In this magical world, much like an online game, there were four types of quality tiers.

The quality tiers for Skill Books were as follows:

Lower Three Tiers: White, Green, Blue

Middle Three Tiers: Orange, Yellow, Purple

Upper Three Tiers: Red, Black, Gold

The quality tiers for Equipment were as follows:

Lower Three Tiers: Stone Grey, Black Iron, Bronze

Middle Three Tiers: Silver, Gold, Platinum

Upper Three Tiers: Purple Gold, Dark Gold, Artifact

The quality tiers for Items were as follows:

Lower Three Tiers: Normal, Exquisite, Superior

Middle Three Tiers: Rare, Ultra-Rare, Epic

Upper Three Tiers: Legend, Mythical, Mythological

The difficulty ratings were as follows:

Easy: F-Class, E-Class, D-Class

Hard: C-Class, B-Class, A-Class

Extreme: S-level, SS-level, SSS-level

The backpack Chen Mo had just synthesized was an item. The ten-cubic-meter backpack he created barely reached the Exquisite tier within the Lower Three Tiers of items. Of course, since it's a Lower Tier, not all Exquisite-tier items can reach the price of ten million. Only special spatial treasures like backpacks could command such a price. For instance, some regular Exquisite-quality potions only sold for a little over a hundred dollars.

Now in possession of a ten-cubic-meter backpack, Chen Mo easily packed all the Dark Wands and the bundle of Skeleton Summoning Skill Books into it.

After bidding goodbye to the old lady, Chen Mo immediately rushed back home without stopping.

Having just tested the power of his Composing Ability, he naturally couldn't wait to synthesize the Skeleton Summoning Skill Books to see what happened.

As the world had undergone tremendous changes, over half of the global regions were now occupied by various monster-filled secret realms, further reducing humanity's living areas. Consequently, those from poor families could only live in such crowded dwellings. Fortunately, Chen Mo's family was relatively lucky. Their home was located next to the building's outer wall, allowing it to receive sunlight. Even if it was just the

afternoon sun, it was somewhat more comfortable than the rooms in the middle of the building, which were permanently dark.

As he unlocked and opened the door, Chen Mo heard a crosstalk performance playing on the television inside. "You all say that Teacher Yu has three hobbies: smoking, drinking, and getting his hair permed. But he actually has a fourth hobby that none of you know about..."

"There's a fourth one? Don't tell them, even I don't know about it. Go on, tell us."

"Another one is that he likes to wear hats?"

"Wear hats?"

"Hmm, and he's particularly picky about the color."

"What color?"

"It has to be green. He won't wear any other color..."

"Oh, come on!"

After a moment, the sounds of two people fighting came from the TV.

Chen Mo found it amusing and promptly went over to watch with interest.

When the segment ended, he noticed his foster mother, Liu Yiyi, asleep on the sofa. Her delicate features showed a hint of fatigue.

Seeing her sleeping soundly, Chen Mo quickly and quietly turned off the TV, fetched a blanket, and gently covered her with it.

Having done this, he tiptoed back to his room.

After closing the door, he promptly emptied his backpack, dumping out all the Skill Books and Magic Wands he had just bought.

First, he picked up three [Skeleton Summoning-White] Skill Books and placed them all into the material slots of the translucent floating window before him.

As the skills fused, the White-tier [Skeleton Summoning·White] skill upgraded into a Green-tier Corpse Squad skill.

Just from the name, it was clear that the number of summons had increased. In addition to the base upgrade, Chen Mo could even choose one of three special effects to add.

Since only one skill of the same origin could be learned (the highest-rank one would be kept), they couldn't be learned repeatedly. All these Green-tier skills originated from the "White Skeleton Summoning" skill. So, even if he synthesized three different ones, he could only learn one. Naturally, he had to choose carefully.

The first option's special effect allowed the summoned Skeleton Monsters to enter an invisible state, only revealing themselves when they attacked. After a period of not attacking, they would return to an invisible state.

While useful for ambushes, it doesn't significantly boost their actual combat effectiveness.

The second and third options, however, could enhance actual combat effectiveness.

The second option, the bomb effect, meant that the summoned Skeleton Monsters could be detonated, either by Chen Mo's command or automatically when the Skeleton

Monster was killed. The explosion radius was quite large—a sphere with a ten-meter radius—and the damage scaled with the Skeleton Monster's Life.

The third option's special effect modified the Skeleton Monsters' Normal Attacks. Each damaging attack would apply one stack of corpse poison to the target. Each stack of corpse poison reduced the target's healing effects by 1%, and when the corpse poison accumulated to one hundred stacks, it would trigger a high-damage poison explosion.

After reading the effect descriptions, Chen Mo fell into hesitation. Except for the first one, both the second and third options were very tempting.

Imagine each Skeleton Monster as an area-of-effect bomb! With them exploding everywhere, wouldn't clearing monsters be incredibly fast?

The corpse poison is also great, especially for fighting a BOSS. It can significantly reduce the BOSS's regeneration and potentially trigger high poison explosion damage, allowing for a quicker kill.

One was practical for area-of-effect damage, the other for single-target situations. It was indeed a difficult choice!
