Item Name: [Yamato] (Reforged)

Item Type: Weapon (One-handed Sword/Katana)

Item Rank: Peak Obsidian (Quasi Meteor)

Growth Type: Current Level - 150

Durability: Indestructible

Physical Attack: 5500 to 6000

Magical Attack: 4500 to 5000

Stats:

+1000 STR and AGI

+500 INT

Details: An inherited Katana that is being passed down from generation to generation. It is the same Katana that has been used by the First Nephilim 'Zheptus'.

Requirements: Can only be wielded by an Envoy of The Church of The Sun and The Moon.

Additional Abilities:

1. Nephilim's Blade (Passive): Every time you hit your target with [Yamato], your attack speed increases by 10% and lasts for 5 seconds, stacking up to 5 times.

At Max stacks you will gain an additional 100% movement speed.

2. Nephilim's Ascent (Active): Enter a berserk state, increasing all your stats by 200% and movement speed by 1000%.

Duration: 30 mins.

Cooldown: 1 hour

3. Nephilim's Clarity (Active): When activated, regen your HP and MP by 5000 points per second and last for 180 seconds.

Cooldown: 1 Hour

4. Nephilim's Flame (Active): Enter a Transcendent State where each of your basic attacks will produce a crescent sword Qi that will fly for 15 meters in range and deal 300% Combined Damage (Physical + Magical) each strike.

Duration: 20 Seconds

Cooldown: 1 Hour

5. Nephilim's Wings (Passive/Active): Summon a pair of wings that will grant you the ability to fly.

Note 1: Upon summoning, the player will experience a huge burden on their mind until the wings are unsummoned. The longer the wings were summoned the stronger the mental burden the player will experience.

Note 2: Flying consumes mentality and mana. Increasing your flying speed will consume an additional amount of mana that will continuously rise depending on the maximum speed added.

Note 3: Every time the player deactivates their wings, you will have to wait for a whole hour before you can summon them again.

Remark: This sword had lost its peak form during the passage of time, but due to your efforts and after being reforged by the Saint Rank Blacksmith, Berlin, it regained its original form and even gained additional power.

Blessing 1: Blessed by the Brilliant Sun and the Abyssal Moon.

You gained control over a higher form Mana – You gained the Power of 'Primordial Eclipse'.

Blessing 2: Blessed by the Dusk and the Dawn.

-Upon activation, the [Yamato] will be split into two swords that carry the abilities of the Blades of the Dusk and Dawn.

-One sword controls the power of the Brilliant Sun while the other wields the power of the Abyssal Moon.

Note: During this form, the effects of the previous weapons – [Dusk Blade] and [Dawn Blade] – will take effect including their equipment set bonuses.

This item is bound to player 'Sickarius'.

Shin felt a little dizzy at the long string of information in front of his eyes. He was already expecting that the description of the weapon was like this, but it still hit a little differently when it was already in front of him.

The bonus stats greatly improved just like he had expected. However, he was not that much interested in it due to the current patch of the game.

The Nephilim's Ascent, which was one of his berserk skills, had some minor improvements. The attack and movement speed bonuses were slightly better than before.
