Sect Master had arrived.

Luo Sanping had not been in the Gold Core realm for long and had formed the core around the same time as Meng Zhang's two disciples, An Xiaoran and An Moran.

He had only recently stabilized his Cultivation Base in the Gold Core realm and had not practiced many secret techniques or Divine Abilities. But due to the shortage of manpower in the sect, he was mobilized to guard Red Rock Valley.

Fortunately, Taiyi Sect now has two Third Rank tool refiners, Shocking ThunderSpirit General and Delicate WaterSpirit General, which ensures that the Gold Core Daoist Masters in the sect can obtain Third Rank magic tools.

Moreover, Taiyi Sect can intermittently acquire some Third Rank magic tools from the outside through various means. In the recently rebuilt treasure trove of Taiyi Sect, there are several usable Third Rank magic tools.

Of course, the truly powerful magic tools are distributed among the cultivators for the final mountain gate defense battle.

Luo Sanping holds a Third Rank magic tool and relies on a Third Rank mountain-guarding formation. As long as it's not a massive invasion by the Sea Clan, he can protect Red Rock Valley.

Even if they encounter a full-scale attack from the Sea Clan, he can hold on for a while and buy time for Taiyi Sect to mobilize its forces.

According to Luo Sanping's report, the Sea Clan has been constantly mobilizing its forces at the border of Taiyi Sect's territory. Their armies occasionally form formations in the border area and sometimes seem to be ready to launch a sudden attack on Taiyi Sect's territory.

After listening to Luo Sanping's report, Meng Zhang has a rough judgment in his mind.

It seems that the Sea Clan currently does not have plans for a large-scale invasion. Otherwise, they wouldn't need to create such a spectacle and could directly launch an attack.

They are most likely trying to bluff and disrupt the enemy.

Of course, if Taiyi Sect appears too weak and exposes significant vulnerabilities, the Sea Clan might take the opportunity to launch a genuine attack and take advantage of Taiyi Sect.

As long as the Sea Clan retreats before the Human Clan's Primordial Spirit True Monarch intervenes, the True Monarch from the Human Clan should not cause any trouble and will firmly hold on to the situation.

These Sea Clan guys really know how to seize opportunities. Taking advantage of the Jiuqu League's battle with the extraterritorial Barbarian Clan, they deliberately stir up trouble here.

Of course, the extraterritorial Barbarian Clan is the mortal enemy of the Human Clan Cultivators and also the enemy of the Sea Clan.

Although the possibility of collusion between the Sea Clan and the extraterritorial Barbarian Clan is not high, Meng Zhang still cannot take it lightly.

After checking the defenses inside and outside Red Rock Valley and confirming that there were no issues, he rejected Luo Sanping's offer to accompany him and flew alone towards the border area between Taiyi Sect and the Sea Clan.

According to Meng Zhang's judgment, as long as the Sea Clan does not intend to wage a full-scale war with the Jiuqu League, they will not deploy Fourth Rank experts. Being a Gold Core completion cultivator, he has nothing to worry about as long as he doesn't get surrounded by the Sea Clan's army.

When Meng Zhang arrived at the border area, he indeed saw a large Sea Clan army forming up ahead.

Although Meng Zhang wished he could annihilate the entire Sea Clan army, the situation forced him to consider his strategy.

The Sea Clan does not want to engage in a full-scale war with the Jiuqu League, which is currently at war with the extraterritorial Barbarian Clan. Similarly, the Jiuqu League does not want to break out into a full-scale war with the Sea Clan at this time.

If Meng Zhang were to cause significant casualties among the Sea Clan's army at this time, Taiyi Sect might have to face the retaliation of the entire Sea Clan alone.

He took out the Yin Yang Gourd, which he had been nurturing in his dantian for a long time, in his left hand.

Meng Zhang raised his left hand, and a black and white mixed airflow spewed out from the mouth of the gourd, transforming into three Daoists wearing black and white Dao robes. These were the Yin Yang Dao Soldiers nurtured within the Yin Yang Gourd. Nurturing Dao Soldiers requires a lot of precious materials and a considerable amount of time.

Under conditions of sufficient materials, one can nurture a Dao Soldier with the initial strength of the Gold Core realm each year, with a total of nine possible. If nurturing Dao Soldiers with the strength of the Foundation Building realm, six can be nurtured each year, with a total of thirty-six possible.

With this Yin Yang Gourd, as long as Meng Zhang had enough materials and time, he alone could rival a well-established Gold Core sect.

Due to time and material constraints, Meng Zhang had only nurtured three Dao Soldiers with the initial strength of the Gold Core realm within the Yin Yang Gourd.

As for Dao Soldiers with the strength of the Foundation Building realm, Taiyi Sect was not lacking. Within the mountain gate, there was a Soldier Nest that had been modified by Meng Zhang.

The Soldier Nest was a legacy left behind by the Fifth Rank Earth Spirit and, after Meng Zhang mastered it, became the source of Dao Soldier production for Taiyi Sect.

From initially producing only one type of Dao Soldier called the Yellow Earth Strongman, it could now produce a total of four types of Dao Soldiers.

Usually, the Soldier Nest primarily produces First Rank and Second Rank Dao Soldiers.

With this batch of Dao Soldiers, Taiyi Sect's strength in lower-level cultivators has increased several times.

Although Dao Soldiers cannot replace cultivators in many situations, they significantly narrowed the gap between Taiyi Sect and those well-established sects.

Now, Meng Zhang summoned these three Gold Core stage Yin Yang Dao Soldiers to show the Sea Clan army some strength and deter them from taking advantage of the situation.
