+10% healing effectiveness with medical supplies

+10% chance to cure minor infections or poisons with medical supplies

+10% speed of applying medical supplies]

[Herbalism Lv10 (Max): An Advanced Survivor Skill that allows the user to heal themselves or others with natural remedies, such as herbs, plants, or mushrooms. It grants the following benefits:

+20% healing effectiveness with natural remedies

+20% chance to cure major infections or poisons with natural remedies+20% speed of gathering and preparing natural remedies]

These two were Anna's Survivor Skill, and they were definitely useful! He actually found a healer!

However, what surprised Shane the most was the fact that the dog also had a Survivor Skill!

[Tracking Lv10 (Max): A Basic Survivor Skill that allows the user to follow the tracks and signs of animals, zombies, or other survivors. It grants the following benefits:

+10% chance to find tracks or signs

+10% speed of following tracks or signs

+10% accuracy of identifying tracks or signs]

"Awesome..." Shane whispered, but he immediately recalled to check the time.

"We still have two hours before the Zombie Wave starts. You two must be hungry. Get inside and have a meal first..."

[Nail Bat (Rare): A crude but effective weapon that can deal serious damage and knockback to low-tier zombies. It is a wooden bat with nails sticking out of it, and has a good balance and weight. It can kill Crawler and Walker Zombies with a single hit on their head and can also cause bleeding damage to zombies. It is also useful for breaking or smashing things.

Effects: +10% damage against Crawler, Walker, and Runner Zombies]

After checking it, she realized that it was indeed a good item. It was a Rare Grade item and could surely smash a zombie's head.

"This looks good... I'll go practice swinging outside." Anna said, but she also didn't forget to take out the wooden plates and utensils to wash.

[Reputation Store]

Price: 5 RP]

[Drone: A small and remote-controlled flying device that can scout, spy, or attack zombies or enemies. It can also carry items weighing not more than 1kg. It has a camera to record and transmit video and audio, and an arm to carry items. It includes a headset and controller.

Price: 15 RP]

[Tattoo: A permanent and artistic mark on the Survivor's skin that can impress or intimidate others. It has 100% chance of unlocking new Survivor Skills. The tattoo's design will depend on the unlocked Survivor Skill.]

Price: 20 RP]

[Reputation Points: 1]

Unfortunately, Shane still lacked some Reputation Points, so he couldn't purchase anything in the store. Well, he guessed that he could only get Reputation Points from killing Leader-Type Zombies since that was where he got his first point.

"Sir Shane, I'm considering giving the helmet to Anna for added protection. I believe she needs it more," Harper's voice suddenly rang out, reaching Shane inside the tent.
