However, as Chen Mo's body glowed with Golden Light and the word "Invincible" hung above his head, everyone fell into despair. How could they fight him now that he had activated his invincibility?

This invincible Skill was also one Chen Mo had copied from an Above SSS-level BOSS. It was known as Supreme Sanctuary. Combined with the Invincible Lotus, he could stay invincible for over ten seconds.

In a battle between experts, over ten seconds was a terrifyingly long time.

As soon as he activated his invincibility, Chen Mo waved his Magic Wand and unleashed a Reflected Healing Wave. Instantly, the terrifying damage from the Healing Wave exploded amongst the crowd.

Healing Wave's effect on enemies:

Inflicts damage equal to "Personal Magic Attack × profession star level × 200 points" to the target. This damage effect will also expand to affect all enemy units within a 200-meter radius of that unit.

If the target's Health is depleted, it will cause fixed damage equivalent to the damaged target's maximum life value, affecting all enemy units within a 200-meter radius of the target.

It was evident that the Healing Wave became more devastating the more concentrated the enemies were!

When Chen Mo attacked, his summoned creatures, Zhui Yi, and Zhui Yi's summoned creatures were not idle either. Hundreds of millions of Skeleton Monsters fiercely attacked this large group of top-level fourth-transition experts according to their respective professions.

Zhui Yi also cast a Healing Wave and deployed his domain. With the combined Healing Wave and domain damage from both him and Chen Mo, the damage output was already incredibly high.

Combined with the relentless assault from hundreds of millions of Skeleton Monsters—their attack power amplified to hundreds of millions of points—even an army array composed of nearly ten thousand top fourth-transition experts was completely unable to withstand this onslaught.

The army array couldn't hold on for even a second before it shattered with a CRACK.

Though these top fourth-transition experts possessed countless methods, what could they do against someone who was invulnerable and unyielding as iron?

They had also tried to activate invincibility like Chen Mo, but their invulnerability couldn't last as long.

Chen Mo's invincibility was Above SSS-level; theirs, at best, was SSS-level and lasted only about three seconds.

To remain invincible longer, their only option was to trigger an Immortality Effect upon death.

Generally, the invincibility accompanying Immortality and resurrection effects triggered upon death could provide a slightly longer period of invulnerability. However, even the invincibility from an SSS-level Immortality effect typically lasted at most about six seconds.

This was incomparable to Chen Mo's invincibility, which lasted over ten seconds. What's more, Chen Mo possessed more than one invincible Skill.

He also had the invincible Skill from the Invincible Lotus, which could extend his invincibility even further.

Actually, I don't even need to activate invincibility. If I just stood here and let them attack, they couldn't do anything to me. It's just that I don't want any unnecessary interruptions. Invincible Skills are meant to be used, after all. Why keep them just for show?

Supreme Sanctuary, when combined with the Invincible Lotus, offered extended invincibility. Even if there was a brief invincibility cooldown period between activating the two invincible Skills, using just these two consecutively in a short time meant the invincibility cooldown period would likely be a mere 0.1 seconds—practically negligible.

This was enough for Chen Mo to achieve 19 seconds of continuous invincibility.

As the army shield shattered, death began!

However, these were all top experts of the fourth-transition, and their life-preserving abilities were indeed extraordinary. After Chen Mo mowed down a wave of them, almost all had resurrection or Immortality effects that allowed them to stand up again.

At this moment, while onlookers only saw Chen Mo's wild slaughter, the top echelons of the major Star Systems were analyzing how he could openly confront nearly ten thousand top-tier fourth-transition experts and still dominate. Unfortunately, without witnessing his methods firsthand, they could only speculate blindly.

Soon, a tenth of the nearly ten thousand top-tier fourth-transition experts had been wiped out. Even if nearby players attempted to resurrect the fallen, they only received a notification: the targets were afflicted with an Unable-To-Resurrect State. Anyone Chen Mo killed could not be revived by others; only self-resurrection would work.

Nearly ten thousand top-tier fourth-transition experts, caught unprepared in a direct confrontation, were being utterly massacred by a mere second-transition player.

Now, the Yongming Star System truly had no need for further promotion. All surrounding Star Systems, strong or weak, felt a profoundly shocking and heaven-defying power!

If a second-transition individual already possessed such heaven-defying methods, what would happen if he advanced to the third-transition? And what if he reached the fourth-transition, or even the fifth-transition? Who could possibly stop him then?

However, the weaker Star Systems, already struggling with their own precarious survival, had no immediate plans to confront Chen Mo. After all, they might not even survive tomorrow, let alone the day after.

For the powerful Star Systems, however, it was a completely different story. They were already confident of victory in the first competition zone. Naturally, they had to consider how to deal with formidable future adversaries in the second zone. This second-transition player from the Solar System, whose power was so outrageously heaven-defying, absolutely could not be allowed to defeat the Yongming Star System and enter the second zone.

In an instant, numerous replies agreeing to an alliance reached the upper echelons of the Yongming Star System. Of course, even while feeling an immense threat, these other Star Systems didn't forget to exploit the situation. They demanded exorbitant terms from Yongming to maximize their own gains. Their demands were so high it was obvious at a glance that Yongming couldn't possibly agree. However, business was always negotiable. Since they made an offer, they were naturally prepared for counter-offers. That was precisely why their initial demands were so steep.

The higher-ups in the Yongming Star System laughed in exasperation upon receiving these replies.

"These vultures! They want us to eliminate their future great enemy, and they want to take a huge bite out of us in the process!"

"What's the consensus? Even if we reject all their conditions, would they really dare not deal with that kid from the Solar System? Judging by their reactions, they're clearly terrified of him too."

"That's true. However, we're the ones directly facing the Solar System first. To them, he's a future threat; to us, he's a sword of Damocles hanging right over our heads, ready to fall at any moment. We

These top-tier fourth-transition experts were completely unable to turn the tide. Spectators of the fourth competition zone were now seeing a relentless stream of death notifications popping up. A second-transition professional was on an absolute killing spree in a competition zone meant for top-tier fourth-transition experts.

It wasn't just the Star Systems competing with the Solar System for the future second zone who were terrified and shocked by Chen Mo's performance. Even other Star Systems with no direct conflicts of interest were utterly astonished by what they witnessed.

Before today, they had never imagined that a second-transition player could overcome the seemingly insurmountable chasms of contract pets and fourth-transition realms. Launching such devastating attacks against fourth-transition powerhouses was beyond their conception. They had never conceived

that a single second-transition player could slaughter nearly ten thousand top-tier fourth-transition experts, all grouped together, as easily as dicing vegetables.

Inside the dungeon, all remaining top-tier fourth-transition experts looked at Chen Mo with nothing but despair in their eyes. Many, knowing their demise was certain, chose to destroy the items in their inventories, unwilling to let Chen Mo gain any further loot from their deaths.

However, Chen Mo wasn't particularly concerned about victory points anymore. His focus was now on the final dungeon points reward. Although Chen Mo had killed all other contestants, the event instance's time had not yet concluded, and the event instance had not entirely ended either. Since he had nothing better to do, and had just acquired two SSS-level Gift Packs which, combined with the one he already possessed, brought his total to three, he decided to act. Moreover, the synthesis shop had refreshed its discounts this month. Chen Mo directly spent ten eternal gold coins to purchase a bottle of Divine Fusion Agent and synthesized these three SSS-level Gift Packs.

Regrettably, it seemed that, once again, likely due to probability balancing, another SSS-level Gift Pack of a specified type was synthesized. Chen Mo wasn't overly concerned. After all, he could now obtain Above SSS-level Gift Packs through conventional means and wasn't heavily reliant on synthesizing SSS-level Gift Packs. In fact, this type of specifiable Gift Pack was actually quite rare.

Chen Mo pondered. Currently, most of my abilities are quite comprehensive, but my curse-type abilities seem to be lacking. He decided to try and get an ability related to curse effects from the specifiable pack.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: You have successfully opened the specifiable SSS-level Gift Pack and obtained the bound item "Cursing-Thought Devil Pupil · Mythic"!]

[Cursing-Thought Devil Pupil]: At the cost of temporary blindness to the user, it inflicts a curse effect on all units within sight, forcing them into a permanent state of cursed blindness. This cursed blindness also affects their ability to perceive visual information. Once cursed, victims not only lose their sight but also their ability to process any visual information.

Directly blocking others' vision and their ability to perceive visual information is quite extreme. It might be a bit lacking, but it's better than nothing. Chen Mo still chose to use it.

Who would have thought that as he was using the Cursing-Thought Devil Pupil, the effects of his Divine Physique and Eye of Origin would be triggered.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Warning! Your Cursing-Thought Devil Pupil has been devoured!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: The Eye of Origin, as the king of all pupils, directly devoured and absorbed the power of the Cursing-Thought Devil Pupil, generating new effects.]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Your Divine Physique detected a harmful constitution and autonomously removed the negative effects from this constitution.]

With the combined effect of these two Above SSS-level Constitutions, Chen Mo's Cursing-Thought Devil Pupil vanished. In its place, the effects of the Eye of Origin changed.

[Eye of Origin]: This is the eye that appeared at the beginning of the world's origin. Once used, it will merge with your eyes.

The Eye of Origin will grant you the ability to see through anything, be it disguises, Illusions, or hidden objects... (including everything an opponent has hidden in their storage space).

It also grants you "God's perspective," allowing you to see through everything within a radius of "Level \* star level \* 10,000 meters" around you without any blind spots.

Possessing it means you effectively have the Eye of God; nothing will escape your sight.

Additionally, you can inflict the Cursing-Thought curse on all hostile units within the Eye of Origin's visual range, plunging them into a permanent cursed state where they lose all perception abilities!

Incredible! Not only are there absolutely no side effects anymore, but even the original curse effect, which only cut off visual perception, has evolved to sever all perception abilities. This truly turns people into utter cripples—deaf, blind, and devoid of touch. The thought of that is too terrifying. A person's perception of space relies on their various senses. If all senses were lost, wouldn't they lose all sense of their own location? They would undoubtedly descend into complete chaos. In such a state, forget attacking; even escaping and defending would be difficult. Because you can't perceive anything, even if an attack landed on you, unless The Heavenly Dao provided a hint that you were attacked, you would remain utterly clueless. Unless you possessed large-area attack abilities, omnidirectional defensive capabilities, or an extremely strong spatial transfer ability, once caught in this cursed state, you would be completely devoid of combat power and become a mere punching bag until the curse was lifted.

Chen Mo was quite satisfied with this curse effect; he now had another major weapon in his arsenal. For the remaining time, he quietly waited for the instance to end.

Meanwhile, the outside world was already in an uproar over his performance in the fourth competition zone. A single second-transitioner had fought and eradicated tens of thousands of top-tier fourth-transitioners. The shock this brought to everyone was indescribable.

Negotiations between the major Star Systems and the Yongming Star System regarding a joint effort against Chen Mo were almost complete. The Yongming Star System knew they would undoubtedly have to make significant concessions this time. So, they negotiated the terms, offered some benefits to the major Star Systems, and secured their cooperation. With all the major Star Systems willing to cooperate, finding a hundred five-stars was relatively easy. However, this time they were dealing with an extraordinary anomaly: a second-transitioner who could effortlessly annihilate tens of thousands of top-tier fourth-transitioners. This meant that not just any five-stars would suffice for the selection. Even if they shared the same star level, their actual capabilities varied greatly. They naturally had to carefully plan and coordinate the composition of this hundred-strong brigade of demonized five-stars. Twenty five-star Supports were absolutely indispensable. And damage dealers would evidently need to account for at least sixty slots. The remaining twenty were to fill in the gaps, covering various other necessary abilities. They aimed to achieve success in this one single endeavor!

Because only the Yongming Star System knew that their opportunity for five-star Demonization was a one-time chance. To perform the five-star Demonization, a very special component was required, one that the Yongming Star System had only managed to obtain once. That component was the Heart of a Five-Star Demon God. This item was incredibly hard to find; the Yongming Star System had only acquired one incidentally when they discovered the "Divine Blood Soul-Devouring Demonization Array". They had not found another one since. Thus, they only had this single opportunity to perform the five-star Demonization; once this material was consumed, there would be no replacement.

When the Yongming Star System shared information related to the Demonization Formation this time, this particular detail about the material was not included. After all, such a Demonization Formation was a significant deterrent, and even in such a critical moment, the Yongming Star System did not want its full capabilities to be easily exposed. The Yongming Star System handled this matter quite cleverly. Firstly, they let others know they possessed a formidable deterrent force. Simultaneously, they conveyed that this power could not be used lightly due to its immense cost. This indirectly informed others that they possessed a powerful defensive trump card. Unless the Yongming Star System itself faced a critical threat, this trump card was clearly not something to be deployed offensively. For instance, even now, when they wished to use it as an offensive measure, they still required substantial help from other Star Systems; otherwise, forming an effective threat would be very difficult.

Most importantly, this method was completely useless against fifth-transitions. Those who had seen the shared information about the "Divine Blood Soul-Devouring Demonization Array" were aware of its limitations. The Yongming Star System had directly shared information about the Demonization Formation itself. What others saw was the complete information as presented by The Heavenly Dao, so they naturally knew the Yongming Star System could not deceive them; all the information they received was genuine. According to the authentic information, the "Divine Blood Soul-Devouring Demonization Array" could only affect units below the fifth-transition. This meant that in the battles within the Tower of Eternity, this Demonization Formation was effectively useless for providing combat power. After all, once a unit's Divine Power exceeded 100, it was tantamount to completely nullifying all abilities of units lacking Divine Power.

Currently, no one in the Star Systems near the Solar System was aware that Divine Power could manifest even in individuals below the fifth-transition. Therefore, they generally held units below the fifth-transition in contempt. They feared Chen Mo, were terrified of him even, but not his current self. In their eyes, his current self could be easily crushed with a single finger if their units with Divine Power over 100 had the chance to enter the Solar System. Even if he impressively soloed tens of thousands of fourth-transitions, he was still like an ant before the overwhelming disparity in Divine Power. Such an ant, naturally, was not worthy of their fear. What they feared was the future Chen Mo, after he reached the fifth-transition and obtained Divine Power. By then, his combat strength would become terrifying to

an almost unimaginable degree. That was why, no matter the cost, they had to eliminate him as swiftly as possible!

While the major Star Systems were intensively carrying out their various plans, Earth was also bustling with activity. [Primordial Huge Hammer · Event-Exclusive Artifact]: This is a special weapon that disregards Profession Restrictions and has no attribute boosts. It possesses extreme toughness and durability. It can shatter all

equipment below SSS-level with a single strike, shatter SSS-level equipment in just three strikes, and even Above SSS-level equipment will break after no more than ten strikes from this weapon.

Outrageous! If someone went into battle carrying this hammer, they'd scare their enemies away before the fight even started. Whether they could win or not, just taking a few hits would be unbearable.

The hammer's power was indeed outrageous, and its intimidation factor was off the charts. It could even shatter Above SSS-level equipment. However, it had no practical use for him, other than disgusting others for his own amusement.

He immediately turned his attention to the other two rewards.

[Endless Elixir · Event-Exclusive Item]: This elixir is refined from numerous medicinal ingredients that are now extinct. It is the only one of its kind in the world. Directly applying it to another person's skin has the same effect as them drinking it, including resurrection.

Drinking the Endless Elixir instantly and fully restores the drinker's Life and Energy, removes all negative effects and curse statuses, and renders the drinker invincible with no Skill Cooldowns for 10 seconds. The resurrection effect works even on targets under effects that would normally prevent resurrection. The elixir is contained in a Time-Reversal Treasure Bottle, which can infinitely refill itself. Each refill takes one minute.

What an incredible elixir! Its effects are off the charts! Resurrection with full health and mana, invincibility, and no Cooldowns. The invincibility even lasts for 10 seconds. It's so powerful!

If he didn't already possess abilities similar to those described for the Endless Elixir, he would have wanted to redeem it immediately. Even so, the Endless Elixir remained highly attractive. After all, it could be used on others. His own abilities ultimately only benefited himself, but the Endless Elixir could significantly boost an ally's combat power, making it an extremely potent Support tool.

With this power, you'll never have to worry about not truly knowing someone's heart again.

The abilities he had mastered before were mostly within the realm of quantifiable data. This mind-reading ability, however, surpassed his understanding of the Heavenly Dao's capabilities. To max out an SS level pet takes 1,000 years.

And an SSS-level pet takes 10,000 years.

During this period, you can feed them growth-accelerating food to speed up the process. However, for SSS-level pets, it's still very slow. To raise them from the growth stage to the maturity stage without advancement items, even with sufficient growth-accelerating food, their daily digestion is limited. At best, it would take ten years. Reading the main quest introduction left them feeling somewhat muddled.

Yusheng Liuyin didn't quite understand what this instance required them to do, only that there were three major BOSSes.

Meanwhile, Chen Mo's Moluo's Brain was rapidly processing and analyzing a great deal of information.

Upon comprehending the analysis from Moluo's Brain, a hint of wild joy touched Chen Mo's face.

He hadn't expected that in this chaotic instance of time, space, and illusory reality, one could deliberately enter distorted time-spaces to challenge BOSSes of various difficulties.

Although killing BOSSes in the wrong time-spaces wouldn't contribute to the final instance rewards, this instance was undoubtedly a prime location for farming materials. One could traverse various time-spaces, kill all sorts of monsters, and gather diverse materials.

Chen Mo currently had a host of Skills that still needed upgrading. He desperately needed an instance like this; it was perfect for raising ability tiers.

After continuous synthesis from purple gold-grade, upon reaching Artifact Level, the Balanced Magic Wand had transformed directly into Death's Scepter!

Death's Scepter now possessed two additional special effects compared to the Balanced Magic Wand, and its attributes were also significantly improved. Chen Mo utilized the reset feature in the synthesis function to remove any obsolete abilities from Death's Scepter.

Abilities like Energy Missile, Shared Fate, and Thousand-mile were already outdated.

Magic Attack:  $(\text{Profession Star Level} + \text{Equipment Level}) * 600 * (3 + \text{Reincarnation times})$

Attack Speed:  $(\text{Profession Star Level} + \text{Equipment Level}) * 300 * (3 + \text{Reincarnation times})$

Energy Recovery Speed:  $(\text{Profession Star Level} + \text{Equipment Level}) * 300 * (3 + \text{Reincarnation times}) / 10$  seconds

Wisdom:  $(\text{Profession Star Level} + \text{Equipment Level}) * 120 * (3 + \text{Reincarnation times})$

Spirit:  $(\text{Profession Star Level} + \text{Equipment Level}) * 120 * (3 + \text{Reincarnation times})$

[Equipment Special Effects]: Balance, Calamity, Death, Authority, Gigantification, Whole Domain

[Calamity]: Your attacks will inflict the Calamity Curse on the target, causing their attacks and skills to have a 50% chance of failing.

[Death]: Your attacks have a 10% chance to instantly kill the target (ineffective against units with Divine Power higher than yours). If the target is not killed, they will be afflicted with the Death God's Curse, reducing all their All Attributes by 50%!

[Authority]: For every point of Divine Power you possess, all attributes of this weapon increase by 1%.

[Gigantification]: All your summoning skills have a 10% chance to summon creatures with attributes and size increased tenfold.

[Whole Domain]: The minimum effective range of all your abilities is increased to your perceptual range.

With its new special effects, Death's Scepter became extremely powerful. It was capable of instant kills and crowd control, incorporated a significant attribute boost based on Divine Power, and even greatly enhanced summoned creatures and skill range.

Its practicality was vastly improved compared to before.

Chen Mo was very satisfied with this new Artifact Level weapon.

He immediately set his sights on the next target.

Next were the materials for the Retrospective Shield.

Watching Chen Mo enter a Space-Time Rift, emerge after a few dozen seconds, and then immediately dive into another, Yusheng Liuyin thought he was using this rapid entry and exit method to track down the final BOSS.

Soon, Chen Mo gathered all the materials for the shield from another Space-Time Rift, enough to upgrade the shield Skill to gold grade.

As he tossed the materials into the synthesis interface, the new shield Skill reappeared before Chen Mo.

[Universal Shield·Gold]

[Profession]: Skeleton Mage

[Level Requirement]: Level 10

[Cooldown]: 30 seconds

[Effect]: Consumes at least 100 Energy to grant all allied units within a 'Profession Star Level x 500 meters' radius a shield. This shield possesses shield points equal to  $5 * (100 + \text{Profession Star Level})$  times the amount of Energy consumed, can resist any damage, and lasts indefinitely.

When an enemy damages a unit protected by this shield, the shielded unit gains 'Frenzy,' increasing its attack speed by 100%. This also triggers 'Lightning Chain Retaliation.' The retaliation damage is equal to 'your Magic Attack' and deals fixed damage equivalent to the 'shield's original maximum shield points' to the unit that ultimately breaks the shield.

If the shield breaks or is dispelled, a new shield is automatically reapplied (this effect triggers only once).

The shield points can be used as universal consumables. All types of damage or resource costs, whether health or Energy, can be primarily deducted from the shield points instead (this specific characteristic does not apply to the Energy cost of casting this shield Skill itself).

Available Special Effects: Electrocutation, Reality, Mutual Destruction, Large Amount, Frenzy, Continuation, Universal.

Chen Mo chose the Universal special effect not just for himself, but primarily for his summoned creatures and allies.

Although the Skeleton Monsters possessed various skills upon being summoned, their energy value was fixed at a pitiful 100 points, preventing them from using many low-level Skills.

Furthermore, skills that consumed resources like fighting intent value or rage value required gradual accumulation.

Now, with the Universal Shield, these cumbersome requirements were gone. Skills could be cast directly by deducting shield points, which was extremely convenient.

Especially for forbidden curses and forbidden attacks that demanded significant resource consumption, Chen Mo's Universal Shield could bear these costs. This allowed many units with such abilities to use them without personal expenditure, significantly enhancing their combat power.
