# Sect Master 721

#### Chapter 721: Branch

Gu Yue Family and Lu Family are both dominant families in Great Wind City. In all aspects, Gu Yue Family is second only to Lu Family. In the world of cultivation, there is no place for those who are content to live a peaceful life as good people. Meng Zhang doesn't believe that Gu Yue Family is willing to forever remain subordinate to Lu Family, meekly accepting their position as the second power for a thousand years. If there is powerful external support, would Gu Yue Family not covet the position of the city lord of Great Wind City? If there is an opportunity to replace Lu Family's status, would Gu Yue Family not be tempted?

Although Taiyi Sect has a close relationship with Gu Yue Family, Meng Zhang has had many dealings with them before. However, after achieving the status of Primordial Spirit True Monarch, this is the first time he has contacted Gu Yue Family with a specific purpose in mind. Despite becoming a Primordial Spirit True Monarch, Meng Zhang has not become arrogant or careless. He continues to act with caution and thoughtfulness.

Before taking action, Meng Zhang specifically sent a message to Daoist Master Luo Ye, asking for her help in gathering deep-level intelligence about Gu Yue Family.

For instance, An Moran's elder sister, An Xiaoran, after forming her Gold Core, still held the position of Hall Master in Pill Hall while also being a Gold Core elder. Taiyi Sect has now become a subordinate of Jade Sword Sect, wholeheartedly serving the interests of Jade Sword Sect. Naturally, Jade Sword Sect will offer some benefits to Taiyi Sect. Setting aside the deepening of the exchange and cooperation between the two sects, the sharing of information and intelligence is a very natural thing.

Meng Zhang and Elder Beast Fury collaborated to kill two Primordial Spirit True Monarchs from New Beast King Mountain, and later, Meng Zhang also wiped out a group of Lu Family cultivators, including Lu Haosheng. This served as a reliable proof of allegiance to Jade Sword Sect.

In the eyes of the higher-ups in Jade Sword Sect, Meng Zhang is considered a reliable ally. As long as Meng Zhang's requests are not too excessive, Jade Sword Sect will try to fulfill them. In front of an old friend, Meng Zhang didn't conceal her thoughts much. Luo YeDaoist Master, being from the Dark Alliance organization, had a special knack for reading people.

That was the Jade Sword Sect, the one that had been clamoring for a full-scale war with the Dali Dynasty many years ago. While there were cunning individuals among Sword Cultivators, generally speaking, they were straightforward and reliable in the Cultivation World. Though often referred to as "sword maniacs," they had much stronger credibility compared to other cultivators.

Meng Zhang couldn't help but feel astonished that these bold Sword Cultivators would collude with their enemies. He almost wanted to recite the Three Character Classic out loud in response.

#### Chapter 725: Launch

Helping the Gu Yue Family replace the Lu Family and control Great Wind City comes with many benefits. Recently, Meng Zhang has devoted a significant portion of his thoughts to this matter. He has delegated the specific details of the work to the high-ranking members of the Taiyi Sect. In the following period, the Gold Core Daoist Masters of the Taiyi Sect have had several secret meetings with the high-ranking members of the Gu Yue Family to formulate various plans.

The Gu Yue Family has also harbored the intention of replacing the Lu Family, but due to various reasons, they knew it would be difficult to achieve. At best, it could result in mutual destruction, so they refrained from taking action. However, they have never ceased to gather information and conduct various investigations regarding the Lu Family.

Unknown to the Lu Family, the Gu Yue Family has long been aware of the family's secrets and the information about their powerful members. They have prepared targeted countermeasures. This time, with the assistance of the Taiyi Sect, the Gu Yue Family aims to overthrow the Lu Family, marking the first comprehensive involvement of the Taiyi Sect in the internal power struggles of a Gold Core force since its establishment.

Although Meng Zhang has assigned the specific tasks to his disciples, he regularly inquires about the progress. After cultivators enter the Primordial Spirit stage, even the spiritual energy provided by a Third Rank Spirit Vein cannot meet their cultivation needs. Apart from refining and absorbing rare Heaven and Earth Spiritual Objects, cultivators in the early stage of the Primordial Spirit can also enter the Nine Heavens to collect Nine Heavens Refined Essence.

Of course, the quality and quantity of Nine Heavens Refined Essence required by cultivators in the early stage of the Primordial Spirit far exceed those of Gold Core stage cultivators. Once their Cultivation Base reaches the mid-stage of the Primordial Spirit, Nine Heavens Refined Essence can no longer meet their cultivation needs. At this point, cultivators need to enter extraterritorial voids to seek various opportunities hidden within.

Although Meng Zhang's combat strength is not weak, he has only recently entered the Primordial Spirit stage. He only needs to enter the Nine Heavens to collect Nine Heavens Refined Essence, which is sufficient for his daily cultivation needs.

However, being a Primordial Spirit True Monarch from a major sect like Azure Origin Sect, he might possess some unknown means.

The Gu Yue Family and the Taiyi Sect's allied cultivators were fiercely attacking various strongholds of the Lu Family. Some of the weaker bases fell without much resistance before the mountain protection grand formation was fully activated. #### Chapter 727: Return

Taiyi Sect had played a significant role in this matter, especially Meng Zhang, in helping Gu Yue Family take control of Great Wind City. Taiyi Sect's contribution was immense, and Gu Yue Family wouldn't overlook their efforts.

Chapter 728: Reclamation

Yellow Lotus Sect East River Branch was in complete chaos from top to bottom, but Taiyi Sect was not idle.

Several fleets of flying boats arrived from Demon Wind Gobi, each carrying elite teams of Taiyi Sect cultivators.

Meng Zhang, with a stern expression, personally flew to the sky above Feihong Mountain and displayed a powerful Great Divine Ability, allowing the cultivators of East River Branch below to witness its might.
