The higher the skill's tier, the more likely it is to have a level requirement for learning it.

Occasionally, there are extremely rare high-tier skills without any level restrictions; these are undoubtedly hot commodities.

Each time one emerges, it's aggressively sought after worldwide and can instantly fetch astronomical prices!

The normal selling price of a yellow Skill Book is just several million, but if it has no level restrictions, the price would instantly soar by hundreds of times, turning into several hundred million!

Obviously, ordinary people simply can't afford these items.

If one doesn't want to spend money and wishes to obtain them through luck, it's also quite difficult.

That's because all locations where these high-quality, no-level-requirement skills can be found are incredibly difficult. Ordinary people simply don't have the capability to clear them.

If someone knowledgeable saw Chen Mo's skill, they would naturally assume he had an extraordinary background.

Having finished with the skill, Chen Mo finally turned his attention to the pile of Magic Wands next to him.

[Dark Wand·Gray Stone-grade]

[Profession Requirement]: Skeleton Mage

[Level Requirement]: Level 1

[Equipment Attribute]: Magic Attack +5

[Equipment Introduction]: A wand forged from low-cost dark mixed ores, crudely crafted and barely serviceable.

The so-called equipment requirements are just the minimum. Although it lists Skeleton Mage and Level 1, any advanced profession of the Skeleton Mage and any character above Level 1 can equip it. The same applies to related skill restrictions.

Gray Stone-grade equipment is trash because it only has one attribute, and it's only increased by such a tiny amount.

After glancing at the equipment attributes, Chen Mo was full of disdain.

I wonder if there are any differences between synthesizing a Magic Wand and synthesizing a Skill Book.

He immediately picked up three wands and placed them into the material slots one by one.

With his talent in action, the three Gray Stone-grade Dark Wands quickly fused into a bound Black Iron-grade Dark Demon Wand.

[Dark Demon Wand·Black Iron-grade]

[Profession Requirement]: Skeleton Mage

[Level Requirement]: Level 1

[Equipment Attribute]: Magic Attack +10, Attack Speed +20

[Equipment Introduction]: A demon wand forged from the cheapest dark mixed ores. This time, the material has been slightly refined, offering more magic power.

Huh? Why aren't any options coming up?

Only after checking the equipment attributes did Chen Mo suddenly realize that this synthesis had completed directly, without offering three choices.

He stubbornly continued to synthesize.

Soon, a Bronze-grade Dark Scepter was synthesized.

[Dark Scepter·Bronze-grade]

[Profession Requirement]: Skeleton Mage

[Level Requirement]: Level 1

[Equipment Attribute]: Physical Attack +15, Magic Attack +15, Attack Speed +30, Energy Recovery Speed 20 points/10 seconds

[Equipment Introduction]: Forged from the cheapest dark mixed ores, this scepter is solid and durable—so much so that it could even be used to bludgeon someone.

Could it be that all weapon syntheses directly produce results without any special effects to choose from?

Chen Mo continued to synthesize.

...You have placed [Dark Scepter·Bronze-grade]*3 into the synthesis slots!

[This synthesis is of medium quality. An additional special material is required: Dark Crystal·Rare]

Gray Stone-grade, Black Iron-grade, and Bronze-grade are all lower-tier and do not require additional materials. Starting at Silver-grade, special materials need to be added.

As for the materials that needed to be added, Chen Mo had anticipated this. The Dark Crystal he had prepared in advance was indeed the material needed for synthesis now.

He added it immediately.

This time, the result of the synthesis changed.

Oh? You can choose three special effects at the Silver-grade level again?

This is consistent with the characteristics of equipment, Chen Mo mused, a look of understanding dawning on him. Indeed, equipment on the market only has additional special effects at Silver-grade or above. Items below Silver-grade have no special effects and only provide attribute enhancements.

Upon understanding, Chen Mo immediately looked at the three special effects of the equipment.

The Tranquil Wand's special effect was a 20% Cooldown reduction. For a Mage profession, the significance of this was self-evident—clearly a great effect.

Chen Mo then looked at the next two special effects.

The Bloodthirsty Wand's special effect allowed Chen Mo to recover life value equal to 10% of the damage he dealt.

Simply put, it increased his survivability.

But as a Skeleton Mage, especially one without any initial range attack capabilities, wouldn't engaging in close combat be putting myself in danger?

Moreover, now that he could summon a large Skeleton Army, there was no point in him personally attacking monsters. It was both dangerous and foolish.

If I can't attack personally and lack a range attack, wouldn't this lifesteal effect be useless?

Skipping the second option, Chen Mo examined the last one.

He had just lamented his lack of a range attack method when the third option presented one.

The third effect granted the Magic Wand a special ability: launching a missile as a normal attack.

This was precisely what Chen Mo needed right now.

Because his Occupational Talent required such a method to activate.

As long as he could hit a target, all his summons attacking that same target would deal double damage. This benefit was undeniably massive.

Compared to a 20% Cooldown reduction, Chen Mo still decided to choose the third option.

[Profession Requirement]: Mage series professions

[Equipment Requirement]: Level 1

[Equipment Attribute]: Magic Attack +(Profession Star Level*20), Attack Speed +(Profession Star Level*10), Energy Recovery Speed (Profession Star Level*10) points/10 seconds

[Equipment Special Effect]: Energy Missile

[Energy Missile]: You can launch a missile attack on any target within fifty meters of you in the form of a normal attack. The missile's attack speed is equal to your normal attack speed, and the missile's power is equal to your Magic Attack.

[Equipment Introduction]: A special Magic Wand with the ability to launch missiles. It contains the power to connect with the Great Dao and can enjoy the blessing of the Star of Great Dao.

As expected of an intermediate-tier piece of equipment; compared to the low-tier ones, it's a complete qualitative transformation.

Chen Mo looked at the attributes of the Silver-grade Magic Wand, very excited.

At his seven-star level, this Magic Wand directly gave him +140 Magic Attack, +70 Attack Speed, and an energy recovery speed of 70 points every 10 seconds!

Compared with the Bronze-grade attributes, this was a huge improvement!

But Chen Mo had a second thought: if he wasn't dual-class, with his two-star Professional Star Level, then the improvement from this Silver-grade Magic Wand compared to the Bronze-grade one wouldn't be too outrageous.

I wonder how much enhancement a golden-grade weapon will bring!

Seeing the Silver-grade Magic Wand had such a massive improvement, Chen Mo immediately couldn't wait to start synthesizing more!
