During his previous life, Zero Wing had conducted its promotion into a Bronze Guild in the Greater God's Domain, so it didn't receive any rewards for its promotion. Although he had fortunately acquired a Bronze Cross-Border Guild Promotion Order in this life, he didn't think becoming the first Bronze Guild would come with such abundant rewards.

It was incredibly difficult for a Guild to raise its God's Domain Fame in the Greater God's Domain. Yet, God's Domain Fame was crucial for Guilds to get promoted beyond the Bronze rank. For example, a Large-scale Crisis Quest would only award a Guild with 1,000 Fame Points. Yet, a Bronze Guild needed 500,000 God's Domain Fame Points to get promoted to the Silver rank.

Aside from needing Fame to get promoted, a Bronze Guild that had accumulated 200,000 Fame Points could apply with the Adventurer's Association to construct a World Tower of its own. Although Bronze Guilds could only construct the first two floors of the World Tower, it was still a privilege that many Bronze Guilds dreamed of obtaining. This was because players would need to pay 100 units of Seven Luminaries Crystal each time they applied to challenge the Advanced Adventurer Certification with the Adventurer's Association.

Indeed. The application fee was charged in Seven Luminaries Crystals, not Coins or Magic Crystals.

However, if a Guild managed to acquire its own World Tower, it could lower the fee by 50%. This would drastically reduce the Seven Luminaries Crystals it needed to spend to let its members take the Advanced Adventurer Certification.

Now that Zero Wing had received 100,000 God's Domain Fame as soon as it had become a Bronze Guild, it would no doubt save Zero Wing a lot of time in the future.

However, compared to the Guild rewards, the personal rewards Shi Feng received were what truly surprised him. Not only did he receive three level-ups, which instantly propelled him to Level 120, but he also received a Legendary Legacy Scroll and an Overtier Spell Book. Both of these two items were of extraordinary value, and they normally could not be bought with money.

An Overtier Spell Book was a spell capable of exhibiting strength above its tier. For example, a Tier 3 Overtier Spell could exhibit power at the standard

of Tier 4 Spells, while a Tier 4 Overtier Spell could exhibit power at the standard of Tier 5 Spells.

Typically, a Tier 3 Overtier Spell Book would be worth one piece of Fragmented Legendary Equipment. As for Tier 4 Overtier Spell Books, their value exceeded even Fragmented Legendary Weapons.

He had returned to Zero Wing's Residence from the Adventurer's Association without hesitation because of this Legendary Legacy Scroll.

Individual rewards awarded by the system would briefly appear before the recipient when the system handed them out. Although other players could not inspect the information of the awarded items, they could still determine the quality of the items based on the Mana and glow effect given off.

Meanwhile, a purple-gold glow typically represented Fragmented Legendary items, while a dark-purple glow represented Legendary items.

If the reward he received was only an ordinary Legendary item, the various superpowers might grow envious, but it wasn't enough to make them go crazy. After all, every superpower had Legendary items of its own, with some even having Legendary Weapons. Needless to say, powers from foreign God's Domains would also have Legendary Weapons.

However, it was a different story for the Legendary Legacy Scroll. Its value was above even that of Legendary Weapons.

The best Legacy Scrolls Shi Feng had seen during his previous life were Epic Legacy Scrolls. An Epic Legacy Scroll could not only teleport players directly to a Tier 4 Legacy Land, but players could also challenge the same Legacy Land up to three times. This made Epic Legacy Scrolls highly sought-after by Tier 3 players who had difficulty finding a Tier 4 Legacy Land.

Meanwhile, above Epic Legacy Scrolls were Legendary Legacy Scrolls. However, the existence of the Legendary Legacy Scroll was akin to a myth in even the Greater God's Domain, and its existence had only ever been mentioned in library records. There were no records of people actually finding a Legendary Legacy Scroll in reality.

As for the value of a Legendary Legacy Scroll, it was something that even the Galaxy Corporation, a titan in the Greater World, would try to obtain, even at the cost of destroying an entire world.

This was because a Legendary Legacy Scroll did not simply teleport the user to a random Tier 4 Legacy Land. Instead, it would teleport the user to a Legacy Land related to their Legacy.

It might not seem like there was a difference since the players would be teleported to a Tier 4 Legacy Land regardless of whether they had used an Epic Legacy Scroll or a Legendary Legacy Scroll. However, the difference between entering an ordinary Legacy Land and a Legacy Land related to one's Legacy was like night and day. It was especially true if one had a unique Legacy.

If a player entered a Legacy Land related to their Legacy, they could further improve their Legacy. It was especially true for God Legacy holders. If a God Legacy holder got promoted to Tier 4 via a Legacy Land related to their Legacy, they would become much closer to the God they inherited their Legacy from.

It should be known that Gods were known as the strongest existences in God's Domain. Even an apex race like Dragons was beneath the God race.

Dragons might be known to be invincible among opponents of the same tier, but Gods were known to transcend tiers. This was why Tier 6 Gods could kill Tier 6 God-ranked players easily.

It would be the same if an Ancient God Legacy holder got promoted via a Tier 4 Legacy Land related to their Legacy. They would become closer to the Ancient God their Legacy was tied to after they got promoted to Tier 4.

Although Ancient Gods were also Gods, they had existed for a much longer period of time. They wielded strength of much greater purity, and they were much stronger than Gods under the same tier.

In God's Domain, any Tier 6 player who had managed to master a complete Ancient God Legacy would become a symbol of invincibility. They could control a world at will, and even the Galaxy Corporation would have to bow its head to such existences.

Meanwhile, a Legendary Legacy Scroll had the ability to create such an invincible existence. Even if the chance of success wasn't 100%, it was still enough to cause all powers in the Greater God's Domain to go crazy.

After taking a long look at the Legendary Legacy Scroll, Shi Feng set it aside in his bag. He did not hurry to challenge his Tier 4 promotion.

The Myriad Worlds' Descent expansion pack had thoroughly changed the status quo in the Miniature Ancient World. Before Zero Wing's situation stabilized, Shi Feng dared not challenge his Tier 4 promotion.

The Tier 4 promotion took a long time to complete. The whole process could take anywhere from several days to half a month. Such a long time was enough for significant changes to take place in the everchanging Miniature Ancient World. Upon hearing the Shield Warrior's complaints, the Level 110 Elementalist sitting next to the Shield Warrior clicked her tongue and said, "You're a Bronze member in Asura, so you have to wait for *only* two hours to get into the city. Do you know how long I had to wait in line as a normal member?"

"I was just saying," the Shield Warrior said, scratching his head as he revealed a silly smile.

Ever since the Myriad Worlds' Descent expansion pack took place, Abyssal Star City had become one of the few cities local players could rest in. This drastically increased the number of players seeking to enter the primordial city. However, as the city only had a maximum capacity of six million players, even after the Asura Mercenary Alliance had raised its membership

requirements, the mercenary alliance's member count had still exceeded ten million. This was far above Abyssal Star City's maximum capacity.

If he hadn't joined Asura earlier on and gotten himself a Bronze membership, he would be stuck as a normal member and have had to wait in line for seven to eight hours just to enter Abyssal Star City.

At this time, a Level 112 Ranger wearing chainmail walked over and sat down next to the Shield Warrior and Elementalist, saying, "Our adventurer team is already one of the more fortunate ones. We were lucky we chose to set our base of operations in Abyssal Star City. Had we set up base in an NPC City, we wouldn't even be able to get into the city. Currently, all core members of Zero Wing enjoyed a special privilege that allowed them to purchase a private house in Abyssal Star City so long as they had enough Guild Contribution Points and Coins to afford it.

"I've seen the list. I heard that those two old monsters only got into the list because the Five Great Super Guilds managed to secure over half of Burning City's management slots and gained thorough control over the city. Otherwise, they probably wouldn't even get into the top 100," the Shield Warrior said.

"The various God's Domains' expert standards are vastly greater than ours. Even Beyond Domain Realms experts can just barely squeeze into the top 100. There simply is no place for people like us."

Subsequently, the Level 112 Ranger said, "But an amazing expert has appeared in our Asura Mercenary Alliance this time. That expert actually got

ranked 27th. This has greatly increased our reputation among the various God's Domains."

The Shield Warrior and Ranger nodded in agreement.

The Asura Mercenary Alliance might have Abyssal Star City to rely on, but it didn't have absolute management rights over any NPC City. It only had two management slots in Hundred Flow City, which allowed it to receive a portion of the city's income. Absolute control over the city lay in the hands of the Divine Hunters Guild, which held six management slots in Hundred Flow City.

Although Abyssal Star City sat in a strategic location, its importance would fall when players gained access to Level 120-plus maps and the NPC Cities there. The conditions to upgrade a primordial city were vastly greater than that of ordinary Guild Cities. Not only did a primordial city have to meet a vastly greater population requirement, but it also needed to fulfill a much greater building requirement.

Originally, Shi Feng thought that Abyssal Star City would need a few more Advanced Constructions built before it could get promoted from an Advanced Town to a Basic City. He didn’t think that the primordial city would meet its building requirement after having only a medium teleportation array constructed.[1]

“Did something happen, Guild Leader?” Su Qianliu asked curiously when she saw Shi Feng suddenly falling into a daze.

“It’s nothing. We simply struck gold,” Shi Feng said, chuckling.

It was a qualitative transformation for a primordial city to become a Basic City. The changes that would take place would be even greater than an ordinary Intermediate Guild City becoming an Advanced Guild City.

“Struck gold?” Su Qianliu tilted her head, her confusion growing even deeper.

The teleportation array connecting Abyssal Star City with Hundred Flow City would indeed generate a significant amount of wealth for Zero Wing. The cost of teleporting players between Abyssal Star City and Hundred Flow City was 30 Silver per person. If the city charged each player one Gold, that would be a profit of 70 Silver.

However, the medium teleportation array could only teleport up to 50 people at a time, and each teleportation took around one minute. Taking into account that there were 48 hours a day in God’s Domain, Abyssal Star City could, at most, earn around 100,000 Gold of profit through the teleportation array each day. That might be a significant sum of money, but it was nothing compared to the money earned from Abyssal Star City’s entrance fees.

Currently, Abyssal Star City was making 1.2 million Gold per day through entrance fees alone. Even after deducting the maintenance cost of the city’s constructions and NPCs, the city would still be left with 600,000 Gold, which was still multiple times more than what the city could make through the teleportation array.

Hence, Su Qianliu couldn’t understand how Zero Wing had “struck gold.”

In fact, let alone striking gold, the teleportation array couldn’t even allow Abyssal Star City to match the income players could make from managing a small NPC City. Even a small NPC City had upwards of ten million in

Overall, Abyssal Star City's total net income couldn't even match one-third of what players could earn from managing a small NPC City, let alone medium and large NPC Cities.

At the end of the day, the addition of the teleportation array only allowed Zero Wing to have stronger bargaining power against the foreign God's Domains' powers.

"How much are Advanced Lineage Crystals selling for in Auction Houses now, Blackie?" Shi Feng asked as he turned to Blackie.

Previously, he had sold ordinary Lineage Crystals for several hundred thousand Contribution Points through the Asura Mercenary Alliance. Meanwhile, each Contribution Point was worth 40 Silver. Yet, now, Advanced Lineage Crystals, which were much better and rarer than ordinary Lineage

Crystals, were being sold at only 200,000 Gold. This was definitely a very low price.

“Do you plan on buying some, Guild Leader?” Su Qianliu asked worriedly.

Advanced Lineage Crystals might be excellent items, but Zero Wing’s expansion had drastically increased its expenditure. The change in the Miniature Ancient World’s environment had only worsened things. Nowadays, it had become normal for players to die at least once when grinding out in the fields. If players were unlucky, their entire team might get wiped out. In that case, resurrection would become impossible, and they’d lose an entire level plus a piece of equipment.

Because of this, Zero Wing needed to spend large amounts of Gold Coins each day purchasing weapons and equipment from the Auction House to restock its Guild Warehouse. Although the Guild could also obtain weapons and equipment through Dungeons and grinding out in the fields, the amount obtained was nowhere near enough to meet demands.

So, Zero Wing was in no situation to be purchasing Advanced Lineage Crystals that cost 200,000 Gold each. Even purchasing only one Advanced Lineage Crystal a day would immediately put Zero Wing into the red. At that time, Zero Wing’s many members would have to stop grinding for levels and focus entirely on raiding Team Dungeons just to prevent the Guild from running out of weapons and equipment.


While Su Qianliu and the others were awed by Abyssal Star City's changes, Shi Feng had set his sights on the heart of the city—the Primordial Tower.

This was because the mana environment inside the 100 miniature worlds on the second floor had already taken on a liquid state. While standing in these miniature worlds, even experts like Hidden Soul had experienced a feeling of omnipotence.

Learning Skills, Spells, combat techniques, and Mana Techniques had become as simple as child’s play in these miniature worlds. Even the learning difficulty of Silver Combat Techniques had decreased drastically, and it only

took them a few tries before they could execute these combat techniques at a rudimentary level.

The effect of these miniature worlds was something even Shi Feng did not expect.

Silver Combat Techniques!

Any player who had managed to learn a Silver Combat Technique, even if their mastery over it was only at a rudimentary level, would become invincible among players of the same tier. If players thoroughly master a Silver Combat Technique, they could even transcend tiers.

In reality, the various superpowers of God's Domain were in possession of many Silver Combat Techniques. However, the number of experts who had managed to actually learn how to use a Silver Combat Technique numbered incredibly few. This was also the case even in the Greater God's Domain.

Even if one could convert Magic Crystals to Mana Stones in the ideal 100:1 ratio, the cost of operating the second-floor miniature worlds would still be 100 times greater than that of the first-floor miniature worlds...

In addition, the cost of maintaining the Primordial Tower itself had also increased drastically. Originally, the tower's maintenance only cost 1,000 Magic Crystals per day. Now, simply keeping the Primordial Tower active cost 1,000 Mana Stones per day...

It seems I'm going to have to start stocking up on Silver Combat Techniques from now on.

Shi Feng didn't know whether to laugh or cry when he saw the situation on the Primordial Tower's second floor.

The consumption of Mana Stones was still acceptable since he could refine Magic Crystals into Mana Stones with the Seven Luminaries Codex. Worst case scenario, the mercenary alliance would simply have to earn more Magic Crystals.

I suggest we only allow contracted members of the Asura Mercenary Alliance to use them,” Liu Wusheng hurriedly said to Shi Feng after snapping out of his daze. “We should also raise the price and usage requirements of the first floor’s miniature worlds.”

Crimson Heart, Galaxy Past, and Zhuo Yalin also nodded in agreement.

The upgraded Primordial Tower was simply terrifying!

Just the changes to the first-floor miniature worlds would already be enough to attract the attention of countless powers, let alone the second-floor miniature worlds. After all, the first-floor miniature worlds’ mist-like mana could allow Refinement Realm experts to quickly master Bronze Combat Techniques and possibly even Advanced Bronze Combat Techniques.
