Chapter 204 Pundits Discussion

Kelly Cates: "Good evening, and welcome to this Sky Sports News special report. 'We are more concerned with seeing our child recover than worry about a game,'

"Whilst I agree with that sentiment we are here to talk about football, So Micah, can you give us an idea of which teams were vying for Rakim's signature before this incident, and what this might mean for those potential deals?"
