Chapter 661: The Difference in the Last Level! (Two-in-One)_1

After Chen Mb skipped the Level 90 Realm Breakthrough Assessment, he once again obtained a Super Divine Stone and an Above SSS-level Gift Pack.

Chen Mb decided to use this Super Divine Stone on the "Omnipotent Transformer."

Although the current "Omnipotent Transformer" was perfectly adequate, Chen Mb was still curious about the extent to which it could be improved. He was particularly curious if the "Omnipotent Transformer" could manifest a conversion for Chaos Damage. Still, since it's only an upgrade to an Above SSS-level standard, it's understandable if it doesn't gain a Chaos Damage conversion, he reasoned.

Upon using the Super Divine Stone, The Heavenly Path's Hint immediately followed.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: You are using a Super Divine Stone on the "Omnipotent Transformer" item. Once effective, the "Omnipotent Transformer" will transform into an origin-grade item of the same type. Confirm!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Conversion successful! Your "Omnipotent Transformer" has evolved into the "Super-Omnipotent Transformer"!]

["Super-Omnipotent Transformer" · Origin-grade]

[Passive effect]: You can select one of seven damage types: Physical, Spell, Siege, Fixed Damage, Chaos Damage, True Damage, or Divine Might Damage. The damage you inflict will be converted to the selected type. This effect has no Cooldown, can be switched freely, and is always active. (Effective even when in inventory.)

[Active Effect]: When activated, you can convert the attack type of any number of your summons to any of the seven damage types: Physical, Spell, Siege, Fixed Damage, Chaos Damage, True Damage, or Divine Might Damage. The effect remains active continuously, but switching types incurs a mandatory 30-second Cooldown that is 'unaffected by Cooldown reduction'. (Effective even when in inventory.)

[Item Introduction]: A legendary item capable of converting various damage types. It is said to have been created by a god of invention known as the God of Omnipotence. However, no one has ever seen this deity in person, so the truth of these rumors remains unknown!

Divine Might Damage is a damage type encountered only after entering the Tower of Eternity. Typically, only units that have condensed a divine character can inflict this type of damage.

Calculations for Divine Might Damage must involve Divine Might Armor. Otherwise, against units without Divine Might Armor, Divine Might Damage directly ignores the target's defensive power. It inflicts fixed critical damage equivalent to a multiple of one's own Divine Power. Furthermore, this damage bypasses damage reduction effects.

This is an exceedingly fearsome damage type. It is also why god-grade beings regard non-god-grade beings as mere ants.

If a fifth-transition individual views those below the fifth-transition as ants, then units that have condensed a divine character similarly view those without one as ants.

Even an ordinary god-grade being like Chen Mo would find it difficult to withstand an attack using Divine Might Damage from an enemy who has condensed a divine character. After all, before condensing a divine character, armor type is generally determined by one's profession.

Professions like Chen Mo's Skeleton Mage, which scale with Wisdom and Spirit attributes, belong to the Cloth Armor Class Profession. Professions such as archers and assassins, which scale with strength and agility attributes, belong to the leather armor class. Professions such as warriors and Knights, which scale with strength and Constitution attributes, belong to the heavy armor class.

Among these, hidden professions can possess special armor types. For example, Chen Mo's current class, Dominator of the Undead, has special Chaos Armor. Attacks, whether Physical or Magic Damage, are significantly reduced. Even Chaos Damage attacks have much of their damage mitigated.

Beyond these, there are other special armor types like city armor, true-armor, and hero armor. These provide varying defensive bonuses against different damage types.

Having successfully obtained another 55 points of Divine Power, Chen Mo proceeded to the Level 95 Realm Breakthrough Assessment.

As usual, he skipped it directly.

Chen Mo once again obtained a Super Divine Stone.

But this time, Chen Mo chose not to use it, as his abilities had almost finished Transcending. He planned to save three to see if he could synthesize a Chaos God Stone.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Congratulations, your Level has increased! Current Level: 99! Due to your Level increase, your divine element has also increased. Based on your profession's star level, you have gained 3.3 divine element points.]

[Experience]: $6,276,826,699 / (1000 - \text{age} * 10)$ hundred million

As he was about to reach Level 100, Chen Mo saw the special requirement for experience points. Unlike the fixed experience points requirement for Level 99, the experience points needed to reach Level 100 were actually related to age.

The older one was, the lower the experience point requirement.

[Alliance Hierarch Jiang]: He went in seven days ago. Calculating the time, he should be out soon. If he doesn't come out after ten days, he's dead inside.

[Chen Mo]: Is this dungeon very dangerous?

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Welcome to the challenge of the Surpassing Dungeon. This dungeon has a difficulty multiplier of 34,560. After clearing it, your Level will increase by 1, ignoring experience point requirements!]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: The main dungeon task has been issued. This dungeon's main task is a surpassing challenge. You must sequentially challenge Level 100 BOSSes of one-star to five-stars difficulty. Each BOSS has a 1-hour kill time limit, and this time limit can be accumulated. Defeat all BOSSes within the cumulative time limit to complete this dungeon.]

If the time limit can be accumulated, then as long as all the BOSSes are killed within five hours, it should be fine, Chen Mo thought. However, with a 34,560 times multiplier, I wonder how much Health these BOSSes will have.

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Warning! Warning! This dungeon has been gatecrashed! The intruders are from the Yongming Star System, Kaiyang Star System, Fairy Star System...!]

Until all intruders are cleared or the dungeon task is completed, no one can leave the dungeon!

Number of intruders this time: 100!

As you are the one being gatecrashed, you will unconditionally receive complete information on all intruders!

As you are the one being gatecrashed, and the intruders outnumber you by 99, you gain a 99x damage multiplier against intruders.

As the current dungeon has changed to a gatecrashed dungeon, both sides may select one chaotic entry rule! You may forfeit this choice if you do not wish to select one.]

Intruders? What's going on? So many Star Systems have gatecrashed? Chen Mo was somewhat stunned by The Heavenly Path's Hint. Seeing the long list of Star Systems the intruders hailed from, he thought, Good heavens, it looks like a grand alliance has formed to raid this dungeon!

Moreover, Chen Mo was even more surprised after learning their information. These individuals were all five-star Demonizers, and each possessed Above SSS-level skills. Furthermore, they all possessed Divine Power and a Demon God divinity called "The Stronger the Foe, The Stronger I Become." According to the description of this Demon God divinity, if a nearby unit possessed higher Divine Power, their own hidden Divine Power would instantly rise to match the target's.

Currently, in the arena, the unit with the highest hidden Divine Power was the dungeon BOSS—Chen Mo's clone. Due to the 34,560 times enhancement, this clone's hidden Divine Power reached a staggering 34,560 points. This meant all the five-star Demonizer professionals present now also possessed 34,560 points of hidden Divine Power.
