Thus, Liam calculated that he would have to vanquish approximately 480 foes—either those at his level or weaker—to accumulate the necessary 500 points.


With a surge of power, he effortlessly blasted through another wave of enemies before descending down the mountain path.

But Liam understood the gravity of the situation; if he chose to skimp on spending the 100 points now, the potential consequences could be far more severe.


After a moment of hesitation, Liam made the tough decision to exchange points for a Refreshing breeze pill and promptly consumed it.
