After the initial birth stage, they go through four subsequent stages: youth, growth, maturity, and complete form. During each of these stages, a pet's star level can increase by a maximum of three stars.

Pet eggs obtainable from S-level pet dungeons with a low probability are generally five-star at birth. After the initial birth stage, the pet's star level may increase by up to five stars in each subsequent stage.

Pet eggs obtainable from SS level pet dungeons with a lower probability are generally seven-star at birth. After the initial birth stage, the pet's star level may increase by up to seven stars in each subsequent stage.

Pet eggs obtainable from SSS-level pet dungeons with an extremely low probability are generally ten-star at birth. After the initial birth stage, the pet's star level may increase by up to ten stars in each subsequent stage.

As you can see, the maximum star level of the pet varies significantly with the rank.

A-Class pets can reach a maximum of only the 15th-star, while SS level pets can reach up to thirty-five stars.

The reason for such a large difference is the vast disparity in acquisition difficulty.

Even if you enter the corresponding pet dungeon, the chance of getting the corresponding pet egg is very low.

Moreover, entering the corresponding pet dungeon is difficult in the first place.

This is also one of the few opportunities to obtain a top-tier pet egg without needing to rely on stacked probabilities.

Just like Chen Mo, who directly scooped up four SSS-level pet eggs in one go from an event.

Under normal circumstances, for a Star System like Earth—which is considered a Life Planet—obtaining even one SSS-level pet egg could take hundreds of years if not for Heavenly Dao events.
