He then lowered his head and apologized, "My failure as a parent led to this. I apologize once more for my son's behavior. Please forgive us, Mr. Hoffman."


Reluctantly, Liam forgave them, telling Nolan, "Take care of him. Ensure strict discipline, or the consequences won't be as lenient next time!"
