[Sunlight Blade] (Saber, Divine Artifact)

Equipment Requirement: Tier 5, Strength 40,000

Cannot be equipped or inspected by players outside of the Holy Race.

For example, most of the weapons and equipment used by human players were developed around Mana, so Holy Race players could not use them. Conversely, the Holy Race's weapons and equipment were developed around Holy Power, so human players could not use them.

Additional Profound Inheritance 1: Formless Sword. Converts any object into a temporary sword. The quality of the sword created depends on the object used and the magic array constructed by the user.

Duration: 1 hour

Cooldown: 1 natural day

Additional Profound Inheritance 2: World Sword. Devour World Sources to evolve.

The Primordial God of Thunder's final creation that has absorbed a main branch from the Holy Tree and Refined Void Blood. The Winter of Eternal Night holds the power source of a Primordial God, and it is capable of freezing all things.

However, for the current Zero Wing, it was an opportunity to achieve a qualitative transformation.

"According to the Green God Corporation, our God's Domain's World Gate appeared in the Starlight Realm roughly five hours ago, and it is situated in the Northern Wasteland that's close to the Ancient River Kingdom," Gentle Snow said. "The Green God Corporation also states that the World Gate will open in ten days at the latest and that the powers of two Realm Empires and six Realm Kingdoms have already mobilized their armies to surround the gate.
