As Chen Mo chose to accept, a wave of surging energy from the ethereal void flowed directly into his body, making him feel as though his soul was about to ascend from the exhilaration.

Every acceptance of power made Chen Mo feel incredibly wonderful.

It was a pity that each experience was incredibly short-lived.

Less than half a minute later, the power inheritance was over.

At that moment, The Heavenly Path's Hint sounded again.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Congratulations on accepting the legacy of the previous Dominator of the Undead. Your current Profession is "Third-transition Dominator of the Undead · 20-stars"!] ]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Due to the successful transition of your Profession, you have received a chance to reset your attributes. Do you wish to do so?]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Due to your Profession successfully reaching the third-transition, you have unlocked the "Soul-Contract Ability." Relevant enhancement items have been unlocked for drops and acquisition. You can obtain related items from subsequent rewards to continuously strengthen your pet's abilities.]

Upon hearing this hint, Chen Mo laughed. He had already advanced into the fourth-transition activity area and acquired relevant items from the fourth-transition activity store. He didn't need to unlock any subsequent rewards; he could use them directly now.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Since your total professional star level has reached the 25th-star, the attribute points you gain from leveling up for free allocation will be quintupled!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Influenced by your SSS-level title 'First Transcender,' the attribute points you gain from leveling up for free allocation will be multiplied sixfold! You will now gain 750 free attribute points per level.]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: As your Profession has been promoted to a third-transition Profession, your Profession has been significantly enhanced!]

[Profession]: Dominator of the Undead (Third-transition, 20-star)

[Occupational Talent]: Lord of the Undead

[[ Lord of the Undead]] : As long as there are Undead Units summoned by you within 'Level \* star level \* 400 meters' of you, you will not die for any reason. You have an Undead Containment Space that can contain up to 'Level \* star level \* 400' Ghosts. Ghosts placed inside the Undead Containment Space will ignore their duration and exist permanently. However, when released, their duration countdown will resume.

[Profession Exclusive Passive Skills]: Dominator's Appearance, Undead Rally, Death Summons, The Undead's Fear, Undead Command, Locked (Unlocked when breaking through the 12th-tier bottleneck).

[[ Dominator's Appearance-The Golden Passive]] : All your Undead Summoning skills can be cast instantly and can ignore any summoning conditions (e.g., energy consumption, need for special materials).

[[ The Undead's Gathering-The Golden Passive]] : When summoning Ghosts, you have a 1/X chance to summon X times the usual number of Ghosts. This check starts with the highest multiplier (maximum of 'Level \* 40' times) and proceeds to lower multipliers, with checks tiered for every 10x.

[[ The Death Summon-The Golden Passive]] : All units killed by you or your summons will resurrect as Special Undead with the strength they had during their lifetime, for you to command! Special Undead can only be contained in a Special Containment Space. Each Special Undead can survive outside this space for a maximum of 4 minutes. Placing them in the Special Containment Space allows them to exist permanently. Each time they are summoned from the space, their 4-minute duration refreshes. [[ The Undead's Fear-The Golden Passive]] : For every Undead-Summoning Item you possess, enemy units within a 'Level \* star level \* 300 meters' radius will lose 1 point of dual defense!

[[ Undead Command-The Golden Passive]] : Your Undead-Summoning Items will be immune to all negative effects. However, any negative effects you suffer will be mirrored onto all your Undead-Summoning Items.

[Profession Exclusive Active Skills]: Undead Summoning-God, Order of Dominance, Dominator's Power, Undead Creation, Ghost Resurrection, Locked (Unlocked when breaking through the 12th-tier bottleneck).

[[ Undead Summoning-God-Golden Active]] : Can be used once every 3 hours, summoning a powerful Ghost. The Ghost's Level changes synchronously with your Level. There is a 100% chance of summoning a medium-rank Ghost, a 40% chance of summoning a top-tier Ghost, a 4% chance of summoning a super-rank Ghost, and a 0.04% chance of summoning a god-tier Ghost. The summoned powerful Ghosts can exist permanently, up to a maximum of 'your Level \* 4' simultaneously. Powerful Ghosts that cannot be made permanent will be sent back to the Undead Realm after 4 hours. (Summoning chances are checked starting from the highest rank).

[[ Dominator's Power-Golden Active]] : You can absorb the power of all Undead Units you summoned, increasing your own attribute values by an amount equivalent to the attributes of all absorbed Undead Units and mastering their active skills. This effect lasts for 30 minutes, with a 30-minute Cooldown. While Dominator's Power is active, you cannot perform any summons. (Each low-level Ghost increases attribute values by 1%; each medium-rank Ghost by 2%; each top-tier Ghost by 5%; each super-rank Ghost by 10%; and each god-tier Ghost by 100%.)

[[ Undead Creation-Golden Active]] : Immediately revive all friendly units that have died within a 'Level \* star level \* 300 meters' radius of you, with the resurrection being SSS-level. The Cooldown is 6 hours (unaffected by any cooldown reduction effects). If a target has a resurrection restriction, this skill will instead remove that restriction.

[[ Ghost Resurrection-Golden Active]] : You can choose to resurrect a creature that died within your line of sight within the past 48 hours, regardless of its level, species, or abilities during its lifetime. The resurrected creature will become your Eternal Servant and retain all its former abilities. Additionally, this unit will gain the special skill 'Special Undead' and be in a permanently invincible state. It will share life and death with you; only your death will cause it to die. However, it cannot move more than 100 meters away from you and cannot bear damage for any other units. (The Ghost summoned by this skill shares your fate, thus it does not trigger your Occupational Talent.)

With the completion of his third-transition, all of Chen Mo's skills were significantly enhanced. He was about to undergo the 12th-tier Realm Breakthrough Assessment, which would soon unlock two new skills.

However, before carrying out the Realm Breakthrough Assessment, Chen Mo immediately took out the chaos-grade pet egg he had been eager to incubate!

Chen Mo thought, feeling a slight thrill of anticipation, I wonder what will hatch.

Chapter 648: Abnormal Chaos Pet, Dual Soul Contract!\_1

Due to the long hatching period of the chaos-grade pet egg, Chen Mo retrieved a large quantity of speed-up hatching materials he had previously exchanged from event dungeons and began to accelerate the pet egg's incubation.

Before starting, Chen Mo first attempted a three-in-one synthesis to see if he could enhance the effect of the Incubation Stones.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: You have obtained a Super Incubation Stone.]

[Super Incubation Stone]: After use, it can reduce the pet egg's remaining hatching time to one-tenth of its current duration.

It really can enhance the effect! Originally, one stone reduced it by half; now, one reduces it to a tenth. The improvement is significant.

Chen Mo calculated the efficiency. Using three regular Incubation Stones would halve the remaining time three times. So, an original 10,000 hours would become 1,250 hours, equivalent to one-eighth of the original duration. After synthesis, a single Super Incubation Stone reduced it to one-tenth, meaning it only took 1,000 hours. This offered a substantial gain. The potency had definitely improved.

"Zhui Yi, what do you think we should name it? I'm not very good at naming things," Chen Mo asked, glancing at Zhui Yi beside him.

Zhui Yi smiled and said, "My Lord, my naming skills are about on par with yours."

At this, Chen Mo couldn't help but laugh. "Then just suggest something random."

"How about Xiao Hui?"

"It's a bit simple, but not bad. Let's go with Xiao Hui."

[Name]: Xiao Hui

[Growth Period]: Newly Hatched Stage (50-star)

[Affection]: 100 (Beloved)

(Affection will affect the pet's combat desire. If affection is too low, the pet may not participate in battles, and the profession star level bonus it provides will also be reduced proportionally.)

[Gender]: Female

[Race]: Chaos Kind

[Species]: Chaos Beast

[Level]: 60

[Experience]: ???/??? (Cannot gain experience points due to skill effects)

[Attribute]: All Attributes = Level × Star Level × 100

[Skills]: Chaos Origin Force, Transcendent Growth, Chaos Breath, Source Change, Passive-Locked (Unlocked in infancy), Active-Locked (Unlocked in infancy)

[Chaos Origin Force - Passive]: A species born in Chaos, it is immune to the erosion of all forces other than Chaos Power (immune to all abnormal statuses and curses). All its attacks are imbued with Chaos Power (this damage cannot be negated except by Chaos Armor).

[Transcendent Growth - Passive]: Unable to gain experience points, but always maintains the same level as its owner.

[Chaos Breath - Active]: Launches Chaos Breath at all enemy units within a [Level × Star Level × 100 meters] radius. This deals [All Attributes × Level × 10] points of Chaos Damage and randomly inflicts the target with ten potent, non-negatable, and non-dispellable abnormal statuses that last for a duration equal to the pet's Personal Level in minutes.

[Source Change - Active]: This pet can transform into any creature below chaos-grade. Its transformed size cannot be more than [Level × Star Level] times larger or smaller than its original size. It also gains the racial skills of the creature it transforms into.

HISS! What an incredible creature! It's already so heaven-defying in its newly hatched stage?!

After reviewing the attributes of the newly hatched Chaos Beast, Chen Mo was dumbfounded. This was too perverse!
