21 Chapter 21: Theory of Spiritual Roots\_1

The Imperial Medical Academy has conducted numerous research studies on the correlation between Spiritual Roots and the speed of Cultivation, eventually culminating in a medical classic entitled the “Theory of Spiritual Roots”.

Research shows that there is a positive correlation between spiritual root attribute points and the speed of cultivation.

Every normally born cultivator, given sufficient Innate Yuan Qi, has 100 points of Spiritual Root Attributes. These are then distributed into the Five Elements attributes, thus forming the “Spiritual Root” that every cultivator possesses.

The quantity of the Five Elements Spiritual Root attributes determines the efficiency of the Cultivation Technique.

For example, there’s a prodigy with extraordinary luck where all 100 points are allocated to the Wood Element of the Spiritual Root. This results in the legendary Perfect Wood-type Heavenly Spiritual Root. His Wood Attribute Cultivation Technique training is twice as efficient as an average person’s.

What would take an ordinary person 100 years to master; he would only need 50.

Chen Mobai’s current Spiritual Roots are: Metal 23, Wood 27, Water 30, Fire 17, Earth 10.

Take for instance now, his highest being Water Attribute Spiritual Root; if he practices the Dark Water Cultivation Technique, based on the Theory of Spiritual Roots’ formula, his efficiency in refining Spirit Qi is only 1.3 times the average person’s.

Of course, the actual efficiency of cultivation also depends on the concentration of spiritual energy, the cultivator’s attitude, as well as whether or not any auxiliary spiritual objects are used, etc., it’s not a one-size-fits-all.

Based on the most ideal circumstances, Chen Mobai, with his aptitude, would need at least half a year's time to break through to the sixth layer of Qi Cultivation using the Five Elements Cultivation.

However, the Water Mansion is a Rank-2 intermediate grade Spiritual land, its Spiritual Energy is five or six times denser than that of a Rank-1 top-grade. The efficiency of practicing in this place is, compared to practicing at school or home, akin to an upgrade from riding a bicycle to riding a rocket.

Regardless of this, based on Chen Mobai's previous calculations and due to his Spiritual Root restriction, he would still need approximately a hundred days, close to the college entrance exam, barely making the breakthrough to the sixth level of Qi Cultivation.

This was before he watched Master Qing Ping's lecture video.

Using the same logic, the counter-clockwise motion is considered regressive and is meant for dispersion. When Spiritual power operates in some congested and narrow meridians, it shouldn't be forced in. Instead, it should be dispersed into thin gentle Qi and slowly advance.

The “Pure Yang Scroll” was divided into five sections, correlating to the five major realms of Qi cultivation, Foundation Establishment, Core Formation, Nascent Soul and Divinity Transformation.

What’s more, the requirements for spiritual root attributes for cultivating the

“Pure Yang Scroll” were not high.

However, there was one prerequisite.

That was the need to cultivate a corresponding Daoist body.

This Daoist body was known as the “Pure Yang Daoist Body”!

The cultivation of the “Pure Yang Daoist Body” also had levels, from one yang to nine yangs. One had to reach a level of three yangs, then six, and finally achieve perfection when they reached “Pure Yang”.

For instance, if one wanted to establish the foundation, they would need to

first cultivate to a Three Yang Body.

If they desired to form their core, they would need a Six Yang Body.

For the Nascent Soul Realm, a prerequisite would be having a Nine Yang Body.

Upon reading this, Chen Mobai stumbled upon something familiar.

The process of cultivating to a Three Yang Body was the same technique that old man Ding had painstakingly used to enhance his spiritual roots when he was young. No wonder the Pure Yang Academy recruited him without trials once he had cultivated this technique.

Unfortunately, Old Ding had never managed to successfully establish his foundation.

But wasn't the Three Yang Body a Daoist body? What did it have to do with enhancing the spiritual roots?

With this question in mind, Chen Mobai wanted to continue reading, but he found out that he lacked enough points. He could only see the overview and table of contents for the Pure Yang Scroll, not the specific method to cultivate the Three Yang Body.

Cursing silently, he found another way.

He opened the "Auxiliary Cultivation" software and entered the search term

"Pure Yang Daoist Body".

Sure enough, all roads lead to Rome.

About two hundred pages appeared, showing that there were indeed quite a few cultivators who focused on the Pure Yang Scroll, offering a multitude of reference points.

Chen Mobai opened the highest-ranked video in the search results, posted by a

Core Formation cultivator named "Shaoyang .

"Although the Pure Yang Daoist Body is a Daoist cultivation technique, it has its roots in the spiritual roots," he explained.

"Although the 'Pure Yang Scroll' is as difficult as the 'Jade Purity Scripture', Yuan Yang, the ancestor who achieved divinity, formulated the cultivation method of the Pure Yang Daoist Body along with the 'Pure Yang Scroll', significantly reducing the difficulty of cultivation."

"The Pure Yang Daoist Body, from the birth of the first yang to the ascension of the ninth, requires 27 points of wood spiritual root, 27 points of water spiritual root, and optimally, more than 20 points of fire spiritual root. In essence, this ensures that the final perfection would undoubtedly be a 100-point fire attribute Immortal Spirit Root."

After listening to this Shaoyang cultivator's explanation, Chen Mobai understood why the art of the Three Yang Body was also a technique for enhancing spiritual roots.

It turned out that the original version of the "Pure Yang Scroll" had equally high requirements, requiring a baby born at the yang year, yang month, yang day and yang hour to cultivate it, essentially needing a Pure Yang Body.

The immortal Sect on Earth's Adeptus Planet had upper echelons who calculated birth dates and manipulated childbirth cycles to have their lower-level cultivators sire infants with Pure Yang Bodies.

One amongst them had great accomplishments, and he was Yuanyang, the founder of the Pure Yang Academy.

However, he was a scholar who prioritized cultivating the younger generation and devoted himself completely to education. In order to spread the teachings of Pure Yang widely amongst the people and make it accessible to most cultivators, he created a technique to cultivate a Pure Yang Body.

This was the "Pure Yang Daoist Body"!

Yuanyang, the ancestor, originated from the Repairing Heaven Institute and had personally experienced the power of "Immortal Technique-Mending the Heaven". He took his inspiration from there.

The "Immortal Technique-Mending the Heaven" was a technique that the ancestors of the Immortal Sect had gleaned from the heavenly scriptures. Once implemented, it could rebuild a cultivator's spiritual root attributes, going against the heavens.

For example, Chen Mobai's spiritual root attributes before consuming the

Azure Blood Carp were:

Gold: 23, Wood: 27, Water: 23, Fire: 17, Earth: 10.

Added together, these five elements spiritual root attributes equaled 100, and this was granted by Heaven, purely left to luck.

However, "Immortal Technique-Mending the Heaven" allowed for the deliberate modification of this allocation.

Using a layman's terms, it was point redistribution.

For instance, if he favored wood, he could convert the attributes of gold (23), water (23), fire (17), and earth (10) to non-attribute points and then allocate all of them to the wood spiritual root, immediately achieving a perfect 100-point wood attribute Heaven Spiritual Root.

Such a 100-point spiritual root had another name within the Immortal Sect, referred to as an “Immortal Spirit Root”.

Such individuals never appeared naturally in the world; only “Immortal Technique-Mending the Heaven” could accomplish this.

The ancestor Yuanyang was the recipient of the baptism of “Immortal Technique-Mending the Heaven”, rebuilding his spiritual roots into a 100-point fire attribute Immortal Spirit Root.

An “immortal Spirit Root”, along with a “Pure Yang Body”, made for a rapid cultivation process.

He achieved the Primordial Spirit level in a mere 500 years, marking him as the fastest cultivator to reach Divinity Transformation in the recorded history of the Immortal Sect.

However, the divine technique could only be performed by cultivators at the Divinity Transformation level, and it would consume a significant amount of Elemental Energy.

Therefore, no one had been blessed to experience it in the last thousand years. Suppressing the excitement within his heart, Chen Mobai watched the entire video where Shaoyang explained the principles of the Pure Yang Daoist Body, and finally understood why it required 27 points of the Wood Spirit Root, 27 points of the Water Spirit Root and ideally, more than 20 points of the Fire

Spirit Root.

The Way of Heaven functions in a manner where it dims the bright and supports the weak.

The cultivation of the Pure Yang Daoist Body follows the principle where it harms the “Water and Wood” to bolster the “Fire” .

Following the theory of the Five Elements generating each other, a cultivator’s water attribute spiritual root points are transformed into wood attribute points, which are subsequently converted into fire attribute points, thus achieving effects akin to using the “Immortal Technique-Mending the Heaven”.

Cultivation for each level of yang depends on a cultivator’s talent, comprehension, and resources. It can decrease a maximum of 3 points of Water Spirit Root and 3 points of Wood Spirit Root, but through the Pure Yang secret techniques, it can increase one’s Fire Spirit Root by 9 points.

If one successfully achieves Nine Yangs and they’re lucky enough to have increased by 9 points each time, then in the end, even a cultivator without a Fire Spirit Root can possess an 81-point Heavenly Fire Spiritual Root. If one initially had a 20-point Fire

Attribute Spiritual Root, after adding the two together, it would directly surge to too, promoting one's spiritual root to an Immortal Fire Spiritual Root.

Upon reaching this point, Chen Mobai, brimming with excitement, looked at his own spiritual root attributes.

He had the exact 27 points in his Wood Spirit Root and after consuming the Azure Blood Carp, his Water Spirit Root went from 23 points to 30, perfectly meeting the requirements for cultivating the Pure Yang Daoist Body.

Then he looked at his Fire Spirit Root, which was 17 points.

This was regrettable.

When the Nine Yangs are cultivated, they would add up to exactly 98 points. He was just 2 points short of achieving an Immortal Spirit Root.

Chen Mobai had already fantasized about cultivating the Pure Yang Daoist Body, achieving Divinity Transformation, sweeping over the whole world, proclaiming himself as Supreme and becoming an Ancestor.

He then watched a few more videos about the cultivation of the Three Yang Body and was immediately doused with cold water, his heart chilled. "The fastest cultivator to achieve the Three Yang Body was a cultivator named Ming Yang, who spent 12 years. He then spent an additional 39 years to achieve a Six Yang Body and finally spent 86 more years cultivating the Nine Yang Body. However, by that time, his lifespan was already depleted and he lacked the strength to push into the Nascent Soul Realm, eventually dying of old age.."

Although the Earth Star has entered the era of immortal cultivation, everyone's lifespan has significantly increased, there are still natural life limits.

The Imperial Medical Academy has conducted a substantial amount of research on lifespan.

After sampling the lifespan limit of a hundred thousand regular cultivators, they concluded the maximum lifespan for each realm's cultivators.

Qi Practitioners generally have a lifespan of two full cycles of the Chinese Zodiac, which is 120 years.

Foundation Establishment cultivators live for four cycles, 24.0 years.

Gold Core cultivators live for eight cycles, 480 years.

Nascent Soul cultivators double that, at sixteen cycles, or 960 years.

Of course, these figures aren't absolute and can vary from person to person, but this is the average lifespan of standard cultivators.

If one practices a special cultivation technique, or correctly applies health preservation techniques, or consumes lifespan-extending spiritual medicine, then it's possible to live a couple more zodiac cycles.

As for god-transcending cultivators, due to the lack of examples and insufficient samples, the Imperial Medical Academy didn't release any information on that front.

However, based on the previous lifespan pattern, it should be thirty-two cycles, which equals 1920 years, a lifespan of two thousand years.

Chen Mobai's greatest dream was to successfully achieve Foundation Establishment before the age of 60.

The Imperial Medical Academy also conducted research on cultivators breaking through major realms, and concluded: the rate of success in a breakthrough is highest before one's lifespan is half over.

For example, Qi Practitioners wanting to establish the foundation are better off trying before the age of 60. Once past this age, no matter how they maintain their Qi cultivation, all kinds of bodily functions will begin to decline drastically.

Originally, Chen Mobai felt that he only had a 1% chance of establishing his foundation before 60, and though he now had the opportunity of the Mysterious Turtle Shell, he felt the possibility was merely 10%.

With the universal cultivation in Celestial Sword, there are three hundred million cultivators.

Those who can ultimately cultivate to the ninth level of Qi Practitioner are one in a hundred.

Among them, those who can successfully establish the foundation are again one in a hundred. The Imperial Medical Academy found, through data analysis of these successful cases, that over ninety percent succeeded establishing their foundation before the age of 60.

Once past 60, without enough vigor and essence, successful foundation establishments are either those with opportunities or are divinely favored.

Establishing the foundation is hard enough, and Core Formation is even harder. The success rate for this realm is one in a thousand.

As for the realm above Core Formation, the Nascent Soul, it hardly needs mentioning. It's possible that not one appears across several eras.

Celestial Sword's current Nascent Soul Masters are antiquities accumulated over a thousand years and a hundred eras.

Chen Mobai, with his average talent, had originally neither assurance nor expectations of establishing a foundation before 60, and if he were to additionally spend over a decade cultivating the Three Suns Body, he felt that he was basically done for.
