Soon, even rare items would not provide any Proficiency, at which point, Intermediate Forgers would have to produce items that were one rank higher to improve.

One could just imagine how abysmal an Intermediate Forger's success rate with producing Advanced items would be.

If one could not complete the forging procedures flawlessly, they would waste an astonishing amount of materials. Moreover, Intermediate Forgers would be producing advanced merchandise, which required rare materials. Even Super Guilds would not waste their rare materials so recklessly.

Guilds mainly nurtured Lifestyle players to make money. Although they would have to invest, this investment was not limitless. There was definitely a cap.

In the Candlelight Trading Firm, rare materials were extremely limited. The trading firm did not have the leeway for everyone to produce higher-rank merchandise limitlessly. Hence, the trading firm would conduct a quality check every now and then, using the opportunity to determine how many rare materials to allocate to each person.

Those with high production success rates received a larger supply of rare materials. This way, they could gain more Proficiency each day, increasing their promotion speed.
This was precisely the reason that
The Basic Meditation Room's Mana density was extremely important. The dense Mana in the air could allow players to maintain a calm mind and high concentration. This way, they wouldn't make errors as easily when crafting. If they could cut down on unnecessary mistakes, their production success rate would increase. Their promotion speed would also increase.


She was overjoyed.

The only thing everyone knew was that Raven's members referred to their Guild Leader as "Bloodfang."
"Care for a drink?" Bloodfang asked after Shi Feng sat. "The beverages here are very good."
Unlike the Dark Guards, Bloodfang's voice was not void of emotion. Only, his tone was somewhat gravely.

"No need. Just tell me what you want. You didn't invite me all this way just for a drink, right?" Shi Feng declined, shaking his head.
"Indeed, just as Bloodsucker had said, you really are straightforward." Bloodfang chuckled. Pointing to the town outside the window, he continued, "I'll just get straight to the point. What do you think of this town?"
"It is very shabby. However, the fact that your Guild has captured this town shows that there must be something of great interest to your Guild here," Shi Feng said honestly.
The Dawn Empire was very far from Star-Moon Kingdom. Teleporting from Star-Moon Kingdom to the Dawn Empire cost 4 Gold, 24 Silver. Even current expert players would be reluctant to pay this price.
In the past, Shi Feng's activity had always remain centered in Star-Moon Kingdom. Hence, other than knowing their general location, Shi Feng did not know much about distant kingdoms and empires.
Of course, he still had some knowledge of major incidents.
Although he had never personally visited these countries, the Secret Pavilion often reported major incidents that occurred in God's Domain's various kingdoms and empires.
However, as far as he could remember, nothing significant had occurred in the Dawn Empire at this stage of the game.

"Your senses are sharp. Indeed, as you've said, this town is quite shabby. However, Raven has paid a
huge price to capture it. We've almost invested everything we've accumulated since joining God's
Domain to do so," Bloodfang said, sighing. "I'm ashamed to say this, but although Raven has
accumulated a lot of resources so far, constructing this town is too expensive."

Shi Feng revealed a surprised expression as Bloodfang explained the situation.

He was very familiar with a town's construction. The construction's early stages required a hefty investment. However, to a power like Raven, it should not pose a problem.

"I don't expect you to believe me. However, I am not lying. This town is somewhat special. Although it looks like this now, this town was initially flourishing. What you're seeing is our second reconstruction." Helplessness tinged Bloodfang's voice as he spoke.

"The second time? Had the town been destroyed?" Shi Feng's shock grew.

It was common knowledge that a newly constructed city could hire NPC guards to protect it for 15 days. To current players, Level 150 NPC guards were invincible. Even if the surrounding Level 40-plus monsters sought to cause trouble, Raven could take care of them easily. This town was indestructible.

"That's right. This town has been destroyed once before. Even after hiring so many guards, in the end, we failed to defend it. Raven has invested too much into this town during its early stages. As a result, we can't afford the reconstruction. Hence, I sought to cooperate with Zero Wing, hoping to convince your Guild to invest into this town and develop it with us," Bloodfang said, nodding sternly. Confidently, he continued, "No other Guild knows about the town's true value. I only discovered it after reading through an Ancient Document. If Zero Wing invests 100,000 Gold, your Guild will receive 20% of the town's income."

"Guild Leader Bloodfang, you're talking about 100,000 Gold, not 100,000 Copper. With that kind of money, you can rebuild this town six or seven times over, or construct six or seven other towns, yet you're only offering 20% of this town's earnings. Even if there were a literal Gold Mine here, this town would never be worth that much money," Shi Feng said, shaking his head.

After hearing Bloodfang mentioning the words "Ancient Document," Shi Feng more or less understood that this town was different.

However, he could construct a city's basic structure with 100,000 Gold, much less a town.

Even if this place had a Gold Mine, harvesting the ore would require tons of resources and manpower. Furthermore, they would have to smelt the ore into actual gold before they could sell it. Even if the harvest were high, if he only got 20% of the profits, who knew how long he would have to wait just to earn back his initial investment? He could not afford to throw what Coins he current possessed at this town.

"Elder Ye Feng, don't reject the offer so quickly. I have yet to explain why this town is so special." Shi Feng's refusal did not seem to surprise Bloodfang.

"Special? What's special about this place?" Shi Feng asked.

"There is a Manatite vein here. One can also obtain Magic Crystals alongside the Manatite Ore. Although the vein does not yield much, I believe that it does yield more than Stone Forest Town's daily income. This could certainly benefit the Candlelight Trading firm," Bloodfang said, chuckling. "How about it? Do you think my offer is worth consideration now?"

"It's no wonder why Guild Leader Bloodfang is so confident. However, why Zero Wing? Wouldn't it be better to work with Super Guilds? With the financial strength and manpower of a Super Guild, you would have more than enough to develop the town," Shi Feng said. He had to admit that the offer was tempting.

Manatite was one of God's Domain's particularly rare minerals. As Manatite Ore contained dense Mana, Magic Crystals formed as a byproduct in a Manatite vein. Although one could collect more Mana Crystals by grinding monsters in the Stoneclaw Mountains, there was one benefit to harvesting Magic Crystals from a mine: the absence of danger. As long as they had a sufficient Mining level, any player could mine Magic Crystals. Moreover, the higher their Mining level was, the greater their chances were of obtaining Magic Crystals.

Chapter 957 – Defense Turret
In God's Domain, many players used Mining and Herb Gathering to get rich.
Ordinary players had very few income options. Generally, players relied on quest rewards as Common monsters rarely dropped Coins. Only Elite rank and higher monsters had any chance of dropping money. Even so, the chances were only around two or three percent. Moreover, they dropped Copper Coins.
As for monsters dropping materials, the chances were even lower

After first joining God's Domain, players could mostly afford their repair fees with their earnings from grinding Common monsters. However, as their levels increased and the quality of their equipment rose,

the money they earned from Common monsters wouldn't be enough to maintain their items. Usually,
they had to grind Elite monsters to cover their costs. If they were lucky and obtained a Bronze Weapon
or piece of Equipment, not only could they afford a day's worth of repair fees, but they might also have
something to save.

Unfortunately, that had only been the case after God's Domain had first launched.

Every time God's Domain evolved, the Main God System lowered weapon and equipment drop-rates. Now that the game had undergone its fourth evolution, even Elite monsters rarely dropped Bronze Weapons and Equipment. One usually had to obtain such items from Field Bosses or Dungeons.

It was precisely this reason that Lifestyle classes had become popular.

Meanwhile, the Lifestyle classes' development relied on various materials.

As players moved through maps, they usually paid attention to their surroundings. However, they were not only doing so to avoid player or monster ambushes, but to find ores and herbs.

A gathering player who was familiar with the environment could earn more money by selling the raw materials they gathered than what Guild elite members could earn from fighting monsters.

In the past, Shi Feng had frequently heard about gathering players obtaining excellent weapons and equipment solely by gathering ores and herbs. Many Guilds and trading firms had signed contracts with expert gathering players. As long as these players fulfilled their monthly quota, not only could they sell their materials at market price, but they would also gain bonus Credits.

Hence, for players in God's Domain, both Mining and Herb Gathering were usually very high-leveled.

If there truly were a Manatite vein beneath this town, they only needed to higher players with high-level Mining Skills. They could certainly earn far more Magic Crystals than Stone Forest Town. After all, Stone Forest Town only earned Magic Crystals from players repair and hotel fees. The town didn't earn nearly as much as players did in the Stoneclaw Mountains.

"My initial plan was to earn a large sum in the Dark Arena. However, Zero Wing's abilities have surpassed my expectations. While I have considered cooperating with Super Guilds before, they are simply too powerful; they might just take the town from Raven. Moreover, even if we form a partnership, with Super Guilds' appetite, Raven won't obtain much.

"Although there are a few more powers aside from Super Guilds that we could approach, these powers cannot provide as many Coins as Zero Wing.

"How about it? By cooperating with Raven, not only would Zero Wing not lack Magic Crystals, but the Candlelight Trading Firm would also have plenty of Manatite Ore. You will certainly earn more than 100,000 Gold."

Bloodfang believed that the conditions he had proposed were quite generous. There was simply no reason for an upstart Guild like Zero Wing to reject his offer.

Currently, Zero Wing did not have many assets in God's Domain. However, it was extremely difficult to invest in the real estate in other kingdoms and empires. The local Guilds had long since claimed the available Lands. As for kingdom and empire's main cities, although some golden Lands were still available, without sufficient Reputation in those cities, purchasing those lands was impossible.

By the time someone from Zero Wing obtained the required Reputation, others would have claimed those Lands.

In other words, Zero Wing should have a lot of money lying around right now, yet it could not effective	ly
utilize the Coins, spending money to make money.	

However, this could not be helped. After all, Zero Wing was merely an upstart Guild. Its income couldn't even compare to a veteran second-rate Guild, much less a super-first rate or Super Guild.

If Zero Wing continued to hold on to its funds, it would eventually depreciate.

This was also why, despite earning boatloads of Gold, Super Guilds had very little liquid funds. This was because these Super Guilds had long since invested the money into something more valuable, particularly various city's Lands with high potential.

If Zero Wing invested its excess Coins into Raven, it could kill two birds with one stone.

"Guild Leader Bloodfang, as I've said before, 100,000 Gold Coins are not 100,000 Copper Coins. Even Super Guilds can't hand over such a large amount, not to mention Zero Wing," Shi Feng said, shaking his head. "And again, you're only offering 20%. It will take ages to earn back our initial investment. God's Domain changes each day. Zero Wing cannot make such a huge gamble. Why don't we change our method of cooperation?"

Bloodfang shook his head, responding, "If you wish to invest manpower, forget it. Current players cannot defend this town. With the number and level of monsters attacking this town, we can only rely on NPCs to defend it; in fact, we need a small army. We also need to construct extremely powerful magical arrays and Defense Turrets before the 15-day protection period is over, all of which requires a large sum of Coins."

If not for his urgent need for money, he wouldn't have considered cooperating with Zero Wing at all. He
very much preferred to have the town's profits to himself.

There was not a single power in God's Domain that would complain about having too much money, not to mention an essential item like the Magic Crystal.

As expected, these monsters must be unusual. Hearing Bloodfang's words, Shi Feng could faintly discern the true reason the town had been destroyed, and he could not help the corners of his lips curing up.

In the past, towns with rare mineral and herb fields nearby were often harassed by the local monsters.

Needless to say, a town with Manatite would be assaulted once every few days.

During God's Domain's early stages, the various large Guilds had headaches over these towns. After all, most of the money the earned had to be spent on the town's defense, with some towns needing additional investment.

As Bloodfang had said, constructing one Tier 3 defensive magic array to defend a town would cost 32,000 Gold. Although the magic array would block any monsters below Tier 4, Level 200, it required a lot of Mana to operate.

As for the Defense Turret, each one cost 7,000 Gold to construct.

Generally, monsters would come from all directions when raiding a town. Even if they placed only one Defense Turret at each of the four cardinal points, they needed at least four Defense Turrets. Moreover, the Turrets' artillery shells were very expensive. At market price, each shell cost 5 Gold, with higher-quality ones costing dozens.

Furthermore, a single Defense Turret at each corner wasn't nearly enough. They would need at least two.
With this, the total cost was around 88,000 Gold.
It was no wonder why Bloodfang wanted a 100,000 Gold investment.
However, players' wisdom was infinite. In the past, after the various large Guilds had experimented countless times, they had finally found a method to not only save on the high construction cost, but also resist against the swarms of invading monsters.
Chapter 958: Inconceivable Zero Wing
"If you can't make a decision right now, you can return after discussing it with your Guild Leader. However, I can only give you a day to consider," Bloodfang did not believe that there was another option for cooperation. He believed that Zero Wing could not afford to hand over that much money in such a short time. "One hundred thousand Gold is no small amount. I do not believe that Zero Wing can collect that much money in so little time, either; you can pay 40,000 Gold upfront and the remaining 60,000 in the next five days."

Raven was currently broke. They had used almost all of their money to reconstruct the town and hire the necessary NPC guards.
However, these NPC guards were still not capable of standing against all those monsters.
If they wanted to defend the town, they needed to construct the defensive magic array. With the magic array and the NPC guards, they should survive through the 15-day protection period. As long as they constructed the Defense Turrets during the protection period, they could begin mining the Manatite vein without issues.
"Guild Leader Bloodfang, 100,000 Gold is just too much. Even Zero Wing can't spend that much money," Shi Feng again rejected Bloodfang's offer. "Why don't we try a different method of cooperation? Zero Wing will be responsible for protecting the town. However, you will pay us 30% of the vein's income."
He still needed a large sum to construct his own city. How could he possibly give Raven his Coins?
Moreover, even without the defensive magic array and NPC guards, it was possible to prevent monsters from trampling the town.
He could simply head to Blackwing City and purchase a Monster Repellent Scroll.
The Monster Repellent Scroll was an item that could disperse monsters within a certain area, preventing low-intelligence monsters from actively approaching. Although the effect was temporary, the scroll was very cheap. Each scroll only cost 5 Gold. It was much more cost-effective than constructing a defensive magic array or Defense Turrets.

In God's Domain, the defensive magic array and Defense Turrets were mainly used during monster raids. When dealing with players, however, they were not as effective as NPC guards, yet they cost far more.

Rather than wasting money on that particular plan, Shi Feng would be better off investing his money into his own Guild or somewhere else.

Generally, the monsters that raided towns and cities possessed very low intelligence, so the Monster Repellent Scroll could chase them away. As for using the scroll against the Abyss Invasion, very few abyssal monsters possessed low intelligence. Hence, the scroll wouldn't be as effective.

"Let Zero Wing defend the town?" Bloodfang could not help but laugh at Shi Feng's proposal. "It's not that I am looking down on Zero Wing, but rather, these monsters are over Level 100. There are thousands of them. With players' current strength, it is impossible to defend against such an onslaught. And even if you succeed, why should I give you 30% for defending the town when I can ensure its safety for 100,000 Gold? Wouldn't that be more of a loss? If this is your offer, I would rather contact several other major powers. I believe that they will be more than willing to cooperate."

Zero Wing was not Bloodfang's only option. The only problem was that none of the major powers could afford a 100,000-Gold investment. However, he did not necessarily need 100,000 Gold. As long as he had the initial 40,000 Gold, he could construct a sufficient number of hotels during the 15-day protection period. With a place to replenish their Stamina in, his subordinates could mine for Magic Crystals continuously. He could earn enough money to construct the required Defense Turrets before the protection period ended.

However, Raven would have to be particularly frugal during this period.

"If so, I have another suggestion. For each monster raid Zero Wing stops, Raven will pay 6,000 Magic Crystals. What do you think of that?" Shi Feng casually suggested.

"Are you serious?" Bloodfang asked in surprise.

If they utilized this method, the town's income would belong to Raven fully. As long as they could begin their mining operation, Raven wouldn't have any financial problems. They could quickly construct a powerful defense. Only, the initial period would be the most difficult.

He hadn't expected Shi Feng to be interested in such an exchange.

Had Shi Feng simply handed over 100,000 Gold, he could have received 20% of the town's income. As time passed, he would earn far more than 100,000 Gold, yet for short-term profit, he had given up on a future goldmine. Bloodfang found it hard to believe that a large Guild's upper echelon would make such a rash decision.

"Of course, I'm serious. I've already discussed this with my Guild Leader, and he has approved. Now, it is up to you whether or not to accept this condition." Shi Feng chuckled.

"Alright, I agree to work with Zero Wing. I just hope that you don't regret this decision," Bloodfang said. Even after watching Shi Feng for a long time, he did not understand the man's thoughts. He could not figure out what Black Flame, Zero Wing's Guild Leader, was thinking, either.

The only reason he had agreed to offer Zero Wing a share of the town was because he had worried the Guild would not be willing to fork over the money. That Zero Wing had refused the shares, only asking for some Magic Crystals, was good news for Raven.

The monster raids did not occur every day. Generally, they only attacked every other night. Even if Zero Wing defended the town from ten attacks, he would only spend 60,000 Magic Crystals. When the town's defenses were complete, he would not need Zero Wing's assistance.

Based on the current market price, each Magic Crystal was worth 25 Silver. Even if Zero Wing defended the town for twenty days, he would only spend 15,000 Gold. No matter how he looked at it, he would profit from this trade.

Following which, Shi Feng signed a contract with Bloodfang. As long as Zero Wing helped Raven defend against a monster raid, Raven would pay 6,000 Magic Crystals. Moreover, the payment could only be made in Magic Crystals. If Raven could not pay up, it would have to pay five times the value of the Magic Crystals with Coins or other products. Aside from that, Raven must also allow Zero Wing to construct a Guild Residence in the town so that Zero Wing's members could travel here easily.

Of course, if Zero Wing failed to defend the town, it would have to pay Raven a reconstruction fee of 30,000 Gold.

"It is highly likely that the next raid will happen tomorrow night, but I can't say for sure. I hope that you will be prepared before then." Although Bloodfang had signed the contract with Shi Feng, he was still worried. Could Zero Wing really defend against that many monsters?

"Rest assured. Once Zero Wing's Residence has been constructed, you won't have to worry about monsters," Shi Feng replied confidently.

Now that they had signed the contract, he was in a great mood.

Although it seemed as if Raven had just secured Zero Wing's help, dealing with the Dark Guild's biggest concern, Zero Wing would gain far more than 20% of the town's income. However, Bloodfang didn't know this.

While the Monster Repellent Scroll was very convenient, it also had a huge flaw.
