All of these Werewolves were Level 55 or above, with the highest at Level 58. They ranged between Elites and Special Elites. If an ordinary player attempted to take all of these monsters on by themselves, they'd definitely be torn apart.

As Shi Feng observed these Werewolves, the sound of a system notification reached his ears.

System: Clear this Divine Shrine to obtain a reward.

When the system notification ended, a system map appeared in the corner of Shi Feng's vision. A teleportation point had been marked on the map in the heart of the forest. It was obvious that he had to reach said teleportation point to leave the Divine Shrine.

In God's Domain, the title of Realm Lord did not represent a monster's rank or Bloodline. Rather, it was a buff that greatly enhanced the monster's Skills and Spells. Monsters with this title also had strengthened physiques and HPs. Basically, they were Boss-like existences among monsters of the same level and rank.

Realm Lords were not particularly rare in God's Domain, but they were usually only found in Level 50plus, resource-rich maps. They protected these resource maps, and as long as they remained in their designated maps, they could display far more combat power than monsters of the same level and rank.

Normally, player teams avoided Realm Lords as much as possible.

Fighting these monsters simply wasn't worthwhile. Despite being so much stronger than monsters of the same level and rank, Realm Lords didn't offer additional or better loot.

Is the Divine Shrine itself some sort of opportunity? After a moment of surprise, Shi Feng's lips curled into a smile.

Obtaining one Mana Barrier Crystal Fragment after killing a single Special Elite ranked Realm Lord was a huge boon from the system.

Each Mana Barrier Crystal Fragment had sold for around 30 Gold in the past. Of course, most Guilds that had obtained these crystal shards had refused to sell them.

When players collected ten crystal fragments, they could seek out an NPC Master Alchemist to synthesize the Mana Barrier Crystal with a 40% success rate. If the synthesis were successful, one would have an everlasting Magic Crystal. The Mana Barrier Crystal was a priceless treasure, useful in multiple aspects, such as powering teleportation arrays, Magic Towers, and other such constructions.

There had even been a few Workshops that had specialized in hunting Realm Lords in distant maps, making a living from selling Mana Barrier Crystals.

After obtaining the crystal fragment, Shi Feng moved towards the teleportation array and left the forest.

When he opened his eyes again, he had arrived at the first Divine Shrine's exit, and the staircase leading to the second shrine stretched before him. Many players were already running towards the second Divine Shrine.

So many people are already out? Shi Feng was surprised. Over a hundred players were already approaching the second Divine Shrine.

Passing the Divine Shrine had only earned him 10 SPs, yet killing the Special Elite ranked Specter Werewolf had awarded 50...

Even the cheapest item available for purchase in the Divine Shrine cost 500 SPs. If one cleared the first Divine Shrine quickly and ignored killing the Guardian Boss, they would only receive 20 SPs. With that method, who knew how many Divine Shrines one would have to clear to accumulate 500 SPs? Moreover, as players climbed the Divine Staircase, the Divine Shrines would become more challenging. If players did not earn as many points as possible early on, it would only become more difficult to earn the points they needed later.

It seems that I'll have to defeat every Divine Shrine's Guardian Boss. Thinking up to this point, Shi Feng realized the fastest way to earn Shrine Points from the Divine Staircase.

Following which, he proceeded towards the second Divine Shrine.

When learned, you will be able to produce the Level 50 Magic Rune Armor. Every piece of crafted armor contains a magic array. Five pieces can be used to form the Basic Strength Battle Array. (Current fragment count 1/9)

I never expected the Divine Shrines to drop something like this! I've really lucked out this time. Shi Feng was at a loss for words as he stared at the Conqueror's Armor Design.

Not only had the Five-headed Demon Snake dropped two Mana Barrier Crystal Fragments, but it had also dropped a Fine-Gold Equipment Design that came with a battle array. Killing the Demon Snake had been far more profitable than killing a Level 60 Grand Lord.

A well-equipped peak expert in God's Domain wasn't a force to be reckoned with. In fact, despite being an individual, they were capable of playing a significant role in a Guild war. However, that did not mean ordinary players were utterly helpless against peak experts. Ordinary players still had a method they could use to fight peak experts. Battle arrays!

If a certain number of players wore equipment with the same battle array, they could trigger the battle array's effects, significantly increasing their combat power.

Battle arrays provided more than just a boost to Basic Attributes; they also improved players' physiques. Most importantly, it allowed players with the same array to share their perception. This helped players remove defensive blind spots, visibly improving their combat standards.

Although a Basic Battle Array only allowed players to share a limited degree of their perception, it still elevated players' combat standards to a whole new level.

Many of God's Domain's small Guilds in the past had survived and thrived, even after ten years, precisely because of battle arrays.

Even without peak experts, Guilds with powerful battle arrays could take down a peak expert with just a few players or a dozen or so working together. Some small Guilds had even stood toe-to-toe with large Guilds by relying on these arrays.

Of course, battle arrays were not without weaknesses.

In exchange for the huge boost in strength, players' Stamina and Concentration consumption increased massively. When players activated a battle array, their Stamina and Concentration would deplete several times faster than normal. This limited the amount of time that players had when using battle arrays.

However, despite such a glaring flaw, battle arrays had been highly sought after by many Guilds.

Equipment with battle arrays was extremely rare, and usually only dropped from super-large-scale Team Dungeons. Monsters in the fields had no chance of dropping such items. Moreover, the higher-quality a piece of battle array equipment was, the more valuable it was. A piece of battle array equipment could easily sell for several times more than a piece of equipment of the same rank.

Although he had only obtained a fragment of a Level 50 Fine-Gold Battle Array Equipment Design, it was still quite valuable. If he completed the design, its value would be immeasurable.

Since the Divine Shrine's Guardian Boss dropped a fragment, the other shrine's Bosses should have a chance of dropping them as well. As Shi Feng examined the Conqueror's Armor Design, he inwardly swore to complete it no matter what. Immediately, he moved towards the teleportation array and proceeded to the next Divine Shrine.

By the time Shi Feng appeared on the staircase leading to the 11th Divine Shrine, players had already reached the 15th. He was far behind.

System: Congratulations! You have passed the Divine Shrine. Rewarding 300 Shrine Points.

System: Congratulations! You have passed the Divine Shrine within the time limit. Rewarding 300 Shrine Points.

System: Congratulations! You have killed the Guardian Boss within the time limit. Rewarding 2,000 Shrine Points.

However, although other players progressed faster than he did, Shi Feng contained the most SPs of any player in the World Summit. Currently, Shi Feng had already accumulated 8,960 SPs. If players ascended the Divine Staircase without defeating the Guardian Bosses, even after reaching the 15th Divine Shrine, they would not have even half of Shi Feng's points.

Time passed quickly, and the Divine Shrines became more difficult as Shi Feng climbed the Divine Staircase. By the time Shi Feng reached the 15th Divine Shrine, he had to face a Lord ranked Realm Lord with a special Bloodline. By the time he emerged from the 15th shrine, many players had been eliminated in the 20th shrine.

As Shi Feng had guessed, the other shrines' Guardian Bosses had a chance of dropping the Conqueror's Armor Forging Design Fragment if he activated Divine Providence when he killed them. By the time he had cleared the 15th Divine Shrine, he had gained another fragment. He just needed to wait for Divine Providence's Cooldown to end before proceeding to the next Divine Shrine.

As for Mana Barrier Crystal Fragments, he now had 17.

However, Shi Feng had grown a bit weary after fighting for so long. Taking a look at the time, he realized how long he had spent in God's Domain. He then consumed a drop of Life Essence from the Blood Refining Crystal to boost his Stamina and Concentration recovery before logging out of the game.

Players' accumulated time in the World Summit only decreased when players were online; logging off to rest would not affect one's progress. Hence, to maintain their combat efficiency, many players had long since chosen to log out. After all, challenging the Divine Staircase was a long and arduous progress, and as one climbed the staircase, they'd have to navigate larger maps in the Divine Shrines. As a result, players had to spend more time clearing the shrines.

By the time Shi Feng logged out, the sun had risen high into the sky. The moment Shi Feng's consciousness returned to his body, he was bombarded by a series of messages and call notifications. There were messages and calls from both Blackie and Aqua Rose.

In fact, Shi Feng received another call from Aqua Rose before he had the chance to leave his gaming cabin.

"What's with the urgency? Has something happened?" Shi Feng curiously asked after accepting the call.

"Guild Leader, you've finally picked up. Any later and I would've sent Blackie to look for you in person," Aqua Rose said somewhat anxiously. "While you were gone, Zero Wing City has developed nicely. The player population has already broken past the 1,000,000-threshold. Once we finish constructing the NPC Shops, the city will attract even more players. But some time ago, two representatives from the Blackwater Corporation sought me out. They told us to hand over Youlan and her companions and 50% of Zero Wing City's income as compensation. Otherwise, they'll turn the full might of the Blackwater Guild against us."

"Hand over Youlan, her companions, and 50% of Zero Wing City's profits?" Shi Feng frowned.

The Blackwater Corporation's retaliation didn't surprise him in the least, but he didn't expect Blackwater to take action so quickly. Moreover, the corporation's timing couldn't be worse, targeting them while they were in a war of attrition against Heaven's Burial. This put Zero Wing at a considerable disadvantage.

Chapter 1575 – Nurturing Experts

It seems that I'll need to speed things up, Shi Feng thought after hearing Aqua Rose's report.

He was quite familiar with the Blackwater Corporation's power. He had witnessed its rise in God's Domain in the past.

Despite joining God's Domain so late, Blackwater had still developed into a Super Guild quite quickly in the past. One could just imagine how frightening Blackwater's potential was. Furthermore, the Blackwater Corporation had invested in God's Domain much earlier in this life.

Blackwater's experts had already caught up with God's Domain's mainstream players. Otherwise, it wouldn't have stood a chance against the other superpowers vying for the Iron Empire.

Of course, Zero Wing didn't have much to be afraid of if the Blackwater Corporation focused on its development in the Iron Empire. Based on what he heard from Youlan, the Guild had only recently taken control of the empire. The Guild was just starting to expand. Although Blackwater possessed plenty of experts and funding, it lacked the power to spread its influence across multiple kingdoms and empires as the various super-first-rate and Super Guilds had.

While the organization might be able to deal with small Guilds right now, it couldn't touch Zero Wing.

Unfortunately, that was only true if Blackwater worked alone. If it worked with Heaven's Burial, Zero Wing's situation would take a turn for the worst.

Blackwater could leave the reconnaissance to Heaven's Burial while it supplied the Guild with a large number of experts.

Currently, players who wanted to grind and level up had to travel to distant maps, and most of the highlevel maps weren't concentrated in a single area. Even if Shi Feng used the Seven Luminaries Ring's Space Movement, it would take a considerable amount of time to travel from one high-level map to another.

"How much time have they given us to consider?" Shi Feng asked.

"One day...but I let my anger get the best of me, and I rejected their offer instantly..." Aqua Rose said in a subdued voice.

"You rejected them?" Shi Feng stared at Aqua Rose in surprise. "Did you really reject them?"

"Mhm." Aqua Rose nodded silently, knowing that she had made a huge mess of things.

By outright rejecting Blackwater's offer, she had undoubtedly created another powerful enemy for Zero Wing.

"Hahaha! Good! Well done!" Shi Feng could not help but laugh when he saw Aqua Rose's guilty expression. "Although Zero Wing is not very strong, we're never afraid of a challenge! If they want to come, let them. We'll fight it out."

"Guild Leader..." Aqua Rose felt guilty and slightly touched by Shi Feng's words. Not only didn't he blame her in the slightest, but he also actively encouraged her.

"Alright, don't worry about it. This isn't the first time we've fought a superpower," Shi Feng said, shrugging. "But be careful this time. Keep an eye on their movement at all times. Also, we need to push our Guild members to complete their Tier 2 promotions. Every bit of help is useful. Have our Guild's internal members focus on leveling quickly, so they can add to the Guild's combat power."

"Mhm. I'll prepare some top-tier equipment, Magic Scrolls, and Advanced Potions for our Guild members to challenge their Promotion Quests. As for the Guild's internal members, I'll help them level up with Summer," Aqua Rose said, nodding.

Following which, Shi Feng mentioned a few good grinding locations for Aqua Rose to use as she helped powerlevel Zero Wing's internal members.

The Guild's internal members already had solid combat standards; they only lacked levels. Once they were brought up to speed, Zero Wing would have another batch of expert players to help defend it.

When Shi Feng finished his call with Aqua Rose, he proceeded to train with the Guild's internal members. To help them improve faster, Shi Feng even provided specific guidance to a few talented members. He even went so far as to use the ten additional black cards he had acquired from the Secret Pavilion to train You Ziping and a few others.

In such a way, Shi Feng trained You Ziping and the other internal members during the day. When the sun set, he'd log back into God's Domain and grind through the Divine Staircase.

The greatest problem other players in the World summit faced was the drain on their Stamina and Concentration, but Shi Feng could rely on his Life Essence to boost his recovery rate, having no issues in this regard.

The only real problem was the Divine Shrine's increasing difficulty. As a result, Shi Feng had to take more time to clear each shrine. Initially, he had only spent 30 minutes on each Divine Shrine, though he spent most of that time waiting for Divine Providence's 30-minute Cooldown to end. As he ascended the

Divine Staircase, however, the amount of time he needed to clear each shrine gradually increased to two, then three hours...

After grinding for four consecutive days, Shi Feng finally defeated the 29th shrine's Guardian Boss, a Great Lord ranked Realm Lord.

He had initially assumed that he'd earn more Shrine Points from each subsequent Divine Shrine he cleared, but that wasn't entirely the case. After the 10th Divine Shrine, the SP reward only increased once every five Divine Shrines, yet these shrines' difficult constantly increased as he cleared the last. By the time Shi Feng cleared the 29th Divine Shrine, he had only accumulated 86,360 Shrine Points.

He was still roughly 14,000 points away from affording the cheapest Bloodline.

Fortunately, although he hadn't acquired as many Shrine Points as he had hoped, he had secured a decent number of Mana Barrier Crystal Fragments. When High Lord and Great Lord ranked Guardian Bosses died, they'd drop at least one crystal fragment, but he had obtained up to three crystal fragments from a single Boss. As a result, he had a total of 43 Mana Barrier Crystal Fragments.

As for the Conqueror's Armor Design, he had collected six fragments thus far. He was only three fragments away from completing the design.

He had also obtained over 100 Level 50 to Level 55 weapons and equipment. Their ranks ranged between Bronze and Secret-Silver, and although they weren't top-tier, they were rare and valuable at this stage of the game.

During this time, the White Tiger Dojo had also delivered the previously agreed 50 bottles of S-rank Nutrient Fluid and 20,000,000 Credits. Upon receiving the payment, Shi Feng assigned Shadow Sword to take charge of the 500 apprentices from the dojo. These apprentices would train in Zero Wing City's Battle Arena, improve their Skill Completion Rates in Stone Forest Town's advanced combat rooms, and level while grinding and questing each day. As a result, their combat standards steadily rose with each passing day.

Unfortunately, Zero Wing's members had encountered group skirmishes with Blackwater and Heaven's Burial's experts in the fields, increasing the Guild's expenditures. Despite the massive revenue source ZeroWing City had become, the situation took a heavy toll on the Guild's funds.

However, monetary compensation wasn't the Guild's biggest problem, but the loss of top-tier weapons and equipment. Meanwhile, the Guild only had a few teams capable of acquiring such items.

Although Aqua Rose and the other core members had formed teams to hunt down the enemy experts, they hadn't obtained enough Level 45 top-tier equipment to replenish the Guild's stock.

"Guild Leader, I'm afraid that our stock of Level 45 top-tier equipment in the Guild Warehouse will run out at this rate. Many of the other large Guilds in the kingdom have already surpassed our raid progress in Level 50 Team Dungeons," Aqua Rose reported, clearly frustrated. "Moreover, based on the latest reports, it seems that Blackwater has sent over 4,000 experts to target our players. Including Heaven's Burial's experts, our teams are suffering a massive disadvantage while grinding in the fields."

If Shi Feng were present, they might be able to slaughter Heaven's Burial and Blackwater's experts a few times by relying on his Spatial Gate, which would, more or less, make up for the Guild's losses.

Zero Wing's members were constantly ambushed in the fields, yet Tier 2 experts like her were limited in their ability to fend off every ambush. Unless their Guild members stopped leveling and questing, there'd be no end to this problem.

Moreover, Level 45 top-tier equipment was required to raid Level 50 Team Dungeons. If the Guild Warehouse ran out of such equipment, they'd have to stop raiding these Dungeons. If this persisted,

Guild members might even lose interest in earning Guild Contribution Points. If that happened, the Guild would fall apart.

"Have Melancholic and the others focus on crafting Level 45 equipment, and temporarily stop sales on Level 45 Secret-Silver and Fine-Gold Equipment. Use some of that stock to replenish the Guild Warehouse. If worst comes to worst, have Snow send some Level 45 top-tier equipment from the Branch Guild," Shi Feng said after giving the matter some thought.

He had never expected Blackwater to be ruthless enough to send 4,000 experts. To make matters worse, that wasn't the Guild's full strength. Blackwater's foundations had truly exceeded his expectations.

Shi Feng jumped back into his virtual gaming cabin, ignoring the fact that it was currently daytime and he was supposed to be resting. After logging back into God's Domain, he immediately made his way to the 30th Divine Shrine.

Chapter 1576 – Divine Shrine's Opportunity

Once Shi Feng entered the 30th Divine Shrine, the space before him transformed.

Currently, he faced a dark cavern. The cavern was very large, as large as a sports arena. Moreover, many tunnels led out of it. From time to time, he also spotted one or two Lizardman patrol squads moving in and out of these tunnels.

Even the weakest Lizardman in these patrol squads was a Level 58 Special Elite, while the strongest was a Level 60 Lord.

Previously, even the strongest non-Boss monster in the 29th Divine Shrine was only a Level 60 Chieftain.

However, when a monster reached the Lord rank, they attained the Tier 2 standard and were capable of using Tier 2 Skills.

It might be fine if all a Demon Player had to deal with were two or three Lords. The crucial point was that, based on what Shi Feng could see, there was a total of 30 Lord ranked Lizardmen patrolling in the cavern alone. If one entered the tunnels, who knew how many more Lords they would encounter?

Against 30 Lord ranked monsters, even a Tier 2 player would get overwhelmed easily, not to mention a Tier 1 player. An ordinary Tier 1 expert would be fortunate if they could survive even ten seconds against such a large number of Lords. It was no wonder many experts in the World Summit had their progress climbing the Divine Staircase halted at the 30th Divine Shrine.

Currently, based on the Ranking List Shi Feng saw before he entered the 30th Divine Shrine, only five players had successfully passed the 30th Divine Shrine.

After observing the patrol routes of the Lizardmen, Shi Feng activated the Seven Luminaries Ring's Aura of Wind and dashed towards the tunnel that the system map indicated provided access to the heart of the cave system.

Any Lizardman that came into contact with the scorching flames received devastating amounts of damage, losing over 1,000,000 HP every second. The Spell's activation instantly killed the Elite ranked Lizardmen.

Meanwhile, before Flame Prison's duration was anywhere close to ending, Shi Feng took out an aquablue Tier 3 Magic Scroll.

Ice Torrent!

A torrent of water crashed down from the cavern's ceiling and impacted the ground heavily. Any living creature that came into contact with the water turned into an ice sculpture on the spot. The Chieftain ranked Lizardmen, who had received critical damage from the initial wave of attacks from Flame Prison, had their remaining HPs thoroughly consumed, their frozen bodies shattering into tiny frost particles. Loot then scattered all over the cavern's submerged floor.

After just a brief moment, only the nine Lords and one High Lord remained of the Lizardman army.

How tough! Seeing that the Lord ranked Lizardmen were already at critical HP, Shi Feng followed up with Flame Domain.

Although Flame Domain was not as powerful as a Tier 3 large-scale destruction Spell, it was more than enough to deal with the Lord ranked Lizardmen.

After the three large-scale-destruction Spells descended, only the High Lord ranked Lizardman Captain remained of the 300-plus Lizardmen that charged at Shi Feng. At this moment, though, the High Lord had less than half of his HP left.

Even so, Shi Feng had no intentions of showing mercy, immediately advancing towards the Lizardman Captain.

If it were during normal times, Shi Feng would pay no attention whatsoever to a High Lord ranked monster. However, he currently had to deal with the Grand Lord ranked Lizardman Chief. If he left the Lizardman Captain alone now, he might very well come to regret it later on.

Currently, the Lizardman Chief was much more powerful than the Grand Lord ranked Purgatory Puppets Shi Feng had fought during the entrance test. The Realm Lord also possessed much greater HP. Moreover, Shi Feng was alone right now, and the system disallowed the use of Summoning Scrolls. Hence, it would be extremely difficult for him to kill the Lizardman Chief, and he definitely could not afford even the slightest bit of carelessness.

However, just when Shi Feng arrived before the Lizardman Captain and was about to use Flame Burst to finish off the High Lord...

Numerous flame spears suddenly shot at him. Upon seeing this, Shi Feng retreated in surprise.

Воот... Воот... Воот...

When the flame spears impacted the ground, large craters immediately formed.

What power! So, this is a Tier 3 Spell cast by a Realm Lord? Shi Feng was inwardly astonished as he looked at the flaming craters.

It was self-evident that the Lizardman Chief had removed the effects of Forbidden Domain.

Although the Lizardman Chief had cast only a Tier 3 Spell, its power was already at the Tier 4 standard. If Shi Feng tried blocking such a Spell, he might very well lose his life in an instant.

Meanwhile, as soon as Shi Feng dodged the flame spears, flames started raining down from midair. At the same time, chains made of flames emerged from the ground and shot at him, giving him no chance to catch a breather.

Whether it was the Rain of Flames or the Flaming Chains, both were Spells capable of killing Shi Feng upon contact right now.

Damn it! Gritting his teeth, Shi Feng activated Heavenly Dragon's Power.

He then executed the Tier 2 Instant Strike at the Lizardman Captain.

In the blink of an eye, Shi Feng's body disappeared from the trajectories of the Lizardman Chief's attacks and appeared before the heavily injured Lizardman Captain.

Phantom Kill!

Nine Dragons Slash!

Shi Feng held nothing back as he launched one powerful attack after another at the Lizardman Captain, who only had around 4,000,000 HP remaining.

Due to Heavenly Dragon's Power's effect, Shi Feng's Strength Attribute increased by 150%. His Strength was now superior to even a Grand Lord's of the same level. There was also Instant Strike's effects, which increased his Attack Speed by 500% and damage dealt by 400%.

In the next moment, damages exceeding -100,000 appeared above the Lizardman Captain's head one after another. Sometimes, a critical hit dealing over -300,000 damage would also occur. As Shi Feng and his doppelganger hacked and slashed at the Lizardman Captain, they also activated Defensive Blade to block the Spell attacks coming from the Lizardman Chief.

The fight with the Lizardman Captain lasted only a matter of seconds. During this period, the High Lord had very little chance to counterattack.

By the time the Lizardman Captain was dead, Shi Feng and his doppelganger had mostly exhausted the block counts of their Defensive Blade.

Although only the Lizardman Chief remained now, Shi Feng did not dare to be careless. As a precaution, he stabbed the Abyssal Blade into the ground and activated Abyssal Curse.

Suddenly, pitch-black shackles emerged from the ground beneath the Lizardman Chief's feet, binding the Realm Lord completely. The Realm Lord's Basic Attributes then began decreasing rapidly.

However, the Lizardman Chief was not an easy opponent to defeat. With a shout, he shattered the restraints on his body and stopped his Basic Attributes from decreasing any further. In the end, the Realm Lord still retained 80% of his Basic Attributes—remaining a nightmarish existence to current players.

However, Shi Feng had long since expected such an outcome. He then activated Disintegration Field, causing the Lizardman Chief's Basic Attributes to plummet once more.

Eventually, the Lizardman Chief's Basic Attributes fell to only 60% of their original values. However, Shi Feng was still not satisfied with this result. He took out the Ring of Gospel and spent 5,000 Magic Crystals, activating World Projection.

Threefold suppression. If players in the outside world were to see this scene, their eyes would most likely fall out of their sockets.

Shi Feng had actually suppressed a Realm Lord-grade Grand Lord to the point where the Boss possessed only 45% of his original Basic Attributes. Now, the Lizardman Chief was no different from a Great Lord of the same level.

However, the Lizardman Chief was thoroughly enraged under Shi Feng's threefold suppression. Waving his staff, he cast the most powerful Spell in his arsenal, Hell Pythons. Suddenly, the Lizardman Chief's staff transformed into a bundle of flames, which then expanded and became nine massive, flaming pythons that were fully under the Lizardman Chief's control.

He still had such a trump card to play? Shi Feng's complexion darkened when he saw the flaming pythons striking at him.

Although he had yet to clash with these flaming pythons, he could already tell that they were not something a Tier 2 player like himself could hope to stop.

Just when the nine flaming pythons were about to come into contact with Shi Feng, the latter suddenly split into ten identical copies of himself.

This move was none other than Divine Steps. Even if he left the nine pythons alone, the latter would be able to attack only nine targets at most at any time. With the flaming pythons distracted, Shi Feng immediately made his way towards the Lizardman Chief.

Thundering Flash!

Flame Burst!

Shadow Blade!

Both Shi Feng's main body and doppelganger attacked the Lizardman Chief in a frenzy. Although the Lizardman Chief was a Realm Lord, his Basic Attributes were now suppressed to the point where they only rivaled a Great Lord's of the same level. Moreover, the Lizardman Chief did not excel in melee battles. As a result, the Lizardman Chief became no different from a punching bag to Shi Feng, whose Basic Attributes were currently superior to a Grand Lord's of the same level.

99%... 95%... 90%...

When Divine Steps ended, Shi Feng took out a Tier 3 Defensive Scroll, Sacred Shield of Water, and used it. The Defensive Spell was capable of blocking Tier 4 attacks even for a short moment, let alone the Tier 3 attacks of the flaming pythons.

By the time Hell Pythons' 20-second duration was over, the Sacred Shield of Water still had over a quarter of its energy remaining.

Without the annoyance of the Hell Pythons, Shi Feng had a much easier time dealing with the Lizardman Chief and was able to whittle down the Realm Lord's HP.

When the duration of Heavenly Dragon's Power ended, Shi Feng promptly followed it up by activating Power of Darkness, maintaining his Strength at the level of a Grand Lord. Meanwhile, every one of his normal attacks dealt over -30,000 damage to the Lizardman Chief and -80,000 for a critical hit. His Skill attacks dealt over -100,000 damage each and -300,000 for a critical hit.

However, Shi Feng would occasionally be forced to block one of the Lizardman Chief's Spell attacks with his weapons, losing 10,000 to 20,000 HP in the process. Fortunately, Shi Feng had Life Domain and Void Shield to help him recover and block a portion of those attacks. Hence, he had no problems keeping his HP above a safe margin. The only real challenge he faced was that the high-intensity combat was depleting both his Stamina and Concentration at a severe rate.

As the minutes passed by, the Lizardman Chief's HP steadily decreased.

50%... 30%... 10%...

"Despicable intruder! I will not let you win!" The Lizardman Chief suddenly exploded in violent fury and tossed aside his staff. He then started gathering a stupendous amount of Mana inside his body. Following which, not only did his body turn pitch-black, but it also doubled in size.

Mana Madness?

At this moment, when Shi Feng looked at the Lizardman Chief, he could feel the threat of death from the Realm Lord. Actually, even if his mind did not warn him about the Lizardman Chief, his eyes could see very clearly just how dangerous the Realm Lord was right now.

Despite the Lizardman Chief just standing still right now, the ground beneath the Realm Lord buckled and shattered from the intense aura his body radiated. The air surrounding the Lizardman Chief had also become extremely heavy as well as scorching hot.

"Roar!"

The Lizardman Chief bellowed and dashed forward, appearing in front of Shi Feng in the blink of an eye. The Realm Lord then raised his massive arms and smashed down at Shi Feng.

"Come!"

Shi Feng had no intention of dodging the Realm Lord's attack. Instead, he activated the Tier 2 Blade Liberation, increasing his Basic Attributes once more.

Shadow Blade!

Suddenly, several streaks of shadow merged with the slash Shi Feng executed using Killing Ray, the combined attack landing squarely on the Lizardman Chief's fists.

Boom!

Shi Feng was forced to retreat by only half a step from the resulting impact. In contrast, the Lizardman Chief's arms got flung away, leaving his scaly chest wide open to attack. Moreover, the counter had also forced the Realm Lord to retreat by two steps.

A chance!

Shi Feng used this opportunity to activate Divine Providence and stabbed the Abyssal Blade at the Lizardman Chief.

Flame Burst!

After launching a series of devastating attacks, Shi Feng eventually reaped the final 10% HP the Lizardman Chief had remaining. Meanwhile, like a bursting balloon, the Realm Lord's body instantly turned into ashes and disappeared...

Chapter 1578 – Basic Strength Battle Array

He's finally dead. Shi Feng breathed out a sigh of relief when he saw the Lizardman Chief disappearing.

After going berserk, the Lizardman Chief was simply too powerful. Not only was the Realm Lord's Strength overwhelming, but his attacks also carried the Mana Erosion effect. Every time Shi Feng clashed with the Realm Lord, although he appeared to have the advantage, in reality, his HP also decreased by a significant amount. At this moment, Shi Feng's HP had already fallen below 25%...

Had the Lizardman Chief been able to endure a few more attacks, the one to die in that battle would have been Shi Feng, instead.

Meanwhile, after the Lizardman Chief died, over a dozen items had dropped to the ground, including three pieces of Level 55 Fine-Gold Equipment, four pieces of Level 55 Secret-Silver Equipment, eight rare materials, and two Mana Barrier Crystal Fragments. For a Level 60 Grand Lord, this loot was quite satisfactory.

Not to mention, aside from all these items, the Realm Lord had also dropped three design fragments. When Shi Feng saw these design fragments, his eyes immediately glowed. After all, these design fragments were meant for none other than the Conqueror's Armor Design.

With this, I'll be able to start producing Level 50 Fine-Gold Equipment that has a Basic Battle Array added to it. Shi Feng smiled as he looked at the three design fragments.

He then combined the nine design fragments, forming a complete forging design.

[Conqueror's Armor Forging Design] (Advanced Design, Fine-Gold Rank)

When learned, you will be able to produce the Level 50 Magic Rune Armor. Every piece of armor produced will have a magic array carved on it. Five pieces of armor can be used to form a Basic Strength Battle Array.

[Conqueror's Armor] (Chest Piece, Plate Armor, Fine-Gold Rank)

Level 50

Equipment Requirement: Strength 700 and Agility 700

Defense +2,150

Strength +64, Endurance +72, Agility +60

Additional Passive Skill-

Life Sacrifice: The lower the wearer's HP, the greater the power they will receive. Increases to a maximum of 10% Strength and 20% Attack Speed.

Additional Active Skill-

Basic Strength Battle Array: Requires five or more players wearing the Conqueror's Armor to activate. Upon activation, increases wearer's Strength by 25%, Agility by 15%, Endurance by 15%, and physique

by 10%. Grants Basic Perception Sharing buff. Stamina and Concentration consumption rates are also increased by 400%. Maintaining the battle array costs one Magic Crystal every five minutes.

The effects of this Basic Strength Battle Array sure are powerful. Shi Feng could not help his astonishment after reading through the Conqueror's Armor's introduction.

•••

He had seen many Basic Battle Arrays before. Meanwhile, a Basic Battle Array would be considered excellent if it increased the Attribute it specialized in by 20%. Normally, though, most Basic Battle Arrays only increased their specialized Attributes by 15%. The Conqueror's Armor's Basic Strength Battle Array, however, actually increased Strength by 25% and two other Basic Attributes by 15%. There was also the 10% improvement to physique. The effects of the Basic Strength Battle Array could already rival the transformation effects of Demon Players.

In fact, the Basic Strength Battle Array provided even greater improvements to a player's combat power than a Demon Player's Demon state did.

After all, the battle array's Perception Sharing buff allowed players to eliminate their defensive blind spots. This, in turn, would improve a player's combat standards significantly. Moreover, coordination between players wearing the Conqueror's Armor would also become much better, and they would be able to execute much more frightening attacks.

If a party of five elite players was equipped with the Conqueror's Armor, they might be able to defeat even a party of five ordinary experts.

This was the reason the various large Guilds had been extremely desperate to obtain equipment with battle arrays in the past. Moreover, the Basic Strength Battle Array was only a Basic Battle Array. If the

Conqueror's Armor had an Intermediate or Advanced Battle Array instead, it could provide even more frightening improvements to a player's combat power.

In the past, it was also because of some special battle arrays that many insignificant small Guilds had managed to survive despite not subordinating themselves to a large Guild.

Currently, the value of the Conqueror's Armor Design was worth even more than Fragmented Legendary items.

After going through the Lizardman Chief's loot, Shi Feng approached the stone altar and carefully picked up the Gold Tablet placed on top of it.

Shi Feng was very curious to find out just what kind of combat technique the tablet recorded.

To all players, Secret Technique Tablets were precious treasures that they could use to learn combat techniques from. Moreover, the higher the rank of a Secret Technique Tablet, the more powerful the combat technique one could learn from it.

In fact, in order to obtain a Gold Tablet, an NPC had gone as far as to commit robbery in the middle of Blackwing City.

After suppressing the excitement in his heart, Shi Feng clicked to inspect the Gold Tablet.

[Secret Body Technique]

The pattern engraved on this tablet is too vague and incomplete, and no information can be deciphered. However, some kind of divine power hides within this pattern. If one gathers all of the stone tablets, this vague and incomplete pattern can be restored.

Current tablet count (1/3)

A Secret Body Technique? Shi Feng's eyes glowed as he looked at the Gold Tablet.

It was common knowledge that among the various combat techniques available in God's Domain, combat techniques focused on the physical body were the most valuable. Moreover, just like Void Steps, such techniques were suitable for both physically and magically oriented classes. Even if one failed to grasp the combat technique completely, they would still be able to improve their control over their own bodies.

After he finished inspecting the Gold Tablet, before he could even store it away, a golden light suddenly shone down on him.

"This is..." A pleasant feeling filled Shi Feng's body as he was enveloped in this golden light. He also fully recovered all the Stamina and Concentration he had exhausted previously.

System: Congratulations! You have exceeded your own limits and achieved an Exploit acknowledged by the Gods.

System: Congratulations! You are the first player to have achieved an Exploit on the Divine Staircase. Rewarding 15,000 Shrine Points.

•••

"So, this is an Exploit?" Shi Feng could not help but feel joyous when he saw the proof of having achieved an Exploit appearing in his status window. "Also, 15,000 Shrine Points? The system sure is generous."

Unlike Shrine Points, one's accumulated Exploits would not reset upon leaving the World Summit. They would remain until players spent them or deleted them deliberately.

Meanwhile, the more valuable items available at the Divine Staircase, such as Bloodlines and Fragmented Legendary items, all required Exploits to exchange for. Otherwise, even if one had the necessary Shrine Points, they would only be able to stare at their desired items, helpless to do anything.

Moreover, due to the system reward this time, Shi Feng's accumulated Shrine Points had finally broken past the 100,000-point threshold. He was now qualified to exchange for the cheapest Bloodline.

After thinking up to this point, Shi Feng could not help but quickly leave the 30th Divine Shrine.

When he appeared back on the Divine Staircase, a series of system notifications entered his ears.

System: Congratulations! You have passed the Divine Shrine. Rewarding 1,500 Shrine Points.

System: Congratulations! You have passed the Divine Shrine within the time limit. Rewarding 1,500 Shrine Points.

System: Congratulations! You have killed the Guardian Boss within the time limit. Rewarding 4,000 Shrine Points.

...

After including these rewards, Shi Feng's total Shrine Points reached 109,360.

However, he still had no intention of ending his challenge. After getting sufficient rest, he immediately proceeded to the next Divine Shrine.

Although he currently no longer had enough Magic Crystals to use World Projection for the subsequent Guardian Bosses, even if he could not beat the Guardian Bosses, he was more than capable of maneuvering past them. In any case, he was not required to defeat the Guardian Bosses in order to clear the Divine Shrines and ascend the Divine Staircase.

Hence, while avoiding battle with the Guardian Bosses, Shi Feng cleared one Divine Shrine after another.

Meanwhile, as he was rapidly accumulating more Shrine Points, some players out on the World Summit had also started to notice something odd.

Previously, the highest record on the Ranking List displayed before the various Divine Shrines was only at the 33rd Divine Shrine. Now, however, someone had already reached the 35th Divine Shrine.

Moreover, this person showed no signs of slowing down as they sped through the 35th Divine Shrine and entered the 36th.

"Who is this person?" Skyhawk, who had just exited the 33rd Divine Shrine, revealed a surprised expression as he looked at the Divine Shrine Ranking List.

As one reached further Divine Shrines, not only would they face much more difficult Bosses, but the traps set up inside the Divine Shrines also became increasingly powerful. In fact, Skyhawk had spent two of his seven attempts on clearing the 33rd Divine Shrine. Furthermore, he had already planned on giving up trying to pass the 34th Divine Shrine altogether.

As for the 35th Divine Shrine, he did not even dare think about clearing it. After all, the Divine Staircase's difficulty increased substantially every five levels. Despite that, there was actually someone who had successfully done so already and was challenging the 36th.

Chapter 1579 – Redeeming a Bloodline

After Shi Feng entered the 36th Divine Shrine, the monsters he came across were mostly Chieftains. Meanwhile, the monster patrol squads he encountered were mainly led by Level 60 Lords, with a few led by High Lords.

Even an expert player would not dare to pick a fight if they came across such monster patrol squads; their only option would be to run away.

In addition, the traps found inside the Divine Shrine had increased in both quantity and quality. Now, every trap was more than capable of killing a player instantly. If players lacked the strength to cope with the traps and patrol squads simultaneously, it was basically game over for them.

To Shi Feng, however, these monster patrol squads were no problem whatsoever. Only, having to deal with both the traps and monsters at the same time consumed a lot of his time and Stamina.

Fortunately, he had Life Essences to help replenish his Stamina. Hence, he still managed to arrive at the teleportation array of the 36th Divine Shrine relatively easily.

From the 35th Divine Shrine onwards, the Guardian Bosses had become Grand Lord ranked Archaic Species. Even if Shi Feng had enough Magic Crystals to execute threefold suppression, he was not confident of defeating such a foe.

A casual hit from a Grand Lord ranked Archaic Species could heavily injure Shi Feng even if he succeeded in blocking the attack. If he failed, needless to say, he would be killed instantly.

As a result, Shi Feng had to resort to Heavenly Dragon's Power and Life Domain to keep himself alive. He then used the doppelganger summoned through Phantom Kill to activate the teleportation array. After the teleportation array was ready, he swapped positions with his doppelganger and promptly left the 36th Divine Shrine.

Although Shi Feng failed to kill the Guardian Boss, passing the 36th Divine Shrine still granted him a total of 4,000 Shrine Points.

Through this method, he smoothly ascended the Divine Staircase all the way up to the 40th Divine Shrine, causing a huge commotion among the players in the World Summit.

After all, the second-ranked player only managed to clear the 33rd Divine Shrine.

Meanwhile, Shi Feng directly chose to give up on the challenge after passing the 40th Divine Shrine.

The reason for this decision was the Guardian Bosses no longer being Grand Lord ranked Archaic Species, but Mythic monsters, instead, from the 40th Divine Shrine onwards. Whether it was in terms of Strength, speed, or combat standards, a Mythic monster surpassed a Grand Lord ranked Archaic Species by a wide margin. Against a Mythic monster, Skills such as Abyssal Curse and Disintegration Field had minimal effect.

Even after Shi Feng had used Heavenly Dragon's Power, the Guardian Boss of the 40th Divine Shrine still managed to overwhelm him. Had Shi Feng made even the slightest mistake during the fight, he would've definitely been killed instantly. In the end, he was left with no choice but to resort to Twofold Berserk. However, even after he did so, against an unsuppressed Mythic monster, it had taken him everything he had just to keep his life. Fortunately, he was able to hold out long enough for his doppelganger to activate the teleportation array, and he succeeded in leaving the 40th Divine Shrine.

However, after activating Twofold Berserk, he had also entered a Weakened state, which had a very long duration.

As this method of clearing the Divine Shrines was simply too time-consuming, Shi Feng decided that it was better to give up and use his remaining time to explore the other Shrines on the World Summit.

After Shi Feng chose to leave the Divine Staircase, he arrived back at the Divine Hall located at the bottom of the World Summit.

There are so many people!

Upon arriving at the Divine Hall, he discovered that most of the Demon Players he encountered at the World Summit's main entrance were currently present in the Divine Hall.

"Buying Demon Potions, 150 Gold per bottle! Willing to use Level 45 top-tier weapons and equipment to exchange as well!"

"Purchasing set pieces for Level 50 Dark-Gold or Fine-Gold Set Equipment! Prices negotiable!"

Among the players present inside the Divine Hall, very few were here to exchange for items using their Shrine Points. Instead, the majority of the players were purchasing items exchanged using Shrine Points. Rather than an exchange center, the Divine Hall looked more like a marketplace right now.

At this moment, a cloaked player approached Shi Feng and asked, "Fellow friend, you just came out from the Divine Staircase, right? If you still have points remaining after you're done exchanging for the items you want, I'm willing to purchase those points at a high price. I'll buy 20 points for one Gold. I'll buy ten points for one Gold if you have over 1,000 points, ten points for two Gold if you have over 3,000 points, and ten points for three Gold if you have over 5,000 points. How about it?"

Hearing the cloaked player's words, Shi Feng was inwardly astonished.

The purchase price was simply too frightening.

If players had over 5,000 points on hand, that meant passing the first Divine Shrine alone could already earn them six Gold Coins. If they defeated the Guardian Boss as well, they could make a total of 21 Gold from clearing the first Divine Shrine.

"Sorry, but I don't have that many points to spare," Shi Feng replied, shaking his head. He then headed straight for the exchange counter, showing no intention of trading away his points for Coins.

After all, he did not have a lot of Shrine Points on hand. Currently, he had accumulated a total of only 146,360 points.

Given Shi Feng's lack of interest, the cloaked player had no choice but to search for willing sellers.

When Shi Feng arrived before the exchange counter, a female Demon NPC smiled at him and asked, "Hello, sir, may I know what item you wish to exchange for?"

"Bloodlines!" Shi Feng replied.

"Bloodlines?" The Demon NPC revealed a shocked expression when she heard Shi Feng's answer. Very quickly, however, she nodded and said, "Alright. Here is a list of Bloodlines available for exchange."

Although Shi Feng and the female Demon NPC did not speak loudly, everyone present in the Divine Hall was an expert. They also possessed considerably good physiques. Moreover, they were very familiar with the high-ranking items available for exchange at the Divine Hall. Hence, upon hearing the word "Bloodline," they turned to look at Shi Feng, who stood before the exchange counter, their ears immediately perking up.

"What?! That person is actually trying to exchange for a Bloodline?! Even the cheapest Bloodline requires 100,000 points!"

"Previously, I heard that the monsters that managed to pass the 31st Divine Shrine only obtained 32,540 points. They are far from reaching 100,000 points. That guy should just be taking a look at the available Bloodlines."

"No, that might not be the case. I checked the Ranking List just now and saw that someone has already cleared the 40th Divine Shrine. He might be that person."

"Still, even if he cleared the 40th Divine Shrine, it shouldn't be possible for him to accumulate so many points."

At this moment, everyone looked at Shi Feng with eyes filled with curiosity.

After all, to them, 100,000 Shrine Points was an astronomical amount.

It seems nobody else has discovered it yet?

From the hushed discussions Shi Feng overheard, he couldn't help but pity these expert Demon Players. In order to save time, these players had chosen the fastest method to clear the Divine Shrines and missed out on the opportunity to obtain the points for killing the Guardian Bosses.

However, he also wasn't so kindhearted as to announce this fact. Following which, he focused his gaze on the list of Bloodlines the NPC provided him.

There was a total of 33 different Bloodlines available for exchange.

Among them, 23 were Basic Bloodlines, eight were Advanced Bloodlines, and two were Peak Bloodlines.

In his two lives playing God's Domain, this was the first time Shi Feng saw so many Bloodlines gathered in one place. Meanwhile, any single one of these Bloodlines could cause any expert in the past to go crazy over it; even apex experts would have been willing to pay any price to acquire one of these Bloodlines.

Chapter 1580 – Hidden Benefit

Sure enough, they are all amazing! It's no wonder so many experts were so crazy about Bloodlines back then! Shi Feng felt slightly emotional when he saw the list of Bloodlines.

In the past, even superpowers had an extremely tough time getting their hands on Bloodlines. Information on Bloodlines was also heavily restricted. Even though Shi Feng had been the Guild Leader of a second-rate Guild, he had not possessed any detailed information on Bloodlines. All he knew was that Bloodlines improved a player's Life Rating and that they were of great help when players got promoted to higher tiers. Meanwhile, although the list of Bloodlines the Demon NPC gave him did not reveal a lot of information, what he could see was already more than enough to thrill him.

Even the most ordinary Bloodline would allow players to undergo a qualitative transformation.

Take the Frost Bloodline, for example. It increased the owner's compatibility with ice-type Skills and Spells, improving their Skill and Spell Completion Rates and base power. In addition, players with Bloodlines would gain some extra Basic Attribute Points every time they leveled up. In the case of the Frost Bloodline, its primary focus was Intelligence, while Strength, Agility, Endurance, and Vitality were secondary. Moreover, the bonus Basic Attributes gained through leveling up would further increase with each tier promotion.

Eventually, as players rose in levels, the gap in Basic Attributes between players with Bloodlines and players without Bloodlines would also grow increasingly wider, to the point where the disparity could instill despair.

However, looking at the cost of the various Bloodlines listed, Shi Feng could not help but frown.

Of the two Peak Bloodlines available, one needed 340,000 SPs, while the other needed 360,000 SPs. In addition, both of them required three Exploits each. These Peak Bloodlines were even more expensive than the top-tier Fragmented Legendary items.

As for the eight Advanced Bloodlines, they, too, were far beyond Shi Feng's reach as even the cheapest among them cost 200,000 SPs and two Exploits, while the most expensive one cost 260,000 SPs and two Exploits.

Even if he managed to kill the Mythic ranked Guardian Boss in the 40th Divine Shrine, accumulating 200,000 SPs was unlikely.

It seems I can exchange for only a Basic Bloodline. Shi Feng could not help but sigh. Revealing a bitter smile, he set his eyes on the 23 Basic Bloodlines.

Even the cheap Basic Bloodline, which was named Boulder Bloodline, cost 100,000 SPs and one Exploit. The Boulder Bloodline improved a player's Defense, and the main Basic Attribute it increased was Endurance. It was a Bloodline more suited for MTs rather than Swordsmen.

In the end, Shi Feng narrowed his choices to three Bloodlines.

[Hurricane Bloodline]

Increases compatibility with wind-type Skills and Spells. Mainly improves Agility, followed by Endurance, Strength, Vitality, and Intelligence.

Requires 115,000 Shrine Points and one Exploit to exchange.

[Scorching Flame Bloodline]

Increases compatibility with fire-type Skills and Spells. Mainly improves Endurance, followed by Strength, Agility, Vitality, and Intelligence.

Requires 122,000 Shrine Points and one Exploit to exchange.

[Earth Dragon Bloodline]

Increases Magic Resistance. Mainly improves Strength, followed by Endurance, Agility, Vitality, and Intelligence.

Requires 125,000 Shrine Points and one Exploit to exchange.

•••

These three Bloodlines were more suitable for a melee physical class like the Swordsman class. Whether they were wind-type or fire-type Skills, the Swordsman class had a little of both. Hence, the Hurricane and Scorching Flame Bloodlines would provide significant improvements to a Swordsman's DPS. As for the Earth Dragon Bloodline, it was suitable for practically every class in the game.

As players reached higher levels, the maps available for them to grind in would have increasingly poor environments. In the past, many players would even prepare multiple sets of equipment to cope with different environments. Hence, Magic Resistance was very helpful to players.

All three Bloodlines were considerably good. At the moment, Shi Feng did not know which Bloodline to choose.

"Sir, should I recommend you a few Bloodlines that are suited to yourself?" the female Demon NPC asked, smiling as she looked at Shi Feng's hesitant expression.

"May I know what your recommendations are?" Shi Feng could not help but ask curiously.

Recommendations from NPCs were generally very accurate. However, it was not easy for players to get one from them. Usually, a player had to be lucky or have sufficiently high Favorability with an NPC for such a situation to occur.

"As you are the heaven's blessed that has progressed the furthest up the Divine Staircase, you get to enjoy a 10% discount on all exchanges. Hence, I recommend either the Thunderblade Advanced Bloodline or the Dark Iron Basic Bloodline," the female Demon replied as she called out two displays showing the details of the Bloodlines she mentioned.

"You're saying the number one ranking player in the Divine Staircase gets a 10% discount?" Shi Feng was slightly surprised to hear this.

He never thought that the Divine Staircase's Ranking List also provided such a hidden benefit.

The Thunderblade Bloodline the female Demon mentioned was an Advanced Bloodline. It improved not only a player's compatibility with lightning-type Skills and Spells but also their Attack Speed. As for Basic Attributes, the Advanced Bloodline mainly improved Strength and Agility, followed by Intelligence, Endurance, and Vitality. However, since it was a powerful Bloodline, its cost was also frighteningly high; it needed a whopping 230,000 Shrine Points and two Exploits.

Even with the 10% discount, he couldn't afford this Bloodline.

As for the Dark Iron Bloodline, it increased a player's compatibility with melee Skills. As for Basic Attributes, the Bloodline mainly increased Strength, followed by Agility, Endurance, Vitality, and Intelligence. The Bloodline's price was, likewise, very high, requiring 150,000 SPs and one Exploit.

Currently, he had 146,360 SPs. If he included the 10% discount, he would have more than enough to exchange for the Dark Iron Bloodline.

"I'll exchange for this Dark Iron Bloodline," Shi Feng said, inwardly ecstatic as he looked at the Dark Iron Bloodline.

Among the many Basic Bloodlines available, the Dark Iron Bloodline was the most suited to melee classes. Since he could afford it, he naturally wouldn't go choosing other Basic Bloodlines.

"Alright. You have to pay a total of 135,000 Shrine Points and one Exploit," the female Demon said, nodding.

Immediately, a payment window appeared before Shi Feng. Without hesitation, he chose to complete the transaction.

A moment later, the female Demon retrieved a pitch-black crystal bottle from a magic array beside her. She then carefully handed the bottle over to Shi Feng.

So, this is a Bloodline? As Shi Feng looked at the pitch-black liquid inside the magic crystal bottle, he could sense vitality radiating from the liquid. Moreover, the liquid also contained terrifying power.

"This is the Dark Iron Bloodline you've purchased. Please store it away properly. May I know if you have anything else you wish to exchange for?"

"I wish to exchange for the cheapest God Crystal available."

When Shi Feng took a look at the Shrine Points he had remaining, he saw he still had 11,360 points left. Meanwhile, the cheapest God Crystal up for exchange cost 12,000 SPs before discount, which was significantly less expensive than an Epic item. Not to mention, compared to an Epic item, a God Crystal was much more useful to him.

Following which, the female Demon inserted her hand into the magic array beside her again and retrieved a God Crystal.

Every God Crystal carried the remnant Divine Might of a God. Hence, the mere appearance of a God Crystal caused the players inside the Divine Hall to feel an enormous pressure bearing down on them.

"What is this pressure?! It's so strong! What kind of item can give off such a powerful pressure?!"

"Who is that person? Just now, he seemed to have exchanged for a Bloodline already. Now, he's even exchanging for such an item. Just how many points does he have?"

The crowd inside the Divine Hall stared at Shi Feng in shock. The players that previously doubted him now looked at him with eyes brimming with envy and admiration.

A Bloodline!

That was something that could allow even an ordinary player to become an expert. If Demon experts like themselves could obtain a Bloodline, they would definitely become one of the apex existences in God's Domain in the future. Hence, how could they not envy Shi Feng?

Meanwhile, after Shi Feng obtained the Dark Iron Bloodline and God Crystal, he no longer had any reason to remain in the Divine Hall. He immediately turned around and headed towards the exit.

However, before Shi Feng could leave the Divine Hall, a man suddenly stood in his way. Smiling, the man said, "Fellow friend, your performance at the Divine Staircase is amazing! May I know if you can hand over that Bloodline you have to the Flower of Seven Sins? Rest assured, the Flower of Seven Sins definitely will not mistreat you and will reward you amply."

With a look, Shi Feng identified the man before him as none other than Skyhawk of the Flower of Seven Sins.

Chapter 1581 – Disintegration Armor Recovers

Overhearing Skyhawk's request, the players inside the Divine Hall could not help but turn to look at him with shocked expressions.

"What? That guy is actually someone from the Flower of Seven Sins?"

"Sure enough, even a superpower like the Flower of Seven Sins is highly interested in Bloodlines."

"I wonder if that person will agree to trade his Bloodline away?"

"Why wouldn't he agree? That's the Flower of Seven Sins we're talking about! It's the strongest assassination organization in the virtual gaming world! Who would dare defy them?"

The surrounding onlookers started a quiet discussion among themselves as they looked at Skyhawk.

The Flower of Seven Sins was known by practically everyone in the virtual gaming world. However, the members of the Flower of Seven Sins always took action covertly, so most players had only ever heard about the organization and knew that it specialized in commissions for assassination. As long as one could afford the price, the Flower of Seven Sins would dare to take action even against Super Guilds.

When it came to tracking and investigative capabilities, the Flower of Seven Sins could rival even the Secret Pavilion. Hence, if given a choice, independent experts would rather provoke a Super Guild than the Flower of Seven Sins.

"Commander, that person sure is arrogant! He actually dares disrespect the Flower of Seven Sins!" the Guardian Knight belonging to Skyhawk's party said as he approached Skyhawk, shock and anger on his face as he looked at Shi Feng's departing figure.

"Since he refuses to trade it to us, we'll just take it away from him by force." Skyhawk sneered as he looked at Shi Feng. "Did you use the Tracking Scroll?"

"I did. For the next twelve hours, no matter where he runs to, we'll be able to find him." The Guardian Knight smiled and nodded. Taking a look at his system map, he continued, "He seems to be heading for the World Summit."

In God's Domain, while it was indeed true that only Rangers and Assassins possessed tracking abilities, other players could rely on special Magic Scrolls to track players.

Meanwhile, as these special Magic Scrolls did not deal any damage, even when used on a player, the said player would not notice the tracking marker and neither could they remove it. Unless the targeted player logged out of the game, they could be located regardless of where they went.

The only flaw of these special Magic Scrolls was that they could not be used repeatedly on the same target. Once a player was marked, no other tracking marker could be placed on them within the next 48 hours.

[Disintegration Armor]

The Disintegration Power will taint any player that carries this item. It has also been tainted by an evil power, making it impossible to recast the armor. (At present, 75% of the armor is still tainted by an evil power.)

[Disintegration Field]

Disintegrates all Skills and Spells within a 100-yard radius (Skills and Spells at Tier 2 and below will be nullified, while Skills and Spells above Tier 2 will be weakened by 70%). All entities within range of the Disintegration Field will sustain a 40% reduction to Basic Attributes, physique, and Stamina in addition to a 400% increase to their Stamina and Concentration consumption rates. No Cooldown.

Despite removing a quarter of the evil power, the Disintegration Armor's power had grown significantly. He didn't dare to imagine how powerful the Disintegration Field would become once he removed the remaining evil power.

Disintegration Field's ability to weaken Skills and Spells above Tier 2 by 70% was outrageous. Such suppression would basically cripple any Skill or Spell it encountered. The Skill or Spell would likely deal even less damage than a normal attack, and that's not even including the 40% reduction to Basic Attributes.

Only three more to go. Shi Feng could not help his grin as he looked at the remaining evil power in the armor.

Not only had Shi Feng used a Domain Skill, but it had also reduced his Basic Attributes by 40%. Only a high-tiered Domain Skill was capable of accomplishing this.

Yet, since the start of the battle, he hadn't seen Shi Feng use any Magic Scrolls...

During Ridiculous's brief shock, Skyhawk approached Shi Feng's right side and swung the broken, pitchblack blade in his hands.

Indiscriminate Slash!

Immediately, over a dozen black energy blades flew towards Shi Feng's blind spots.

At the same time, Ink Hunter bombarded the Swordsman with Soul Cloud, launching magic blades from above.

As everyone expected the energy and magical blades to devour Shi Feng's HP, something astonishing occurred.

Both attacks vanished half a yard from Shi Feng. It was as if these attacks had never existed...

"This... What is going on? Did he use an Invulnerability Skill?"

"Is he an NPC?"

Everyone's jaws dropped.

All of the watching players were experts in God's Domain. They had seen countless Skills and Spells in their travels, and they had a certain understanding of Invulnerability Skills. As far as they knew, Invulnerability Skills typically formed an eye-catching barrier of sorts to protect the player, yet despite

the lack of any barrier around Shi Feng, both Skyhawk and Ink Hunter's attacks had been nullified. This was simply inconceivable.

A Defensive Skill? Skyhawk remained relatively calm despite his failed attack. Sneering at Shi Feng, he hissed, "How long do you think this Skill of yours can last? Do you think it can protect you from this?!"

The first Skill was Mana Rebound.

The second was Mana Nullification. With this effect, the weapon could even slice through Invulnerability Skills.

One could say that the weapon was a magic killer. In fact, this ability suited the broken blade's name perfectly.

Mana Cutter!

All Defensive Spells and Skills were useless in the face of Skyhawk's attacks. Moreover, if melee players weren't careful with the Skills they used to attack Skyhawk, Mana Rebound might turn their own attacks against them rather than damage Skyhawk.

Because of this weapon, Skyhawk was the most formidable of the Flower of Seven Sins' seven commanders.

If one wanted to defeat Skyhawk, they had to rely on techniques or Basic Attributes. Unfortunately, Skyhawk was a monster in both regards.

If Hidden Soul had to face such an offensive, even she'd have no choice but to activate Vanish, receiving Ridiculous' attack, before putting as much distance between herself and Skyhawk as possible. If she tried to fight the Berserker and Guardian Knight simultaneously, she'd have no hope of victory.

The Mana Cutter? Shi Feng felt a little jealous as he watched the broken, pitch-black blade, which had transformed into five black snakes.

In the past, every player had known about the Flower of Seven Sins' commanders. They were just as popular as Super Guilds' Guild Leaders. Their weapons and equipment had been just as famous.

Among them, countless Berserkers and Swordsmen dreamed of wielding Skyhawk's Mana Cutter.

Realizing that Skyhawk and Ridiculous' attacks were about to hit their target, Shi Feng disregarded the idea of intercepting them forcibly. Instead, he used Divine Steps and split into eleven copies, spreading out to circle his two opponents.

Shi Feng still suffered a Weakened state, and although the duration was much shorter than earlier, it still reduced his Basic Attributes by 80%. Overall, his Basic Attributes were only slightly higher than Skyhawk

We're talking about one of the Seven Sins commanders here. The Flower of Seven Sins definitely won't take such a blow lying down."

Meanwhile, God's Domain's other superpowers began their own investigations.

At this point, Shi Feng, who was wholly ignorant of the commotion he had caused, reached the World Summit's Epic Shrine area.

Compared to the Dark-Gold and Fine-Gold areas, the Epic area was void of players. The majestic Epic Shrines in the area remained unoccupied. Shi Feng didn't need to worry about any competition over the Shrines.

The God Crystals aren't as valuable as Epic items, but the Shrine's difficulty increases with altitude. Correspondingly, the Shrines should offer more treasures. Normally, NPCs' combat techniques were far stronger than monsters of the same level and tier. Furthermore, the NPC before him was a High Human...

High Humans were unlike the current humans populating the God's Domain continent. High Humans had long since gone extinct in God's Domain.

Long ago, the Gods had blessed High Humans, and their Life Rating was much higher than their ordinary, current cousins. They were bona fide humanoid monsters. In fact, the legends that spoke about humans who had slain Dragons didn't refer to current humans, but High Humans. Current humans' Life Rating was far lower than Dragons', and not even a Tier 5 NPC would be a match for an ordinary Tier 5 Dragon.

However, High Humans could fight and defeat Dragons.

As another example of how powerful High Humans were, the Tier 4 Shrine Knight before Shi Feng could easily kill Mythic monsters of the same level as if they were ants.

Chapter 1588 – Bloodline Improves

After the stone enveloping the Shrine Knight shattered on the platform, it started to move towards Shi Feng.

As the situation developed, the pressure Shi Feng felt continued to build.

Had Shi Feng not known that the Shrine's trials wouldn't kill the challengers, he would've likely used Absolute Domain to defend himself.

"Challenger, you have two choices. The first is to dodge all of my attacks; the second is to surpass me in combat standards. Your time limit is three hours. You have three minutes to consider. If you do not decide in three minutes, you'll be forced out of the Shrine automatically," the Shrine Knight mechanically explained.

Dodge all of his attacks or surpass him in combat standards? Shi Feng took a closer look at the Shrine Knight before him. After a moment of consideration, he declared, "I choose the second option!"

The Shrine Knight was a Tier 4 Sword Emperor.

Even if the NPC were the same level as Shi Feng, its attacks wouldn't be a trivial matter. Furthermore, Shi Feng was still in a Weakened state. That would make it even more difficult to dodge every one of the Sword Emperor's attacks.

Competing against the Shrine Knight in combat standards was his only chance to clear the challenge.

Normally, after NPCs reached Tier 3, their combat standards would be on par to ordinary expert players. Some powerful Tier 3 NPCs could even reach the Refinement Realm. Including NPCs' superior Attributes, Tier 3 NPCs were generally far more powerful than Tier 3 players.

Even the weakest Tier 4 NPCs' combat standards were at the Refinement Realm, and the more powerful ones could even reach the Void Realm. Not even Tier 4 peak experts would have dared to provoke Tier 4 NPCs in the past.

As for the Heroes who were summoned to protect towns and cities, those capable of reaching Tier 4 had no issue reaching the Void Realm. This was precisely why they could summon towns and cities.

Although Shi Feng bore a Weakened state, his combat standards weren't affected.

Moreover, competing against a Tier 4 NPC via techniques was a rare opportunity.

Unlike players, an NPC's combat techniques were far more refined. Their application could even stun players.

"Excellent. Let's start the battle, then. During this time, my Basic Attributes will drop to match yours. I will also be set at Tier 2. Neither of us will be allowed to use any Skills or Spells during this fight. You're also prohibited from using any tools. You will only complete the trial after depleting my HP completely," the Shrine Knight said, nodding. His aura then began to weaken as the Shrine Knight fell from a Level 100 Sword Emperor to a Level 61 Sword Master.

For a brief moment, Shi Feng felt restricted. A notification then appeared, telling him that he was temporarily barred from using Skills, Spells, or tools.

Shrine Knight now had 1,000,000 HP remaining. It was entirely possible for Shi Feng to end this battle quickly, even while relying on his combat techniques.

Despite their equally high Attack Speeds, the Shrine Knight overwhelmed Shi Feng due to the difference in their reaction speeds.

His Strength had risen by 10%, Agility by 7%, Endurance, Vitality, and Intelligence by 5%. Assuming that his physical limit wasn't a factor and his opponents only had a peak reaction time of 0.1 seconds, the two extra reactions would allow him to outmaneuver his opponents, utterly overwhelming them.
