[Demonic Flame Tiger] (Dark-Gold Mount)

Level 40

HP 1,020,000/1,020,000

In the past, the best Mount Shi Feng had ridden was only Fine-Gold rank.

In this life, however, he had obtained a Dark-Gold Mount after killing Noya, a Guardian Boss in the Dark Den.

Mounts were extremely useful to players in field battles, especially a Dark-Gold Mount.

Even a Bronze Mount already possessed certain combat capabilities, assisting players in battle.

After reaching Dark-Gold rank, the Mount was the equivalent of a Chieftain of the same Level. Although a Chieftain might not be anything to a top-tier expert, a Dark-Gold Mount's true power did not lie in its damage dealing abilities. Such a thing was only useful to ordinary players.

The true value of a Dark-Gold Mount lay in its Support Skills.

Having a Dark-Gold Mount was the equivalent of having a player with Support Skills by one's side.

Sure enough, a Dark-Gold Mount's Skills are very powerful. Shi Feng was slightly surprised after he examined the Demonic Flame Tiger's Skill Menu.

A Level 40 Fine-Gold Mount only had two Support Skills. One was single-target Skill, while the other was an AOE Skill.

However, a Level 40 Dark-Gold Mount had three Support Skills, with one being a single-target Skill and the other two being AOE Skills.

[Synergy] (Passive Skill)

While within 100 yards of the Demonic Flame Tiger, all Attributes of owner increase by 10%.

[Battle Roar]

The Demonic Flame Tiger releases a deafening roar. All allies within 20 yards experience a 20% damage increase, Movement Speed increased by 20%, and Attack Speed increased by 30% for 10 minutes.

Cooldown: 30 minutes

[Dark Blessing]

All allies within 20 yards gain 100 points of Magic Resistance, 20% damage reduction, and all Attributes increased by 10% for 30 minutes.

Cooldown: 10 hours

These three Skills alone could raise the strength of the entire team by a huge margin. This was the value of Dark-Gold Mounts.

"A Mount?" Everyone's jaws dropped when they heard Shi Feng's explanation. "This can't be true, right?!"

The Demonic Flame Tiger before them looked absolutely stunning. Moreover, they felt a heavy pressure from it. Based on its HP, it should be at least as powerful as a Chieftain.

A monster like the Demonic Flame Tiger could even serve as the Boss in a Party Dungeon, yet such a powerful monster was actually a Mount. This shattered any knowledge they had about Mounts.

"Secret-Silver?"

"Fine-Gold?"

Guardian Bosses usually had very high HP. Chances were high that players could not even deal enough damage to these Bosses to overcome their innate battle recovery.

Although the Frost Bone Dragon had received the attack without any resistance, when Gunfire's attack struck the Grand Lord's white bone, it felt as if he had just hit a solid wall. Not only did the attack fail to cause any external damage, but the resulting vibration also inflicted pain to his own hand.

His attack had only caused slightly over -700 damage...

"What kind of Defense is this?!" Horror filled Autumn Goose as she stared at the damage.

No matter what was said or done, Gunfire was one of the top ranking experts in the Wind God's Spear; he was very well-equipped. Even against all those Great Lords prior to this fight, his Beheaded Skill always dealt around -2,000 damage. Now, however, even after receiving a significant boost to his Attributes, his Beheaded had only caused around -700 damage. The Frost Bone Dragon's Defense had to be more than double that of the previous Great Lords.

Meanwhile, the Frost Bone Dragon had 64,000,000 HP. With its battle recovery alone it could regenerate 640,000 HP every second. Not to mention, since the battle had begun, the Grand Lord had been absorbing 1% of their HP every three seconds.

Absolute Strike was her most powerful Burst Skill, yet even after a critical hit, the Skill only dealt over - 10,000 damage. At this rate, they would die from exhaustion before they could kill the Frost Bone Dragon.

If this was already the case for Fire Dance, there was no need to mention how little the others could do against the Frost Bone Dragon.

Everyone's most powerful Skills had only managed to deal around -4,000 damage to the Grand Lord. At this rate, they would need to fight for five or six hours to kill the Grand Lord. Unfortunately, it would be a miracle if everyone's Stamina lasted for ten minutes. With the Tier 3 Battle Demon acting as a meat shield, Shi Feng used Silent Steps and appeared directly behind the Frost Bone Dragon.

Flame Burst!

Shi Feng and his doppelganger released a series of 30 dazzling explosions on the Bone Dragon's weakened ribcage.

-20,484.

-28,497.

-41,054.

-57,149.

Thirty consecutive hits struck the Frost Bone Dragon, instantly stealing a small chunk of the Grand Lord's HP.

Aqua Rose used Song of Sprites and cast the Tier 1 Spell Soul Cloud. In the next moment, several dozen damages appeared above the Frost Bone Dragon's head, each one devouring over 1,000 HP. In addition, Aqua Rose summoned three Bluefire Crows and three Forest Sprites. Although each summoned creature could only deal around -1,000 damage, with the six attacking together, they instantly destroyed over 6,000 of the Grand Lord's HP. Seconds and minutes passed quickly. Under Shi Feng and his team's all-out assault, the Frost Bone Dragon's HP quickly fell to 30%. Finally, the Tier 3 Battle Demon was in an extremely miserable state. It currently had less than 20% of its HP remaining.

"Foolish humans, feel the wrath of the Abyss!" the Frost Bone Dragon bellowed as it suddenly flapped its wings. The Frost Bone Dragon instantly appeared above South Lake City.

In the next moment, an endless amount of elemental Mana surged towards the Frost Bone Dragon's body from all directions. At the same time, a deep-blue, twofold magic array appeared above South Lake City as well, enveloping the entire space above the city.

The violent power radiating from the magic array threw everyone to the ground as if the end of the world had arrived.

"It's over... How does the Bone Dragon know such a Spell?" Shock filled Aqua Rose's eyes as she stared at the magic array above South Lake City. With her understanding of magic arrays, she knew that they had absolutely no chance of defending against the Frost Bone Dragon's Spell. It had already been five minutes since Aqua Rose last used Song of Sprites. The Skill's Cooldown should have ended.

"Ah?" Although Aqua Rose did not understand what Shi Feng intended to do, she cast Song of Sprites on him.

Shi Feng then flew towards the Frost Bone Dragon, which was still in the process of gathering and condensing Mana.

Absolute Time!

This was Shi Feng's final trump card against the Frost Bone Dragon.

Even the combined EXP they gained from killing the twenty Great Lords from before could not compete against the EXP provided by a single Frost Bone Dragon.

While everyone was celebrating over their success in killing the Frost Bone Dragon, a system announcement suddenly surprised everyone.

System Announcement: Congratulations! You have killed the Guardian Boss Frost Bone Dragon! War God's Temple Reputation +20 points. Rewarding five Basic Medals of Honor.

"Wah! We've hit the jackpot this time! We got five Basic Medals of Honor!"

Autumn Goose and the others were similarly stunned by this situation. They never imagined that there would be such great rewards for killing the Frost Bone Dragon.

They had heard that many large Guilds had organized massive expeditions to conquer towns. Meanwhile, aside from earning a large amount of Honor Points, another important reason these Guilds were organizing such expeditions was to increase their Reputation with the War God's Temple, as well as obtain Basic Medals of Honor.

The higher one's War God's Temple Reputation was, the more discounts one could obtain when exchanging for items using Honor Points. At the same time, after one's Reputation with the Temple reached a certain level, they could also exchange for higher ranking items.

The high-ranking items available for exchange would tempt even top-tier expert players, much less ordinary expert players.

For example: Battlefield Mounts, rare Skills, high-ranking rare potions, and many other items could not be found on the market.

Although a Battlefield Mount was only useful in the Abyss Battlefield, the quality of the Mount itself was very high. Players could exchange for a Bronze Mount right from the onset. As one's War God's Temple Reputation increased, one could even exchange for a Dark-Gold Mount. These Mounts could increase a player's combat power in the Abyss Battlefield significantly. Not to mention, there were also all sorts of rare Skills.

However, aside from needing a large amount of Honor Points, these high-ranking items also required one other thing for which to exchange.

And that item was the Basic Medal of Honor!

Exchanging for a single Bronze Battlefield Mount required 20 Basic Medals of Honor and 30,000 Honor Points.

Without Basic Medals of Honor, even with all the Honor Points in the world, one would not be able to exchange for items that were truly useful to players.

However, it was extremely difficult to obtain a Basic Medal of Honor. From the knowledge they gained through the research done over the past few days, for players who participated in capturing a town there was only a single Basic Medal of Honor awarded. Now each of them had obtained five medals. That was equivalent to capturing five towns.

If one wanted to exchange for a Bronze Mount, they'd need to capture a total of 20 towns.

Capturing a town was easier said than done.

Unlike the outside world, once players died in the Abyss Battlefield, they had to wait until the next day to enter the battlefield again. Hence, one's life was essential in the Abyss Battlefield. To avoid death players would usually act carefully and spend a long time raiding a single town.

However, there were currently no Bronze Mounts being sold on the market at all. Only a single Common Mount was for sale, which cost 40 Gold. Even if someone were selling a Bronze Mount, it would cost several hundred Gold, at the very least. How could ordinary players possibly afford to purchase one?

Consequently, if one wanted to experience riding a Bronze Mount, this was the fastest method to do so.

In the Abyss Battlefield, Battlefield Mounts were slightly more powerful than normal Mounts. Not only were they faster, but their combat power was also higher by a single rank. Just a Fine-Gold Battlefield Mount could already rival a Chieftain of the same Level, while Dark-Gold Battlefield Mounts could rival a Lord of the same Level. With such a Mount, players could obtain Honor Points in the Abyss Battlefield more easily in the future.

While everyone was feeling ecstatic over their unexpected harvest, Shi Feng had appraised all the items dropped by the Frost Bone Dragon.

Although the Frost Bone Dragon had only dropped five items, every piece was either a top-tier weapon or equipment.

"Big Brother Ye Feng, looking at how happy you are, just what kind of items did the Boss drop? Hurry up and share them with us! Don't just keep them to yourself!" Blue Bamboo became exceedingly curious when she saw the smile on Shi Feng's face.

This was the first time she had raided a Grand Lord. Moreover, there was also a rumor going around in the outside world saying that Grand Lords had a chance of dropping Epic items.

"Nothing much. I'm just happy because we managed to complete the Abyss Set. Aside from that, the Boss has also dropped a Level 40 Dark-Gold ranked shield, a Level 40 Dark-Gold ranked ring, and a pair of Growth-type gloves," Shi Feng said, laughing. He then shared the details of the shield and ring through the team chat.

[Frost Bone Shield] (Shield, Dark-Gold Rank)

Level 40 - Level 45

Equipment Requirement: Strength 500

Defense +2,720 (Level 40)

Block Rate: 37%

Strength +43, Endurance +51

Ice Resistance +10

Evasion +10

Weakens damage received from the front by 20%.

Every time shield is struck, 10% of damage will be converted into user's Defense. Up to a maximum of 2,000 Defense can be converted.

Maximum HP increased by 10%.

Additional Skill-

Frost Body: Becomes immune to all damage coming from the front for 4 seconds.

Cooldown: 5 minutes

"The Defense on this shield is especially high. Just the Defense on this shield alone is already a match for my total Defense." Aqua Rose was dumbstruck after seeing the Attributes of the Frost Bone Shield.

The Divine Bluefire Shield Cola was currently using only had 1,950 Defense. However, the total Defense the Frost Bone Shield could provide was 4,720 points. Not to mention, the shield itself also had a Passive Damage Reduction Skill and an Active Skill that provided pseudo-invulnerability.

With this shield, they would be able to take on even the super-powerful Skills of Bosses in the future. Particularly, when the healers could not keep up with the damage the MT wielding the Frost Bone Shield was taking, said MT could use Frost Body to alleviate the burden on the healers.

[Ice Spirit Ring] (Ring, Dark-Gold Rank)

Level 40 - Level 45

Equipment Requirement: Intelligence 400

Strength +15, Agility +18, Endurance +24, Intelligence +55, Vitality +37

Casting range +2

Casting Speed increased by 10%.

Magic damage increased by 10%.

Attacks have a certain probability to trigger Freeze effect, freezing target for 3 seconds.

Additional Skill-

Rapid Cooldown: Resets Cooldown of all Skills learned by user. At the same time, removes all Control effects and increases casting speed and Movement Speed by 30% for 10 seconds.

Cooldown: 10 minutes

After everyone saw the statistics of the Ice Spirit Ring, their eyes nearly fell out of their sockets.

"With this ring, a magical class's damage output would increase by at least 20%!" Blue Bamboo said as she greatly admired the Ice Spirit Ring. This was the first time she had seen a ring with such amazing Attributes.

Ornaments were very rare in God's Domain. Their value was much higher than even weapons.

Despite being fully geared in top-tier equipment, the ring she currently wore was only a Level 20 Mysterious-Iron Ring. However, she was very well-off already. Many players were still wearing Level 10 Bronze ranked rings.

However, compared to the Ice Spirit Ring, her Level 20 ring was practically trash.

"Don't get too excited. Whether it is the shield or the ring, the value of these two items most likely cannot be compared to this pair of gloves." Shi Feng then shared the stats for the gloves with everyone.

Chapter 826 - Background of the Number One Guild

"Growth-type Equipment?"

Everyone looked at the image that was releasing a faint white glow. There were many divine runes carved on the pair of gloves. There was also a small, dark-blue magic array etched on the back of the gloves, with a light blue bead embedded in the middle of the magic array.

[Frost Gloves] (Gloves, Cloth Armor, Bronze Rank)

Level 40 - Level 90

Defense +348 (Level 40)

Intelligence +26

Vitality +22

Endurance +21

Additional Passive Skill-

Forced Chant: While casting, there is a 5% chance to cast Tier 1 or below Spells instantly.

Additional Active Skill-

Frost Breath: Deals 500% magic damage in a cone to enemies within 30 yards and freezes all targets hit for 5 seconds, and then reduces their Movement Speed and Attack Speed by 40% for 15 seconds.

Cooldown: 1 hour

Gloves that had once been worn by the Frost King with Frost Beads embedded on the gloves, which were sealed by the Frost King, and are unable to display their full power. To lift the Frost King's fivelayered seal, a large amount of EXP is needed to be absorbed. (Removing the first seal requires 300,000,000 EXP)

"The upgrade requirement of this equipment sure is rough. Just the first seal requires 300,000,000 EXP." Blackie raised his brows. This much EXP was enough to allow current ordinary players to level up once. Moreover, this was only the first seal. There would still be four more seals after this one. Needless to say, the following seals would surely have higher requirements.

"But the Skills of this piece of equipment are amazing. It is capable of instant-casting Tier 1 Spells. Only, the chances are a little too low. The AOE Control Skill, on the other hand, is quite good. With these two

Skills together, this pair of gloves would not lose out to any Dark-Gold Equipment," Aqua Rose commented.

When Shi Feng heard everyone's unbiased evaluations, he could not help but shake his head and laugh, saying, "Do you guys think that removing the seals will only improve the equipment's Basic Attributes? This is Growth-type Equipment. It can be upgraded into Epic rank if you remove all of the seals. Whether it is the Basic Attributes of the gloves or its Skills, both will gradually improve along with the undoing of the seals. Dark-Gold Equipment definitely cannot compare to something like this."

"This is Epic Equipment?" Everyone was surprised.

Zero Wing's core members had a profound understanding of just how powerful Epic items were.

Compared to Epic Equipment, Dark-Gold Equipment was practically garbage. The two were on entirely different levels. Even just equipping a single Epic Weapon or Equipment could instantly increase a player's combat power by a large margin, unlike Dark-Gold Equipment, where multiple pieces were required to display their advantages.

"So this is Epic Equipment?" Autumn Goose and the others were momentarily at a loss for words when they looked at the Frost Gloves.

While they were still at the stage of being joyful over getting a piece of Dark-Gold Equipment after defeating a Great Lord, Zero Wing had already set its sights on Epic Equipment. Over time, the gap between them and Thoughtful Rain would unquestionably grow increasingly larger.

Of course, part of the reason for such a result was because the other magical class members of the team had all set their sights on the Frost Gloves.

Unfortunately, the gloves were still won by Aqua Rose in the end.

After completing the equipment distribution, everyone teleported out of the Abyss Battlefield together.

Inside the large Guild Hall, Zero Wing's members could be seen moving about busily.

All this was due to the appearance of the Guild Stable.

To purchase their own Guild Mount once they reached Level 40, everyone began frantically taking on quests one after another, earning as much money as possible. This situation caused the entire Guild to buzz with activity.

Although Magic Weapons had helped many players become experts, they had ruined far more.

Ordinary Stranger was one of those people who had managed to control a Magic Weapon in the past. Hence, he had become one of King's Return's top ranking experts. Otherwise, he would never have become one of the Super Guild's top ten Summoners.
