It had only been a short while since Ye Tian's name disappeared from the list. Could there have been some sort of problem?



The spirit shook its head. "The War God Tower doesn't deal in points, but whether someone is willing to transfer points to you depends on your abilities."


Ye Tian realized that this meant the transaction of points happened privately and was unrelated to the War God Tower.
