Meng Zhang has a faint feeling that the merit he gained from killing Xu Huanshan alongside Xu Mengying this time is quite substantial, surpassing what he obtained when he killed the Demonic Cultivation Ye Feifan in the past. Xu Huanshan was a Primordial Spirit late stage cultivator, and his descent into demonic cultivation was significant for the demonic path. On the other hand, Ye Feifan, despite having extraordinary potential and being recognized by the Demon Domain, was just a Gold Core stage cultivator.

Killing Xu Huanshan holds great significance, making a greater contribution to the Grand Dust World. The impartial and just Grand Dust World Heavenly Dao treats all beings like grass.

The merit Meng Zhang obtained from this enlightenment has already dissipated by half. However, it saved him decades or even hundreds of years, helping him complete his final accumulation and removing the last obstacles on his path to the Primordial Spirit stage.

Meng Zhang has a strong intuition that after returning to Taiyi Sect, he can directly enter closed-door cultivation to break through to the Primordial Spirit stage. Everything is now prepared, only the right opportunity is needed.

Meng Zhang wastes no time and rushes back to Taiyi Sect's mountain gate, Hundred Grass Slope. Shortly after returning, he sees Shocking Thunder Spirit General, who is covered in scars, missing half an arm on the upper body, and floating in the air with no legs visible. Indeed, Shocking Thunder Spirit General brought a piece of extremely bad news, one might even call it a calamity. One of the fiercely combative and veteran Gold Core Daoist Masters in Taiyi Sect, Zheng Chao, suffered critical injuries and was on the brink of death. If not for the timely return of Jin Li True Monarch, who expended great effort to heal him, his life might not have been spared. However, even with the treatment, Zheng Chao would require a very long time to completely recover and would likely have significant lingering effects. His Cultivation Base would be unable to advance any further in the future.

Another highly skilled Gold Core Daoist Master in beast-taming techniques in Taiyi Sect, Hu Jing, lost all three Third Rank natal spirit beasts in battle and was severely injured, her foundation shaken, and her Cultivation Base compromised.

The other Taiyi Sect Gold Core cultivators in Dongyuan City fared somewhat better, but the situation was still far from optimistic. After Jin Li True Monarch stabilized their severely injured bodies, they were promptly sent back to Taiyi Sect. As for the Foundation Building stage cultivators dispatched by Taiyi Sect, their casualties were nearly total, with only a few survivors.

Jin Li is one of the first Primordial Spirit True Monarchs who rushed to support Dongyuan City. With the extraterritorial Barbarian Clan attacking and capturing Dongyuan City, Jin Li could be considered negligent in her duties.

The losses suffered by the Jiuqu League this time were exceedingly severe. Not to mention the casualties among ordinary cultivators, just the deaths and injuries of two Primordial Spirit True Monarchs were unprecedented losses that hadn't been seen in many years.

Furious, Jin Li True Monarch displayed her might and directly killed several of the Barbarian Clan's generals on the spot, even injuring a Barbarian King.

After taking control of Dongyuan City, she showed special consideration for the Taiyi Sect cultivators due to their unique relationship. She actively searched for medical treatment for the severely injured Taiyi Sect cultivators and even expended her own vital energy to stabilize the injuries of several Gold Core Daoist Masters.

She arranged for this group of Taiyi Sect cultivators to handle logistics in Dongyuan City, originally intending to take care of them. But now, seeing the devastating losses suffered by the Taiyi Sect cultivators, she felt guilty and had a sense of shame.

Using her authority, she prioritized sending the Taiyi Sect cultivators back to their sect. A significant portion of the Taiyi Sect cultivators were conscripted to Dongyuan City, while some were directly participating in frontline battles.

Although the latter group of cultivators had also suffered losses in the frontline battles, they had not experienced such a calamity.

Niu Dawei, who was commanding Taiyi Sect disciples in the frontline battles, heard about the situation in the rear and left Wen Qiansun and Yang Xueyi in charge. He rushed back to Dongyuan City along with Extreme Sword Spirit General.

Upon returning to Dongyuan City, they arrived just as Jin Li True Monarch was stabilizing the injuries of the severely injured Taiyi Sect cultivators, preparing to send them back to Taiyi Sect.

Niu Dawei and Extreme Sword Spirit General escorted the injured cultivators back to their sect.

Shocking Thunder Spirit General returned to the sect and first reported the details to Meng Zhang. Initially, Meng Zhang was planning to go to Dongyuan City to retrieve the injured Taiyi Sect cultivators. However, the flying vessel carrying the injured cultivators returned to Taiyi Sect before he could depart.

Upon seeing his master Meng Zhang, Niu Dawei felt deeply ashamed and knelt down to apologize, saying that he hadn't taken good care of his fellow sect members.

The few surviving Foundation Building cultivators also received careful care from the sect.

An Xiaoran and An Moran, who were left behind to guard the sect, are actively seeking medical treatment for their fellow disciples. An Xiaoran, being a Third Rank Alchemist, quickly began alchemy and produced several batches of healing elixirs.

Meng Zhang's Cultivation Base has reached the Gold Core completion stage, and he has gained a deep understanding of the Grand Dao's rules. In terms of treating injuries, his abilities exceed those of most medical practitioners in the Cultivation World.
