This process lasted for ten minutes. Ten minutes later, a brand new God Chaser Set appeared in Shi Feng's hands.

"How did it go, Guild Leader?" Gentle Snow eagerly asked when she saw Shi Feng inspecting the strengthened God Chaser Set.

Shi Feng had directly informed Gentle Snow, Fervent Samsara, and Heavy Abyss about his plans to use the Seven Luminaries Crystals he acquired from Verdant Rainbow to strengthen the God Chaser Sets. Hence, Gentle Snow wasn't surprised by what just happened. However, that didn't stop her from growing curious about the outcome of the strengthening process.

"Take a look yourself," Shi Feng said as he shared the new God Chaser Set's statistics with Gentle Snow.

Meanwhile, after Gentle Snow was done reading the new God Chaser Set's Attributes, excitement appeared on her face as she exclaimed, "Amazing! The strengthened God Chaser Set is simply beyond extraordinary!"

After being strengthened, not only did the Epic-ranked God Chaser Set's quality advance to the Fragmented Legendary standard, but its set effects also underwent drastic changes.

At the Epic rank, the God Chaser Set's four-piece set effect only increased Physique by 50%, while its six-piece set effect increased the Basic Attributes the set provided by 80%. As for the eight-piece set effect, it elevated the set's Basic Attributes to the Level 220 standard while lowering the equipment requirement to Level 200. When players equipped the set, the Basic Attributes they could gain would be similar to if they were fully equipped with Legendary Equipment.

After ascending to the Fragmented Legendary rank, though, the God Chaser Set's four-piece set effect increased Physique by 100%, while its six-piece set effect increased the set's Basic Attributes by 120% and improved the wearer's Skill and Spell Completion Rates by 10%. As for the eight-piece set effect, although it similarly elevated the set's Basic Attributes to the Level 220 standard, the equipment requirement was changed to Tier 6 only. So long as players were at Tier 6, they could equip the set at any level. On top of that, the eight-piece set effect also improved neural responses by 50%.

It wouldn't be an exaggeration to say that so long as a Tier 6 player equipped the Fragmented Legendary-ranked God Chaser Set, they would instantly become a monster of the new era!

Setting aside the fact that the set allowed Level 180, Tier 6 players to have Basic Attributes surpassing Level 200, Tier 6 Gods, just the fact that it increased Skill and Spell Completion Rates by 10% and improved all neural responses by 50% were enough to make it beyond incredible. In the era after the major system update's implementation, the Fragmented Legendary-ranked God Chaser Set could artificially raise a player's combat standards by one or two levels.

At this time, Gentle Snow even had the feeling that if she equipped this new God Chaser Set, she could defeat even veteran fifth-floor experts in battle. When the participants in Miniature World 006 saw Returning Blade and Gentle Snow step onto the ring, they started a hushed discussion among themselves.

Of the 21 participants assigned to Miniature World 006, most deemed Returning Blade to be the strongest among them. So, whether they could rank first in the group depended on whether they could defeat Returning Blade.

I would even go as far as to call it a tactical weapon. So long as Black Flame can regroup with the rest of his party, the Verdant Rainbow Party will still hold the overall advantage."

Frost Raven pondered over Azure Dragon's words for a moment before she nodded in agreement.

Although Shi Feng had lost the opportunity to eliminate Moon Demon, it did not change the fact that his Law Projection could impose a powerful suppression on all his enemies. Hence, the Verdant Rainbow Party still held a considerable advantage in this match. So long as the Verdant Rainbow Party could avoid taking any casualties before everyone regrouped, it would have a considerable chance of winning the match.

While it would be beneficial if they could exhaust a huge threat like Shi Feng, the problem was that they couldn't do any damage to Shi

Feng, whereas Shi Feng could deal considerable damage to them. This meant that they would ultimately lose and that it would be foolish to keep fighting Shi Feng.

Now, their best option would be to regroup with Daystar and work with her to eliminate Shi Feng. Otherwise, the Holy Guard Party would never win this match.

"Do you think I'll let you leave so easily?" When Shi Feng saw Holy Blood and Moon Demon intending to withdraw, he immediately executed Sword's Orbit with his two swords.

Holy Blood and Moon Demon were two of the Sun Dynasty's three strongest Holy Children. They were also among the three key combatants of the Holy Guard Party. So long as Shi Feng could eliminate them here, the match was as good as won.

Conversely, if Shi Feng allowed Holy Blood and Moon Demon to regroup with Daystar, even if he could now cast his Law Projection with the Pseudo-Goddess Law, he dared not say he could win with certainty.

Hundreds of rotating sword lights spread across the dilapidated urban sprawl, demolishing every building in their path and causing rubble to rain on the street.

When the sword lights dissipated, dust and smoke clouds filled the air. Amidst the ruins, Moon Demon pushed away the debris covering her. Although she did not sustain any visible injuries, her previous delight was nowhere to be seen, replaced by a grave expression.

Previously, although she and Holy Blood remained at a disadvantage after working together, they could still trade blows with Shi Feng without taking catastrophic damage.

In God's Domain, players would only be considered to have reached the apex if they had learned a Gold Combat Technique. This was because only combat techniques that had reached the Gold rank could pose a threat to fifth-floor experts and above.

Previously, although he had learned the Gold-ranked Flowing Space, it primarily enhanced his maneuverability since it was a body technique. While he could use Flowing Space to overwhelm his opponent's senses, he still had to ensure he had an advantage in Basic Attributes if he wanted to overpower his opponent's defenses. Of the top-tier techniques in his repertoire, only Dark Moon, a Primordial God-ranked Mana

Technique, enhanced his offensive power significantly and allowed him to threaten stronger opponents.

Now that Sword's Orbit had been elevated to the Gold rank, he would have one more offensive measure to fall back on. Additionally, as Sword's Orbit was a Gold Combat Technique, using it would place less burden on his Concentration than a Primordial God-ranked Mana Technique. It also wouldn't conflict with the mana control of his Law Projection as its execution relied solely on the user's body.

Hence, even though his Concentration was only at the Tier 6 Advanced standard currently, he could afford to cast a Pseudo-Goddess Law Projection while using a Gold Combat Technique. This development increased his combat power significantly. In his current state, he wouldn't need much time to finish off Moon Demon.

Meanwhile, this unexpected development excited the various human spectators.

"What a powerful sword technique!"

"The Holy Guard Party is in trouble. There's no way Moon Demon can last long by herself. Once Black Flame regroups with Verdant Rainbow, not even Daystar can survive against them."

On the battlefield, hundreds of illusory fists bombarded Verdant Rainbow and the others at speeds that broke the sound barrier. Stronger Tier 6 NPCs would have a Fragmented Divine Artifact-ranked weapon, and they would be as strong as barely equipped Tier 6 Gods.

As for the six War Goddesses, they were fully equipped with Fragmented Divine Artifacts...

"I must be dreaming! How can this be real?!"

"Is that summoning tool a Divine Artifact?"

The Holy Race experts who originally wanted to ridicule Shi Feng for overestimating his capabilities gaped in shock when they saw the six War Goddesses. Even Verdant Rainbow and the others who were aware of the Feather of Oath's existence couldn't help but be shocked.

Tools that could summon Level 200, Tier 6 NPCs weren't particularly rare in the Greater God's Domain. All major powers would have some of these tools. Only, none of them could summon NPCs as strong as War Goddesses. It was also completely unheard-of for summoned Tier 6 NPCs to come fully equipped with Fragmented Divine Artifacts.

It should be known that the rarity of Fragmented Divine Artifacts was much greater than that of Legendary Weapons. Even the various apex powers didn't have many in their possession. Aside from their chosen ones, they would never assign a Fragmented Divine Artifact to their younger generation members. "Rin didn't even make a move throughout the entire match. Her five party members thoroughly suppressed the Eight Paths Party," Phoenix Flame said as she shared a battle video with Elise. "Out of Rin's five party members, the strongest one would have to be the Archon named First Light. He single-handedly killed Eight Paths and another one of the Eight Paths Party's key members, and Arclight, the Divine Weapon he wields, is comparable to the Sun Dynasty's Moonlight Blade."

In the video Phoenix Flame shared, a six-meter-tall young Crystallian man stood on a flying shuttle formed from countless sharp blades while manipulating a hundred-meter-long greatsword to attack his opponents. His attacks were comparable to those of Level 200 Ancient Gods, and he shaved off multiple buildings with every swing of his greatsword. Additionally, his attacks were unbelievably fast, making it look like he was brandishing a feather rather than a colossal weapon.

In front of First Light's weapon, Eight Paths was no different from an ant. He could not evade any of First Light's attacks and could only defend against them, losing a considerable chunk of his HP each time he did so. Ultimately, even with the support of his party members, Eight Paths still died to the Crystallian named First Light.

Meanwhile, after Elise finished watching the video, she turned to Phoenix Flame and asked, "He's quite strong. Do you think you can keep him busy?"

The Crystallian race did not manipulate Holy Power like the Holy Race or Mana like the human race. Instead, they were proficient in manipulating implements and could manipulate them like they were manipulating their limbs. Meanwhile, the Archon class was one of the best classes available to the Crystallians, with owners of the class being able to turn their implements into a copy of themselves. Out of all the Crystallian classes, the Archon class was the trickiest to deal with.

"If he doesn't have any more Divine Artifacts hidden, I should be able to keep him occupied," Phoenix Flame answered after considering Elise's question.

"Good. I'll leave him to you, then," Elise said without hesitation. She did not cast any doubt over Phoenix Flame's claim.

"Don't worry. Learning even one of the lesser Legacies within a day is easier said than done, let alone the primary Legacy," Elise said indifferently. "If Black Flame is so confident in his abilities, I don't mind giving him a day."

Phoenix Flame agreed with Elise when she heard the latter's words.

Each Goddess Tablet contained a multitude of Legacies. It was especially so for the ranked Goddess Tablets. Although even the lesser Legacies inside these Goddess Tablets were extraordinary, learning them was a significant challenge. Previously, Phoenix Flame had taken a month just to learn a Legacy from the Sixth Goddess Tablet—and that was only one of the tablet's lesser Legacies rather, not the primary Legacy.

Not to mention, before players could even access the Legacies inside a Goddess Tablet, they would first have to decipher the Goddess Tablet.

With only a day granted to him, the most Shi Feng could accomplish was deciphering the Sixth Goddess Tablet and learning how many Legacies it held. Ultimately, he would be no better than someone who had never held the Sixth Goddess Tablet.

For expert players who had mastered many kinds of techniques, developing their Concentration was of utmost importance.

Unfortunately, few methods were available to improve a player's Concentration in the Greater God's Domain. Most players could only improve their Concentration by continuously straining their bodies. Although some items could be used to improve Concentration, they would be fiercely contested by the various powers whenever they appeared.

Fortunately, Shi Feng was already familiar with the Goddess Tablets' mana interpretation method. For most players, even developing their Concentration to the Tier 6 standard was already a monumental challenge. The reason most expert players could never advance to Tier 6 was their lacking Concentration. Meanwhile, once players developed their Concentration to the Tier 6 standard, it would become even more difficult to develop it further. If players did not encounter any fortuitous opportunities or priceless treasures that could permanently improve their Concentration, the only way they could improve it was by engaging in high-intensity combat for considerable amounts of time.

This was also why very few Tier 6 players could develop their Concentration to the Tier 6 Peak standard, with most hovering at the Tier 6 Intermediate and Tier 6 Advanced standards.

However, so long as a player successfully developed their Concentration to the Tier 6 Peak standard, their strength would undergo a qualitative transformation.

In God's Domain, particularly after the major system update, players would expend a considerable amount of Concentration when using Skills, Spells, Combat Techniques,

Mana Techniques, and Law Projections. Because of this, if there wasn't a huge gap in Basic Attributes and combat standards, battles between players would often turn into a competition of Concentration, and whoever possessed the stronger Concentration would emerge victorious.

Meanwhile, after a player's Concentration reached the Tier 6 Peak standard, not only would they have twice as much Concentration to expend as players with only Tier 6 Advanced Concentration, but they would also expend 30% less Concentration when using Skills, Spells, etc. Furthermore, their perception and control over their body would also improve significantly.

All in all, these improvements made it so that huge gaps in strength existed even among Tier 6 players.

In his previous life, Shi Feng was fortunate enough to develop his Concentration to the Tier 6 Peak standard shortly after he reached Tier 6. Hence, even when he encountered experts with superior combat standards, he could defeat them with ease. He had even eliminated experts wielding Divine Weapons who did not have Tier 6 Peak Concentration.

Originally, Shi Feng thought he would need considerable time to develop his Concentration to the Tier 6 Peak standard in this life. He never expected to accomplish it so quickly.

Now that my Concentration is at the Tier 6 Peak standard, paired with the Mental Condensation technique, my Concentration can probably already rival those old monsters whose Concentration is at the Tier 6 Limit standard, Shi Feng thought as he executed the Mental Condensation technique. Then, he eagerly cast his Pseudo-Goddess Law Projection to test his upgraded Concentration's effects. Sure enough, my Concentration consumption has halved compared to before. Now, I should have no trouble using Dark Moon with the Pseudo-Goddess Law Projection.

Previously, when his base Concentration was still at the Tier 6 Advanced standard, he could only artificially elevate it to the Tier 6 Peak standard with the Mental Condensation technique, and maintaining the Pseudo-Goddess Law Projection put a huge burden on him. Because of this, he couldn't afford to use Dark Moon, a powerful Mana Technique that required him to actively manipulate the magic elements around him.

However, now that his base Concentration had reached the Tier 6 Peak standard, he should have no trouble using the Pseudo-Goddess Law Projection and Dark Moon simultaneously.

Of course, he couldn't possibly test this theory in the lounge. So, instead of doing so, he decided to try out a different hypothesis.

Immediately, Shi Feng began to pace around inside the lounge, executing Flowing Space under the effects of his Pseudo-Goddess Law Projection. It felt like he was stepping into the gaps in space with each of his steps, and he created over 50 afterimages in the blink of an eye. That was triple the number he could previously create while executing Flowing Space.

As Shi Feng continued executing Flowing Space, he became more familiar with and proficient at manipulating his surrounding environment. This, in turn, led to the creation of even more phantom bodies.

[Shadow Incinerator (Dark Soul)] (One-handed Sword, Sealed Godly Relic)

Equipment Requirement: Soul-Bound

Attack Power (1,400% of Strength)

Attack Speed (5% of Strength and Agility)

All Attributes (Increases according to the user's level)

When equipped:

Attacks ignore 100% of all defensive effects;

Attacks have a 50% chance of triggering the Soul Devour effect;

Attacks have a 100% chance of being elevated by one rank and dealing 1,000% damage;

Attacks cause an additional 200% damage to all creatures below Tier 6;

Ignore Levels +80;

All Attributes increased by 300%;

Physique increased by 200%;

Reaction speed increased by 120%;

Effects of all attacks increased by two ranks (up to Tier 6 Limit);

The strength of Mana increased by one rank (up to Tier 6 Limit);

Concentration increased by one rank (up to Tier 6 Limit).

Additional Passive Skill-

Incinerator's Body: Weakens all damage received by 80% and increases World Perception by one rank.

Additional Profound Skill 1-

Incinerator's Phantasm: Sacrifice 20 Levels to summon the Phantasm of a player. The Phantasm can only be two tiers higher than the Shadow Incinerator's wielder (up to Tier 6).

Duration: 10 minutes

Cooldown: 3 natural days

Additional Profound Skill 2-

The End: Sacrifice the wielder's soul, reducing the wielder's level by one as a result, to incite all of the Shadow Incinerator's power to deal a devastating blow to a 50,000-yard radius. The stronger the soul sacrificed, the stronger the attack will be (up to Tier 6 Limit).

Cooldown: 30 minutes

Additional Profound Skill 3-

Scorching Flame: Sacrifice a portion of the wielder's soul to attach the Flames of Shadow to the Shadow Incinerator. The Flames of Shadow can destroy all weapons and equipment below the Legendary rank and damage those below the Divine Artifact rank.

Duration: 5 minutes

Cooldown: 1 natural day

Additional Profound Skill 4-

World's Descent: With the wielder as the center, call down a complete world to strengthen the wielder's Law Projection.

Duration: 5 minutes

Cooldown: 1 hour

The myriad Ancient Gods have placed four seals on the Shadow Incinerator. Two of the seals have been lifted thus far. Wielding the Shadow Incinerator will cause continuous mental scorching. Deaths while wielding the Shadow Incinerator will result in a loss of 50 points in all Attributes.

What heaven-defying Attributes!

Shi Feng's jaw dropped when he finished reading through the Shadow Incinerator's updated Attributes.

Even when comparing Basic Attributes only, the Shadow Incinerator was superior to most Fragmented Divine Artifacts. As for its Attack Power, it was simply absurd. For comparison, Gentle Snow's Chaos Windblade, despite being a two-handed weapon, only took 1,600% of its wielder's Strength Attribute as its Attack Power. Meanwhile, the Shadow Incinerator, despite being a one-handed weapon, took 1,400% of its wielder's Strength Attribute as its Attack Power.

However, compared to the Shadow Incinerator's Basic Attributes, the absurdity of its offensive effects and the limits of these effects was on a whole other level.

As a Fragmented Divine Artifact, the Chaos Windblade had already reached the rank's limits. Even so, the limits of the weapon's effects could only reach the Tier 6 Peak standard. This was also the limit of virtually all other Fragmented Divine Artifacts. Yet, the Shadow Incinerator had broken this norm, its effects having the potential to achieve the Tier 6 Limit standard.

What did it mean to reach the Tier 6 Limit standard?

Most players in God's Domain would only assume it to be the limits of Tier 6 players, which, in the best-case scenario, would translate to the Tier 6 God standard. Hence, it couldn't be considered anything significant.

However, players with experience fighting Ancient Gods would know that wasn't actually the case. Instead, the Tier 6 Limit mentioned in weapon and equipment introductions referred to the limits any creature could achieve before they went beyond Tier 6.

Currently, only Primordial God-ranked existences were known to have gone beyond Tier 6. Besides them, the strongest creatures in God's Domain had yet to go beyond Tier 6. In other words, the Shadow Incinerator's effects could achieve near-Primordial God standards and rival the effects of many Divine Artifact-ranked weapons.

My current Basic Attributes can rival Holy Children armed with three Divine Artifacts. When Shi Feng sensed the improvement in his Basic Attributes, he discovered that the overall improvement he received from the Shadow Incinerator was comparable to that of a Divine Artifact-ranked one-handed weapon. Once he paired the Shadow Incinerator with the new God Chaser Set, not even players equipped with three Divine Artifacts should consider surpassing him. Now, he truly was strong enough to win the entire championship.

Before Shi Feng could familiarize himself with the Shadow Incinerator, he suddenly received a call from Verdant Rainbow.

"How is your rest coming along, Guild Leader Black Flame?" Verdant Rainbow asked anxiously. "The second round's first match is about to begin."

"So much time has passed already?" Shi Feng was a little surprised. He didn't think he had spent over 40 hours undoing the second seal.

"We need you to come over quickly. Although the Star Maiden Party has agreed to switch opponents with us, we can't do the switch unless all party members are present," Verdant Rainbow said, feeling exasperated when she saw Shi Feng's look of realization.

Shi Feng was the one who negotiated the deal with Elise to switch opponents. Yet, even though the match was about to start, he was nowhere to be seen.
