[Myriad Doppelgangers] (Action-type)

Pseudo-Tier 7 Taboo Skill

Create up to 10,000 true doppelgangers. The more true doppelgangers are created, the less Strength each doppelganger will receive. If three or fewer doppelgangers are created, each will receive 100% of the user's Strength.

Duration: 5 minutes

Cooldown: 6 hours

*A Pseudo-Tier 7 Taboo Skill?* Shi Feng couldn't believe his eyes when he saw Myriad Doppelgangers' introduction.



The fact that the Undying Mother had dropped a super-ancient design was already mind-blowing. He never expected it to drop a Pseudo-Tier 7 Taboo Skill as well. A Pseudo-Tier 7 Taboo Skill could rival bona fide Tier 7 Skills. Apart from relying on weapons and equipment that came with Tier 7 Skills, players could only access Tier 7 Skills by learning them after reaching Tier 7.

Additionally, it was a Doppelganger Skill with true doppelgangers, which meant that the player would never die so long as even one doppelganger remained alive. Myriad Doppelgangers also allowed its user to create up to 10,000 true doppelgangers. Even if creating so many doppelgangers would result in them coming out much weaker than the main body, it was still a heaven-defying ability. Myriad Doppelgangers could already be considered an Immortality Skill.

After Shi Feng chose to learn Myriad Doppelgangers, he had Blackie come and collect the Light of Dawn Design and Mutant's Blood. He tasked Blackie with assigning trustworthy Great Grandmaster Engineers to secretly produce Lights of Dawn. As for the Mutant's Blood, it was to be handed to Purgatory Jade and Umbra Talon to complete their transaction.

Level 254!

He had never seen or heard of such a level in any of his lives.

Past Level 200, monsters would gain a significant increase in Basic Attributes with each level-up. A Level 254 monster, even if it was only an ordinary Tier 6 Divine monster, would have Basic Attributes rivaling that of the Level 245 Undying Mother. Needless to say, a Level 254 Superior Divine-ranked Chaos Creature would have much higher Basic Attributes.

Before Shi Feng could turn around to leave, the Chaos Crocodile let out a deafening roar. Immediately afterward, a surge of World Power descended upon him, sending him stumbling.

*What a powerful suppression! Even with Miniature Abyssal World active, my Basic Attributes still got suppressed by 20%! Is this a true World's suppressive effect?* Shi Feng was astonished when he saw the drop in his Basic Attributes.

After his Concentration and Mana had reached the Pseudo-Tier 7 standard, his Primordial God-ranked Law Projection could let him come out with a small advantage, even against the Undying Mother's unique Law Domain.

Yet, despite being at Tier 6 like the Undying Mother, the Chaos Crocodile could overwhelm his Miniature Abyssal World and suppress his Basic Attributes by 20%. He dared not imagine how an Advanced Law Projection would fare against the Chaos Crocodile's World.

Upon realizing the disparity in strength, Shi Feng summoned several hundred true doppelgangers using Myriad Doppelgangers and fled in all directions without hesitation.

Even if he used his last bottle of Divine Blood, he dared not say he could beat the Level 254 Chaos Crocodile in Basic Attributes. Moreover, that was assuming his Basic Attributes weren't suppressed by 20%. With his Basic Attributes suppressed, he'd be asking for an early death if he tried to fight the Chaos Crocodile head-on. All he could do in this situation was run away.

However, the moment Shi Feng's true doppelgangers turned to flee, the Chaos Crocodile also took action.

All the Chaos Crocodile did was raise and lower one of its mountainous claws. Immediately afterward, the ground around it began to sink, and over half of Shi Feng's true doppelgangers were reduced to dust in a few breaths...

*Did it use a Pseudo-Tier 7 Skill?*

After Shi Feng ran a thousand yards away, he finally sensed stable ground underfoot. When he turned back and saw the collapsed ground behind him, a shiver ran down his spine.

The suppression the Promotion Land imposed on its inhabitants was much stronger than that of the Eternal Realm. Even as a Tier 6 player equipped with the Flame God Set, Shi Feng could only exhibit speed and destructive power equivalent to those of a Tier 3 player in his home God's Domain. Under such circumstances, a Tier 6 Skill's effective range would be a radius of two hundred yards, at most. For a Skill to affect a 1,000-yard radius in this Promotion Land, it had to be at the Pseudo-Tier 7 standard.

At this discovery, Shi Feng was glad he decided to flee. Even if he were to use Divine Blood and Absolute Thunder, he doubted he could last long against a Level 254 Chaos Creature capable of using Pseudo-Tier 7 Skills.

Then, he took out the three World Sources he had redeemed from Enos.

Even the Divine Set users he had met thus far would have a high chance of dying if they encountered one of these Chaos Creatures.

When Shi Feng noticed this change, he promptly used an Appraisal Skill on the Feather of Oath.

[Feather of Oath] (Divine Artifact)

An item worn by the Goddess of Space. It is a treasure created using the souls of twelve heroes from before the Great Destruction. Although the Feather of Oath suffered serious damage during a fight against three Holy Ancestors, it is now repaired.

#### Additional Skill 1-

War Goddess Summoning: For every 1,000,000 units of Seven Luminaries Crystal expended, summon one War Goddess of the same tier but no more than twenty levels higher. (The summoned War Goddesses can reach up to Tier 6 and come equipped with Divine Artifact-ranked Equipment Sets.) Every War Goddess summoned will last six hours. Up to twelve War Goddesses can be summoned at the same time. No incantations required. No Cooldown.

#### Additional Skill 2-

Heroic Pledge: Expend ten God Crystals to double a War Goddess's Basic Attributes. (No limit.)

Duration: 30 minutes

Cooldown: 6 hours

#### Additional Skill 3-

Goddess Battle Array: Expend 100 God Crystals to have twelve War Goddesses form a Large Advanced Gold Battle Array.

Duration: 30 minutes

Cooldown: 6 hours

*Amazing!* Excitement shone in Shi Feng's eyes as he looked at the fully repaired Feather of Oath.

Although the cost of using the complete Feather of Oath was much higher, its three Skills had improved qualitatively. Now, the equipment of the War Goddesses he summoned would no longer be random. Instead, all War Goddesses would come equipped with a Divine Set. This improvement was much greater than if a player switched from a full set of Divine Artifacts to a Divine Set.

In God's Domain, the hidden level limit of Divine Artifacts for players was Level 240. However, that was not the case for NPCs. This was also why Holy Cities guarded by Level 240-plus NPCs were incredibly difficult to capture.

After all, if a player and an NPC fully equipped with Divine Artifacts were to reach Level 243, the player's equipment would stop at Level 240, while the NPC's equipment would grow to Level 243. This meant the Level 243 NPC would receive more Basic Attributes from his equipment than the Level 243 player. To make matters worse, NPCs inherently had more Basic Attributes than players. This disparity in equipment level only served to widen the gap in Basic Attributes between players and NPCs.

Now that he was Level 239, he could summon Level 259 War Goddesses, and he could summon up to 12 at a time.

If he were to encounter the Chaos Crocodile again, he felt that he might even be able to kill it, let alone keep it pinned.

*This Promotion Land is absurdly massive. It's almost as large as the average God's Domain. I didn't think it would take a day of travel just to reach the Promotion Land's core area. Hopefully, there is a powerful Chaos Creature whose World suits me, Shi Feng thought, glancing at the fleeing Chaos Frostwolf before quickly shifting his focus to a distant mountain range.*



After repairing the Feather of Oath, Shi Feng felt that completing his Tier 7 promotion with just an ordinary Chaos Creature's World would be a waste. Hence, he decided to aim for the powerful Chaos Creatures residing in the Promotion Land's core area.

According to the colossal phantom, the stronger the Chaos Creature, the stronger their World would be. Going by this logic, when players were advancing to Tier 7, the stronger the World they created for themselves, the stronger they would be at Tier 7.

With the Level 259 War Goddesses being able to easily suppress ordinary Chaos Creatures, Shi Feng would have a much easier time completing his Tier 7 promotion if he only targeted ordinary Chaos Creatures. But in that case, should he encounter other Tier 7 players in the future, he wouldn't have any obvious advantages over them.

On the other hand, if he were to replicate a powerful Chaos Creature's World, he would be able to manipulate a lot more World Power. This would give him an advantage over the average Tier 7 player.

Not to mention, he had already constructed the Miniature Abyssal World. Thanks to it, he could fight Mortal Gods despite not being a Mortal God himself. It would be a shame if he couldn't maintain such an advantage once he reached Tier 7. Moreover, now that he had a chance to create a stronger World, he naturally had to try it.

As for the four top-tier Chaos Creatures, Shi Feng dared not set his sights on them.

According to the Grand Library's records, the average Chaos Creature already had the strength to give Primordial Gods a headache, while powerful Chaos Creatures were as strong as the average Primordial God. Even with the Feather of Oath, Shi Feng doubted a Tier 6 player like himself could last long enough to steal a top-tier Chaos Creature's strength and replicate its World.

Shi Feng felt death descending upon him at this scene. He activated Heroic Pledge almost instinctively, doubling the Basic Attributes of the shield-wielding War Goddess leading the charge.

The shield-wielding War Goddess in question also understood that the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's attack was not to be trifled with. Without hesitation, she planted her golden shield into the ground, erecting nine World Barriers between her and the lightning bolt.

Pseudo-Tier 7 Profound Skill, World's Protection!

This was the Profound Skill of the shield-wielding War Goddess's Divine Set. It was also the strongest Defensive Skill in her arsenal.

*Boom!*

The instant the pitch-black lightning bolt made contact with the World Barriers, six of them vaporized, while the remaining three World Barriers cracked and shattered one after another. The pitch-black lightning bolt only disappeared after colliding with the golden shield, forcing the shield-wielding War Goddess back several steps, and reaping over 10% of her HP.

*How strong! Is this the strength brought about by an Advanced World's enhancement?* Shi Feng was shocked to see the shield-wielding War Goddess lose over 10% HP.

Under the effects of Heroic Pledge, the shield-wielding War Goddess's Basic Attributes could rival those of Primordial Gods of the same level. Nonetheless, she lost so much HP despite using a Pseudo-Tier 7 Profound Skill.

A War Goddess's HP was several dozen times higher than that of players of the same level. An attack that could cause a War Goddess to lose even 10% HP would be enough to kill a player of the same level several times over.

The average powerful Chaos Creature definitely couldn't exhibit such power, even with a Pseudo-Tier 7 Skill. The only explanation was that the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's roar was enhanced by the World Power of its Advanced World, making the lightning bolt, which resulted from the roar, difficult for the shield-wielding War Goddess to neutralize.

As Shi Feng marveled at the might of an Advanced World, the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon—dissatisfied with the outcome of its attack—reared all three of its remaining heads to launch a much stronger attack.

*Dammit!* When Shi Feng saw the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon preparing to launch a similar attack, he promptly took out the Taboo Nucleus and injected 100 God Crystals into the Feather of Oath. *Don't even think you can kill me off so easily!*

Shi Feng targeted the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon with the Taboo Nucleus, using it to absorb the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's strength. Although doing so would anger the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon even more, he could weaken the Chaos Creature to a certain extent.

Additionally, he expended the 100 God Crystals he had just injected into the Feather of Oath to activate the Goddess Battle Array. This caused golden divine runes to light up all over the 12 War Goddesses, and their auras, in turn, surged in power. Now, even the other 11 War Goddesses exuded auras rivaling that of the shield-wielding War Goddess.

Subsequently, with the shield-wielding War Goddess as the center, the 12 War Goddesses executed a combination technique, which was also the strongest combat technique the Goddess of Space had granted them.

God-Slaying Spear!

Although this combination technique could be executed with just six War Goddesses, completing it required some time. However, when executed by 12 War Goddesses, no preparation was required; it could be launched straight away.

Immediately, a 5,000-meter-tall phantom of the Goddess of Space appeared on the battlefield and cast the golden spear in its hand at the roaring Five-Headed Chaos Dragon.

*Bang!*

The pitch-black lightning bolt created by the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's threefold roar exploded on contact with the golden spear. Numerous spatial tears appeared around the epicenter of the explosion.

*Good! I still have a chance!* Shi Feng was overjoyed when he saw the War Goddesses neutralizing the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's attack.

The Taboo Nucleus required time to absorb the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's strength. Although he didn't know how long this process would take, it definitely wouldn't be short. Hence, if, even after activating both Heroic Pledge and the Goddess Battle Array, the War Goddesses couldn't neutralize the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's attacks, he would have had no choice but to retreat.

I won't let you have my strength, even with the Primordial Abyssal God helping you!"

After saying so, the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon flew toward Shi Feng, the movement of its wings collapsing the space within a 3,000-yard radius.

Without hesitation, the 12 War Goddesses took to the skies to intercept the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon. However, their Basic Attributes plummeted as soon as they were within 3,000 yards of the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon, and all the benefits they received from the Goddess Battle Array were negated in the blink of an eye. Only the shield-wielding War Goddess could barely rival Primordial Gods of the same level.

*Even if you have an Advanced World, I won't fall so easily!* As Shi Feng watched the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon getting closer, he took out the Phantom Crystal and summoned Kalisha's phantom.

As Shi Feng crushed Kalisha's Phantom Crystal, a phantom doppelganger 10,000 meters in height descended upon the Northern Plain.

*Ten thousand meters?* Shi Feng couldn't believe his eyes when he saw Kalisha's towering phantom.

The suppression the Primordial Abyssal God's Promotion Land exerted on its inhabitants was the strongest Shi Feng had ever seen. Even powerful Chaos Creatures that could challenge Primordial Gods of the same level had their heights reduced to under 3,000 meters.

Although the size of NPCs and monsters didn't fully correlate with their strength, it could indicate their energy standards.

A 10,000-meter-tall phantom!

If speaking purely in mana standards, Kalisha's phantom was much stronger than even the 12 War Goddesses when enhanced by Heroic Pledge and the Goddess Battle Array. This situation was simply unbelievable.

Although Kalisha, the Dragon Princess, was regarded as one of the ten strongest NPCs in the human race's Greater God's Domain in his previous life, she only rivaled Primordial Gods of the same level. Not to mention, while he might have helped Kalisha recover her strength in this life, her phantom should only hold a small portion of her strength. The phantom shouldn't be anywhere close to matching Kalisha herself.

Despite that, Kalisha's phantom was already stronger than even the Goddess phantom the War Goddesses conjured when they executed the God-Slaying Spear Technique. Shi Feng dared not imagine how strong Kalisha was right now.



Kalisha's gigantic phantom similarly frightened the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon.

The Five-Headed Chaos Dragon, with its height of over 2,000 meters, could already be considered massive. Shi Feng would appear smaller than an ant if he were to stand before it. Nonetheless, the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon was nothing more than a slightly larger lizard before Kalisha's phantom.

"You came to that old fellow's territory to conduct your promotion? It seems I've underestimated you before," Kalisha said, glancing at her surroundings before looking at Shi Feng in surprise. She completely ignored the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon before her.

"I got lucky. I happened to complete a commission and earned the opportunity to come here," Shi Feng explained in response to Kalisha's praise.

"Is that your target?" Kalisha finally turned to look at the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon before her. Then, she said with a nod, "Not bad. It has already grasped an Advanced World despite having yet to reach adulthood. At this rate, it might be able to crown itself as a king among Chaos Creatures once it reaches adulthood."

"Can you stop it from attacking me for 90 seconds?" Shi Feng asked worriedly when he heard Kalisha's evaluation of the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon.

A king among Chaos Creatures!

This was a top existence among Chaos Creatures. Even the Primordial Abyssal God should have difficulty dealing with such an opponent. Seeing as Kalisha had given the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon such a high evaluation, it likely hadn't revealed its true strength thus far.

"Ninety seconds?" Kalisha glanced at the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon that was opening its three mouths once more. Without hesitation, she answered, "That won't be difficult."

After saying so, Kalisha's phantom raised its hand and erased all light within a 10,000-yard radius. At the same time, the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Basic Attributes plummeted to just 70% of their original values in the blink of an eye. Immediately afterward, the phantom lowered its hand, creating a dark ripple that neutralized the three pitch-black lightning bolts the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's roars created.

Meanwhile, the 12 War Goddesses seemed to have been freed from their restraints as they recovered their Basic Attributes. Because of this shift in circumstances, the War Goddesses' Basic Attributes exceeded that of the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon by a slight margin. Now, even without the intervention of Kalisha's phantom, the 12 War Goddesses could keep the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon from Shi Feng.

Subsequently, time passed rapidly as the Taboo Nucleus absorbed the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's strength.

Eighty seconds... Sixty seconds... Thirty seconds...

Even as the Taboo Nucleus absorbed the last vestiges of its strength, the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon never managed to touch Shi Feng. Despite its frustration, the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon ultimately transformed into light particles and disappeared from the Promotion Land.

System: Congratulations! Your Taboo Nucleus has absorbed the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's strength. Do you wish to receive the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's World Structure?

System: You have ten minutes to decide. Once you accept the World Structure, you will have one natural day to replicate it before it automatically disappears. The higher the fusion rate, the more World Power you can access after you complete your promotion.

System: If you cannot finish replicating it in one natural day, or if your fusion rate fails to reach 70%, you will fail your promotion, and you will not be able to receive the power of a Taboo Nucleus again for one year.

*A fusion rate of 70%? Shi Feng smiled wryly as he read the system notifications. No wonder nobody from the three races ever managed to reach Tier 7. This requirement is simply ridiculous.*

Shi Feng was pleasantly surprised when he saw he was given a one-day time limit to replicate the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World. However, when he saw the requirement of a 70% fusion rate, he felt like someone had just poured a bucket of cold water over him.

The process of constructing an unfamiliar World using unfamiliar World Laws was already a huge undertaking in itself. However, the Tier 7 promotion required him to replicate the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World and ensure its compatibility. In other words, he'd have to make modifications to the replicated Advanced World. This was a fatal requirement for someone who couldn't even construct a World of his own.

After all, he could modify a World from countless aspects. How was he supposed to know which modifications, or combination of modifications, would make the Advanced World more compatible with him?

“How lucky of you to obtain something as good as the Abyssal Fruit!” When Kalisha saw Shi Feng’s indecision, a look of vexation appeared on her phantom. “With the Abyssal Fruit, your chances of making that step are drastically higher than others, so stop hesitating and wasting time.”

“The Abyssal Fruit?” At Kalisha’s exasperated remark, Shi Feng grabbed the Abyssal Fruit from his bag and ate it whole, wondering what effects it would bring him.

Although he had previously inspected the Abyssal Fruit, its introduction only stated that it was an Abyssal Relic and nothing else. Hence, he had left it sitting in his bag.

Now that the Taboo Nucleus had finished absorbing the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon’s strength, it was the right time to use the Abyssal Fruit.

Three seconds after Shi Feng consumed the Abyssal Fruit, he sensed immense power welling up within his body and condensing in the depths of his mind. Then, it augmented his Concentration at a frightening rate.

Ten seconds later, Shi Feng felt he had broken through some kind of restraint. Originally, his perception only extended 1,000 yards away. Now, he could perceive everything within a 100,000-yard radius.

*Tier 7 Concentration?!*

Shi Feng was shocked by this sudden transformation.

Out of all Attributes in God’s Domain, Concentration was the most difficult to raise. Even after reaching Tier 6, many players’ Concentration would still be stuck at the Tier 5 standard. Most Tier 6 players would have to undergo a long development period before their Concentration could advance from Tier 5 to Tier 6. This showed just how difficult it was to develop one’s Concentration.

Although Shi Feng’s Concentration was previously at the Pseudo-Tier 7 standard, it had still been a far cry from the Tier 7 standard. He had even considered slowly developing his Concentration to the Tier 7 standard after completing his Tier 7 promotion.

But now, the Abyssal Fruit had propelled his Concentration to the Tier 7 standard.

## Chapter 1014 – 96% Fusion Rate

System: Congratulations! Your Concentration has reached the Tier 7 standard. Rewarding Level +1 and 100 Free Legacy Skill Points.

Following the system notification, a purple-gold light enveloped Shi Feng as his level increased from 239 to 240.

However, this supposedly monumental achievement did not draw Shi Feng's attention, as he focused entirely on his mental state.

*Are these the benefits of having Tier 7 Concentration?*

Shi Feng had difficulty believing the changes brought about by the improvement of his Concentration.

His perception range increasing from 1,000 yards to 100,000 yards in the Primordial Abyssal God's Promotion Land was only the tip of the iceberg. Compared to the improvements to his control over mana, the improvement to his perception was insignificant.

With a flick of his wrist, Shi Feng controlled the mana within a 100,000-yard radius as if it were an extension of himself, creating seven mana vortices in the blink of an eye. Each of these mana vortices gathered one of the seven magic elements—earth, water, wind, fire, time, illusion, and space—as they orbited him, eventually forming seven independent Law Projections.

With another flick of his wrist, Shi Feng merged all seven magic elements to create a Miniature Abyssal World that covered a 100,000-yard radius. Immediately, all the Chaos Creatures drawn by his fight with the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon and caught within his Miniature Abyssal World were heavily suppressed, their Basic Attributes reduced by 50% or more.

*No wonder Enos can promise to double my chances of getting promoted. With such incredible mana control, I can probably create a World from scratch if given enough time, let alone replicate a Chaos Creature's World.* When Shi Feng saw how effortlessly he had constructed the Miniature Abyssal World, he suddenly understood why Enos had placed so much faith in the Abyssal Fruit.

Even the difference between Tier 7 Concentration and Pseudo-Tier 7 Concentration was utterly staggering, let alone between Tier 7 Concentration and Tier 6 Limit Concentration. It wouldn't be an exaggeration to say they were entirely different things.

If he still needed to use his hands before to manipulate magic elements, those magic elements were now his hands; he could move them with just a thought.

With such incredible mana control, he could have these magic elements reproduce World Laws as easily as having his body perform various actions. Compared to before, when it felt like he was manipulating a puppet with strings, the difficulty was drastically lower.

After Shi Feng familiarized himself with his improved Concentration, he promptly accepted the World Structure of the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World.

*This place is too close to the core area. I should find a safer place to study the World Structure.* When Shi Feng sensed over a dozen Chaos Creatures within 100,000 yards of him, he promptly traveled to the Promotion Land's outer area with the War Goddesses and Kalisha's phantom.

With Kalisha's phantom dealing with the Chaos Creatures in their way and the War Goddesses protecting him, Shi Feng arrived at the outer area in less than two hours. Then, he found a safe location and studied the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World.

*As expected of an Advanced World. Its complexity is truly astounding. If my Concentration hadn't reached the Tier 7 standard, I might not be able to replicate even 30% of it in a year.*

After spending half an hour accepting all the information recorded in the Taboo Nucleus, Shi Feng better understood how difficult it was to reach Tier 7.

Although he had known that constructing a World would be difficult, only after seeing the World Structure of the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World did he understand why he had never heard of any player from the human race's Greater God's Domain successfully advancing to Tier 7.

The Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World comprised 1,000 Basic Laws and 36 Advanced Laws centered around the Law of Destruction. These World Laws intertwined and operated around one another, and only when all of them were positioned correctly could they form a complete World.

In the human race's Greater God's Domain, most Tier 6 players would be fortunate if they could even replicate a Basic Law and get it to function properly. As for experts among Tier 6 players, they struggled to even get an Advanced Law to function properly.

Yet, to construct a World, players needed to simultaneously operate over a thousand World Laws, some of which were Advanced Laws. Even Mortal Gods capable of Manifold Execution would likely find it impossible to accomplish such a feat.

*Although the difficulty is high, I should be able to replicate the Advanced World with my Tier 7 Concentration. The only problem now is modifying it.*

After taking a deep breath, Shi Feng began his first attempt at replicating the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World.

The real challenge in constructing a World was establishing a functioning framework of World Laws, also known as a World Structure. In a situation where he already had a functioning World Structure, he could simply copy it as if copying a magic array and skip this challenging step entirely.

As Shi Feng expected, his Tier 7 Concentration allowed him to fully reconstruct the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World in under three hours. It even operated normally, albeit with some minor problems here and there.

Finally, 28 hours after Shi Feng accepted the World Structure of the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World, he achieved a 69% Fusion Rate. He was just 1% short of meeting the requirement to advance to Tier 7.

*Sure enough, the system won't let me achieve a 70% Fusion Rate simply by making a perfect copy.* Shi Feng frowned when he saw no more imperfections in the Advanced World he had constructed within his Divine Body.

With his Tier 7 Concentration, perfectly replicating the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World was simple. Even so, this simple task had taken him over 20 hours to complete. As there were only 48 hours in one natural day in God's Domain, he had just 20 hours to modify the Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World and increase its compatibility with him...

The Five-Headed Chaos Dragon's Advanced World had 1,000 Basic Laws that could be altered in various ways. Even if he made only one modification to each of these Basic Laws, he would end up with a thousand different combinations. If he were to try every possible combination, it could take him years to find the right one.

*With the time I have left, going down the less volatile route of modifying Basic Laws is out of the question. If I want to increase the compatibility of this Advanced World quickly, modifying its Advanced Laws that serve as its core should be the way to go.* After mentally glancing at the miniature world he had created within his Divine Body, Shi Feng gritted his teeth and decided to modify the Advanced World's Advanced Laws.

On his first attempt, Shi Feng modified the position of only one Advanced Law. Nonetheless, the change had destabilized the World Structure so much that the Advanced World collapsed on the spot...

Modifying the Advanced World's World Structure was much more challenging than he expected. He only succeeded in producing two stable World Structures out of his 4,345 attempts. System: Congratulations! Your replicated Advanced World has achieved a 96% Fusion Rate. You have met the requirement for fusion. Do you wish to proceed with the fusion?
