Besides, I overheard your discussion just now and think the scene works well. Don't worry."


Tyler grasped her meaning, yet his nerves persisted. "But I'm concerned Mr. Anderson might take issue


with it if he finds out. What if he becomes jealous and starts an argument with you?"
