In this format, the point system was determined by the number of members remaining standing at the end of the match.

In the first few minutes of the match, a single member was equivalent to 1 point. But this system had a limit of 5 maximum points while the remaining five points would be given to the winning team once they had wiped out the opposing side.

This would then have a total of 10 points at the end of the match.

But this result was only applicable for the perfect win, which meant that the winning team should not have any casualties during the battle.

If the opposing team had killed at least a single member of the opposing side, then that point would be subtracted from the maximum points (10), which would make the final result a 9 to 1 score.

If the said team then managed to kill 5 players from the opposing side before getting wiped out, then the other side could only get a total of 5 points regardless of the number of their kills.

This would end in a draw.

But in case both teams were wiped out at the end of the match, then the two teams would receive an equal amount of points, which was 5 points each and would have the same result as the previous case, a tie.

It was somewhat of a high-risk, high-reward gamble.

This was the reason why most of the team did not choose this format, especially if the opposing side had an equal strength. It was better to proceed with the regular format of the tournament, which was very steady when 'farming' points.

It was also the reason why this was only applicable when they were against a much weaker team.

This was why most of the people could not figure out why the Empyrean Talons had chosen this format, especially when they could secure the top spot in the leaderboards if they continued with how the tournament was supposed to play.

Moreover, the opposing side had top-notch and highly experienced veterans on their team, which could lead to serious accidents.

The Empyrean Talons couldn't have underestimated the lineup of the Hien Workshop, especially after seeing the abilities of their star players in the previous rounds.

If the old veterans were together, then the consequence would be serious even if the lineup of the Empyrean Talons was filled with superstars.
