After making his reward choices, Chen Mo grew curious about how the second wave of the Beast Swarm Army would operate.

I've almost completely wiped out the front line of Demon Beasts. How will they dispatch the second wave? he thought.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Your SSS-level title "Divine-Slayer Challenger" has reached Level 3!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Your SSS-level title "Pioneer" has reached Level 5!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Congratulations on passing the SSS-level assessment! You have acquired the mythical-grade equipment, the 'Life-And-Death Emblem'!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: As you completed this assessment with a perfect score, you will be able to choose any difficulty level for your next Realm Breakthrough Assessment without consuming experience points!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: As you completed this assessment with a perfect score, you have received an additional 'SSS-level Realm Breakthrough Assessment Clearing Scroll'!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: This assessment is now over. In 3 seconds, you will be teleported back to your original world!]

Life-And-Death Emblem? What is that?

Chen Mo immediately checked the effects of this newly acquired item.

Chapter 248: The Activity of the Milky Way Begins! (Three in One, 5/5)_1

[Life-And-Death Emblem - Mythical-Grade]

[Item Passive Effect]: When carried, the owner can take damage from only one unit per second.
(Effective even inside the backpack)

[Item Active Effect]: Upon activation, this effect ignores all barriers and designates a unit within a radius of (100 * Level) meters as your death-duel target, forcibly pulling them to within one hundred meters of you. During this period, neither party can voluntarily leave a one-hundred-meter radius around the other. This continues until one party dies!

Upon entering Life-And-Death status, neither party can harm units other than their death-duel target, and the target's All Attributes will be suppressed by 50%.

This effect cannot be negated or dispelled! Cooldown: 1 hour. (Can be activated from within the backpack)

[Item Introduction]: This item is a favorite of the War God. If he sets his sights on you, you can only pray for good luck!

"What a perverse item! Isn't this a complete counter to us Summoners? Since it can't be negated or dispelled, once you're hit by it, there's no escape."

Chen Mo was speechless after reading the item's effects.

If someone else had this item, even his thousands of troops would be useless. After all, the enemy can only take damage from one unit per second. So, even if I had hundreds of millions of units attacking simultaneously, the enemy would only take damage from one of them.

This is definitely a powerful item that counters the summon series!

This single effect alone is enough to be considered god-tier!

Besides this, it also has an extremely overpowered one-on-one effect. Once an enemy is designated, they are forced into a direct confrontation. If they don't engage, their inability to attack other units effectively neutralizes their combat power.

Even if the enemy wanted to fight me to the death, it would be difficult for them to launch an effective counterattack with their attribute values suppressed by 50%.

This item is incredibly useful against multiple enemies and in one-on-one fights!

Chen Mo inwardly sighed in relief that he hadn't encountered this kind of enemy before; otherwise, he certainly would have been in trouble!

However, he wasn't particularly afraid of others having this item now.

After all, he had obtained the Dominator's Power Skill!

He could absorb all of his summons to greatly enhance his own combat power.

Even in a one-on-one fight, he wouldn't be afraid anymore.

Just as Chen Mo finished inspecting the Life-And-Death Emblem, he was teleported out of the instance.

Back in his room, before he had time to check his recent Harvest, a series of prompts from the Heavenly Path arrived.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Your Level has increased, current Level 16!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Your Level has increased, current Level 17!]

...

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Your Level has increased, current Level 20!]

[Experience Points]: 5,827,938 / 375,200

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Your Level has reached 20, hitting the fourth-tier bottleneck. You can choose to undertake a Realm Breakthrough Assessment!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Detected: You have not yet undergone your profession's first-transition. Please complete your profession's first-transition before undertaking the Realm Breakthrough Assessment!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: As your initial combat profession is five-stars, the difficulty of the profession's first-transition challenge you can choose ranges from six-star to ten-star!]

It had been some time since the perfect completions of the Level 5 and Level 10 Realm Breakthrough Assessments. For the sound of the great path to ring out again today, around the same time as the announcement concerning the five-stars initial hidden profession, was truly unexpected.

The Level 15 SSS-level Realm Breakthrough Assessment, which had been quiet for several days, had finally been perfectly conquered by someone!

Title Introduction: Even when facing a God, you can bravely challenge and slay it. Your power will ultimately surpass Divine Power!

Oh? I got another new skill effect? Godslaying Secret Technique can control a god-grade unit for a full 5 seconds? That's insane! It's almost cheating!

Chen Mo hadn't expected to receive such a powerful effect.

Moreover, the effect of Godslaying Heart had also been enhanced, now able to nullify two divinities of a god-grade unit. That was a major upgrade.

[SSS Rank Title—Pioneer]

Title Level: LV5

Title Experience: Maxed

Title Effect: All Attributes +500. When alone, experience points gain +1000%, and recover 100% of maximum life value and energy value per second.

Title Skill: The Pioneer's Light, Pioneer Glory

[The Pioneer's Light-Golden Passive]: The Pioneer's radiance illuminates all darkness and dispels all confusion. When alone, you can perceive all information within a (100 x Level) meter radius (including invisible units).

Current Effect: Active (Can be toggled on or off at will)

[Pioneer Glory-Golden Passive]: Your glory astounds all beings. Monsters will not proactively attack you. Your pets will always maintain maximum affinity and loyalty towards you.

Title Introduction: As a Pioneer, you always forge ahead alone, blazing a trail for those who follow. Even enemies are moved by your presence and will not harm you readily!

The five-star title is a huge improvement from before, its effects have doubled!

Chapter 250: The Activity of the Milky Way Begins! (Three in One, 5/5)_3

Chen Mo remembered that at four-star, his recovery was only 40% per second. Based on the usual pattern, five-stars should have meant 50%, but to his surprise, it directly doubled to 100%. His sensing range also doubled.

That wasn't even the most crucial part. The most critical aspect was obtaining a very powerful title Skill.

He knew that maintaining a pet's affection and loyalty in the future would be an incredibly costly endeavor. If these two pet statuses never declined, he could save a considerable amount of money and effort. Furthermore, possessing this title would also prevent monsters from actively attacking him, which was another very powerful life-saving ability. In the future, when facing monsters, as long as Chen Mo didn't strike first, he would essentially be safe and sound.

After reviewing the two powerful titles, Chen Mo finally took out the SSS-level Gift Pack that the sound of the great path had just announced as his reward.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: You have successfully opened the SSS-level Gift Pack. Congratulations, you have obtained Bound Equipment "Transfer Ring: Artifact Level"!]

[Transfer Ring: Artifact Level]

[Profession Restriction]: None

[Equipment Requirement]: None

[Equipment Attribute]: All Teleport abilities are unobstructed by space!

[Equipment Special Effects]: Group Teleportation, Group Recall

[[Group Teleportation]] : You can designate all units within a 10,000-meter radius and teleport all units not resistant to your teleportation to a teleport marker point. Up to ten teleport markers can exist simultaneously. One marker is restored every minute. Current available teleport markers: "10/10". Teleportation chant duration: 1 second.

[[Group Recall]] : You can recall all units bearing your recall markers who do not resist being recalled to your side, regardless of distance. You can mark an unlimited number of units. Recall Cooldown: 1 second.

[Equipment Introduction]: A powerful ring capable of quickly executing group teleportation and recall, possessing extremely high strategic value.

Group Teleportation, interesting. Paired with my Divine Flicker, doesn't this mean I can set up teleport marker points wherever I want? Its capability for group ambushes or group life-saving is truly first-rate!

Although this ring didn't offer any immediate combat power enhancement for Chen Mo at his current stage, it was definitely a good item. Even if he couldn't use it right away, he could wear it for now.

After inspecting all his Harvest, Chen Mo began to consider how to gain experience points.

At Level 20, grinding for experience points in the wilderness wouldn't yield much, unless one encountered The Master of Mutation. Besides entering instanced dungeons, the only ways to quickly obtain a large amount of experience points were to hunt red-named individuals or find Rift Dungeons.

However, red-named individuals were actually not easy to find. Everyone cherished their life, and red-named individuals knew that being found basically meant certain death, so they would definitely hide far, far away—unless they had only recently escaped. This was like the red-named individual Chen Mo had encountered before. Should I hunt red-named individuals, or find a Rift Dungeon?

Yes, this time it wasn't just the Solar System; the sound of the great path echoed throughout the entire Milky Way!

"Attention all professionals! Attention all professionals! This month's special event, 'Survival Game,' is about to begin!

Please check The Heavenly Path's Hint to understand the relevant rules. The special event will start in 10 minutes."

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: The special event 'Survival Game' is about to begin. This instance has two modes!

The first mode is 'Leisure Mode'.

Once it opens, all professionals can enter. It will be divided into a total of 100 million competition zones, with each zone accommodating 100 participants. Entry is granted to those who register first.

In Leisure Mode, all professionals will use data-based Avatars of equal strength to participate in the event. No penalties will be incurred for death, and the final surviving professionals will receive a small amount of experience points and S-level rewards.

The second mode is 'Slaughter Mode'.

Slaughter Mode requires participants to enter with their real bodies, relying on their original strength. It is not a balanced mode. Once killed, if a participant lacks the ability for resurrection, it will be considered a permanent death. Please participate with extreme caution.

Slaughter Mode rules: Survive for 12 hours in the special 'Survival Game' instance map! During this period, the more opponents you eliminate, the richer the rewards you will be able to Harvest! The kill counts accumulated by the opponents you eliminate will ultimately be added to your own. If you can

eliminate all other participants on the same map within 12 hours, you will receive a large amount of experience points and SSS-level rewards!

Note: The 'Survival Game' instance contains a large quantity of powerful equipment, items, Skills, and other supplies that can be used temporarily. Each participant can freely search for and pick up these supplies within the instance, bind them for use, and thereby enhance their survivability and combat power! However, each person can bind a maximum of only five such items per instance. Once this limit of five bound items is exceeded, any additional special supplies picked up within the instance cannot be used.
