Gunman, Ji Xiang, these formidable assassins, although slightly lacking in strength, are not necessarily weaker than the average Semi-Grandmaster because of their adept and formidable assassin skills...

Unfortunately, everyone overlooked one point, they ignored Qin Fang's hidden identity... Qin Fang is also an assassin, and he even aims to become the King of Assassins.

The gunman is formidable not only because of his extraordinary power but also because of his hidden identity as a ninja, one who has cultivated ninjutsu to a considerably high level.

Such a hidden identity provides him with numerous advantages in his assassin profession, allowing him to tackle stronger opponents and better hide himself...

Even a master like Ji Xiang, who is evenly matched with him, had an extremely unpleasant expression upon discovering that the gunman is a ninja.

It's not that Ji Xiang is inferior to the gunman; it's just that ninjas are natural-born assassins and are notoriously difficult to handle. Without the necessary tools, Ji Xiang may have no problem protecting himself, but defeating the gunman is impossible... Even if the gunman tries to escape, Ji Xiang is equally helpless!
