Is this the strength of the Holy Seal Cavalier Class?

After saying so, Solitary Mad God snapped his fingers, prompting the battling Ominous Cavalry members to flock to him. Then, he retrieved a golden scroll from his bag.

In Shi Feng's previous life, neither the powers of the human race nor the Holy Race could do anything against the Ominous Cavalry. Besides having multiple sixth-floor experts, another reason for this was that it had a powerful escape tool. The tool was rumored to be a Divine Artifact. If that was indeed the case, unless one had a powerful space-sealing Godly Relic or the ability to one-shot Solitary Mad God, nobody could stop Solitary Mad God from escaping.

"Guild Leader, here are the latest reports on the Guild's income and expansion progress. I've also included reports on the recent state of the war," Blackie said, wearily placing a stack of papers onto Shi Feng's desk.

"This many?" As Shi Feng perused the documents Blackie had prepared, he was reminded of Blackie's managerial talent. Blackie's attention to detail was unquestionably superior to that of combat-oriented Vice Guild Leaders like Hidden Soul and Gentle Snow.

The data Blackie compiled not only listed the Guild's various revenue sources in detail but also provided recommendations for expanding them to allow the Guild to maximize the use of its Eternal Coins. He had also categorized the Guild's newly recruited members so that they could be put into roles that best utilized their talents.

For example, some experts were more adept at using combat techniques, while others were more adept at using Skills and Spells. Even if these experts had similar combat standards, their performances in battle would differ depending on their assigned roles and opponents.

Besides that, Zero Wing managed to attract many fifth-floor experts to join it thanks to the 10,000 Level 235 Taboo Fragmented Legendary Equipment that Shi Feng had obtained from Dragon's Crown. Currently, Zero Wing already had nearly 2,000 fifth-floor experts under its command.

Even before the Tower of the Abyss's appearance, only a few pseudo-apex powers could come up with a force of nearly 2,000 fifth-floor experts. The only problem was that most of Zero Wing's fifth-floor experts were under Level 230. As for those who were Level 230 or above, there were only 106 of them, and they primarily consisted of players from the Greater God's Domain who had entered the Eternal Realm by luck.

All 106 players were fully equipped with Level 235 Taboo Fragmented Legendary Equipment. Paired with the Behemoth Set (a Combat-ranked Secret Treasure Set) and the Intermediate Divine Strengthening Scrolls that Blackie had distributed to them, they could barely match the standards of the various powers' Level 235-plus elite experts.

Currently, excluding the main force members operating in the Flame Dragon God's Nest, these 106 players were the strongest members of Zero Wing. They also played a crucial role in ensuring the development of Zero Wing's members in the World Ark. If not for them, Zero Wing's members would be easy prey for the Holy Race's elite

experts. A few elite experts from the Holy Race would be enough to slaughter a 100-man team of Zero Wing members under Level 230.

Even so, these 106 players could, at most, let 50,000 of Zero Wing's Level 225-plus elite members[1] safely grind in the Taboo Maps around the Blood Curse Resurrection Camp. As for the Guild's more numerous normal and internal members, they had no choice but to fend for themselves. After all, the World Ark's Taboo Maps were limited in size and number. This made competition in these maps extremely intense, making securing even a small leveling spot challenging.

Moreover, it was largely thanks to the Seven Luminaries Alliance, the Red Dragon Nation, and Azure Fang that Zero Wing could have its current leveling spots in the World Ark's core area. Otherwise, Zero Wing would be fortunate if it could even occupy a 10,000-man leveling spot.

However, the biggest change Zero Wing experienced during this period was to its income. Originally, Zero Wing earned at least 300 million units of Seven Luminaries Crystal and 800,000 Eternal Gold daily through Shadowring Town. But now, Shadowring Town wasn't generating even one-third of those amounts, and these numbers were still falling by the day...

"Does Evil Nature's interference have such a huge impact?" Shi Feng was surprised by the sharp drop in the Guild's income.

"Yes, it's affecting us massively," Blackie sighed, nodding. "It might have been fine if it were only Evil Nature harassing us since Evil Nature only has a limited number of elite experts operating in the World Ark. But after Evil Nature constructed its Guild City, it placed a bounty on all players entering and leaving Shadowring Town.

"Evil Nature is rewarding each kill with one Eternal Gold and one merit point. Merit points can be used to redeem items from Evil Nature. The more merit points a player accumulates, the better the items they can redeem. With 1,000 merit points, players can redeem Fragmented Divine Artifacts, Advanced Gold Holy Arts, and even permanent priority access to all of Evil Nature's Guild Towns and Cities.

"This bounty has sparked a frenzy among the Holy Race players in the World Ark. They are targeting every player caught entering or leaving Shadowring Town, including Holy Race players. This situation has scared many players from visiting Shadowring Town. Now, only the experts of powers affiliated with Zero Wing dare to come. If not for Holy Ring City's NPC patrols, those people would have flattened Shadowring Town by now..."

Shi Feng was astonished by this revelation. He never thought that Evil Nature would take things so far.

It would have been nothing had Evil Nature simply placed a bounty on Zero Wing's members. All of Zero Wing's members getting killed once would only cost Evil Nature a few hundred thousand Eternal Gold. It was just that outside experts couldn't enter the Eternal Realm before this, so everyone had more or less the same levels and equipment standards. However, as more outside experts entered the Eternal Realm, Zero Wing's lack of capable experts became more apparent.

The gap in levels and equipment standards between an upstart Guild like Zero Wing and the Greater God's Domain's long-established powers could not be overcome in a short period. It was especially so when it came to high-ranking weapons and equipment. Players had to invest significant time and effort to raid high-level dungeons and complete high-difficulty quests to obtain these items.

Of course, it wasn't impossible for players to obtain high-ranking weapons and equipment quickly. So long as they had the proper connections and enough money, they'd have no trouble obtaining Fragmented Divine Artifacts. This was why powerful lone wolves occasionally appeared among the Greater God's Domain's younger generation.

These lone wolves might not have the backing of a major power, but they came from wealthy families that enabled them to obtain powerful weapons and equipment. If they could find opportunities to hone their combat standards on top of that, they'd quickly become powerhouses in the Greater God's Domain.

The current Zero Wing similarly could quickly let a fifth-floor expert rival Level 230 Ancient Gods in strength. Take the Flame God Set, for example. Any fifth-floor expert who equipped it would instantly become strong enough to beat up even the royal powers' Level 230 Ancient God-ranked experts.

The problem was that Zero Wing could only produce one such expert; it couldn't produce a second one. It also couldn't produce a group of experts that could rival Level 230 Ancient Gods and single-handedly defend its territories in the Eternal Realm.

Fortunately, Zero Wing's situation wasn't completely hopeless. It might not have the years of accumulation needed to produce a group of Level 230 Ancient God-ranked experts, but there was an alternative method it could use.

Craftsman-ranked Lifestyle Players!

When Lifestyle Players achieved the Great Grandmaster rank, any apex power or below would treat them as VIPs. When Lifestyle Players achieved the Craftsman rank, even royal powers would treat them with great care.

The reason for this was simple: Craftsman-ranked Lifestyle Players could make products with heaven-defying effects. These items could even be used to produce powerhouses in batches.

Take Craftsman Forgers, for example. With the requisite designs and materials, they could mass-produce Fragmented Divine Artifacts. They could even produce Divine Artifacts, albeit at a low success rate. This was also the case for Craftsman Alchemists. The Craftsman Strength Potion they produced could increase the user's Strength by 500% for ten minutes. Such a potion could let a Level 235 elite expert beat up even Level 230 Ancient Gods.

Currently, Silent Wonder had already reached the limits of the Great Grandmaster Alchemist rank. With her astonishing talent in alchemy, if she used the Alchemy Door, she would likely achieve a breakthrough and become a Craftsman Alchemist on the spot. At that time, Zero Wing would gain the capability to trade blows with royal powers in the truest sense.

Although there were quite a number of Advanced Craftsman Alchemy Recipes in the Greater God's Domain, players only knew a small portion. While Shi Feng was a little disappointed that the recipe Silent Wonder had learned wasn't for one of the stronger known recipes, so long as Divine Blood wasn't a recovery-type potion, it should greatly help the current Zero Wing.

"This..." Silent Wonder hesitated momentarily, unsure how to word her answer. Ultimately, she simply shared the potion's information with Shi Feng and stated, "I think you'd best look at it yourself, Guild Leader."

[Divine Blood] (Advanced Craftsman Potion)

A potion concocted by the First-Generation Philosopher using Eternal Essence extracted from God Crystals. When consumed, the potion temporarily improves the user's Life Rating and provides an unrestricted 400% increase to all Basic Attributes for 30 seconds.

Cooldown: 5 minutes

An unrestricted increase of 400% to all Basic Attributes?

Divine Blood's introduction stunned Shi Feng, making him wonder if he was hallucinating.

Although there were many berserk-type Skills, potions, and tools in God's Domain, they all came with limitations, such as being effective up to a certain tier. This was why the higher a player's tier, the less frequently they could be seen using berserk-type Skills, potions, and tools. This was especially so for Tier 6 players, and there were two reasons for this.

Firstly, berserk-type Skills, potions, and tools that could affect Tier 6 players were incredibly rare. Even apex powers didn't have access to many of these things.

Secondly, the effectiveness of berserk-type Tier 6 Skills, potions, and tools on the various major powers' top combatants paled in comparison to that of Advanced and Peak Gold Combat Techniques. They might not even have any effect on players fully equipped with Divine Artifacts.

However, Divine Blood did not have such a restriction. It wouldn't be an exaggeration to call the potion heaven-defying.

Additionally, Divine Blood provided an astonishing boost to Basic Attributes. Although it did not provide as large an improvement as specialized potions—such as the Craftsman Strength Potion, which increased the Strength Attribute by 500%—it provided a 400% increase to every Basic Attribute. This was more than what the Abyssal Eye's Tier 7 Abyssal Will Skill provided. Moreover, Divine Blood had a Cooldown of only five minutes.

"How confident are you of producing Divine Blood?" Shi Feng asked, his eyes gleaming with excitement.

If Divine Blood could be mass-produced, it would absolutely rewrite the status quo of the current Greater God's Domain. After all, the potion could instantly turn players fully equipped with just Taboo Fragmented Legendary Equipment into Pseudo-Tier 7 combatants. At just Level 230, a Pseudo-Tier 7 combatant could fight a Level 240 Ancient God-ranked expert.

"The production process is too complex. I doubt I can achieve even a 20% success rate with my current capabilities," Silent Wonder said, shaking her head. "If I can advance to the Craftsman rank, I should be able to raise it to 40%."

"Less than 20%?" Shi Feng wasn't too surprised by Silent Wonder's answer. After thinking for a moment, he continued, "It's a little low, but Divine Blood is too important to ignore, so do your best to produce as many as you can."

"Guild Leader, I'm afraid this will be difficult...," Silent Wonder said, scratching her nose awkwardly as she shared a list of materials with Shi Feng.

Shi Feng frowned when he saw the materials needed to produce Divine Blood.

The cost of producing Divine Blood far exceeded his expectations. Besides about 100 Eternal Gold's worth of secondary materials, Divine Blood also required three God Crystals to produce.

Any player who had delved into the production of items in God's Domain would know that theoretical success rates did not translate to practical success rates. With a success rate of under 20%, Silent Wonder would be fortunate if she could successfully produce Divine Blood once out of ten tries. A more realistic scenario would be one success out of every 20 tries. In other words, it would cost Zero Wing 60 God Crystals and 2,000 Eternal Gold to produce one bottle of Divine Blood.

"Guild Leader, why don't we wait a little longer?" Silent Wonder suggested to Shi Feng when she saw his ugly look. "I've already obtained Divine Blood's recipe. Although it isn't directly related to the potion I am researching. I learned some Craftsman-ranked

production methods from it. I am confident I can become a Craftsman Alchemist within four months. At that time, the cost of producing Divine Blood will go down significantly."

"No need!" Shi Feng shook his head and firmly stated, "You might have learned some production methods, but you still need actual practice to better grasp them. Moreover, four months is too long. I will have Blackie procure the materials you need, so just focus on making the potion."

Zero Wing urgently needed top combatants that could fight Ancient God-ranked experts. Even Shi Feng had to rely on the Threefold Mana Body Technique and Dark Moon to fight Level 230 Ancient God-ranked experts, let alone Level 235-plus Ancient God-ranked experts.

If the production of Divine Blood was delayed by four months, Zero Wing would miss out on many of the Eternal Realm's ancient ruins. Not to mention, Shi Feng didn't have much time left until he needed to kill the Undying Mother. If he could supply every member of a 100-man raid team with a bottle of Divine Blood, the raid's success rate would undoubtedly increase.

As for the God Crystals needed to produce Divine Blood, as long as Zero Wing was willing to pay the price, obtaining a large amount from the various powers wouldn't be impossible.

"Thank you, Guild Leader! I won't disappoint you! I'll try to become a Craftsman Alchemist as soon as possible!" Silent Wonder grew ecstatic at Shi Feng's words.

As Shi Feng stated, theoretical studies weren't enough for an alchemist to improve; practice was also necessary. The only problem was that this practice came with an exorbitant price tag. Typically, Guilds would only procure production methods for their alchemists to study. At most, they would grant their alchemists some materials to practice these production methods a few times. Never would they give their alchemists a blank check to practice production methods.

After Shi Feng instructed Blackie to assist Silent Wonder in producing Divine Blood at all costs, he started to learn how to produce the Advanced Divine Enhancement Scroll.

Divine Blood might be a terrifyingly powerful trump card, but it only had a 30-second duration. It was only suitable for critical situations and could not be used to fight other powers over a long period. In contrast, although Divine Engraving Scrolls did not provide as significant an improvement as Divine Blood, they could provide players with long-term improvements. In the case of the Advanced Divine Enhancement Scroll, it could be used to strengthen the Basic Attributes of Legendary Equipment permanently.

So long as he could mass-produce the Advanced Divine Enhancement Scroll, it would ease Zero Wing's equipment problem. After all, Legendary Equipment was much more readily available than Fragmented Divine Artifacts.

With my Concentration at the Pseudo-Tier 7 standard, if I use the Threefold Mana Body Technique to improve my control over mana, I should be able to learn how to produce the Advanced Divine Enhancement Scroll, Shi Feng thought as he stared at the Advanced Divine Enhancement Engraving's Legacy recorded in the Book of Eternity. Then, he clicked to learn the Legacy.

Did I make a mistake in the solidification process? But I engraved the nine divine patterns perfectly, so why can't I solidify them? Shi Feng couldn't help but hesitate as he watched the scroll in his hands turn to ash. Should I make another learning attempt?

The cost of learning the Book of Eternity's Legacies increased with the rank of the divine engravings he chose. Starting from the bottom, learning a Basic Divine Engraving cost only five God Crystals. However, it cost 50 God Crystals to learn an Intermediate Divine Engraving and 500 God Crystals to learn an Advanced Divine Engraving. For the sake of learning the Advanced Divine Enhancement Engraving, he had spent 500 Eternal God Crystals.

Eternal God Crystals were much more precious than ordinary God Crystals. They also had many more uses than ordinary God Crystals. If not for Zero Wing lacking ordinary God Crystals, he would never have used Eternal God Crystals as a replacement. After all, Zero Wing's stockpile of Eternal God Crystals had already fallen below 10,000, and he had no way of replenishing it. Unlike ordinary God Crystals, Eternal God Crystals could not be obtained from ruins and Taboo Dungeons. It was also unlikely he would come across a treasure trove like the Nameless City's treasury.

Just one more time. If I still can't find the reason, I will give up and try again when my Concentration is stronger or my control over mana has improved.

After thinking it over, Shi Feng bit the bullet and spent another 500 Eternal God Crystals to learn the Advanced Divine Enhancement Engraving. However, he swore this would be his last attempt at learning it.

Although Zero Wing could use some Advanced Divine Enhancement Scrolls in its current situation, they weren't a necessity, merely icing on the cake.

Legendary Equipment might be much more readily available than Fragmented Divine Artifacts, but the rarity of Taboo Legendary Equipment was no less than that of Fragmented Divine Artifacts. In the case of Level 240 Taboo Legendary Equipment, its availability was just slightly higher than that of Fragmented Divine Artifacts. When it came to the Eternal Realm, there were probably more players equipped with Fragmented Divine Artifacts than players equipped with Taboo Legendary Equipment.

In other words, even if he could produce the Advanced Divine Enhancement Scroll, it wouldn't help Zero Wing by much. Rather than Taboo Legendary Equipment, the Advanced Divine Enhancement Scrolls produced would likely be used to enhance Zero Wing's Taboo Fragmented Legendary Equipment. However, while the Advanced Divine Enhancement Scroll could provide a greater improvement than the Intermediate Divine Enhancement Scroll, it wasn't enough to let Zero Wing's elite experts match the various apex and royal powers' elite experts in Basic Attributes.

Hence, rather than waste Eternal God Crystals on trying to learn the Advanced Divine Enhancement Engraving, it would be more worthwhile to use them to produce Divine Blood.

After Shi Feng chose to learn the Advanced Divine Enhancement Engraving again, the Book of Eternity released a colorful brilliance, giving him another mental demonstration of the Advanced Divine Enhancement Engraving's inscription process.

Like before, the demonstration started with the Structural Analysis of nine divine patterns, followed by the Structural Remodeling of the magic elements' operations. Once the Structural Remodeling of all nine divine patterns was complete, they were quickly put through Structural Solidification. When the nine divine patterns were remodeled and solidified, the mana structure they created attracted far more mana than the Intermediate Divine Enhancement Engraving.

Is it because my Concentration is lacking?

Instead, the demonstrator took an easier approach, dividing each divine pattern into multiple parts and remodeling these parts simultaneously. While not as fast as remodeling nine divine patterns simultaneously, this approach greatly accelerated the remodeling process of each divine pattern.

Success! Shi Feng grew ecstatic when he saw the system notifications.

The system rewards were nothing significant. The Advanced Divine Engraver's Insignia only halved his Concentration expenditure when producing divine engravings, while the

level reward only increased his level from 231 to 232. However, his success in producing the Advanced Divine Enhancement Scroll meant that Zero Wing now had the capital to purchase God Crystals in bulk.

For the Greater God's Domain's various powers, the Intermediate Divine Enhancement Scroll was only useful for improving the strength of their upper-middle-level combatants. It might help the various powers improve their overall strength considerably, but it wouldn't be much help in changing their standings in the Greater God's Domain. This was because the various powers primarily relied on their top-level combatants to compete with one another.

However, it was a different story for the Advanced Divine Enhancement Scroll, which could improve the Basic Attributes of Legendary Equipment by 50%.

Once a piece of Taboo Legendary Equipment was enhanced by the Advanced Divine Enhancement Scroll, its Basic Attributes could rival that of Fragmented Divine Artifacts. With Fragmented Divine Artifacts being available in very limited numbers in the current Greater God's Domain, a batch of Advanced Divine Enhancement Scrolls could let the various powers gain many new top-level combatants.

The attraction of top-level combatants to the various powers far exceeded that of Eternal Coins. Even if Shi Feng had the Abyss Chamber of Commerce charge God Crystals for Advanced Divine Enhancement Scrolls, the various powers would be more than willing to pay the price.

After thinking up to this point, Shi Feng promptly began mass-producing Advanced Divine Enhancement Scrolls.

After completing about a dozen Advanced Divine Enhancement Scrolls, Shi Feng decided to sell them through the Abyss Chamber of Commerce to test the waters. However, before he could do so, Blackie suddenly contacted him.

"Guild Leader, the bastards from the Ominous Cavalry attacked one of our leveling teams in the core area's Frost Shadow Forest!" Blackie reported grimly. "By the time Vice Guild Leader Frey arrived, over half of the team had been killed. Among them, about 60% are elite members who have just reached Level 220. Most of them are only equipped with Level 220 Epic and Fragmented Legendary Equipment, so they have likely suffered a true death..."

"Do you know where the Ominous Cavalry's members are right now?" Shi Feng's expression became indescribably cold when he heard Blackie's report.

Anyone who could become an elite member of Zero Wing was a guild member who had made significant contributions and possessed great talent and strength. They had

trouble displaying their strength only because their levels and equipment standards lagged behind those of experts of pseudo-apex powers and above. Had they joined a major power instead of Zero Wing, they would have become elite experts by now.

These players were willing to stay in Zero Wing because they believed in the Guild's future. Yet, they got bullied by an adventurer team like the Ominous Cavalry.

This time, the Ominous Cavalry had truly angered Shi Feng.

As for Lakelight Mirror, Firmament's second strongest Profound Skill, it similarly required 1,000 players to execute. However, each activation cost 500 God Crystals or Holy Origin Crystals and 50 million units of Seven Luminaries Crystal or Holy Power Crystal.

As for Celestial Guidance, Firmament's strongest Profound Skill, not only did it require 3,000 players to execute, but it also cost 3,000 God Crystals or Holy Origin Crystals and 200 million units of Seven Luminaries Crystal or Holy Power Crystal per activation.

Simply put, every one of Firmament's attacks cost a fortune. Using it was simply beyond the means of the average power. If not for Zero Wing having nearly 10,000 Eternal God Crystals in its warehouse, Shi Feng would never have dared to deploy Firmament.
