[[Death Imprisonment]] : Units you kill cannot be resurrected (except through the unit's own innate resurrection abilities).

[[Resurrection of the Dead]] : 3/3. Upon your own death, you can consume 1 point of stored Energy to resurrect yourself. Upon the death of another, you can consume 3 points of stored Energy to resurrect them. Energy recovers at a rate of 1 point every 24 hours (recovery speed is unaffected by any haste effects). Resurrection Level: SSS!

Therefore, an SSS-level resurrection was currently the most powerful type of resurrection ability available.
