A deluge of The Heavenly Path's Hints bombarded him. Before Chen Mo could even read them, Shen Rulong, huffing angrily, walked up to him and said with lingering fear, "You reckless brat! That was a red-named individual. If he had accidentally killed you, not even our resurrection ability could bring you back! How dare you act so recklessly!"

"Exactly! You scared me to death just now, you annoying kid," Su Tianxin also immediately stepped forward and pinched Chen Mo's cheek.

"Teacher, it hurts... It won't happen again." Chen Mo, wincing in pain, quickly begged for mercy.

Although he was scolded, both the Principal and his teacher were clearly angry out of concern for him, and Chen Mo naturally understood their feelings.

"The scare you received earlier might have affected your emotions, and that could potentially influence your performance today. Do you want to apply for a delay in the assessment?" Shen Rulong asked, looking at Chen Mo.

"That won't be necessary, Principal. We from Seaside Second Middle School aren't scared that easily," Chen Mo said, rubbing his cheek while smiling at the Principal.

"You do have some mettle, which probably explains your rash behavior earlier. But you can't act so recklessly anymore, got it?"

Shen Rulong lifted his Magic Wand and rapped Chen Mo on the head.

Professionals can unleash attacks with the power of their undefeated state with every move. However, reality and the game remain distinct. Even though the maximum of everyone's physical abilities is represented by data, they can still control their strength freely.

Take, for example, when Su Tianxin flicked Fang Datong's forehead earlier. If she had used her actual damage to attack Fang Datong, even as a Priest, she could have literally blown his head off.

"I understand." The pain on his face hadn't subsided yet, so Chen Mo immediately rubbed the spot on his head where the Principal had struck.

This time, the Principal's tap wasn't light. Although it didn't cause much damage, it definitely hurt.

It was obviously intended to make Chen Mo remember this lesson.

After he finished speaking, the Principal prepared to restart the assessment.

However, at this moment, Fang Datong noticed something unusual.

"How did you reach Level 5?"

Upon hearing this, Su Tianxin and Shen Rulong immediately turned their attention to Chen Mo.

Concerned for Chen Mo's safety, they hadn't noticed any other changes in him. However, Fang Datong was in a team with Chen Mo.

Being in a team meant that each member's Level, life value, and energy value were synchronously displayed above their heads.

This information was displayed so teammates could promptly assess each other's status and provide appropriate assistance.

Of course, if you were willing, you could also share this information with people outside your team.

Just like in today's assessment, everyone would voluntarily display their life bar and energy bar to the teachers protecting them, so the teachers could judge the situation in time.

As Su Tianxin and Shen Rulong cast a probing spell, they confirmed that Chen Mo's Level had indeed jumped directly to 5.

Name: Chen Mo

Level: 5

A person's attributes can only be probed by others if they choose to make them public. However, Level can be probed by others at will, unless you intentionally use some hiding-type abilities to conceal or alter it.

Seeing the information fed back by the Heavenly Dao, Su Tianxin was the first to show confusion. "Weren't you at Level 1 just a moment ago, kid?"

Shen Rulong, however, was the first to understand. "Perhaps all our Weaken skills earlier nullified Yang Weinan's defenses. This brat then had a skirmish with Yang Weinan and luckily managed to chip away some of his Health, thus gaining kill participation credit for the red-named individual."

"Kill participation for a red-named individual?" Fang Datong asked in confusion. "What does that have to do with Mo suddenly reaching Level 5?"

"Everyone knows that if you kill a red-named individual, you gain half of their total experience points.

But what many people don't know is that if multiple people participate in the kill, then half of the total experience points are distributed among all participants according to their degree of participation."

"Yang Weinan is a Level 30 professional with at least nearly ten million total experience points. Even if Chen Mo got only a thousandth of that, he would have received tens of thousands."

As soon as Shen Rulong finished speaking, the nearby students were dumbfounded.

"Wow, just by tagging a red-named individual, he can get so many experience points! That's way better than farming monsters!"

"No wonder red-named individuals are immediately ganged up on when discovered. Even a small assist earns a considerable amount of experience points."

"I initially thought Chen Mo was unlucky, but now I'm instantly envious. Why wasn't I the one taken hostage?"

"Don't jinx it! Chen Mo was lucky to survive. How can you still think about that? If a red-named individual kills you, resurrection isn't possible. Risking your life for experience points you can get sooner or later? Are you crazy?"

Regarding Chen Mo's accidental windfall, some were envious, while others remained indifferent...

Chen Mo himself, however, was ecstatic.

He had just been reprimanded by the Principal and hadn't had time to review all The Heavenly Path's Hints.

Opening The Heavenly Path's Hints now, he realized he had made a huge profit in experience points.

The Heavenly Path's Hint: You earned 76,880 experience points!

The Heavenly Path's Hint: Congratulations, your Level has increased. Current Level: 2!

The Heavenly Path's Hint: Congratulations, your Level has increased...

...

The Heavenly Path's Hint: Congratulations, your Level has increased. Current Level: 5!

The Heavenly Path's Hint: Your Level has reached 5, and you have hit the first-tier bottleneck. You can now choose the Realm Breakthrough Assessment!

The Heavenly Path's Hint: The Realm Breakthrough Assessment can only be attempted once, regardless of success or failure. If you choose to challenge it, please do so in your best condition.

The Heavenly Path's Hint: If you do not wish to undergo the Realm Breakthrough Assessment, you can choose to break through autonomously. At this stage, you only need to wait one day to break through the Level limit on your own. However, you will be unable to gain or accumulate experience points during this period.

The Realm Breakthrough Assessment is a special challenge that occurs every five levels, which issues a challenge corresponding to your profession.

There are nine difficulties to choose from, ranging from F-Class to SSS-level.

Different challenge difficulties require different amounts of experience points to initiate them and offer varying rewards.

The F-Class difficulty allows for teaming up, so its difficulty is quite low. Basically, anyone can complete it. It only requires twice the experience points needed to level up from 5 to 6 to initiate the challenge.

Upon completion, your Level increases directly from 5 to 6, and your upgradeable level cap is raised to 10, but there are no other rewards.

Choosing the F-Class difficulty challenge might seem like a poor deal, as there are no rewards and it requires double the experience points for leveling up. However, the advantage is that you don't need to wait a day and can continue accumulating experience points to level up.

Otherwise, if you choose autonomous breakthrough, you won't be able to gain or accumulate experience points during that period, effectively wasting an entire day.

However, if you are confident in your abilities and want to seize this once-every-five-levels opportunity to gain benefits from the Realm Breakthrough Assessment, then you need to choose a higher-difficulty challenge.

Starting from E-Class difficulty, teaming up is not allowed; the challenge must be completed alone.

Upon passing, you will receive item rewards appropriate to the difficulty tier and a title reward corresponding to that difficulty.

These titles can enhance attributes, provide special characteristics, provide skills, and more. It occurs once every five levels; missing one chance means having less combat power than others.

So, it is very important to choose an assessment difficulty that matches your own abilities!

Chapter 18: Chapter 18 Level Difference_1

"That's not right, is it? If Mr. Mo is Level 5, doesn't that mean he can't team up with us anymore?"

Seeing Chen Mo reach Level 5, Fang Datong immediately voiced his regret.

He had been planning to hunt monsters with his buddy to show off the power of his new gear.

However, a large level difference generally makes hunting monsters together inefficient.

Under the heavenly path's rule, when teaming up to hunt monsters, Experience is calculated based on the largest level difference within the party. If a slain monster has a level difference with any team member, the Experience Points gained will be reduced accordingly.

This doesn't just apply to teaming up. Even if someone who isn't in the team helps by dealing damage, reducing a monster's Health, or performing actions like lowering a monster's attributes or controlling it to let low-level players get the kill, an Experience penalty will still be applied.

The Experience gained from monsters is fixed: a Level 1 monster gives 1 Experience Point upon being slain, a Level 2 monster gives 2 Experience Points, and so on.

For each level of difference between you and a monster, you will incur an Experience Point penalty when you kill it. You lose 1 Experience Point for each level of difference. After Level 10, this penalty doubles to 2 points per level. After Level 20, it increases to 3 points per level, and this pattern continues for every subsequent 10 levels.

For example, if you are Level 3 in a team and kill a Level 1 monster, the 2-Level difference means the Experience gained will be reduced by 2 points. Since Level 1 monsters only provide 1 Experience Point, this isn't enough to cover the penalty. While the system won't actually subtract Experience from your total, you won't gain any Experience from killing that Level 1 monster.

Special Reminder: This rule only applies to team situations and takes effect only when the level difference between the highest-Level and lowest-Level team members exceeds 2. Normally, a low-level professional killing a high-level monster can gain bonus Experience Points.

Similarly, if you are Level 1 in a team with a large level disparity and your team kills a Level 3 monster, the 2-Level difference means your Experience gained will also be

reduced by 2 points. However, since a Level 3 monster provides 3 Experience Points, even with the penalty, you will still gain at least 1 Experience Point.

If you are Level 13 and kill a Level 11 monster, even though there's only a 2-Level difference, the penalty after Level 10 is 2 points per level. So, for a Level 11 monster that provides 11 Experience Points, you'll have 4 points deducted (2 levels * 2 points/level), meaning you only earn 7 Experience Points.

The same applies if you are Level 23 and kill a Level 21 monster. After Level 20, the penalty is 3 points per level. You'll be deducted 6 Experience Points (2 levels * 3 points/level). So, a Level 21 monster, which would normally give 21 Experience Points, will only yield 15 Experience Points.

The reverse is also true when in a team. If you are Level 11 and kill a Level 13 monster, the penalty is still based on the 2-Level difference. Post-Level 10, this is 2 points per level, so a 4-point deduction. A Level 13 monster (13 EP) would yield 9 Experience Points. If you are Level 21 killing a Level 23 monster, the penalty (post-Level 20) is 3 points per level, so a 6-point deduction. A Level 23 monster (23 EP) would yield 17 Experience Points.

If there are multiple different levels in the team, Experience Points are penalized based on the largest level difference found between any single team member and the monster.

For example, if your team has members at Levels 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, and you collectively kill a Level 5 monster.

According to the maximum level difference rule, the heavenly path's rule will apply penalties based on this largest gap. The difference between the Level 1 member and the Level 5 monster is 4 Levels. Therefore, the Experience Points provided by the Level 5 monster (normally 5 EP) will be reduced by 4 points, leaving only 1 Experience Point.

And this 1 Experience Point must then be shared among all team members.

This means that for a five-person team with members from Level 1 to Level 5 killing a Level 5 monster, each player ultimately gains only 0.2 Experience Points.

Because of these rules, it's very difficult for high-level players to power-level low-level players.

As long as the level difference within your team is significant, whether you're helping low-level players kill low-level monsters or high-level monsters, the substantial level-difference penalties will severely reduce the Experience gain for all team members.

The same applies to item drop rates.

After killing a monster, for each level of difference (based on the maximum level difference as determined before), the monster's item drop rate is reduced by 10%.

Using the previous example of the Level 1 to 5 party: if they kill a Level 5 monster together, the presence of the Level 1 member creates a 4-Level difference, so the monster's drop rate is reduced by 40%.

Similarly, even if not formally teamed up, if a high-level individual intervenes in a fight—whether by helping with damage, using control Skills, debuff Skills, or any other combat-related Skill—this intervention will affect the drop rate. The drop rate penalty will be calculated based on the level difference between this intervening high-level individual and the monster.

The Heavenly Dao's detection is extremely strict; it offers no such loopholes to exploit!

The only exception involves healing-type professions. They can heal from outside the team. As long as they only restore Health and don't cast any enhancing buffs on those fighting, it's not considered intervention.

This is the only way a high-level player can help low-level players improve their monster-hunting efficiency without incurring penalties.

However, thankfully, the heavenly path's rule is also quite reasonable. Where there are penalties, there are also balancing factors and rewards.

All the above restrictions on assisting low-level players apply only when there's a large level difference within a team or when an outsider interferes.

If the level difference between the highest-Level and lowest-Level members in a team does not exceed 2 Levels, Experience after killing a monster is calculated based on the team's average Level, and there are no Experience penalties for killing monsters of a higher level than the team average.

And if you are solo and manage to kill a high-level monster on your own, not only will you avoid Experience Point and drop rate penalties, but you'll actually receive rewards.

The reward rules are the inverse of the penalty rules.

If you are Level 1 and solo-kill a Level 5 monster, you earn the base 5 Experience Points plus a bonus of 4 Experience Points for the level difference, totaling 9 Experience Points.

Similarly, if you are Level 1 and solo-kill a Level 5 monster, its item drop rate will be increased by an additional 40%.

Clearly, while the heavenly path's rule limits high-level players from power-leveling low-level ones, they also provide benefits for capable low-level players to advance quickly.

Everyone is very familiar with these rules.

That's why Fang Datong was so frustrated. If Chen Mo joined their team, the level difference would become too large.

Regardless of what Level monster they decided to hunt, the returns wouldn't be good.

Hunting Level 1 monsters: Chen Mo, at Level 5, would cause a 4-point Experience penalty (a 4-Level difference). Since Level 1 monsters give 1 EP, this results in $1 - 4 = 0$ EP (as it can't go negative). No gain.

Hunting Level 2 monsters: Chen Mo (Level 5) would cause a 3-point Experience penalty (a 3-Level difference). Level 2 monsters give 2 EP. Result: $2 - 3 = 0$ EP. No gain.

Hunting Level 4 monsters: The largest level difference would be between a Level 1 party member (like Fang Datong) and the Level 4 monster (3 Levels). This incurs a 3-point Experience penalty. Level 4 monsters give 4 EP. Result: $4 - 3 = 1$ EP (to be shared).

Hunting Level 5 monsters: The largest level difference would be between a Level 1 party member and the Level 5 monster (4 Levels). This incurs a 4-point Experience penalty. Level 5 monsters give 5 EP. Result: $5 - 4 = 1$ EP (to be shared).

Hunting Level 3 monsters: The level difference between Chen Mo (L5) and the L3 monster is 2 Levels. The difference between a Level 1 party member and the L3 monster is also 2 Levels. So the penalty is 2 Experience Points. Level 3 monsters give 3 EP. Result: $3 - 2 = 1$ EP (to be shared).

And this single Experience Point would have to be shared among all teammates. Divided up, each person gets practically nothing. For a team of four, where perhaps three are fighting monsters above their Level, the shared Experience would be pitifully small. Such a team would be pointless and inefficient.

"Since Chen Mo is already Level 5, he shouldn't continue with this team. He should prepare for the Realm Breakthrough Assessment immediately.

Yesterday, a team from Class Three mentioned they were short on people; only two had signed up. Datong, Bingbing, and you, the girl from Class Four—the three of you should team up with those two."

After all, with such a significant level difference, it's just not suitable.

Hearing Su Tianxin's words, Chen Mo and the others didn't say anything more and willingly disbanded their small party.

Chapter 19: Chapter 19: SSS-level Assessment Difficulty!_1

After Fang Datong and the others left, Su Tianxin turned to Chen Mo and said, "Chen Mo, considering your professional level, you might want to avoid high-difficulty tasks. I suggest you choose the F-Class difficulty for the assessment. After all, you've just received a significant amount of experience points. Losing double wouldn't hurt much."

Chen Mo nodded. "Hmm, I'll look into it."

"Alright then. If you have any questions later, feel free to ask me or the Principal and the others. For now, you should stay near the Principal and his group to prevent any further incidents. I need to go protect Datong and the others, so I can't stay here with you."

"Okay."

Watching Su Tianxin enter the forest, Chen Mo refocused his attention on the semi-transparent floating window that only he could see. He didn't rush to review the difficulty levels of the assessment tasks. First, he examined the title he had unexpectedly obtained from participating in the kill of the red-named individuals.

[S-level Title - Law Enforcers]

[Title Level]: LV1

[Title Experience]: 0/10 (Earn 1 point of experience for each red-named individual killed in an assist, 10 points of experience for each solo kill.)

[Title Effect]: All Attributes increased by 10 points. When attacking a red-named individual, damage inflicted increases by 10%.

[Title Introduction]: Red-named individuals are sinners manifested by the Heavenly Dao. Killing them is to enact justice on behalf of the Heavenly Dao. As a novice Law Enforcer, you are just starting out. Continue to purge evil, and you shall receive greater rewards.

What a powerful title! And it's even growable! Even at Level 1, it provides a full 10 points to All Attributes! Chen Mo exclaimed internally after reading the title's description. After all, the attribute-boosting titles others excitedly showed off usually only provided a one or two-point increase to a single attribute. Who had ever seen such a generous boost to All Attributes?

Chen Mo's astonishment was understandable; among all the ways to gain significant attribute boosts, the Law Enforcer title was one of the easiest to obtain. However, 'easy'

is relative, as it wasn't actually simple. After all, being killed by red-named individuals meant permanent death, and most red-named individuals were desperados with multiple lives on their hands. Confronting such people was an extremely dangerous affair in itself. Not just anyone could easily acquire such a title.

After reviewing the title's effects, Chen Mo allocated his attribute points. Having just leveled up to 5 in one go, his seven-star profession granted 70 attribute points per level. Thus, he had instantly gained a full 280 freely allocable attribute points. Chen Mo allocated these points according to his previous method.

At this moment, Chen Mo's attributes were:

[Name]: Chen Mo

[Grade]: Seven-Star (Two-star + Five hidden stars)

[Profession]: Skeleton Mage (initial profession), Infinite Fusion Master (Hidden initial profession)

[Level]: Level 5

[Experience]: 71,880/5,500 (first-tier bottleneck)

[Attributes]:

Constitution 70 = Life 2,100, Physical Defense 350, Life Recovery 70 points/10 seconds

Strength 20 = Physical Attack 60

Agility 20 = Critical Damage +20%

Wisdom 205 = Magic Attack 895

Spirit 205 = Energy 10,250, Magic Defense 1,025, Energy Recovery 345 points/10 seconds

With attributes like these, a two-star professional would probably not even measure up after reaching Level 10 and equipping a full set of Level 10 gear.

Of the more than 76,000 experience points he had just acquired, leveling from 1 to 5 had only consumed 5,000. He still had over 70,000 left, enough for Chen Mo to choose any Realm Breakthrough Assessment. After all, the entry fee for even the most difficult SSS-level assessment was only 10 times the experience needed to go from Level 5 to Level 6, which amounted to just 55,000 experience points.

This is just C-Class difficulty, and the requirements are already so outrageous. Are these tasks even meant for humans? Chen Mo couldn't help but think to himself, *No wonder I've barely heard of anyone choosing high-difficulty assessments. These Realm Breakthrough Assessments are truly insane!*

He then looked at the B-Class difficulty. Good heavens, the B-Class difficulty was even more outrageous: kill two BOSSes within an hour.

A god-grade BOSS at Level 5! This is outrageous! They really dare to issue such assessment tasks!

The greatest difference between god-grade and ordinary characters is that ordinary characters only possess characteristic effects, while god-grade characters possess divinity effects, which are vastly more powerful! For instance, an ordinary Solid characteristic might reduce Physical Damage taken by 5%, whereas the Solid divinity provides a tenfold effect, reducing Physical Damage by a full 50%! So, even if everyone appears to be the same level, the effects of another's divinity alone could put them leagues ahead of you!

After reading the introduction for the SSS-level assessment difficulty, Chen Mo had initially planned to give up on such a high-difficulty task. However, he then noticed a "Calculate Pass Probability" option in the bottom right corner. This was a free testing opportunity; it would be a waste not to try. Chen Mo immediately clicked it.
