Chapter 561: Undead Command, Ghost Resurrection!_1

Chen Mo immediately checked the item's effect, which looked quite similar indeed.

[Super Divine Stone]: Can transform one of the user's non-occupational SSS-level abilities into an Above SSS-level quality!

The term "ability" here encompasses all means one possesses, including equipment, skills, and items.

Clearly, the Super Divine Stone's effects surpassed those of the Touchstone by a significant margin.

This offers such a broad range of possibilities, it momentarily left me somewhat at a loss as to which ability to upgrade.

However, before making his decision, he first reviewed the two new occupation-exclusive skills unlocked after his breakthrough.

[Undead Command·Golden Passive]: Your Undead-Summoning Items will be unaffected by any abnormal effects. However, any abnormal effect you suffer will also be mirrored onto all your Undead-Summoning Items. This effect, described in two simple sentences, was extremely straightforward.

[Ghost Resurrection·Golden Active]: You can choose to revive a creature that died within your line of sight and within the past 24 hours. Regardless of its level, species, or pre-death abilities, the resurrected creature becomes your Eternal Servant, retaining all abilities it possessed in life. Additionally, this unit will gain the special skill 'Special Undead,' achieve a permanently invincible state, and its existence will be tied to yours—it dies only if you die. However, it cannot move more than 100 meters away from you and cannot absorb damage for any other unit. (The undead summoned by this skill shares your fate, thus it will not trigger Occupational Talents.)

At first glance, this Ghost Resurrection skill seems somewhat similar to Death Summons, one of the passive skills of the Dominator of the Undead. Both skills convert a deceased unit into a summoned creature under my control. However, there are significant differences. The primary similarity is that the summoned creatures—both Special Undead and Eternal Servants—retain the abilities the deceased unit possessed in life. But the differences are numerous.

Firstly, Death Summons only works on units Chen Mo himself has killed, transforming them into Special Undead under his command. In contrast, Ghost Resurrection allows any unit that dies in Chen Mo's presence to be revived as an Eternal Servant under his command. While the pool of eligible units might not differ drastically, subtle distinctions remain.

Secondly, Special Undead are temporary, whereas Eternal Servants can exist indefinitely.

Thirdly, Death Summons creates a Special Undead possessing the power the unit had in life. However, the undead obtained through Ghost Resurrection are more than that; these Eternal Servants also gain the special skill 'Special Undead.'

This 'Special Undead' skill is the same one possessed by undead summoned via the Undead Summoning Divine Skill, granting the resurrected creature all the characteristics of a Skeleton summon. This represents a qualitative change.

Without this skill, even a Ghost possessing the deceased unit's full abilities would be rather ordinary. But when an Eternal Servant also gains the boons equivalent to those from the Skeleton Summoning Skill, the enhancement is enormous.

Fourthly, the Eternal Servant is permanently invincible. I don't need to elaborate on how incredible invincibility is; the value of permanent invincibility is self-evident.

Considering these four points, the strength of an Eternal Servant definitively surpasses that of a Special Undead revived by Death Summons.

Chen Mo was quite satisfied after seeing the potency of these two skills. The passive skill significantly increased the stability of his summoned minions' combat strength, while the active skill would allow him to gain a powerful helper.

After reviewing these two skills, Chen Mo prepared to use the Super Divine Stone. However, deciding which SSS-level ability to upgrade to Above SSS-level requires some serious thought.

Chen Mo reviewed his current SSS-level abilities and realized there were still quite a few he wanted to upgrade.

But if he had to prioritize, the Divine Replication Seal would be at the top of the list. After all, possessing it was like having many different tools at his disposal; it was incredibly useful.

At SSS-level, it could already replicate three abilities. If upgraded to Above SSS-level, what would its effects be? That was truly something to look forward to.

After some consideration, Chen Mo decided to upgrade the Divine Replication Seal.

As he activated the Super Divine Stone with a thought, he immediately received a notification from the Heavenly Dao.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: You are using the Super Divine Stone on the "Divine Replication Seal". After activation, the "Divine Replication Seal" will transform into an origin-grade item of the same type. Confirm?]

[Confirm!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Transformation successful! You have acquired the "Origin God Seal"!]

[Origin God Seal · Origin-grade]

[Passive Effect]: When carried, it automatically records skills up to Dazzling Grade released by any unit within a range of 'Level x 100'. It can store up to (Level/10) skills (currently 3/4). This effect also works if the item is in the backpack.

[Copied Skills]: Illusion Creation, God-level Collecting Technique, Space Banishment

[Active Effect]: You can choose to use recorded skills. You can temporarily imbue a non-Dazzling Grade skill with the effects of a Dazzling Grade skill. This ability can be used once per hour and stacks up to 10 charges (10/10). (Can be activated from the backpack).

[Item Introduction]: Origin God Seal: Glimpse the world's supreme power, borrow the strength of others to achieve my path.

The upgrade is so significant!?

He had initially thought that upgrading the Origin God Seal would only increase the maximum number of copied skills and raise the replicable skill grade to Dazzling Grade.

He hadn't expected such a significant increase to the replication limit. It would continue to improve based on his Personal Level.

Furthermore, it could even allow replicated non-Dazzling Grade skills to manifest with the quality and effects of Dazzling Grade skills. This particular feature was incredibly overpowered.

It truly reflected the phrase in the item description: "Borrow the strength of others to achieve my path."

Using other people's abilities directly wasn't as potent as using them after they were replicated by the Origin God Seal.

Chen Mo immediately tried using the Illusion Creation Skill. Originally, Illusion Creation only replicated a large number of allied illusions that died in one hit and couldn't receive any buffs. But now, when cast with the Dazzling Grade effect granted by the Origin God Seal, the replicated Illusions possessed durability comparable to the original.

They could also receive any buffs. If the original unit being copied had any buffs, the replicated Illusions would also carry them. However, the Illusions' inability to use skills remained unchanged. Obviously, this was fundamental to the skill's logic.

Even so, this enhancement was significant. Previously, the Illusions shattered with a single touch and were extremely easy to clear out. Now, possessing the same durability as the original and able to receive all sorts of buffs, Chen Mo could even provide them with shields. This meant he could effectively maintain double the number of summons permanently.

Truly a one-man army.

After using the Super Divine Stone, Chen Mo decided to begin the Legendary Trial. Since the Legendary Trial would take a full day, he left Zhui Yi outside to attend class.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: You are about to enter the Trial Tower for the Legendary Trial. Regardless of how long you spend inside the Trial Tower, one day will pass in the outside world. Upon completing the Legendary Trial, whether you succeed or fail, your level cap will increase. However, please note: failing the Legendary Trial will result in the loss of all your current experience points. Dying during the Legendary Trial will not cause true death, but your level will drop!]

Chen Mo currently had a vast amount of experience points. Having cleared the first twenty floors, he felt he had a good grasp of the trials and wasn't worried. He initiated the challenge directly.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Welcome to the Divine Training Tower! Upon entering, you can challenge ten consecutive floors. Each floor offers only three challenge attempts. Failing to pass a floor after exhausting all three attempts will result in overall challenge failure. Please note: if you find yourself outmatched, it is advisable to press the 'Stop Challenge' button. Do not await defeat by death, or you will face a level demotion penalty!]

Already familiar with the process, and now possessing Moluo's Brain, Chen Mo naturally didn't need additional hints from the Heavenly Dao. He immediately initiated the trial of the twenty-first floor.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: The trial on the 21st floor of the Trial Tower now begins. The first objective is to 'Protect the Core.' The challenger must survive a lightning storm while protecting an immovable enchantment core. Lightning will periodically strike random locations, inflicting massive damage upon impact and to the surrounding area. This Heavenly Lightning deals true damage, ignoring shields and attributes; exercise extreme caution. If other units are near the enchantment core, they will absorb all incoming damage first. The more units present, the more the damage will be dispersed. Heavenly Lightning possesses a unique special resistance. Endure each initial Heavenly Lightning strike as much as possible to accumulate high Heavenly Lightning resistance; this is crucial for withstanding the power of the final Heavenly Lightning.]

After reading the Heavenly Dao's hint, Chen Mo remained completely unfazed. Even Moluo's Brain didn't bother formulating a perfect strategy. From its perspective, this trial posed no difficulty whatsoever given Chen Mo's current abilities; no strategy was needed. Even if he didn't bother to build up Heavenly Lightning resistance and simply waited quietly by the enchantment core for the final Heavenly Lightning, he wouldn't suffer any harm.

Chen Mo, naturally, had no intention of wasting effort. He went directly to the enchantment core's area and summoned over a hundred million Skeleton Monsters. [The Heavenly Path's Hint: Warning! The Heavenly Lightning in this trial is incredibly powerful. Without maximum resistance, the final Heavenly Lightning can instantly kill anything. Are you sure you want to skip to the end?]

[Confirm.]

The moment Chen Mo confirmed his choice, the sky above him abruptly churned with roiling clouds, and an incredibly terrifying Rule Energy began to gather relentlessly.

Chapter 563: Change of Reward! (Two in One)_1

You can choose to claim the Divine Power and exit, but as you progress, the Divine Power you can gain on each level will increase. Please choose wisely. Currently, you have been rewarded with 1 point of Divine Power. You can still challenge nine more stages. Do you wish to continue the challenge?]

Previously, opportunities to exit and receive rewards were only given on the fourth, seventh, and tenth levels. Unexpectedly, after the twentieth level, every level offered both an exit opportunity and rewards. Chen Mo found this quite agreeable, as it made retreating easier if one's strength proved insufficient, ensuring their efforts wouldn't be in vain.

However, Chen Mo was currently still in an exceedingly relaxed state, so he naturally accepted the next level's trial without hesitation.

That damn Heavenly Dao is really something, always keeping quiet about special rewards! Good thing I have Moluo's Brain! With Moluo's Brain, I really don't have to worry about missing out on rewards anymore. When I first heard The Heavenly Path's Hint, I was planning to go straight for the unsealing, too lazy to fight the four enemies around it. That would have been faster. After all, with two hundred million Skeleton Monsters by my side, the treasure box couldn't possibly interfere with my unsealing speed. But I never expected Moluo's Brain to analyze that defeating the four surrounding Keykeepers to get their keys and open the treasure box would yield this floor's hidden reward. Discovering this, I naturally chose to immediately eliminate the four powerful Keykeepers.

After stashing away the SSS-level Gift Pack, I feel that the two most useful rewards I've gotten so far are the outer incarnation and Moluo's Brain. They're practically like having two cheat codes. They're incredibly satisfying to use.

Having snagged an SSS-level Gift Pack for free, Chen Mo then ascended the stairs that had materialized out of thin air, proceeding to the twenty-fourth floor, his anticipation growing. I hope the Divine Trial Tower throws more hidden missions my way. That way, Moluo's Brain will truly have a chance to shine.

Chapter 565: The Light and Dark Origin Stone! (Four in One)_1

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Your trial for the 24th floor of the Trial Tower officially begins. This trial involves a confrontation between light and darkness.

The challenger must battle amidst the alternation of light and darkness to defeat this floor's Guardian.

During the Light Stage, the Guardian possesses extremely high defensive capability and increased Skill power, with the Cooldowns of all its abilities significantly lengthened (unaffected by Cooldown reduction). Conversely, during the Dark Stage, the Guardian boasts high offensive ability, with reduced Skill power and shortened Cooldowns for all its abilities (this cannot affect Skills immune to Cooldown reduction).

The challenger must wisely utilize the alternation of light and darkness in battle.

If both light and darkness coexist, the Guardian's Divine Power will increase by an additional 100 points.]

As the hint from the Heavenly Path concluded, the figure of the Guardian appeared before Chen Mo.

This Guardian showcased a unique appearance, befitting both light and darkness.

His image fluctuated with the interchange of light and darkness, presenting drastically distinct appearances.

In the Light Stage, the Guardian was enveloped in radiance, emanating a dazzling brilliance.

He was clad in armor, wore a helmet, and carried a gleaming weapon.

After examining the Light and Dark Origin Stone, Chen Mo felt it was quite useful.

Although he already possessed Extreme Calmness, a 90% cooldown reduction skill, normal cooldown reduction effects could not stack. However, the Dark Mode of the Light and Dark Origin Stone explicitly stated that its cooldown reduction effect could be stacked.

On this point alone, this Light and Dark Origin Stone had a very high value.

For some skills with long cooldown times, a mere 90% cooldown reduction was not enough.

Besides affecting skill cooldown times, the Light and Dark Origin Stone also brought a significant enhancement to skill power.

The Form of Light increased skill power but required longer cooldown times. However, sometimes, extending the cooldown time did not necessarily have a significant impact.
