

Thus, all the Rank 3 fire-attribute magic plants in the first stage must have been taken. Despite that, the first stage was still left as is.


In other words, the fire-attribute magic plants weren't the most important resource, nor was it the only resource in the first stage.

'That means... Trial challengers aren't allowed to share the information because it's considered helping other challengers in the trial,' Vaan guessed.


The one giving information would be disqualified, but there's a chance that the one receiving the information would also be disqualified.

That said, there wasn't a single Peak-level Rank 4 to be seen in the second stage, except from time to time for a brief moment.


Zodreg was the only exception. He was a genius among the dragons, no doubt.


Most Peak-level Rank 4 dragons were only interested in staying on the third stage, even if they couldn't last long there.

Vaan couldn't imagine how much higher the difficulty had to be for the fourth stage's entrance to emanate such a threatening sense of danger and death.


It didn't seem possible for mortals to survive the fourth stage.
