

Christopher had invited her to dinner a few times, and she felt it was time to return the favor. They walked out of the apartment and drove to a restaurant.


Meanwhile, The Faust Group was holding a board meeting. Mortimer's face darkened when he heard Alec propose to dismiss him as head director.
