Before these merit points rewards, his sovereign level was already very close to level 13. These combined merit points pushed his sovereign level directly to level 14, earning him 20 ruling powers. At sovereign level 14, he could recruit his tenth royal agent. He would wait until he performed the next Call to Arms to see what recruit he received first before sending an invitation.

To get to sovereign level 15, the required merit points increased again. It now needed 700,000 merit points.

Four new affairs popped up. He sent the details to the investigative teams and let them do the work.

The slain demon lord provided a large sum of exp, but the exp points were shared with allied players in the vicinity. But since Jack also received exp points from the demons slain by those allied players, it sort of evened out.

The highest amount of exp points Jack received was during the battle on the first day they arrived here. Jack was fighting with his army then. After that, he mostly went lone wolf.

As a result, even though he received many exp points in this war, it wasn't as many as he hoped for. Even so, it was still much more than the average players. He leveled up a total of six times. All his classes leveled up twice. His Brave Swordsmaster and Time Sage were now level 79, while his Beast Monarch was level 78.

Therras didn't receive the bonus exp from enemies killed by Jack's soldiers. The enemies it killed only gave enough exp points to level up Therras twice to level 78.

For the other players who didn't die, they leveled up an average of three times from this war. Most of these top players were now around level 73 to 75.

When the demon lord fell, it dropped some loot. Jack had used his Runestone of Luck then. He left most of the loot except for some which Jack's God-eye monocle marked with silver color. He snatched those loots without checking them and went back to fighting.

"Yeah. Let me tell you first that it won't work on legacy equipment, so you won't be able to use it on your regal outfit," Peniel informed.

"That's okay, I've another equipment in mind," Jack said.

"Do you want to use it on a longsword and feed it to Storm Breaker?" Peniel asked. Jack did have a unique-grade longsword in his inventory. If he did as Peniel said, he would be able to upgrade his Storm Breaker into legendary grade.

"Let's deal with it later," Jack said. Thelgrun had invited Jeanny and him to the palace. They wanted John to join as well so they were waiting for John before going into the palace. The others were cleaning up the mess in the meantime.

Jack was about to give the Demon Lord Summoning Crystal to Jeanny, but he noticed the girl was side by side with David. The guy had one arm around her. Jack pointed at the two while gaping at Paytowin, who shrugged in response.

David finally moved away. Jack came to Jeanny with a playful grin.

"What are you grinning about?" Jeanny asked, confused.

Jack decided to not tease her. He gave her the Demon Lord Summoning Crystal. She could copy it and use it when they got into a guild conflict or to supplement their guild army during country wars. He also lent the Soul Seed and Upgrade Cell for Jeanny to check how many mana cores were needed to copy. Peniel said this upgrade cell that could only upgrade equipment should require fewer mana cores than the previous version.

But when she used her divine skill to scan the Soul Seed and the Upgrade Cell, she was still surprised.

"The Soul Seed needs 50,000 mana cores and this Upgrade Cell needs 80,000 mana cores," Jeanny said. "This is crazy, other evolve seeds only required around 500 to 3,000 mana cores. Why does this one require so many?"

"Soul and Chaos are the two most powerful elements. Evolve seeds that grant skills with those elements are also much rarer and exceptional. Maybe that's why it consumes much more mana cores than other seeds," Peniel gave her opinion.

"Do you want to keep these items to copy them later after you have enough mana cores?" Jack asked.

After giving the matter a brief thought, Jeanny gave the Soul Seed and Upgrade Cell back to Jack. "I will have to stop copying items for other members for a very long time. I think I should focus on copying cheaper things that could strengthen as many core members as possible. You should use these items rather than have them gather dust for I don't know how long."

Jack didn't object. He was glad instead. This meant he could use these items immediately.

# Chapter 1515: Won

Jack didn't use those items right that moment. Instead, he dealt with his free attribute and free skill points first. He had 24 free attribute points, 9 free skill points for Brave Swordsmaster and Time Sage, and 6 free skill points for Beast Monarch.

He also checked his Container of Souls. The container had 6,900,000 souls inside. These were the souls gained not only from the recent battle but also from the maze under Sangrod royal mausoleum and the souls from Emperor Marcus' death.

He spent all 24 free attribute points on his Endurance, increasing this attribute to 2,420 points.

He then spent Brave Swordsmaster's 9 free skill points and 100,000 souls on Ghost Sword. This skill was fully maxed to level 20. The skill now lasted a half minute.

He still had the Field of Swords at level 1 but he decided to leave that skill for now.

For his Time Sage's 9 free skill points, he spent 7 of them to max the Invisibility spell. This spell's duration was now fifty minutes.

He didn't have any other spells that needed leveling up, so he stored the Time Sage's 2 free skill points for later use.

He spent Beast Monarch's 6 free skill points on Beast Tantrum. The skill became level 16 and it lasted 12.5 minutes.

Many of his skills and spells had also gained some star upgrades. Two among them had their first stars, Time Realm and Gigantify Pet. Each star of Time Realm slowed hostiles within its AOE by an additional 2%. For Giganty Pet, one star increased its damage boost by 1% and damage reduction by 2%.

Jack used 6,600,000 souls to further upgrade 22 stars on various skills and spells.

His first choice was Reset. 1,800,000 souls were used to upgrade the spell by six times to a full ten stars. Reset's cooldown was now four hours. When he upgraded Reset's tenth star, he expected to hear a notification. He received a title for being the first player to fully level a skill. Upgrading a skill's star was much harder. It made sense that it should have a reward as well. He didn't believe someone else had maxed a skill's stars faster than him, not even Master.

He was not disappointed. He heard a notification. He was not granted a title, though. It was something better.

"Congratulations, for being the first to fully upgrade your skill to its tenth star. You have gained a talent, Fast Learner."

"But I just got this one. Doesn't this imply that someone other than me can also get this talent if he fully upgrades his skills first?"

"... Maybe it's because you do have this talent and this achievement simply pull it out to the surface. Maybe if you don't have it within you, you will get a title instead. I don't know! I said before that I don't know what accomplishment gives reward and what reward you get from that accomplishment, don't I?"

"Okay, okay," Jack said. He wasn't going to fuss about the reason. He was glad enough that he got one.

This talent was similar to his title, Hard-working Achiever, but that title needed to be equipped before he could enjoy its effect. This newly gained talent was passive. Its effect would always benefit him from now on.

The exp boost of Fast Learner talent was slightly less than the Hard-working Achiever, but the skill proficiency gain was much better. With this talent, he practically only needed half the time the other players needed.

Between this talent and his Container of Souls, even if he couldn't match Master in terms of skill quantity, he could excel in skill quality.

He chose Beast Form and Dances of the Brave for the next skills to be star-upgraded.

All elemental resistances +40.

All status effect resistances +20%.

Calming wave (Active effect): All monsters of rare elite grade and below, and a maximum of ten levels above the user, will not turn hostile, Duration: 10 minutes, Cooldown: 6 hours.

Summon archdemon lord (Eternal monster), Cost: 50,000 mana cores, Duration: 3 hours, Cooldown: 6 hours

The elemental resistances and status effect resistances were doubled from their previous stats. Its two original abilities, the calming wave and the summoning ability had their durations extended. Previously, the calming wave's duration was five minutes. The summoning ability was one hour.

The summoning ability's duration was extended three times the original. Jack was very happy with this upgrade. If the archdemon lord could stay that long during a war, it would have more influence on the war's outcome.

He still had to collect the mana cores, though. He was still short more than 20,000 mana cores to summon another Archdemon Lord.
