
Nowadays, people post everything online, no matter how trivial.

"Forget helping her, they're actually bullying her!"



Before Cindy Clarke had a chance to explain, Wyatt Kirk had already turned cunning.


He spoke to Adrian Zhekova first, "Master Adrian, you still remember me, right? I'm Little Wyatt."
