It was especially so for the powers based near the Sea of Giants now that the Divine Seal Saint had sent the Wind Seal Commander, one of the Four Seals, there to await the opening of the Miniature Ancient World’s World Passage.

“Have that person in the Seven Luminaries Alliance carefully look into this matter. If it turns out to be true, this matter is going to be interesting,” Frey said, her lips curling up a little. “But be sure to do things secretly. We must not let a third party know about this matter.”

“Rest assured, Young Miss. That person is a confidant trained by the Galaxy Conglomerate. He will never leak this information to other powers,” the Guardian Knight assured.

“Good. You should know how important a Great Grandmaster Magician is to the Galaxy Conglomerate. If any mistakes occur, you won’t be able to afford the consequences,” Frey calmly said.

“Understood!” The Guardian Knight hurriedly nodded, cold sweat rolling down his forehead. “I won’t disappoint you on this matter, Young Miss!”

While Frey was looking into the latest Great Grandmaster Magician going by the name of Ye Feng, the Starlight Realm’s various hegemonic powers and conglomerate were also frantically looking into this person. They even offered to give anyone who could provide useful information related to Ye Feng a permanent resident status in a first-tier city.

When this news spread, the entire Starlight Realm instantly went into an uproar.

For ordinary players, just the opportunity to gain permanent residence in a third-tier city was already an unattainable dream. As for permanent residence in a first-tier city, that was something not even mental strength grandmasters would dare to think of obtaining. At most, they could afford to visit a first-tier city for a few days every now and then.

Yet, now, there was an opportunity to gain permanent residency in a first-tier city simply by providing information on Ye Feng. How could everyone not be shocked?

While the Starlight Realm's players and powers were busy looking into the player named Ye Feng, Shi Feng was focused on creating his Tier 5 Mana Body.

After becoming a Great Grandmaster Magician, Shi Feng not only noticed his Concentration undergoing an evolutionary change, but he also felt his elemental ascending to a new level. Or, more specifically, the Great Grandmaster Emblem he wore had increased his elemental affinity by one level.

When worn, it increases the wearer's elemental affinity by one level, up to a maximum of Level 6.

*The Magician class's Great Grandmaster Emblem is truly incredible. Now that my elemental affinity has reached Level 5, I only need to expend half as much Concentration to manipulate solid mana.*

Shi Feng grew ecstatic as he integrated the Great Grandmaster Mana Gathering Arrays he created with his Mana Body one after another.

Elemental affinity was crucial for players in controlling mana.

Normally, players' elemental affinity would only be at Level 1, while gifted individuals could reach Level 2. Compared to players with only Level 1 affinity, players with Level 2 affinity would have an easier time perceiving and manipulating the various elements.

Although elemental affinity could be artificially increased using various methods, such as using tools and improving one's Mana Body, there was a limit to the effectiveness of such methods. Even with a Legendary Mana Body, Shi Feng only managed to raise his elemental affinity to the Level 4 standard.

Level 4 also happened to be the highest standard Shi Feng achieved during his previous life, and he had achieved that standard after relying on various tools. This was also the limit for most Tier 6 experts.

So, the fact that the Great Grandmaster Emblem for Magicians could elevate his elemental affinity to Level 5 was incredible. This effect alone made it as valuable as a Fragmented Divine Artifact.

In less than half an hour, Shi Feng finished constructing a Mana Body that was fully made up of Great Grandmaster Mana Gathering Arrays.

“Start the assisted creation!”

In the current Miniature Ancient World, there was no native expert player who wouldn't recognize this old man.

It should be known that in the current Miniature Ancient World, even the various hegemonic powers would only have one or two titled experts under their command, while most superpowers didn't even have titled experts under their command. So, Thousand Swords' presence had allowed World Dominators to become a superpower that was only second to the various hegemonic powers in the Miniature Ancient World.

"All of you, be extremely careful once we are inside the World Passage! Do not get washed away by the beast tide! Any ship caught by itself will be quickly devoured by the Void Creatures!" Thousand Swords said, issuing a command to all ships in the fleet through the team chat.

“Finally! We are finally going to enter the Greater God’s Domain!” Gu Yiren, who had similarly reached Tier 4, revealed an excited expression as he looked at the nearing World Gate.

“Don’t get too excited, Yiren,” Thousand Swords said as he glanced at his student. “The World Passage is a very dangerous place. Based on the information we’ve collected, even the weakest Void Creature in a World Passage will be at the Grand Lord rank. There will even be plenty of Mythic and Superior Mythic Void Creatures mixed among them. Also, our ultimate goal might be to enter the Greater God’s Domain, but we also have to try to earn as many Association Contribution Points as possible.”

“Don’t worry, Teacher. I’ve prepared over a dozen Tier 4 Magic Scrolls for those Void Creatures. We can definitely earn a ton of contribution points,” Gu Yiren confidently said as he patted the spatial bag on his waist.

So long as one bothered to do a little research, anyone would know about the welfare provided by the Greater God’s Domain’s Adventurer’s Association to players of isolated God’s Domain.

For two days after a World Passage opened, players who entered the World Passage could earn Association Contribution Points by killing Void Creatures in the World Passage. Then, players could use the points they earned to exchange Immortal Weapons and Equipment from the Adventurer’s Association. If players collected enough points, they could even exchange for the incomparably Legacy Guidances. These were all things that would let isolated players have an easier time settling in the Greater God’s Domain.

Meanwhile, Gu Yiren had done a lot of preparation in anticipation of the World Passage’s opening.

Of the Tier 4 Magic Scrolls he prepared, every one of them held a large-scale Destruction Spell. Although these Spells were incapable of one-shotting Tier 4 Mythic monsters, they were strong enough to heavily injure Mythic monsters. So long as these monsters were killed later on, the system would judge him as having made a big contribution to the kill and award him at least 10% of the monster’s points.

This was an incredibly effective and efficient way of earning contribution points. It was significantly better than trying to kill one Void Creature with a large group of players.

With over a dozen Tier 4 large-scale destruction Spells, he would have no problem heavily injuring over a thousand monsters. Even if he only earned a few points from each monster, that would still be several thousand contribution points. If he was lucky, he might even earn over 10,000 contribution points.

Based on the information World Dominators had collected, 1,000 points could be exchanged for an Epic Immortal Weapon, 3,000 points could be exchanged for a Tier 5

Demigod's Legacy Guidance, 5,000 points could be exchanged for a Tier 6 NPC's Legacy Guidance, 10,000 points could be exchanged for a Tier 6 God's Legacy Guidance, and 20,000 points could be exchanged for a Legacy that provided a perfect experience of a Gold Combat Technique's use.

Setting aside the perfect experience of a Gold Combat Technique, just receiving a Tier 6 God's Legacy Guidance would be of significant help to him when he challenged his Tier 5 and Tier 6 promotions in the future. After all, all Tier 6 Gods possessed extraordinary Mana Bodies with extremely high reference value for players.

If he could create a Tier 5 Mana Body that reached the Epic rank, he could instantly reach the peak of his life.

While Gu Yiren was fantasizing about earning 10,000 Association Contribution Points and exchanging them for a Tier 6 God's Legacy Guidance, Thousand Swords suddenly tensed up as he looked at a fleet of ships coming from behind. However, so long as players could mold their Concentration into an object, it was only a matter of time before they could break a Divine Might Seal. They wouldn't even need to find the seal's mental nodes to break it. Of course, the process would naturally be faster if they could target the mental nodes.

Hence, the current situation confounded Shi Feng a little.

*A collision between mental objects would have definitely resulted in a loss of mental energy to a certain extent. Could these chains not be made up of mental energy? Shi*

Feng wondered as he scrutinized the illusory metal spheres responsible for linking the illusory chains with one another.

Currently, there were over a thousand such metal spheres in his mental sea. Although all of these metal spheres looked to be mental nodes at first glance, only eight of them were actually responsible for holding up the foundation of the Divine Might Seal.

However, no matter how Shi Feng looked at these eight metal spheres, they were undoubtedly mental objects. In other words, so long as they were struck by a foreign mass of mental energy, they should lose some of their own mental energy. Yet, that did not seem to have happened...

*Is it because my Concentration standard is lacking? Is that why these metal spheres can ignore my attack?*

This was the only explanation Shi Feng could come up with after racking his mind. However, upon coming to this conclusion, he couldn't help but have a headache.

Currently, there was no doubt that he had already pushed the boundaries of a Tier 4 player, his Concentration reaching the Tier 5 Peak standard. Moreover, he had only reached this standard after becoming a Great Grandmaster Magician. Otherwise, he would only be at the Tier 5 Advanced standard.

It should be known that most Tier 5 players didn't even have Tier 5 Advanced Concentration. Instead, they would be stuck at the Tier 5 Basic standard. This was because, unlike levels, players could not develop their Concentration by simply killing monsters or completing quests.

Normally, if players wished to improve their Concentration standard, they would have to continuously sharpen their mental will and learn how to control it.

Apart from that, players could also improve their Concentration standard by raising their tiers. After players reached a higher tier and gained a stronger Physique, the stronger Physique would subtly influence the improvement of their Concentration. For players who got promoted to Tier 5, their Physique could help to develop their Concentration until the Tier 5 Basic standard.

However, this method of raising one's tier to develop one's Concentration could only be used up till Tier 5, which was why most Tier 5 players' Concentration would only be at the Tier 5 Basic standard.

As for why this method couldn't be used up to Tier 6, it was because of the requirements to get promoted to Tier 6.

In God's Domain, players seeking to reach Tier 6 would face three major problems.

The first and second problems were related to the Divine Body. Firstly, players needed to gather the 100,000 units of Seven Luminaries Crystal[1] required to construct a Divine Body. Secondly, players needed to know how to construct a Divine Body.

As for the third problem, it was the requirement of having Tier 6 Concentration!

If players couldn't raise their Concentration standard to Tier 6, they would be incapable of getting promoted to Tier 6. This was why many Tier 5 experts would get stuck at the cusp of Tier 6.

As for individuals like Shi Feng, who possessed Tier 5 Peak Concentration as a Tier 4 player, they were exceedingly rare in God's Domain. The only reason Shi Feng could achieve such a standard was that he had already sharpened his mental will to its limits and could not only materialize it but also materialize it into a metal object.

It was also because he had such control over his mental will that he could remain undeterred by Tier 6 Divine Might.

System: You are attempting to equip a suit of Sacred Armor. To wield its effects, you will need to fully grasp the Sacred Armor's foundational mana. Do you still wish to equip it?

"Equip it!" Shi Feng answered without hesitation.

Although the current Mana Equipment Set he used was excellent, it was still vastly inferior to a damaged suit of Fragmented Legendary Sacred Armor. Not to mention, the Sacred Armor possessed a hidden ability that his Mana Equipment Set did not!

There was a fundamental difference between Mana Equipment and Sacred Armor in God's Domain. Mana Equipment was made of magic arrays and magic patterns that drew on mana from the surrounding environment to enable players to exhibit strength far beyond what they possessed. Incinerator's Phantasm: Sacrifice 20 Levels to summon the Phantasm of a player. The Phantasm can only be two tiers higher than the Shadow Incinerator's wielder.

Duration: 3 minutes

Cooldown: 10 natural days

Additional Active Skill 2-

The End: With death as the price, incite all of the Shadow Incinerator's power to deal a devastating blow to a 5,000-yard radius. The stronger the soul sacrificed, the stronger the attack will be (up to Tier 6 Peak).

The myriad Ancient Gods have placed four seals on the Shadow Incinerator. Wielding the Shadow Incinerator will cause continuous mental scorching. Deaths while wielding the Shadow Incinerator will result in a loss of 50 points in all Attributes.

...

*A Godly Relic?* Shi Feng was dumbfounded when he saw the Shadow Incinerator's stats.

Godly Relics were different from other items. They were items that had existed since the birth of God's Domain and were not specifically categorized. As a result, Godly Relics

could vary drastically in strength, with stronger ones being superior to even Divine Artifacts and weaker ones being inferior to even Legendary items.

However, the Shadow Incinerator was clearly among the top end of Godly Relics in terms of strength. Despite having four seals placed on it, the Shadow Incinerator was still stronger than Fragmented Legendary Weapons. In terms of Basic Attributes, it was already close to matching Legendary Equipment.

Among these people, some were friends and families of those who had passed the selection, while some were the Star Lake Legion's reserve participants and members of the Star Lake City's various powerful families.

Shi Feng didn't think much of this scene and simply squeezed through the crowd.

Every city legion would only recruit members once a year, and the day of the recruitment would be the liveliest day of the year for a city. It would also be a day when many people's fates would change.

Apart from people who had passed a city legion's selection, the city legion's reserve participants and members of the city's various powerful families would also be paying close attention to this annual recruitment. One could even say that the latter group was much more concerned over the city legion's annual recruitment.

It was true that those who managed to get into a city legion selection's top 1,000 would be guaranteed a place in the city legion. However, not all members in the city legion would be of equal position.

Upon joining a city legion, a person would, first and foremost, be put into one of two main groups: official participants and reserve participants.

Of the 1,000 people who passed the selection, the top 100 would be made into official participants, while the remaining 900 would be made into reserve participants.

Subsequently, the city legion was split into three tiers of official participants, and each tier would have numerous battle groups. Every battle group would receive different treatment from the city legion based on their importance.

Ace battle groups received the best treatment in the legion, which showed in the contribution points they received each month. Even without doing anything, an ace battle group member could pay their monthly residence contribution and have excess points that they could use to exchange for the city's limited resources.

The city's limited resources were items highly coveted by the various corporations.

An example of these limited resources would be the Stardew. Just one drop of Stardew could drastically improve the user's nervous response system and let the user recover up to 50 years of their youth. If a person consumed one drop of Stardew every year, their mental strength would naturally rise from the one-star mental strength master standard to the one-star mental strength grandmaster standard within three to five years.

Even after a person became a mental strength grandmaster, consuming Stardew could still speed up the improvement of their mental strength, letting them reach the three-star mental strength grandmaster standard much more quickly. This would, in turn, give them a better chance at going beyond the grandmaster realm.

In addition, Stardew could let mental strength grandmasters better preserve their youthfulness. Typically, a mental strength grandmaster would have little to no chance of going beyond the grandmaster realm past the age of 100. However, if a mental strength

grandmaster regularly consumed Stardew, they could extend this time limit to 150 years old.

Unfortunately, because the various conglomerates monopolized the technology to manufacture Stardew, the various cities needed to go to great lengths just to exchange for a small amount. So, most cities could only afford to allocate their supply of Stardew to the members of their city legion. Moreover, it would be at the price of one million contribution points per drop of Stardew.

It should be known that the average civilian living in Star Lake City's suburbs only needed to pay a monthly residence contribution of 1,000 points. Even those living in the city center only needed to pay 3,000 points a month.

Meanwhile, the average official participant in the Star Lake Legion would only receive 2,000 contribution points a month if they didn't participate in any city battles. If they completed commissions for the city legion, they would receive about 100 contribution points per commission. So, it was nigh impossible for the average official participant to exchange a drop of Stardew.

Only by joining an ace battle group and participating in every city battle available could a person have any hopes of exchanging a drop of Stardew when they reached the retirement age of 50.

Therefore, it was of great importance that one joined an ace battle group when joining the Star Lake Legion.

In the Star Lake Legion, each battle group could only have up to 50 members. Specifically, each battle group could have up to 20 regulars and 30 replacements. The regulars of each battle group would usually be the ones participating in city battles, and the replacements would take the place of the regulars if the regulars happened to be out of commission.

As only those under the age of 50 could be in a city legion, there would be people retiring from the Star Lake Legion every year. This meant empty slots would be available in the various battle groups every year.

While the minimum requirement to join a battle group was to be an official participant, reserve participants could try for one of these vacant slots. After all, the Star Lake Legion's selection would only bring in 100 new official participants each year. Yet, the Star Lake Legion had nearly 200 battle groups spread across the three tiers.
