Chapter 631: Perfect Level Up Instance! (Two in One) _3

Meanwhile, the effects of some skills were related to the amount of Energy consumed; the more Energy consumed, the more potent the effects. If a forbidden curse with such an effect were combined with Chen Mo's Universal Shield's shield quantity, the devastation could reach a planetary destruction level. For these reasons, Chen Mo had opted for this universal attribute.

Having dealt with the shield Skill, Chen Mo continued to work overtime on the next Skill. The next was the Worship Skill. It took him only a few dozen seconds to gather the materials needed to upgrade it to Gold quality.

[Worshipping the God of Death·Gold]

Profession: Skeleton Mage

Level Requirement: 5

Cooldown: 60 seconds

Effect: Consumes 100 Energy points, activates Worshipping the God of Death for all summoned entities within a 'Profession star level x 500 meters' radius, increasing their attack speed and attack power by 300%, and afflicting their targets with Apathy and Despair, stackable.

If they possess a shield, they gain an additional 100% movement speed and attack speed, and their attacks deal bonus damage equal to 1% of their current shield points.

Moreover, they gain the 'Immortal' and 'Flying' abilities for the duration.

If they die during this period, they inflict the Death Curse on their killer, increasing all damage the killer suffers by 5%, stackable.

The Worshipping the God of Death effect lasts indefinitely, but its effects do not stack when reapplied to the same unit.

While Worshipping the God of Death is active, each summoned entity will be equipped with the 'Reaper Suit' of its corresponding profession. The Reaper Suit's level will be the same as the caster's Level!

Selectable Effects: Death, Despair, Skyward Flight, Apathy, Immortal, Shielded, Reaper

Chen Mo had reviewed the Reaper Suit. It was exceptionally powerful, able to directly increase the power of skills cast by the wearer by a factor of their Personal Level. It could also inflict various random god-grade dark curses and was extremely suppressive.

If Worship Skills weren't restricted to summoned entities, he would have wanted a set for himself.

Now, only the Healing Skill and the Honor Brave Challenger Suit were not yet maxed out. Without delay, Chen Mo immediately began upgrading his Healing Skill. He had already planned the upgrade path for his Healing Skill. After rapidly gathering the necessary materials, Chen Mo also upgraded his Healing Wave Skill to Gold quality.

[Endless Healing Wave-Gold]

Profession: Skeleton Mage

Level Requirement: 15

Cooldown: 10 seconds

Effect: Consumes 500 Energy points to cast an Endless Healing Wave on all units within a 'Profession star level x 5,000 meters' radius. The wave preferentially bounces to unaffected units; if enemies are nearby, it is bound to bounce back and forth between allies and enemies. The Healing Wave bounces every 0.005 seconds, healing or damaging each unit it touches.

On allied targets, it provides healing equal to your 'Personal Magic Attack x Profession star level x 500 points'. This healing effect also extends to all friendly units within a 500-meter radius of the target.

If a healed target's Health is already full, it instead inflicts area fixed damage equal to the healed target's maximum life value, affecting a 500-meter radius around that target unit.

On enemy targets, it deals damage equal to your 'Personal Magic Attack x Profession star level x 500 points'. This damage also extends to all enemy units within a 500-meter radius of the target.

If an enemy target's Health is depleted by this damage, it inflicts area fixed damage equal to the target's maximum life value, affecting a 500-meter radius around that target unit.

If the wave loses its current target, it returns to the previous target to strike again. If it continues to lose targets, it will keep returning to prior targets until all preceding targets are gone.

Each time the Healing Wave bounces, its healing and damage amounts increase by 1%. This effect has no upper limit!

Selectable Effects: Broad-ranging, Rapid, Spreading, Overflowing Damage, Infinite, Bouncing Back, Endless

Chen Mo had wanted to acquire the Endless effect previously. However, he considered the Bouncing Back effect more important than Endless, so he had chosen Bouncing Back first. After all, without the Bouncing Back effect, the Endless effect could be easily interrupted, diminishing its value. Things are different now. With Bouncing Back combined with Endless, as long as the Healing Wave isn't easily lost, the multiplier will accumulate incredibly quickly!

Chapter 632: Deified Brave Suit! (Two in One)_1

Having addressed all his skills, Chen Mo turned his attention to the Honor Brave Challenger Suit. This top-grade armor, which automatically leveled up with him, was exceptionally powerful. It had already been synthesized to Dark-gold Grade initially and now only required one more synthesis to reach Artifact Level.

Chen Mo quickly used Moluo's Brain to identify the required materials and their corresponding Space-Time Rifts, then entered them for an intensive farming spree. He swiftly collected all the necessary materials.

He tossed the three pieces of the Honor Brave Challenger Suit, prepared long ago, into the synthesis slot. In no time, a brand new Brave Suit materialized before him.

[Deified Brave Challenger Suit • Artifact Level]

[Special Restriction]: Only those with the title of The God of Bravery can equip it.

[Equipment Level]: Same as Character Level

[Equipment Attributes]:

energy value: $(\text{Class Star Level} + \text{Equipment Level}) * 15,000 * (3 + \text{Number of Rebirths})$

[Assimilation]: Can absorb the special effects of other armor, but the total number of special effects cannot exceed the equipment level.

[Mirage]: Can be glamourised into any type of clothing (cannot be seen through).

[Isolation]: Blocks all detection abilities not exceeding this equipment's grade (Currently SSS-level).

[Divine Guard]: All incoming damage, except true damage, is reduced by 50%!

[Glory]: All attributes increased by (Class Star Level + Equipment Level)%.

[Barrier]: Automatically resists any control and abnormal status effects. Can also be actively used to remove such effects from others. The number of resistances/removals equals the equipment level. Recovers 1 resistance/removal charge every 5 seconds. Current charges: 60/60.

[knowledge]: Experience gain rate increased by 100%.

[Harvest]: Item drop rate increased by 100%.

[Bounty]: 50% chance for double item drops.

[Deification]: Allows usage of abilities ignoring Divine Power requirements!

[Equipment Description]: Only a brave person who has attained pinnacle glory can wear this Extraordinary Suit. An ordinary person will not be able to bring out any of its effects.

Upon synthesizing the Honor Brave Challenger Suit, Chen Mo gained an extremely powerful characteristic. The Deification characteristic allowed him to ignore any Divine Power requirement!

This characteristic might not seem immediately useful, but Chen Mo was preparing for his future entry into the Tower of Eternity. The Tower of Eternity houses exceptionally unique items, such as Eternal

Divine Weapons, Eternal Divine Objects, and Eternal Divine Skills. These items are not classified within the same tier system as conventional items. Their potency is solely determined by their Divine Power requirement. Generally, those without a Divine Power requirement are the weakest of their type.

Previously, while climbing the Divine Trial Tower, Chen Mo had received gifts from some god-grade entities, acquiring a few Eternal Divine Weapons. However, they were all of the lowest grade, requiring no Divine Power. It wasn't that these entities lacked better items; rather, Chen Mo's Divine Power was too low for him to utilize them.

But now, with the Deification characteristic, things were different. Wearing the Deified Brave Challenger Suit, Chen Mo could directly use any Eternal series items he obtained, regardless of their Divine Power requirements. For example, many powerful individuals on Earth currently possessed Eternal series treasures they couldn't activate or use due to insufficient Divine Power. They had to wait until their Divine Power increased to the necessary level before they could use them.

Ignoring the warning from The Heavenly Path's Hint, Chen Mo flew directly into the area. With a Divine Flicker, he instantly arrived at the very center—a vast, distorted spatial structure characterized by the most chaotic and fractured space. This was the domain of Space Lord Clarks, just as The Heavenly Path's Hint had described.

However, at first glance, the Lord of Space was nowhere to be seen; it was a simple trick. The entity had hidden itself within three layers of space rifts. To awaken Clarks, he needed to strike a peculiar, energy-laden spherical space rift at the center of this area three times. Clarks was currently in a deep sleep.
