Additional Skill 2: Abyssal Will. Grants the wearer the power of the Abyss, increasing Defense by 500%, Strength by 400%, Agility by 300%, Physique by 300%, and Endurance by 400%. Also increases Concentration by one rank. (Up to Tier 7)

Duration: 5 minutes

Cooldown: 10 natural days

Possession of the Abyssal Lord. It is a naturally occurring Abyssal Relic composed of the power of the Abyss. It has the power to control the Abyss.

Tier 7?

The Abyssal Eye's updated stats dumbfounded Shi Feng.

The highest known tier that could appear in the current human race's Greater God's Domain was Tier 6. Even the mighty Ancient Gods could only use up to Tier 6 Taboo Skills and Curses. No person or object could exceed this limit. Not even Divine Artifacts could do so.

Thus, the existence of Tier 7 Skills and Spells was as illusory as Primordial Gods. It wouldn't be an exaggeration to call them myths.

No wonder I have to kill the Undying Mother! As Shi Feng looked at the repaired Abyssal Eye, he suddenly understood why Enos had given him such an unreasonable quest.

No matter how Heiser wrestled with the idea, she couldn't fathom it. After all, how could a mere Level 200, Tier 6 player, devoid of any Divine Artifacts, overwhelm her senses?

"I'm certain. Guild Leader Black Flame was only Level 190 when he fought Uncle Xiao in a simulation battle three days ago. Uncle Xiao even complained afterward about not being able to fight at full strength," Twilight Leaf stated firmly. "As for whether Guild Leader Black Flame is Level 200 now...that I can't say for sure."

"Is that so..." Heiser fell into thought for a moment. Then, the corners of her mouth raised into a playful smile as she said, "I guess my teacher wasn't joking when she described Guild Leader Black Flame as mysterious. Now, I have another expert I can challenge besides Big Sis Frost!"

Subsequently, Heiser and Twilight Leaf advanced deeper into the Shadow Mountains to regroup with the other members of Holy Dragon Spear. Meanwhile, a commotion broke out in the Shadow Mountains' outer area as news of the Divine Wing Dynasty's number one chosen one getting killed got around. Simultaneously, the legend of a Swordsman named Black Flame spread like wildfire.

This was the first time in centuries that a Level 200 player had managed to kill a pseudo-apex power's Level 226 chosen one in the Primordial Dragon Sanctuary. Moreover, this Level 200 player wasn't even among the Divine Glory List's top 30. Instead, he was only ranked 281st.

Additional Skill 1-

War Goddess Summoning: For every 100,000 units of Seven Luminaries Crystal expended, summon one War Goddess of the same tier (up to Tier 6 and equipment up

to the Divine Artifact rank) but no more than twenty levels higher. Every War Goddess summoned will last six hours. Up to nine War Goddesses can be summoned at the same time. No incantations required. No Cooldown.

Additional Skill 2-

Heroic Pledge: Expend ten God Crystals to temporarily upgrade a War Goddess by one tier (up to Tier 6 and equipment up to a Divine Set).

Duration: 1 hour

Cooldown: 6 hours

Additional Skill 3-

Goddess Battle Array: Expend three God Crystals to allow the War Goddesses to form a Small Advanced Gold Battle Array (at least six War Goddesses are required).

Duration: 10 minutes

Cooldown: 3 hours

Shi Feng dared not believe his eyes when he saw the Feather of Oath's updated stats.

After sensing the Divine Might the Feather of Oath emanated, he initially thought it would only be as powerful as the average Divine Artifact. However, the Feather of Oath's improvements far exceeded his expectations. In its current state, Shi Feng felt that the Feather of Oath could rival the Abyssal Eye.

It should be known that the Abyssal Eye's abilities could only achieve the Tier 7 standard because it was fully repaired. In comparison, the Feather of Oath remained partially damaged. Yet, it already had the potential to breach the Tier 7 standard.

Additionally, the War Goddesses he summoned could now come equipped with Divine Artifacts instead of only Fragmented Divine Artifacts. They could also exceed him by up to 20 levels. The War Goddess Summoning Skill alone trumped many Divine Artifacts.

War Goddesses already possessed stunningly high Basic Attributes, even without Divine Artifacts. Shi Feng dared not imagine how powerful they would become if they were fully equipped with Divine Artifacts.

Although Divine Artifacts and Fragmented Divine Artifacts were only separated by one rank, they were worlds apart in performance. It was like the difference between Ancient Gods and ordinary Gods. Moreover, he could summon up to nine War Goddesses with the improved War Goddess Summoning.

Who among the same level could contend with him if he were to summon nine Ancient Gods to fight for him?

Not to mention, there were still the Feather of Oath's second and third Skills, which were even more extraordinary. Although it cost a hefty sum of God Crystals to activate these two Skills, their effects were well worth the cost. If he could equip a War Goddess with a Divine Set, said War Goddess would become invincible among opponents of the same level. The Goddess Battle Array could also temporarily increase the strength of the War Goddesses by a large margin.

From what Shi Feng could recall, Gold Battle Arrays were already the strongest battle arrays that the various human powers possessed. If an ordinary hegemonic power were to get its hands on a Gold Battle Array, its status would instantly skyrocket to match that of conglomerates. Although Shi Feng didn't know how powerful an Advanced Gold Battle Array was, he wouldn't discount the possibility that it could let the War Goddesses hold their ground against Primordial Gods of the same level.

While Shi Feng was marveling at the Feather of Oath's astonishing Skills, the commotion caused by the Feather of Oath attracted a Tier 6 Divine monster.

[Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand] (Dark Primordial Tribe, Divine)

Level 236

HP 100,000,000,000,000,000

The Dark Primordial Tribe? Shi Feng was speechless when he saw the hundred-metertall monster that exuded a strange form of mana. He didn't know whether he should consider himself lucky or unlucky.

The Dark Primordial Tribe consisted of a group of creatures that were no weaker than any other creature in the Greater God's Domain. In his previous life, they were first seen

after the discovery of the Flame Dragon God's Nest. More specifically, they were creatures the Primordial Flame Dragon had sealed in the Flame Dragon God's Nest.

The Dark Primordial Tribe originally inhabited the depths of the Void Sea. Even among the terrifying creatures that inhabited the boundless Void Sea, the Dark Primordial Tribe was considered powerful. The weakest member could rival Ancient Gods, while the stronger ones could kill even Primordial Gods.

Although the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand before Shi Feng was only a walking corpse with an incomplete soul, it should still be able to exhibit at least 20% of the combat power it possessed when it was alive. It could be considered one of the Flame Dragon God's Nest's overlords. Without a 100-man Tier 6 team of experts of the same level, killing it would be a challenge.

Great! There's a chance!

Shi Feng's eyes lit up when he saw that the greatsword-wielding War Goddess was only slightly disadvantaged in Strength.

Normally, soloing a Tier 6 Boss with 100 quadrillion HP should be impossible for a player. After all, such a monster could recover 2% of its HP every five seconds. It was nigh impossible for a player to overcome this barrier by themself.

However, the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand was a little different. As a monster that had died long ago, it didn't possess battle recovery like normal monsters. So long as one could survive its attacks, one could grind it to death.

Thinking up to this point, Shi Feng took out ten Eternal God Crystals and activated the Feather of Oath's second Skill, Heroic Pledge. Immediately, a War Goddess wielding a square shield and a spear had her equipment transformed into a Divine Set. The intensity of her aura surged, and she became much stronger than even the greatsword-wielding War Goddess, who was equipped with eight Divine Artifacts.

The change in the shield-wielding War Goddess's aura caught the attention of the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand. Almost instinctively, the magic eyes that covered its body shone with dark light, and hundreds of greatswords exuding strange mana filled the area within a thousand yards, occulting the sky.

Is this the power of the Dark Primordial Tribe? Shi Feng was momentarily stunned as he looked at the one thousand greatswords floating silently in the sky.

At first glance, the floating greatswords seemed to be weapons. However, on closer inspection, Shi Feng realized that they were actually puppets. Moreover, each of these "puppets" was a Level 236 Divine monster. In other words, besides the Dead Thousand-

Eyed Demonic Hand, he now had to face a thousand Level 236 Divine monsters as well...

A thousand Divine monsters!

Even a 1,000-man Tier 6 legion would have difficulty fighting such an array of monsters!

"Die... Die... All of you die!" Although the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand did not possess a mouth, the mental fluctuations it gave off conveyed its thoughts directly into Shi Feng's mind, and they radiated hostility toward the living.

As the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand conveyed its thoughts, the dark greatswords in the sky aimed their tips at Shi Feng. Evidently, the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand knew its true opponent in this battle.

"Use your Goddess's Howl!" Shi Feng instinctively shouted at the shield-wielding War Goddess when he saw the dark greatswords targeting him.

Goddess's Howl. This was a Tier 6 AOE Taunt Taboo Skill that the shield-wielding War Goddess had learned. Although the Taboo Skill had a five-minute cooldown, it would compel all enemies within 1,000 yards to attack the user once activated. Should taunted targets try to resist this compulsion and attack someone else, they would receive significant amounts of continuous damage. In contrast, the user would receive a buff to their Basic Attributes over time, starting at 100% and capping out at 300%.

Responding to Shi Feng's command, the shield-wielding War Goddess stomped on the ground and let out a low shout, stirring up a storm that swept across a thousand yards. Additionally, over a thousand golden chains emerged from the golden magic array under her feet and established a link with the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand and the dark greatswords to force them to target her.

When the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand and the dark greatswords turned their focus to the shield-wielding War Goddess, she did not panic. Instead, with a swing of her spear, she called down countless lightning bolts from the sky to strike them.

Subsequently, damage values in the hundreds of billions appeared above the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand one after another. Almost instantly, it lost over a hundred trillion HP, and its HP bar fell 0.1%.

Their HPs are shared? Shi Feng grew ecstatic when he saw how much HP the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand lost.

Originally, he was quite troubled by the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand's HP of 100 quadrillion. He had no idea how long it would take him to kill such a tough monster. However, as maintaining the Miniature Abyssal World placed a huge burden on his Concentration, his complexion turned a shade lighter with every second he kept it active. Meanwhile, the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand's HP decreased at a snail's pace...

When the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand's HP fell below 100 trillion, it suddenly went berserk a second time, increasing the number of dark greatswords on the battlefield from 2,000 to 3,000. However, before any of these dark greatswords could wreak havoc, the shield-wielding War Goddess hurled her spear into the sky. Immediately afterward, a golden spear ten thousand meters long fell from the sky, its majesty visible across hundreds of thousands of yards.

Boom!

In just one strike, the area within ten thousand yards of the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand was turned into a sea of lightning, and the Divine Boss lost its last bit of HP.

Finally.

Shi Feng sighed in relief as he looked at the fallen Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand.

The Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand proved even tougher than anticipated. He truly had not expected the Divine Boss to have a second berserk phase. This battle would have been lost if not for the shield-wielding War Goddess.

Three thousand Level 236 Divine monsters!

Such a force would devastate most Realms in the Greater God's Domain. Though every Realm had plenty of Divine monsters, none had 3,000 Divine monsters at Level 236. Even a Level 230, Tier 6 tank wielding a Divine Shield could barely contend with a Level 236 Divine monster. However, most upper-ranking hegemonic powers didn't even have more than a few Level 230, Tier 6 tanks, let alone Level 230, Tier 6 tanks with Divine Shields.

Only pseudo-apex and apex powers, with their Level 235, Tier 6 tanks fully equipped with Divine Artifacts or Divine Sets, stood a chance against 3,000 Level 236 Divine monsters. Weaker powers shouldn't even dream of engaging such a horde.

Following the death of the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand, Shi Feng's experience bar soared. In the blink of an eye, he rose from Level 200 to Level 201, and then again to Level 202.

Normally, even a 1,000-man legion of Level 230, Tier 6 players would consider the EXP from the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand a substantial reward. Now, Shi Feng monopolized this EXP. Additionally, it was also multiplied by the maximum possible EXP bonus due to the 36-level gap between him and the Divine Boss. As a result, his level skyrocketed until he reached Level 212.

Twelve levels in one go? Shi Feng was astounded at how many levels he gained.

In the Greater God's Domain, even with unlimited access to Taboo Secret Lands, players past Level 200 would need a week or more to level up once. Furthermore, this duration would only increase with their level due to the scarcity of higher-level monsters.

Yet, he gained 12 levels in one hour. This was likely the fastest anyone had ever leveled up in the human race's Greater God's Domain post-Level 200.

It's a pity Level 236 Bosses like the Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand are incredibly rare. Otherwise, I could have aimed to hit Level 220 within a day. Wistfulness filled Shi Feng as he glanced at the fading Dead Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand. With the Feather of Oath, if I were at Level 220, I could even compete with the Dragon God Palace and Holy Dragon Spear for the Flame Dragon God's Nest.

The Flame Dragon God's Nest was one of three super-large-scale Taboo Secret Lands in the human race's Greater God's Domain. It was also one of only three Level 240-plus Taboo Secret Lands that Shi Feng knew of, and it could have a huge impact on a power's development. This was because it could let players progress to Level 240 and beyond unobstructed.

Since Tier 7 remained unattainable in the human race's Greater God's Domain, Level 230-plus, Tier 6 players and Divine Artifacts became units of measurement for a power's overall strength. The more a power commanded, the stronger it would be.

For this reason, whoever controlled the Flame Dragon God's Nest would secure a future as an apex power for themselves. This was also why Holy Dragon Spear could fight an army of one million Tier 6 Holy Race players with just an elite force of 10,000 Tier 6 players.

When Holy Dragon Spear showed up on the battlefield with 100 Level 240-plus, Tier 6 experts and 10,000 Tier 6 experts close to Level 240, it had shocked the various human powers.

At the time, even apex powers in the human territories boasted only a few thousand Level 235-plus, Tier 6 experts after years of accumulation, while conglomerates and upper-ranking hegemonic powers would be fortunate to have a hundred. After all, although the monsters in secret lands respawned quickly, it didn't happen instantly. Thus, the EXP secret lands could yield was finite, and powers could not afford to grant all their members unrestricted access.

However, a super-large-scale secret land could accommodate many more players than large-scale and ordinary secret lands. This was why Holy Dragon Spear could produce so many Level 235-plus, Tier 6 experts in a short time. They could have even competed against the various apex powers' experts if not for their inferior equipment standards.

While Zero Wing was a formidable power in the Eternal Realm, it lagged far behind the various powers operating outside the Eternal Realm when it came to levels, weapons, and equipment. If Zero Wing could gain control of the Flame Dragon God's Nest, it would undoubtedly make up for the Guild's deficiencies.

The problem was that the Dragon God Palace's and Holy Dragon Spear's frontline experts were already inside the Flame Dragon God's Nest. Without sufficient strength, Zero Wing had no hope of challenging these two pseudo-apex powers for the secret land's ownership.

Thus, Shi Feng could only keep his thoughts to himself. He was already lucky to gain entry into the Flame Dragon God's Nest. It was simply unrealistic to try to snatch it from the jaws of two pseudo-apex powers. After all, each of these pseudo-apex powers had at least a 100-man team of Level 235-plus, Tier 6 experts inside the secret land. They also had all sorts of Divine Artifacts to fall back on. exclusive Divine Artifact. The resulting Divine Artifact can only be used by the bound user and cannot be used by others.

[Primordial Dragon Holy Crystal] (Divine Artifact)

A soul crystal formed by the Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand after devouring a part of the Primordial Flame Dragon's soul. The Primordial Dragon Holy Crystal can be absorbed by Dragon-type creatures for one bloodline transformation opportunity.

How powerful was this Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand when it was still alive? When Shi Feng finished reading the descriptions of the two items, he suspected that the Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand was much more fearsome when it was still alive than he had first thought.

Although Shi Feng found it unbelievable that the Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand could come back to life in the Flame Dragon God's Nest, he initially hadn't thought it had reached the standard of Primordial Gods. However, the Primordial Dragon Holy Crystal's description forced him to rethink his assessment. After all, if the Thousand-Eyed Demonic Hand's strength did not reach the Primordial God standard, it could never have devoured a portion of the Primordial Flame Dragon's soul.

"The Dark Divine Silver is useless to me, but I can give it to Snow to upgrade her Chaos Wind Blade," Shi Feng muttered as he put away the Dark Divine Silver before reaching for the Primordial Dragon Holy Crystal. "This thing, however, is something I can use. I wonder how much it can improve the Frostflame Dragon?"

"Here you go, little guy," Shi Feng said as he threw the fist-sized Primordial Dragon Holy Crystal to the Frostflame Dragon.

The Divine-ranked Frostflame Dragon could grow into a Tier 6 Dragon if fed normally. The only problem was that this process required time. Thus, since his promotion to Tier 6, Shi Feng had treated the Tier 5 Frostflame Dragon only as a means of transportation.

But that could potentially change now that he had obtained the Primordial Dragon Holy Crystal. If he could promote the Frostflame Dragon to Tier 6, it would greatly help him.

As a Divine Flying Mount, the Frostflame Dragon already possessed the Basic Attributes of Tier 6 monsters despite being at Tier 5. Once it advanced to Tier 6, it might surpass Tier 6 Gods in Basic Attributes. At that time, while its offensive capabilities might remain inferior to War Goddesses equipped with multiple Divine Artifacts, its HP and tanking capabilities would be leagues above War Goddesses of the same level. Additionally, the Movement Speed of Flying Mounts would skyrocket once they reached Tier 6. Not only could they fly between Realms, but they could also let players riding on them gradually recover their Stamina and Concentration. Tier 6 Flying Mounts were essentially miniature mobile fortresses. This was also why Tier 6 Flying Mounts could be used for cross-realm travel.

After swallowing the Primordial Dragon Holy Crystal, the Frostflame Dragon became drowsy and slept beside Shi Feng. A moment later, divine runes gradually surfaced on its scales. Within a minute, three layers of divine runes covered the entire Frostflame Dragon, creating a cocoon of divine runes.

When the cocoon formed, it radiated a powerful aura that shook the mending space in the area. Then, the cocoon released draconic roars that echoed across tens of thousands of yards, scaring all Tier 5 monsters in the vicinity into fleeing.

This is...it's Tier 6 form?

Immediately, Shi Feng pulled up the Frostflame Dragon's Attribute Panel, wanting to see what was going on.

What perverse Attributes! When Shi Feng saw the Frostflame Dragon's statistics, the Feather of Oath's War Goddesses suddenly seemed lackluster.

[Frostflame Sacred Dragon] (Dragon, Advanced Divine)

Level 212

HP 6,000,000,000,000,000

At their peak, Sacred Dragons were existences that could rival Ancient Gods. Thus, it was wonderful news that the Frostflame Dragon had evolved into a Sacred Dragon. Additionally, the Frostflame Sacred Dragon possessed unbelievably high HP and Defense. Despite being at Level 212, it already had six quadrillion HP, which was only slightly lower than the HP of a Level 230 Legendary monster. Paired with its Sacred Armor Defense, it could probably shrug off the attacks of a Level 230 Legendary monster. Its sturdiness could definitely match Level 220 Divine monsters.

Subsequently, Shi Feng looked at the Ancient Oath in his hand and saw that it had similarly undergone significant changes.

[Ancient Oath]

Can be used to summon an Advanced Divine-ranked Tier 6 Frostflame Sacred Dragon as a partner to fly and fight freely in the sky. If the Frostflame Sacred Dragon dies, it will need 30 natural days to return to life. The Frostflame Sacred Dragon can gain EXP through combat, but it cannot exceed the Ancient Oath's wielder by more than 10 levels.

Additional Effect: The Frostflame Sacred Dragon will share 20% of its Basic Attributes and 30% of its Concentration with the Ancient Oath's wielder.

Crap! A Dragon-type Divine Artifact?! Shi Feng was at a loss for words as he switched his gaze between the Ancient Oath and the Frostflame Sacred Dragon.

It was already a huge surprise that the Frostflame Dragon managed to evolve into a Sacred Dragon. However, the changes to the Ancient Oath were even more astonishing.

System: Congratulations! Your Concentration has exceeded the Tier 6 Limit standard and reached the Pseudo-Tier 7 standard.

System: Congratulations! You are the first player from the human race to have achieved Pseudo-Tier 7 Concentration. Rewarding the Special Skill Mind Gaze.

[Mind Gaze] (Special Skill)

When activated, weakens the target's Concentration by 50%.

Duration: 30 seconds

Cooldown: 3 minutes

With my current strength, I should be able to match Ink Crystal, even without summoning the Frostflame Sacred Dragon. When Shi Feng sensed the changes to his body, he suddenly felt that sixth-floor experts were no longer out of his reach.

With his Pseudo-Tier 7 Concentration, he could now cast the Miniature Abyssal World without struggling. He should also be able to execute Gold Combat Techniques while maintaining the Miniature Abyssal World.

If he paired Gold Combat Techniques with the Miniature Abyssal World, he should have no trouble fighting sixth-floor experts at the same level and Basic Attributes. Not to mention, he also had the Basic Attribute bonus from the Frostflame Sacred Dragon. Now, he was basically a Tier 6 Humanoid Boss. Tier 6 Shield Warriors of the same level were unlikely to have even one-fifth of his HP, while Level 220, Tier 6 experts would need at least three or four Divine Artifacts to match him in Strength.

Moreover, this was before the Frostflame Sacred Dragon gained any additional levels. If the Frostflame Sacred Dragon were ten levels higher than him, a Level 220, Tier 6 expert would need at least five Divine Artifacts to surpass him in Strength.

Just as Shi Feng was about to get a feel for the improvements brought about by the Frostflame Sacred Dragon, his Pseudo-Tier 7 Concentration allowed him to detect a group of players that appeared within 10,000 yards of him.
