As Chen Mo stepped into the eighth layer, he saw the space had transformed into an arena.

An arena? What's this for?

Just as Chen Mo was wondering about the purpose of this layer, a beam of light suddenly flashed before him, revealing a strange, entirely black humanoid creature.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: The trial for the Trial Tower's Eighth Layer now officially begins. The content for the eighth layer is an endurance trial.

Enemies on this layer, upon defeat, will continuously reappear with increased Divine Power. You will have no time to resupply during this period, so please monitor your condition carefully.

Defeat the enemy ten times to clear this layer. If at any point you feel outmatched, you can press the 'Abort Trial' button at any time!]

Continuously increasing Divine Power? That's a bit insane. I wonder how much it increases each time.

Chen Mo scanned the strange black humanoid creature before him. It possessed no skills or abilities, only a mere 50 points of Divine Power.

It doesn't seem too difficult to deal with, at least for now.

Fifty Divine Power was clearly insufficient. A single volley of combined attacks had instantly obliterated it.

However, as soon as it was slain and fell, a surge of Rule Power flowed into its body. In the next instant, it sprang up from its prone position, as vigorous as ever.

Checking its attributes now, Chen Mo saw its Divine Power had already climbed to 55 points.

If its Divine Power increases by 5 points each time, and the Heavenly Path's Hint said I need to kill it ten times to pass... does that mean this creature's Divine Power could reach almost 100 points?

As Chen Mo's Skeleton Monster continued to instantly defeat it, the black humanoid creature kept reviving, growing stronger each time it stood up.

It was quickly defeated nine times. As the creature stood up for the tenth time, its Divine Power had reached 95 points.

With its Divine Power now 85 points higher than Chen Mo's own 10 points, the damage dealt by Chen Mo's Skeleton Monster was reduced by 85%.

But its Health was only a little over 60 billion. Even with an 85% damage reduction, it couldn't withstand the Skeleton Monster's burst damage.

Even without Undying Worship and the Amplification Divine Ring, the remaining 15% of the Skeleton Monster's damage was enough to inflict over 500 billion total damage, more than enough to instantly defeat it.

It was still a complete rout.

The Divine Power on the eighth layer went up to 95 points. How high will it get on the top two layers?

When the passage and stairs to the next level appeared, Chen Mo headed straight up.

The ninth layer was still the same arena.

However, the rules had changed.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: The trial for the Ninth Layer of the Trial Tower now officially begins. The content for the ninth layer is an endurance trial.

The attributes of the enemy on this layer are equivalent to a level 20 first-transition team BOSS. Initially, its Divine Power is 100 points, and your Divine Power is considered 100. Thereafter, every minute, your effective Divine Power will decrease by 5 points, while the enemy's Divine Power will increase by 5 points. This will continue until your effective Divine Power drops to your original Divine Power.

If at any point you feel outmatched, you can press the 'Abort Trial' button at any time!]

A team BOSS? 100 Divine Power? How much Health would that be?

Soon, a bizarre, blood-red figure materialized before Chen Mo.

Chen Mo immediately scanned its attributes. Good heavens! This creature possessed a staggering 36.75 trillion Health, over 700,000 attack power, and nearly one million defensive power.

Fortunately, like the creature on the first layer, it had no skills or abilities—just exceptionally high Divine Power.

Of course, sheer high Divine Power was sometimes enough to be overwhelming.

Initially, the enemy possessed 100 Divine Power, while Chen Mo's Divine Power was merely treated as 100. This meant the enemy's attributes were genuine. Chen Mo's Divine Power being treated as 100 was solely to offset the enemy's; his actual Divine Power was still only 10.

Under such conditions, defeating the enemy quickly would be truly challenging.

After all, the longer the fight dragged on, the harder it would become.

The disparity between them would progressively widen. During the first minute, with no effective difference in Divine Power, both could inflict 100% damage. However, each subsequent minute, the enemy would gain 5 Divine Power while Chen Mo's effective Divine Power would decrease by 5. This created a 10-point relative Divine Power shift each minute, widening the gap in their damage capabilities.

The longer it went on, the less damage Chen Mo would be able to inflict.

Although the enemy's Health was incredibly high, the damage output of Chen Mo's Skeleton Monster was nothing to scoff at.

Chapter 344: Eternal Divine Weapon! (Five-in-one, 5/10)_2

Even without factoring in critical hits, the Skeleton Monsters could instantly kill previous monsters. However, this new foe would be different; critical hits would be essential. But with Chen Mo's God-Grade Critical Strike Aura active, it was impossible not to land a critical hit.

Once the two million Skeleton Monsters unleashed their critical hits, paired with the effect of the Balanced Magic Wand sharing Critical Damage, a single round of burst damage could reach 219 trillion without any reduction. The total Health of this blood-red creature was only 36 trillion.

In a single exchange, Chen Mo easily dispatched the opponent, who didn't even get a chance to react.

The Ninth Floor, originally considered quite difficult, was practically a freebie for Chen Mo. He completed its trial within seconds.

This final stage of the extreme trials seems much simpler than the leader trial of the second stage.

After quickly dealing with the BOSS on the ninth floor, Chen Mo easily stepped onto the tenth floor.

I wonder what trial will be set for me on this final floor.

Chen Mo was looking forward to the trial on the final floor.

As Chen Mo stepped onto the last floor, The Heavenly Path's Hint followed closely.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: The trial of the Tenth Floor of the Trial Tower has officially begun. The trial of the tenth floor is the extreme trial.]

The enemy on this floor has attributes equivalent to a level 20 first-transition Golden BOSS, and its Divine Power is 100 points higher than yours. Every minute that passes, the opponent's Divine Power will decrease by 1 point.

If you feel you cannot overcome this challenge, you may press the 'End Trial' button at any time!]

That's ridiculous! His Divine Power is 100 points higher than mine. Doesn't that mean I can't inflict any damage? So, I have to suffer for a minute?

The peculiar impact of Divine Power stems from its application at the very end of the damage calculation, not during any intermediate steps.

To illustrate an 'intermediate step,' consider having 100 attack power against an opponent with 150 defensive power. Your damage would be reduced by their defense, perhaps to around 50 points. If both parties also had damage increase or reduction effects at this point, these would further alter the damage. For instance, if the opponent also possessed a 50% damage reduction effect, you might only inflict about 25 points. However, if you were dealing true damage, you could bypass both defensive power and damage reduction, directly inflicting the full 100 points of true damage.

In these three scenarios—whether you deal 50 points of normal damage, 25 points after damage reduction, or the full 100 points of true damage—the damage output is determined after all influencing factors (like attack-defense differentials, damage modifiers, damage types, critical hit probability, etc.) are compiled. This result is typically considered the 'pre-Divine Power final damage.'

Usually, at this stage, no further data participates in the settlement. However, a few exceptional effects can still modify this value. These are final damage enhancement, final damage reduction, and Divine Power.

These three factors have the lowest calculation priority, with Divine Power being the absolute last. In other words, Divine Power only comes into play after all other damage calculations are complete.

At that stage, any damage increases, true damage properties, or Critical Damage bonuses are effectively irrelevant for this specific step. This is because those parameters have already been factored into the preceding calculations to determine your base damage output. Once all other calculations are done, if your base calculated damage is 100 points, but your Divine Power is 99 points lower than your opponent's, you will only inflict 1% of that damage—just 1 point. And if this Divine Power disparity reaches 100 points, you will inflict 0% damage, meaning you can't deal even a single point of damage.

This is the origin of the saying that 'everyone below the fifth-transition is an ant.' As long as a fifth-transition individual possesses 100 Divine Power, all your abilities against them will result in 0% effectiveness. Whether you apply status effects or deal true damage, the final outcome of any calculation will be zero; you cannot harm them in the slightest.

This illustrates the power of Divine Power as a final damage adjudicator. Of course, while Divine Power is exceptionally potent for defense due to its final calculation step, this isn't always advantageous on the offensive side. For example, if your initial damage is 10 points, but it's completely nullified by the opponent's stacked damage reduction before the Divine Power step, then the damage value to be amplified by Divine Power is zero. In this case, no matter how high your Divine Power is, amplifying zero still results in zero damage. Conversely, if Divine Power were to be factored in earlier in the calculation, your damage output could be significantly higher. This highlights the double-edged nature of Divine Power: the defensive advantage it provides through late-stage calculation can become an offensive limitation.

However, this offensive drawback is generally quite manageable. For instance, if you deal true damage, you can bypass an opponent's defensive power and damage reduction, ensuring high base damage. This damage would then only be affected by final damage reduction. The impact of final damage reduction is typically much lower. Then, a subsequent boost from your own Divine Power can further increase your

final damage output. After all, the maximum effect of final damage reduction differs from standard damage reduction; final damage reduction caps at 50%, whereas standard damage reduction can go as high as 99%.

Chen Mo was now facing an enemy whose Divine Power was a full 100 points higher than his own. This meant Chen Mo couldn't inflict any effective damage whatsoever. Whether he tried to apply status effects or deal direct damage, any attempt would be nullified by the sheer disparity in Divine Power.

This was the chasm between gods and mortals! A 100-point difference in Divine Power represented the inviolable majesty of gods!

However, this kind of situation was significantly mitigated within the Tower of Eternity. The Tower of Eternity contained numerous chaos treasures and Eternal Divine Weapons capable of bridging such Divine Power gaps.

But this was only a way for gods to bridge the gap between them.

Currently, Chen Mo, apart from the God-Exploding Pill he had just obtained, had no other means to bridge this gap in Divine Power.

However, he didn't want to use the God-Exploding Pill at this moment.

Such a precious item, using it here feels like a waste.

After all, so what if the opponent's Divine Power was 100 points stronger than his? As long as they couldn't kill him and he survived the first minute, there would be plenty of opportunities to finish them off later.

Scattering the Skeleton Monsters around him, Chen Mo lay on the ground, closing his eyes to rest his mind, waiting for the BOSS to arrive.

Through the thin white gauze, it could be seen that the being was genderless. While many features were human-like, apart from a slightly raised chest, she had no sexual characteristics on her body.

Her appearance was somewhat reminiscent of a human female.

In her hand, she held a gold-plated longbow adorned with two small feathers, and a quiver was tied at her waist. As soon as she arrived in the arena, she immediately fixed her gaze on Chen Mo.

Chen Mo wasn't truly idle; he began to perceive the enemy's attributes.

The last time, with the Thunder God Avatar, he'd nearly been caught out by not carefully analyzing the enemy's abilities. This time, Chen Mo made sure to examine every detail meticulously.

Eight hundred thousand attack power, and all her abilities enhance damage output. Quite powerful indeed.

Especially her first Skill, Chaos Arrow Rain.

This Skill could summon a vast rain of arrows, and the damage was double the base damage, meaning each arrow could inflict two million damage. Furthermore, the damage type was Chaos, which ignored damage reduction.

Considering only defensive power, Chen Mo's Skeleton Monsters had absolutely zero.

The opponent could inflict maximum damage directly.

And this maximum damage would then be doubled due to the 100-point difference in Divine Power.

After doubling, the damage of a single arrow would be three million two hundred thousand. One such arrow wasn't much.

But if the quantity increased, the damage would be explosive.

According to the Skill's description, there would be at least hundreds of millions of arrows. How much damage would that amount to?

Although dispersed over a large area, it would still result in a tremendous amount of total damage.

Even if Chen Mo had millions of Skeleton Monsters, they definitely wouldn't be able to withstand it.

Of all the Punishment Angel's abilities, this was the one Chen Mo found somewhat troublesome.

He immediately activated his Godslayer Challenger Skill, sealing her Chaos Arrow Rain.

While he was at it, he also sealed her God Arrow Exorcism.

The rest of her abilities posed basically no threat.

It wouldn't matter if she unleashed her full offensive power.

Just as the Punishment Angel appeared and was about to speak, she felt two forces of Rule Power envelop her.

"Interesting. So you're a Godslayer Challenger. Let's see if you can withstand my attacks even after sealing two of my abilities," she said.

"We'll see," Chen Mo replied with a laugh, lying leisurely on the ground.

Anyway, he couldn't do anything for the first minute, so he couldn't be bothered to engage.

Seeing herself so easily dismissed by a human, the Punishment Angel was visibly angered.

Originally, she might have held back a little, but now she decided against it.

Her attack speed flared. SWISH! SWISH! SWISH! In just a single second, her hand speed was so astonishingly fast that she had launched dozens of arrows.

If not for his perception ability, Chen Mo wouldn't have even been able to track her archery speed with the naked eye.

To the naked eye, it would have seemed as if she had merely lifted her hand before a flurry of arrows flew towards him.

Since Chen Mo had no intention of dodging, BANG! BANG! BANG!
