First, Shi Feng had tanked a Level 44 Lord. Now, Shi Feng swiftly defeated a Level 43 Special Elite by himself. Both the Swordsman's combat techniques and his Basic Attributes were far more powerful than his own.

With such a powerful DPS player like Shi Feng in the party, they could clear out the Crystal Giants and Crystal Wolves far faster.

In less than half an hour, the Giants and Wolves inside the cave had died, leaving behind all sorts of weapons, equipment, and materials.

Players could use Mounts once they reached Level 40. At that time, she would not have to waste so much time running about. She could also explore new places, reducing her competition over resources.

The other party members also received a huge boost to their EXP bars. Their leveling speed here was at least two or three times faster than their usual leveling speed.

To Shi Feng, however, the EXP he obtained from killing the Crystal Giants and Crystal Wolves was not nearly enough.

He was Level 39 already. Moreover, he required double the normal EXP to level up. The EXP these Special Elites and Common monsters provided barely moved his EXP bar.

"Huh? There's a Skill Book here!" Death Wind stated when he noticed a thick, glowing golden book on the ground. Picking it up, he exclaimed, "A Berserk Skill Book! We've hit the jackpot!"

The main method to learn Skills in God's Domain was by visiting NPC instructors; players also learned Skills by purchasing them with Legacy Skill Points or obtaining Skill Books.

The Skills that instructors offered were general. Their strength was also subpar at best. However, one could learn a large variety of Skills with this method.

Meanwhile, although the Skills one purchased with Legacy Points were very powerful, it was extremely difficult to obtain Legacy Points. Normally, players only obtained them by leveling up.

As for Skills learned from Skill Books, they were generally quite powerful. Some were even stronger than Legacy Skills.

In the current God's Domain, a player's strength did not only depend on weapons and equipment. Skills were very important as well. It was especially true for Berserk Skills.

If an elite player learned a Berserk Skill, they could contend with expert players; they might even be able to defeat them.

If an expert player learned a Berserk Skill, they could defeat top-tier experts who lacked their own Berserk Skill. They could also hold off a Lord ranked monster of the same Level for a short time. Hence, Berserk Skills were incredibly valuable in God's Domain.

Unfortunately, Berserk Skills were even rarer than top-tier Dark-Gold Equipment.

On the market, a single Berserk Skill Book could cost several hundred Gold. This fascinated countless players. If they could obtain an extremely powerful Berserk Skill, they could easily sell it for hundreds of Gold to a large Guild.

However, players were rarely willing to sell their Berserk Skills.

Even now, the powerful Wind God's Spear only had two players with Berserk Skills.

"Big Brother Wind, what kind of Berserk Skill is it?" Blue Bamboo asked, her eyes practically glowing. "Is it for magical classes?"

When the others heard this, they glanced at the golden Skill Book as well. They were all curious about the Skill Book.

"It's a melee class Berserk Skill called War Spirit Possession," Death Wind said. He then displayed the Skill's introduction to the party chat.

[War Spirit Possession]

Allows a heroic spirit to possess a melee class for a short period. When activated, decreases all Skill Cooldowns by 30%, increases damage by 20%, Strength by 90%, Agility by 50%, and Endurance by 50% for 60 seconds.

Cooldown: 8 hours

(Cannot be stacked with other Attribute-increasing Skills.)

Shortly after the new expansion pack launched, everyone had adapted to the new changes. Many players had already gained some experience of the playstyle in the Abyss Battlefield.

Shi Feng was very surprised when he arrived.

He had not expected everyone to adapt to the Abyss Battlefield so quickly.

The Abyss Battlefield was a paradise for experts, particularly solo experts. In addition, these solo experts were strong enough to kill monsters of a higher Level. Overall, solo experts were able to level only slightly slower than Guild experts.

Aside from the EXP buff, Honor Points could also be traded for top-tier equipment. Although the equipment's Attributes leaned more towards PvP, it was still valuable.

The various large Guilds also took advantage of the Abyss Battlefield to grind for top-tier equipment.

There were many Bosses in the Abyss Battlefield. Every town that monsters conquered would contain multiple Bosses. The weakest among these Bosses were Lords, while most were Great Lords. Some towns were even protected by High Lords or Mythic monsters. Guilds didn't need to look far to find Field Bosses.

However, although there were many advantages to the Abyss Battlefield, it had its downsides as well. Every player who entered the Battlefield was allotted one life each day. In addition, the monsters dropped neither materials nor money; they only dropped weapons and equipment. If one's goal was purely to obtain top-tier equipment, the Abyss Battlefield was the perfect place for them.

Shi Feng led his team into the Abyss Battlefield.

After entering the Abyss Battlefield, players were transported to the human race's campsite.

As soon as Shi Feng and the others arrived, they were greeted by a sea of players. White River City's players weren't the only ones who had gathered at this campsite. Players had arrived from every city in Star-Moon Kingdom. They were all gearing up and preparing to set out.

"Wow! That much?! One of those potions could improve my Attributes by 10% and reduce my Stamina consumption by 15% for two hours. The Basic Body Strengthening Potion costs five times as much as the Basic Double EXP potion!"

"What did you think? They cleared out the Abyssal monsters of an entire town! Naturally, they received a ton of Honor Points. The various Guilds are dispatching their armies to clear out these monster towns. With enough Basic Body Strengthening Potions, raiding Dungeons will be a breeze. It's a pity that my Guild is so small. We are nowhere near strong enough to clear out a town."

The players around the campsite chatted as they stood in line to repair their weapons and equipment. They envied the players who had joined large Guilds. Unlike those players, they had to accumulate Honor Points slowly by killing wandering Abyssal monsters in the Abyss Battlefield's outermost regions.

Shi Feng opened the Battlefield's map. After examining it for a moment, he headed towards the nearest small, ruined city.

"Wow, those guys got guts. They are leaving the campsite with just a 20-man team. Are they tired of living?"

More monsters wandered around the outer region of towns, most being Elites with a few Chieftains thrown in the mix. Ordinary players who ventured into these areas quickly lost their lives. However, one could earn quite a sum of Honor Points if they survived.

Monsters were abundant inside a town. There were also plenty of Lord ranked monsters present. Sometimes, even Great Lords would appear in towns. A party of players would find it very difficult to survive.

As for small cities, these were considered monster nests. When players entered the city, their Attributes were suppressed immediately. Generally, Great Lords guarded these small cities. Sometimes, one even encountered a Mythic monster. Even a 100-man elite team would find it very difficult to survive here.

Grand Lords generally ruled over medium cities, and players had a very high possibility of encountering a Mythic monster.

In large-sized cities, players were guaranteed to find a Mythic monster waiting for them. Even a Guildorganized 1,000-man army risked a one-way trip by attempting to challenge these locations.

Naturally, Shi Feng understood the Battlefield's layout. He was far more familiar with the Battlefield's rules than any other player.

To grind for Great Lords, towns were the safest choice. However, Shi Feng had a time limit. Hence, he had no choice but to pick a small city.

After traveling for over two hours, Shi Feng and the others finally arrived at South Lake City.

The entire city had become a nest for Abyssal monsters. One could smell the rich scent of blood from the city's edge.

"Is that a Grand Lord?" Autumn Goose's heart pounded when she saw the giant monster, which was over 100 meters long, hovering above the city.

Every member of the party was flabbergasted as the watched the massive figure in the sky.

[Frost Bone Dragon] (Undead, Grand Lord)

Level 45

HP 64,000,000/64,000,000

This was the first time Autumn Goose and her companions had ever seen a Grand Lord, and they stared, struggling to breathe.

The Frost Bone Dragon had a staggering 64,000,000 HP.

However, this was not the Bone Dragon's biggest threat.

At the rank of Grand Lord, a monster could inflict a powerful mental pressure, preventing players from exerting their full strength.

"That thing can probably instant-kill me with its breath attack." Gunfire involuntarily gulped as he watched the Bone Dragon circle above the city.

"Are we really going to kill monsters here? There are too many!" Blue Bamboo asked worriedly as she glanced at the sea of Abyssal monsters within the city walls.

[Skeleton Soldier] (Undead, Elite)

Level 42

HP 140,000/140,000

These Skeleton Soldiers bore a shield and weapon in each hand. They also stood together in large groups with over a hundred other Skeleton Soldiers. If they fought one of those skeleton squads, it was highly likely that they would attract even more Skeleton Soldiers. Skeleton Captains also roamed the city.

[Skeleton Captain] (Undead, Chieftain)

Level 42

HP 1,300,000/1,300,000

If they fought here, an endless stream of monsters could easily surround them. Their chances of survival would plummet.

"Why don't we check somewhere else?" Autumn Goose suggested.

They could deal with these numbers if they were merely Common monsters. However, the weakest monster in the city was an Elite. Chieftains even called this city home. Even a 20-man team had little hope of surviving this place.

Although they knew Shi Feng and the others were quite strong, the Skeleton Captains were not isolated. From where they stood, they could spot as many as six Captains. Who knew how many more would appear once they started fighting?

It was simply too dangerous to fight here.

"Relax. You guys just need to watch from the sidelines." Shi Feng laughed, not bothering to explain.

After stabilizing their mental states, Fire Dance and the others burst into action.

Ordinary experts might struggle against this sea of monsters. To Zero Wing's core members, however, this wasn't even a challenge. This was a paradise!

Fire Dance and Flying Shadow charged into the crowd of Skeleton Soldiers, luring the Elite monsters. Meanwhile, Minor Wind and the other ranged classes launched their bombardment from a distance.

The three MTs stood like an iron wall as they blocked the undead's advance.

The three Skeleton Captains had just as much trouble. Even against the Chieftains' attacks, Cola and the others did not retreat by a single step. They dodged the majority of the attacks sent at them, launching counterattacks and dealing over -2,000 damage to each Chieftain.

At this time, Cola and the others suddenly stomped the three Skeleton Captains, causing all three to lose their balance and fall to the ground. Immediately after, the three MTs retreated.

-28,467!

A frightening damage of -19,482 points appeared above the Skeleton Captain's head.

"Is she even human?"

Fire Dance's damage shocked Autumn Goose and her team.

Thoughtful Rain and Blue Bamboo were also shocked into silence. This was their first time they had seen their Guild's upper echelons grind monsters. The difference between the way they normally grinded was like the difference between heaven and earth.

In a Party Dungeon, a Chieftain ranked monster was a Boss. In front of Fire Dance, however, it was no different than a Common monster.

Not a single one of Fire Dance's attacks dealt less than -10,000 damage...

Under the continuous bombardment of Zero Wing's core members, the three Skeleton Captains had not even had a chance to land a finger on Cola and the other two MTs. Meanwhile, Violet Cloud, one of the team's healers, had become one of the main damage dealers. Each of her numerous Mana Balls dealt over -600 damage to the Skeleton Captains. Seeing the scattered bones and their rapidly rising experience bars, Autumn Goose and the others were at a loss for words.

Facing hundreds of Level 42 Elites and three Level 42 Chieftains would be a challenge even for a 100man team of Level 40 elite players. Now, however, a dozen or so players had easily defeated these monsters...

Although they had realized that there was a gap between them and Zero Wing's core members, this battle made it clear just how wide that gap was.

"This grinding and leveling speed is amazing. I wish we could level like this every day." Blue Bamboo sighed as she looked at her experience bar.

She had gained more EXP in less than a minute than she usually obtained after two hours of grinding.

They were leveling faster than a rocket.

Moreover, the speed at which they were earning money was simply ridiculous.

In less than one minute, they had gained six pieces of equipment.

Nowadays, in God's Domain, the higher a monster's level was, the lower its drop-rate for equipment would be. They had killed many Level 40 monsters before. Even when they killed Level 40 Elites, they rarely obtained any equipment. Only Level 40 Chieftains were certain to drop equipment. Even then, they usually only dropped one or two pieces.

Among the six pieces of equipment they had obtained, four were Level 40 Bronze Equipment, and two were Level 40 Mysterious-Iron Equipment. Although they were not pieces of top-tier equipment, they could sell for quite a bit of money. Even after splitting the profits among the team, they would earn more than what an ordinary player earned in a single day.

Shi Feng had intended to split the loot equally. However, Autumn Goose and the others rejected the offer. After all, they had not done anything; they also were not members of Zero Wing. They already felt uncomfortable about receiving a share of such a lucrative amount of EXP despite not contributing. As for Thoughtful Rain and Blue Bamboo, the two girls similarly rejected the offer. Hence, it was important to annihilate the monsters outside the city first.

Moreover, in the Abyss Battlefield, monsters in towns and cities had long respawn times. They didn't have to worry about endless respawning. They also wouldn't have to waste a lot of time getting out of the city.

Following which, Fire Dance, Flying Shadow, and Minor Wind lured wave after wave of monsters towards Cola and the others.

After the MTs had built up their aggro with the Skeleton Captains, Shi Feng would use Firestorm. Anyone else who possessed AOE Skills would join him with their own attacks, finishing off the Skeleton Soldiers quickly. Afterward, everyone would focus their attacks on the Chieftain ranked Skeleton Captains.

The team finished off a wave of monsters every five minutes, rapidly filling their experience bars.

After three hours of hard work, Autumn Goose and the others reached Level 35, whereas Blue Bamboo reached Level 36. The five felt as if they were dreaming as they watched their absurd leveling speed.

"We're leveling so fast. I'm the same level as the boss now." Gunfire was flabbergasted by his own Level.

Autumn Goose and Death Wind had similar reactions.

Even expert players needed to grind for two or three days just to reach their Level. It should be known that there were 48 hours in a single day in God's Domain. Now, however, they had only taken three hours to level up. Their leveling speed was ridiculous.

Abyssal monsters had a hierarchy. The lowest monsters generally lived in the outermost regions. As players ventured deeper into a city, they would encounter higher ranked and stronger monsters.

Rather than increasing inside the city, the concentration of monsters decreased significantly. However, it was not difficult to spot the Skeleton Warriors that roamed the city streets.

[Skeleton Warrior] (Undead, Special Elite)

Level 42

HP 550,000/550,000

The city was also home to plenty of Skeleton Captains.

Even a Level 40, 100-man elite team would have to be extremely careful upon arriving here. One mistake could attract hundreds of Skeleton Warriors and seven or eight Skeleton Captains, leaving the team surrounded.

Fortunately, Zero Wing's core members would have little trouble handling such a situation. They could defeat a monster army of such size with relative ease.

However, Shi Feng's goal was not to level up, but to kill Great Lords. Hence, he prioritized scouting the city over grinding.

"I've discovered a Great Lord over here!" Flying Shadow, who used Stealth to scout the city, reported through the team chat. "I'm in the city plaza. Only, there is another team of players fighting the Great Lord right now."

South Lake City was many times more dangerous than monster towns in the Abyss Battlefield. Even a Level 40, 100-man elite team had to be extremely careful here. "They're a 100-man team. These people are wearing a Guild Emblem, so they should be the main force of some Guild," Flying Shadow reported as he observed the situation. "The lowest leveled player is Level 34, while the commander is level 36. Currently, they've dropped the Great Lord's HP by a third and have yet to suffer any losses."

Field Great Lords were different from Dungeon Great Lords. They were a lot stronger. However, they did have a little less HP. The fact that the team had taken one-third of a Level 40-plus Great Lord's HP without losing a single member showed that the team was extraordinarily strong.

"Hold on; I'll send you their battle video." Flying Shadow then started recording a short video before sharing it with the team. "I've never seen their Guild Emblem before. I don't think that it's a Star-Moon Kingdom Guild. However, the fact that they can handle a Great Lord this well shows that the Guild is certainly not ordinary."

[Skeleton General] (Undead, Great Lord)

Level 43

HP 18,000,000/18,000,000

The Skeleton General brandished its war axes madly, each swing causing the earth to tremble. However, the players fighting the Skeleton General were very coordinated. Their MTs guided the Skeleton General's attacks to an area void of other people. Meanwhile, the healers and ranged damage dealers responded when and how they needed to, decreasing the Great Lord's HP continuously. Overall, the players were quite organized.

This is interesting. I hadn't expected to meet them in a place like this. Shi Feng's lips curled up into a faint smile after seeing the players in the video.

Chapter 814 - Legendary Guild

"These people have relatively good combat standards and equipment, but why haven't I heard of this Guild before?" Even after wracking her mind, Aqua Rose could not figure out which Guild these players were from.

The Skeleton General displayed frightening power.

Not only did it possess extremely high Strength, but it was also very fast.

Even for Cola, tanking this Great Lord would be a burden.

The instant the Agonizing Banshee arrived, she released a piercing screech, forcing over a dozen players into a Confused state; these players lost all control over their bodies as they began behaving like raving lunatics. The sudden development was precarious for the team.

"Let's head over and take a look," Shi Feng said, laughing as he watched the Agonizing Banshee massacre the team of players.

It was not unusual that Aqua Rose had not heard of this Guild. After all, the Guild wasn't famous; it was an upstart Guild. The Guild's name was Immortal Light.

Immortal Light was based in the Twin Towers Kingdom.

The Twin Towers Kingdom and Star-Moon Kingdom were adjacent to each other. Hence, Shi Feng knew quite a bit about the Twin Towers Kingdom.

Normally, when she raided High Lords with Autumn Goose and the others, they needed at least three healers to focus on a single MT. Even so, their heals were not always sufficient. As for the other melee classes like Shadow Sword and Rampant Blade, they never dealt less than -3,000 damage.

[Abyss Armor] (Breastplate)

Level 40 - Level 60

Equipment Requirement: Strength 700

Defense +1,240 (Level 40)

Magic Resistance +10

Strength +42, Endurance +40, Agility +35

[Abyss Set Equipment]

Level 40 - Level 60

Equipment Requirement: Berserker

Set consists of eight parts: head, shoulders, chest, hands, wrists, waist, legs, and feet.

Set effect

Two-piece effect: Increases all Attributes by 10%.

Four-piece effect: All Skill damage increased by 20%, Attack Speed increased by 20%, and Movement Speed increased by 15%.

Six-piece effect: Obtain Abyss Rampage Skill: Increases all Attributes by 100% and gain immunity to all control effects for 1 minute. Cooldown: 5 hours.

Eight-piece effect: Obtain Blade of Abyss Skill: Transforms equipped weapon into the Blade of Abyss, increasing Strength Attribute by 300%, Attack Speed by 100%, and attack range by 10 yards for 15 seconds. Cooldown: 3 hours.

"What a powerful Set!" Blackie nearly drooled when he saw read the Abyss Set Equipment's information.

The breastplate's Basic Attributes were only the equivalent of a Dark-Gold item. However, as one obtained more pieces of the set, their combat power would grow exponentially. If one gathered all eight pieces, although the set's Basic Attributes might not compare to Epic items, the boost it granted would only be slightly weaker than a set of Epic Equipment.

"Of course, it is strong. This Set Equipment is purely intended to increase violence. Even the Tier 1 Set Equipment for Berserkers cannot compare to the Abyss Set. After reaching Tier 2 at Level 50, no Tier 1 Set Equipment will be able to compete with the Abyss Set," Shi Feng explained.
