With no other fifth-transition powerhouses present, it wasn't so easy for Chen Mo to deal with a fifth-transition monster alone. The attributes of the fifth-transition monster were extremely high, and they were different from god-grade monsters. Not every creature with Divine Power is a god-grade unit. Only those clearly labeled as god-grade units in dungeons are considered god-grade units. The normal fifth-transition rank is still far from god-grade. Due to the fragmented nature of previous explanations, some students hadn't fully grasped the relationship between corpses and resurrection. Here is a consolidated explanation.

Common Question: Can you store some of your body tissue before death to be used for resurrection?

Answer: No, you cannot.

First, resurrection Skills only apply to the corpse remaining after death. This means that whatever portion of your body was present at the moment of death constitutes valid resurrection material, even if it's subsequently damaged or separated. However, any tissue separated **before** death is useless.

Second, even if you wanted to separate parts of your body, it would be very difficult. This is because any self-inflicted harm prioritizes deducting health points rather than causing physical severance. Of course, you could have someone kill you in a safe place, then separate and preserve parts of your corpse, and subsequently be resurrected. However, according to the first rule, this "newly born" you would be considered distinct from the corpse that was just dismembered. Therefore, those tissues excised **before** this new resurrection do not count as part of **your** remains should you die again, and thus cannot serve as a resurrection medium.

Third is the commonly understood twenty-four-hour rule: if death exceeds this time, resurrection is impossible.

Fourth is the rule concerning resurrection Level and the proportion of the corpse remaining: the higher the resurrection Level, the smaller the proportion of the corpse required.
