Turning back to Elizabeth with a smile, Janet said, "I saved some food for you. You probably haven't had a chance to eat since you left work. Please have something to eat first."

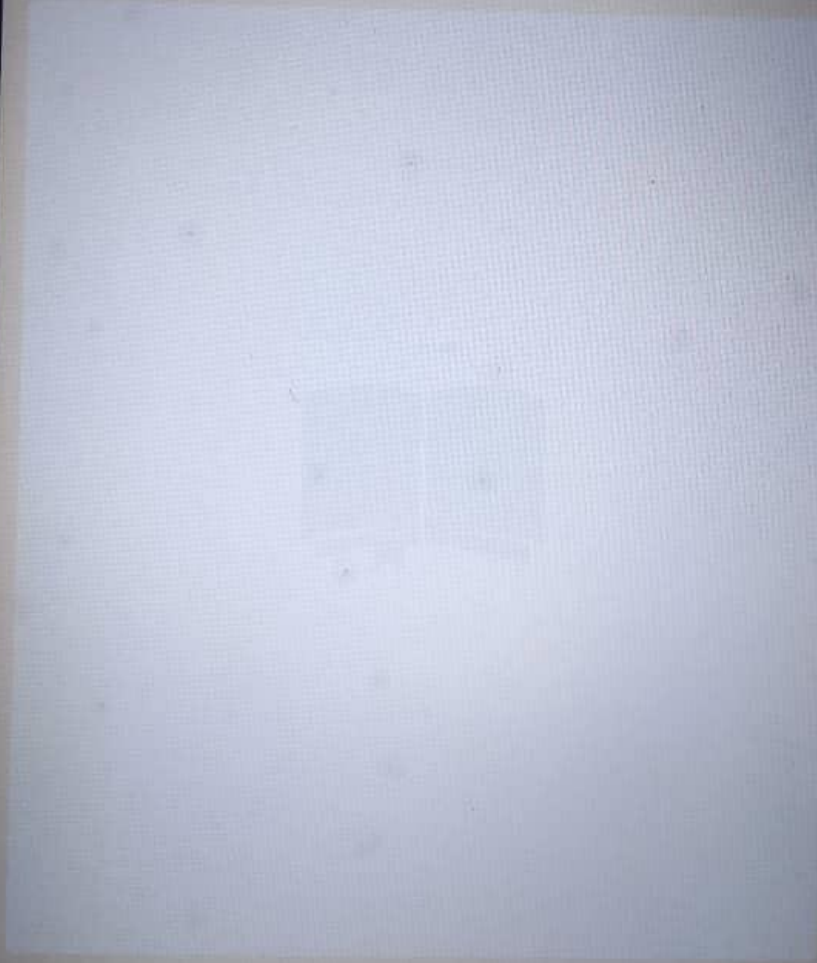
After the meal, Elizabeth did not bring up the topic of the abortion. She focused solely on Janet's well-being. Knowing Janet might be feeling isolated at
