Louder explosions could be heard, and the ground started to shake. Traditional explosives, along with crystal weapon traps, were ignited.

Flesh and blood flew among the zombie and beast hordes. Batches and batches of lifefoms fell under such attacks. Those attacks previously used on the mutated apes reappeared and were much stronger now.

A very powerful crystal cannon appeared. You needed to equip over 20 level five crystals, but it could only fire twice.

This wasn't a new model. It was only modified. In Le Dayuan's words, this thing insulted the lab's standards.

But at this moment, it was very effective. This modified cannon was very rough. The energy conversion rate was low and didn't use much crystal energy. It was a serious waste of energy. The material of the barrel and cannon body wasn't suitable, and after a few dozen shots, it would spoil and cause a huge waste.

But Ye Zhongming still crafted many of these modified cannons for their strengths.

They were simple and violent.

This gave other weapons a great chance to attack and they were super efficient.

Many lab members who opposed crafting this weapon were finally supportive.

Sometimes, you had to look at the effect and not just at the actual numbers.
