After returning home, Chen Mo immediately began synthesizing.

The first ability he synthesized was Undying Worship, which would enhance the Skeleton Monster's combat power. After some consideration, Chen Mo concluded that the Skeleton Monster's current combat capabilities were quite comprehensive. Any further enhancements should focus on attack speed or special attack attributes.

He threw all the materials into the synthesis slot.

When the synthesis results appeared, Chen Mo glanced at the ten available options. However, none of them seemed particularly appealing.

They were all negligible improvements, so Chen Mo refreshed the options immediately.

After refreshing three times, Chen Mo finally saw two promising options.

[Godspeed Worship]: Increases movement speed by 100%.

...

[Destruction Worship]: Increases damage dealt to enemies with less than 50% of their life value by 100%.

Previously, Chen Mo had copied the Rapid March skill to increase the Skeleton Monster's movement speed. Usually, the Skeleton Monster's movement speed wasn't critical, but it could be crucial at times, so having this ability prepared was definitely beneficial. Destruction Worship, on the other hand, could significantly boost attack power. Many abilities in this world only trigger when a target's Health drops to a certain percentage. Therefore, possessing the ability to exert greater pressure on low-Health units was highly advantageous, especially when an enemy was about to trigger their own abilities.

However, these still didn't quite hit the mark, so Chen Mo refreshed them again.

After three more refreshes, Chen Mo suddenly spotted an exceptionally powerful trait.

[Shield Worship]: When you possess a shield, your attack speed and movement speed increase by 100%, and all damage you inflict gains an additional 1% of your current shield points.

Seeing this trait, Chen Mo was immediately overjoyed. Didn't this give him all the abilities he wanted? Not only did it provide movement speed, but it also granted attack speed and bonus damage! Considering the current magnitude of his shield, even 1% of its value would translate into formidable additional damage! This upgrade was simply massive!

Without hesitation, Chen Mo selected the Shield Worship trait.

[Shield Worship-Black]

Profession: Skeleton Mage

Level Requirement: 5

Cooldown: 60 seconds

Effect: Consumes 100 Energy. Launches Shield Worship on all summoned creatures within a range of 'Profession Star Level × 200 meters.' This increases their attack speed and attack power by 200% and applies Null and Despair debuffs to their attacks (stackable).

If the summoned creatures possess a shield, they gain an additional 100% movement speed and attack speed, and their attacks inflict bonus damage equal to 1% of their current shield points.

Simultaneously, they gain the 'Immortal' and 'Flying' abilities for the duration of the effect.

If an enhanced unit dies while the effect is active, it will inflict Death Curse on its killer, increasing all damage the killer sustains by 5% (stackable).

The Shield Worship buff is permanent, but its effects do not stack if reapplied to the same unit.

Selectable Effects: Death, Despair, Flying, Null, Immortal, Shield.

After finalizing Shield Worship, Chen Mo immediately placed the three Infinite Healing Wave skill books into the synthesis slot.

Regarding this ability, since it could bounce infinitely, it would be best to grant it effects that could trigger multiple times. However, the skill had a significant drawback: if a target dodged the returning wave, it would automatically stop if it failed to hit anyone.

Although the bouncing speed of the Healing Wave is very fast and not easy to dodge, it doesn't prevent others from possibly being faster. So, this is also a problem that needs to be solved.

As the combination ended, Chen Mo immediately scanned the ten combination effects.

On just the first page, he spotted a rather decent combination effect.

[Amplified Healing Wave]: Each bounce of the Healing Wave adds 1% damage and healing effect.

The bouncing speed of the Healing Wave is very fast. As long as it isn't lost, the frenetic bouncing will rapidly increase the damage. This trait was definitely good.

Chen Mo hesitated a bit. Currently, Healing Wave's weak point is still that it can be dodged; the effect enhancement is secondary.

After thinking for a moment, Chen Mo decided to discard this trait.

Next, he concentrated on searching for a trait to prevent the Healing Wave from being dodged.

However, even after using all ten of his free attempts, he still hadn't seen the trait he needed.

At this point, Chen Mo couldn't help but think, Could it be that there isn't such a trait?

"I'll spend money to refresh it three more times. If it still doesn't show up, I'll choose something else that's usable," he muttered.

It was unknown whether it was because of the ten initial refreshes or if spending money really increased his luck, but on Chen Mo's first paid refresh, he managed to find the trait he wanted.

[Recursion Healing Wave]: If it loses its target, it will bounce back to the previous target and reactivate. If it continues to lose its target, it will keep bouncing back to earlier targets until it loses all previous targets.

"This is it!"

[Recursion Healing Wave-Black]

Profession: Skeleton Mage

Level Requirement: Level 15

Cooldown: 10 seconds

Effect: Consumes 500 Energy. Inflicts all units within a 'Profession Star Level x 2,000m' radius with an endlessly bouncing Infinite Healing Wave. This wave prioritizes unimpacted units; if enemies are present, it will definitely bounce back and forth between allies and enemies. The Healing Wave bounces every 0.005 seconds. Each time it touches a unit, it deals one instance of healing or damage to the target.

Heals an allied target for 'Personal Magic Attack x Profession Star Level x 200' points. This healing effect also extends to affect all friendly units within a 200-meter radius of the target.

If the healed target's Health is full, it instead deals fixed damage equivalent to the healed target's maximum life value to all units within a 200-meter radius of that target.

Deals 'Personal Magic Attack x Profession Star Level x 200' points of damage to an enemy target. This damage effect also extends to affect all enemy units within a 200-meter radius of the target.

If the damaged target's Health is completely depleted, it instead deals fixed damage equivalent to the damaged target's maximum life value to all units within a 200-meter radius of that target.

If it loses its target, it will bounce back to the previous target and reactivate. If it continues to lose its target, it will keep bouncing back to earlier targets until it loses all previous targets.

Chosen Special Effects: Wide, Rapid, Diffusion, Overflowing Damage, Infinite, Recursion

Upon upgrading the Healing Wave to Black quality, its effects were significantly improved. Not only was the range doubled, but almost all effects were doubled as well. Even the bouncing speed received an upgrade, becoming twice as fast.

With this upgrade, the Healing Wave could bounce 200 times per second.

This speed was extremely fast, making it even harder to dodge the Healing Wave than before.

Of course, now with the Recursion trait, even if others dodged it, it didn't matter; the Healing Wave would bounce forward to find someone else.

Now he could combine it with the Amplified Healing Wave he had seen earlier. He had already decided that when he synthesized the golden skill later, he would look for effects similar to Amplified Healing Wave.

Having completed the ability enhancements he needed, Chen Mo was ready to open the dungeon.

Before opening the dungeon, Chen Mo noticed Zhui Yi looking at him eagerly. It seemed Zhui Yi really wanted to stay with him.

"The Reincarnation Challenge is set to last six hours in the outside world. I have nothing to do from this afternoon through the evening. You don't need to stay here; just come into the dungeon with me."

Upon hearing Chen Mo's words, Zhui Yi immediately smiled.
