Chapter 67 Divine Artifact - Second Component! (1/5)_1

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Congratulations on receiving extra rewards from the great path. You have obtained the mythical-grade equipment "The Turbid God's Heart"!]]

[The Heavenly Path's Hint: Your Level has increased, current Level 11!]]

After reviewing all the hints, Chen Mo immediately checked the effects of the rewards he had received.

[Stellar Shift • Mythical-grade]

[Passive Effect]: When carried, a Stellar Shift Shield covers the user. While the shield is active, any control or abnormal status effects the user suffers will automatically be transferred to a random nearby enemy unit. If the shield is lost, a new shield is gained every 10 seconds, and this shield lasts permanently. (Effective even when in the backpack)

[Active Effect]: When activated, all damaging effects from an attack on the holder can be redirected to the attacker themselves, lasting for 3 seconds. Cooldown: 30 seconds. (Can be activated even when in the backpack)

[Important Note]: This item is an important component of a certain divine artifact. Handle with care!

[Item Introduction]: A treasure created by a powerful existence, according to rumors. It was originally intended as a core component for a divine artifact but was lost to the mortal realm during the upheaval of the great Dao. If you happen to find it, please store it with utmost care. In the future, you might be able to find that divine artifact and regain astonishing Divine Power!

Indeed, it's this 'Stellar Shift.' Although it will lead to a death competition, its effects are truly highly practical! With the Space-Time Pearl and Stellar Shift, if they really come, it seems I wouldn't need to be afraid?

As he said this, Chen Mo immediately shook his head with a smile; he had, it seemed, habitually overlooked the opponent's combat strength. If the opponent also triggered the task, wouldn't they also possess three mythical-grade equipment? Their power would likely be no less than what he had.
