At this point, even the person nearest to Chen Mo was still a considerable distance away.

This was much farther than the distance between the trio and any nearby individuals.

After a little while, the group of three had grown into a group of ten.

They themselves found it rather absurd. Ten prominent second-transition powerhouses, yet they chose to collaborate just to deal with a zeroth-transition level 20 professional! If word got out, they would feel somewhat embarrassed. But what could they do? This man was too unpredictable—his removal was a necessity. No one wanted to die in confusion. They would accept it if they were defeated in an equal fight! But being killed by a zeroth-transition level 20 in such a bewildering manner would leave them restless even in death!

With the establishment of the ten-person squad, Chen Mo had finally reached his target.

The main reason was that Chen Mo wasn't flying at maximum speed, because he had observed something peculiar en route.

Initially, two Aliens met. Surprisingly, they didn't fight. Instead, they teamed up and then found a third Alien.

Then, these three Aliens also refrained from fighting. They too joined forces and began searching for a fourth Alien...

This peculiar behavior baffled Chen Mo no end. It was a single-person instance with single-person rewards, and additional benefits came from killing one another. Why were they teaming up? Were there any notable BOSSes in the instance? BOSSes with high rewards? This wasn't likely; as per the nature of this instance, only a few people would survive in the end. Is their alliance necessary? Even if they kill the BOSS, could they even take the rewards out in the end? Or perhaps, each one was overly confident? Did

they all believe that teaming up with others to fight the BOSS was just doing the dirty work, only for someone else to reap the rewards?

In any case, these people's actions were extremely bizarre.

After observing for a while, Chen Mo discovered they had already formed a ten-member squad.

This was truly baffling.

However, Chen Mo still hadn't figured out their specific motives.

He could only continue monitoring their activities.

Soon, another kill notification flashed within the instance.

Chen Mo effortlessly killed the nearby second-transition full-level-full-star expert.

This person was also quite powerful, but his abilities were heavily skewed towards damage output. And his damage output was abnormally high. Some of his damage Skills, when cast, would put him into an Invincible State. Moreover, his damage output was terrifyingly high.

If Chen Mo hadn't been so durable that he could stand there and let his opponent attack him without dying, anyone else would have perished countless times already.

The enemy was invincible while attacking, and his combos were fast, making it hard to find an opening when he wasn't invincible. However, Chen Mo employed an unexpected strategy. That strategy was to deploy eight hundred thousand Skeleton Monsters to surround him in a continuous self-destruction sequence.

With 80 Skeleton Monsters self-destructing per second, this barrage could continue for 10,000 seconds—nearly three hours.

Each of Chen Mo's Skeleton Monsters now possessed over 650,000 Health; let's call it an even 650,000.

With 80 Skeleton Monsters detonating simultaneously, they could inflict 52,000,000 self-destruction damage per second.

The Skeleton Monsters' self-destruction damage was fixed damage, even without using the Almighty Converter.

Fixed damage bypassed defensive power and directly reduced Health. If the opponent lacked damage reduction abilities, a mere one-second window when he wasn't invincible would be enough to kill him.

Even if the opponent had damage reduction, and even if Chen Mo's Skeleton Monsters had no damage-increasing abilities of their own (meaning their damage might theoretically be entirely negated by a strong enough defense), the maximum effective damage reduction in the system was 99%.

Normally, fixed damage couldn't benefit from critical hits. However, Chen Mo possessed the God-Grade Critical Strike Aura!

The God-Grade Critical Strike Aura ensured that any damage inflicted by friendly units near Chen Mo would always be a critical hit.

The fixed damage from the Skeleton Monsters' self-destruction naturally fell under the scope of "any damage."

Previously, even a critical hit would only double the damage.

However, the current Skeleton Monsters were different. Now, influenced by the shared Critical Damage from Chen Mo's Magic Wand, if the fixed damage from their self-destruction triggered a critical hit, it would be amplified by over a hundredfold from its base!

Chen Mo had 16,236% Critical Damage, equivalent to a 162-times multiplier. If the 52,000,000 base damage was boosted 162 times by this Critical Damage, then reduced by 99%, it would still inflict 84,240,000 damage.

Therefore, even assuming maximum damage reduction, the slightest moment he wasn't in an Invincible State would mean he'd suffer a full 84,240,000 points of fixed damage—an amount high enough to blast him to death instantly!

The outcome was inevitable. After a brief, futile struggle, the opponent died.

Dealing with him had been no challenge at all.

While Chen Mo dispatched his target with ease, the ten observers grew increasingly horrified.

Except for the one with the infinite coordinates, the others had been skeptical. While they found Chen Mo incredibly strange and suspected Yun Zhi could only have died at his hands, they hadn't been entirely sure of his true capabilities.
